FIG. 1 is a plan view looking into the end of the tubular post, FIG. 2 is a front elevation of the post, and FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the post.

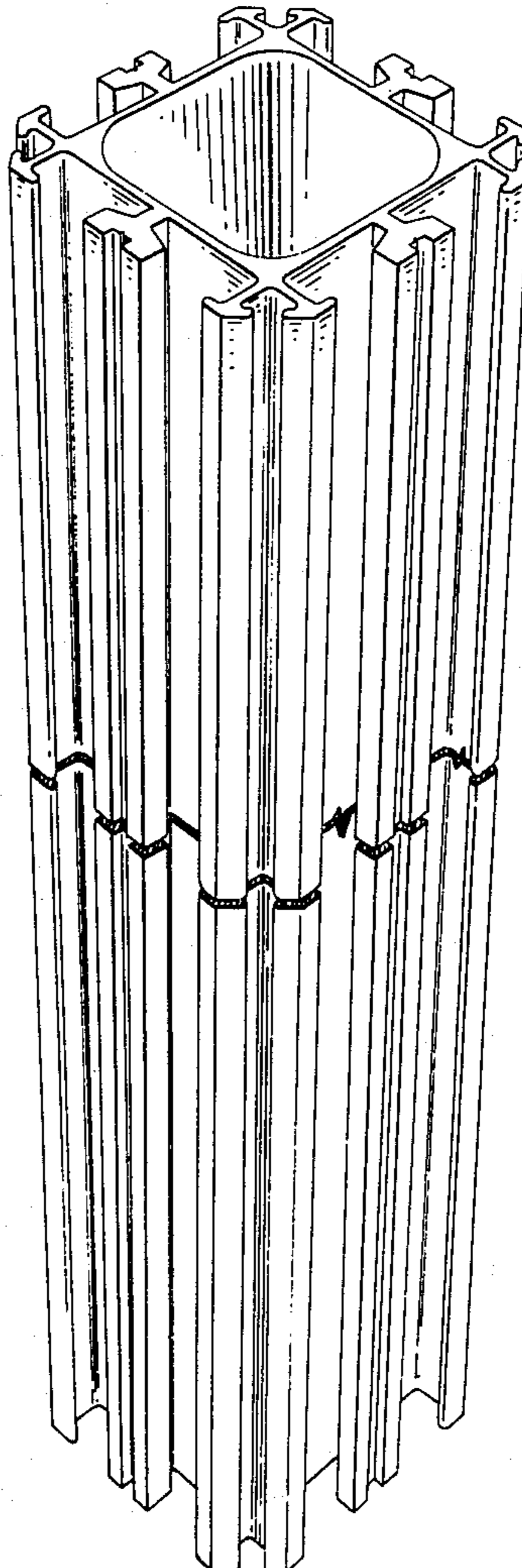

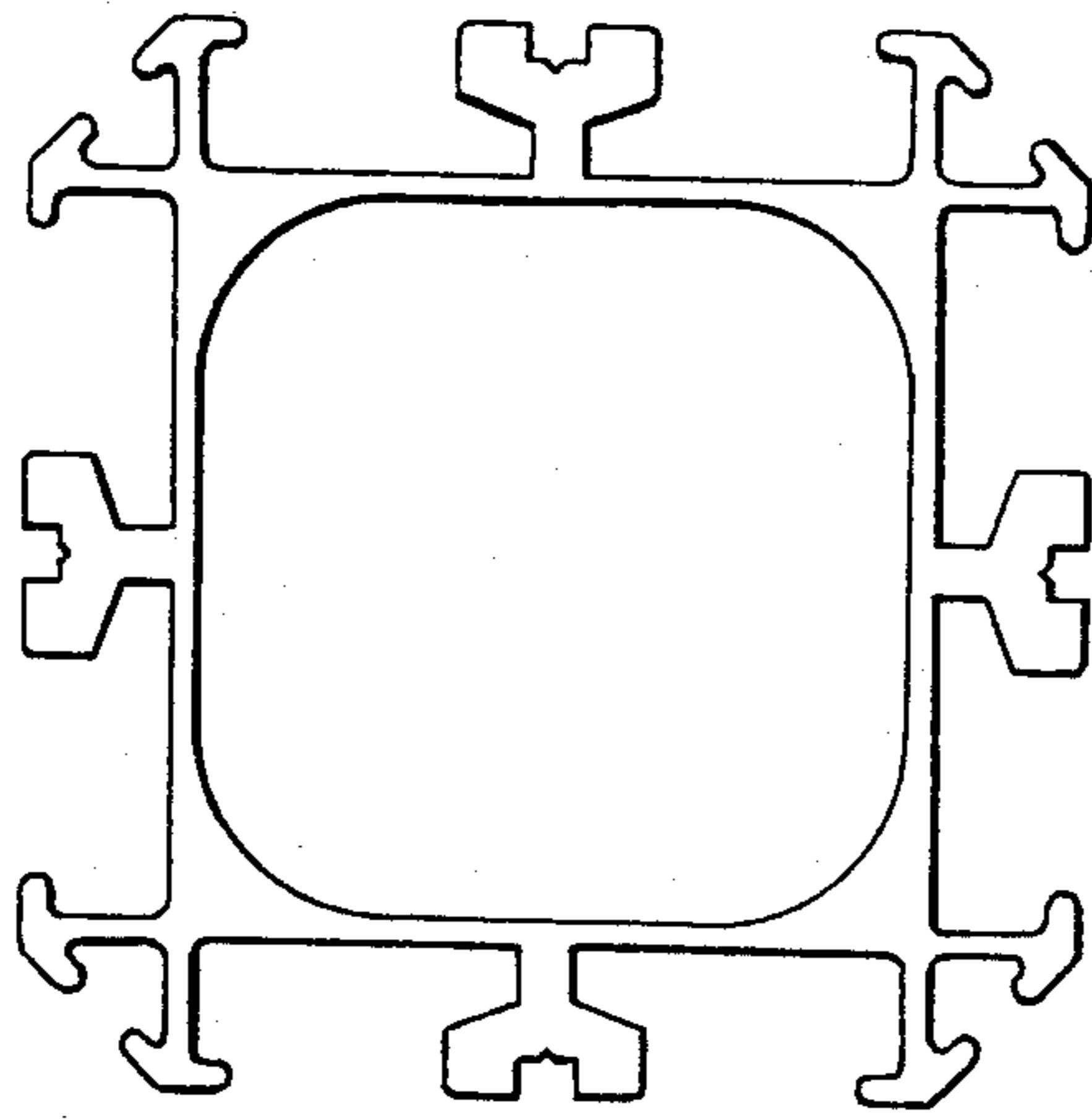
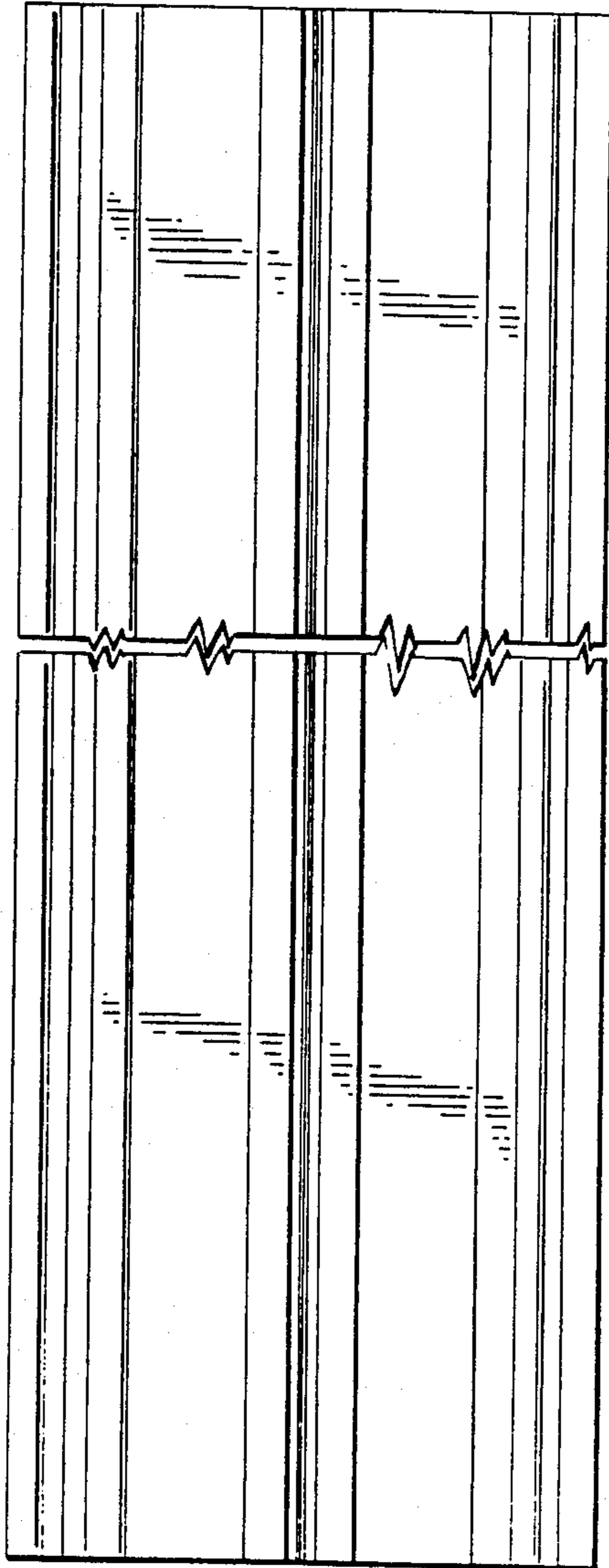

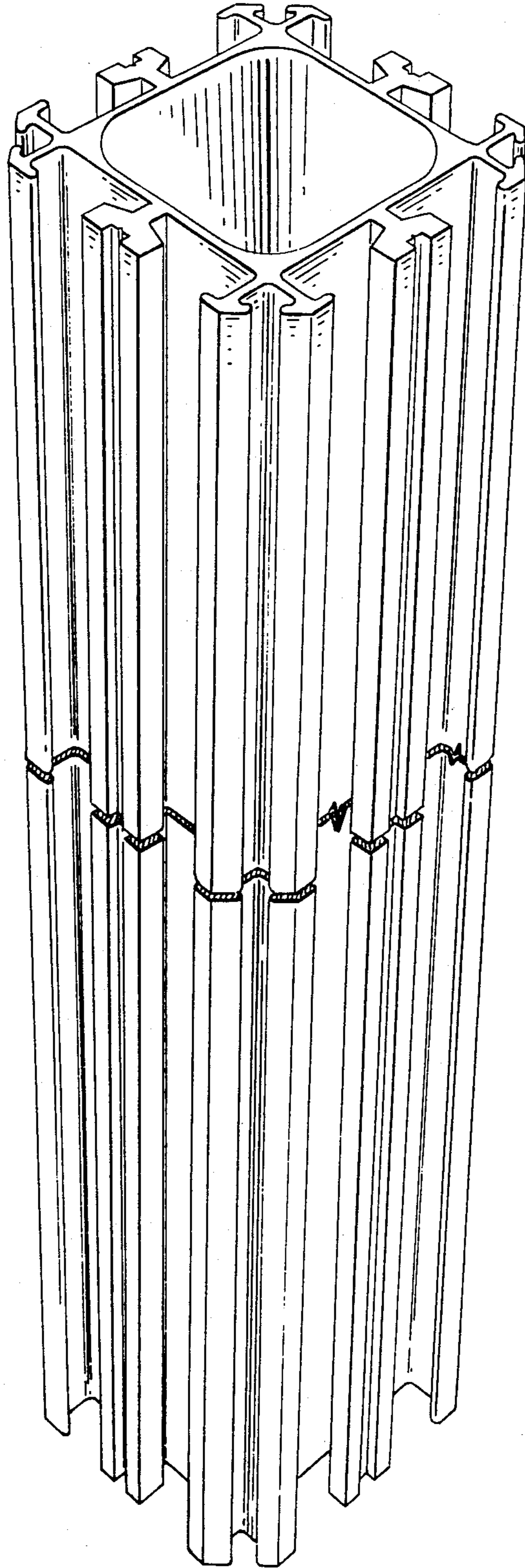
