[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an anti-water splash shield for bathtubs, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left end elevational view of an anti-water splash shield for bathtubs showing my new design. FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof. FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof. FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof. FIG. 5 is a right end elevational view thereof. FIG. 6 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken on line 6-6 of FIG. 2.
