[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a field hockey stick, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a field hockey stick, showing our new design,

FIG. 2 is an enlarged fragmentary view of the blade portion,

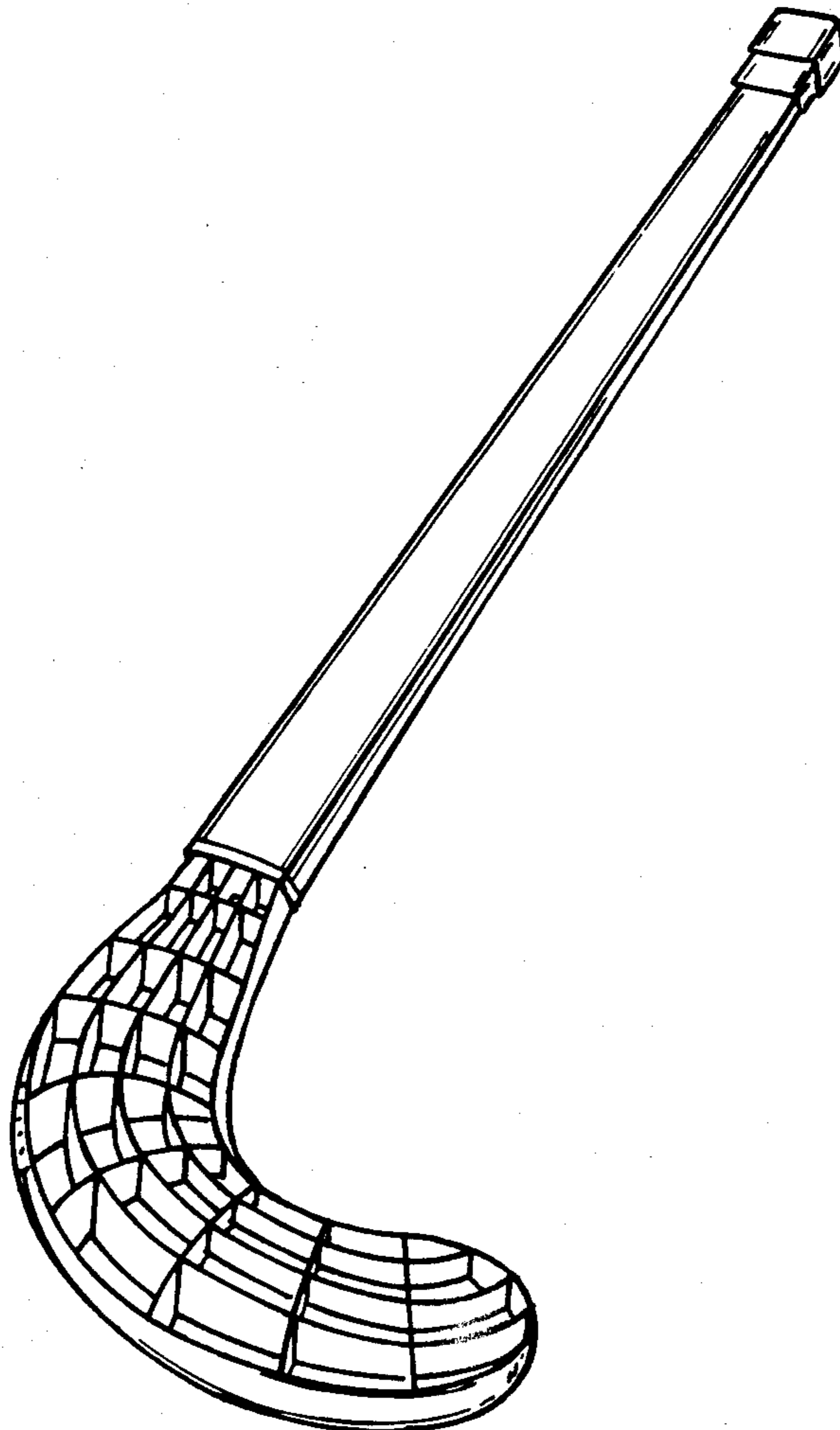
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof,

FIG. 7 is an elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 6.



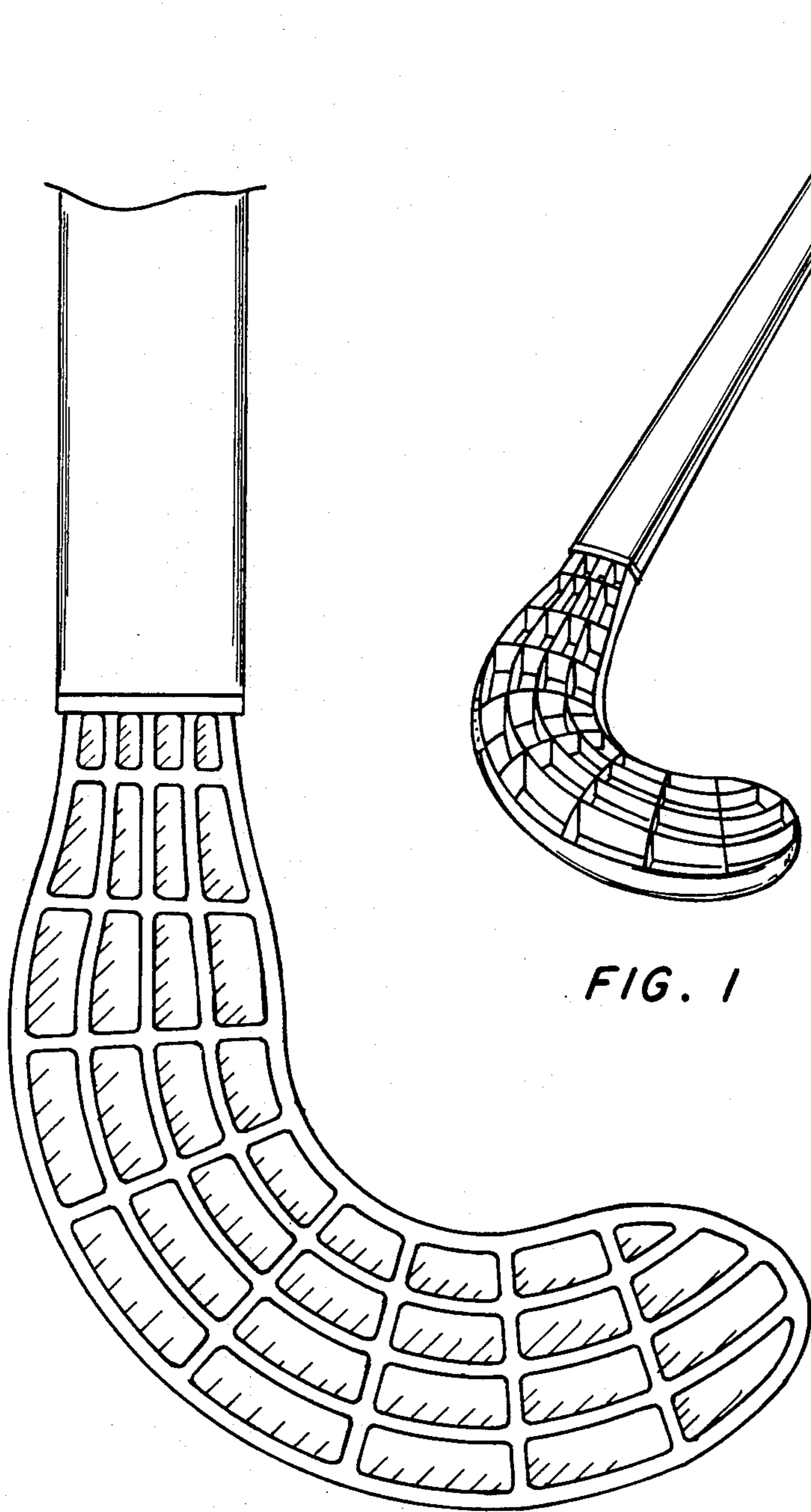

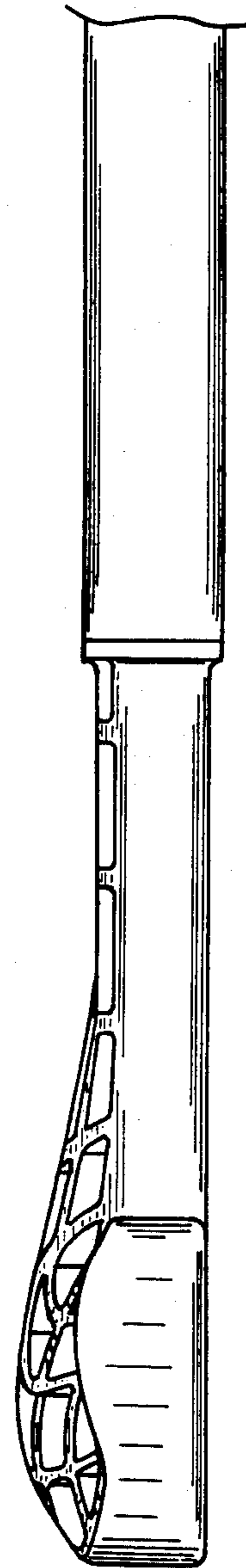

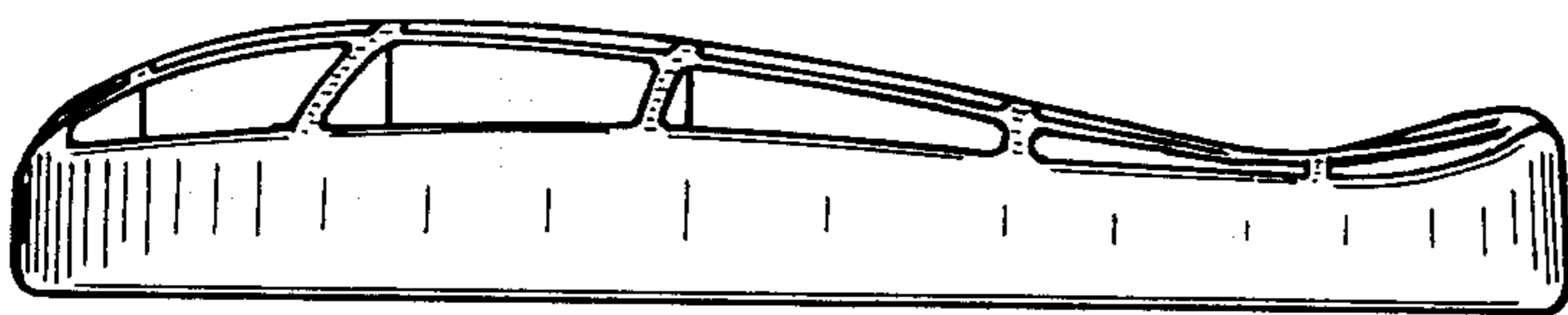

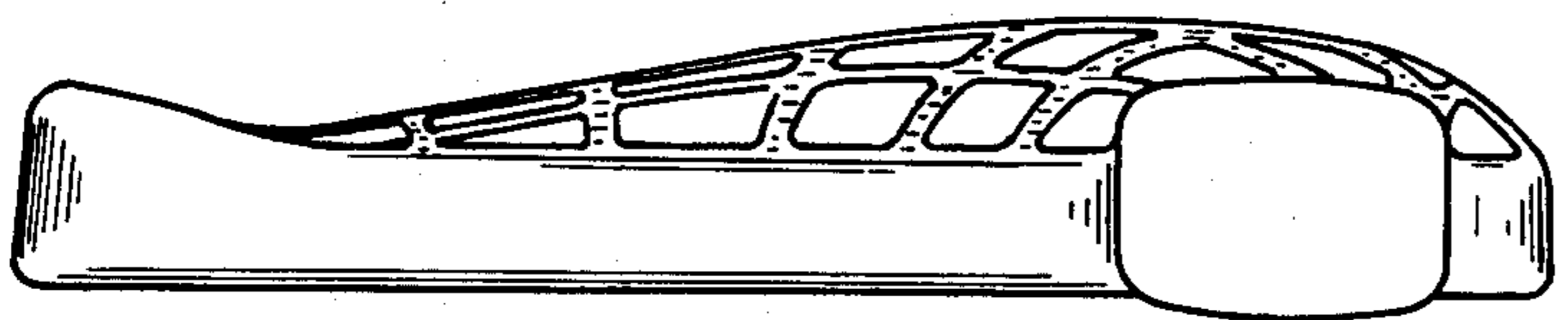

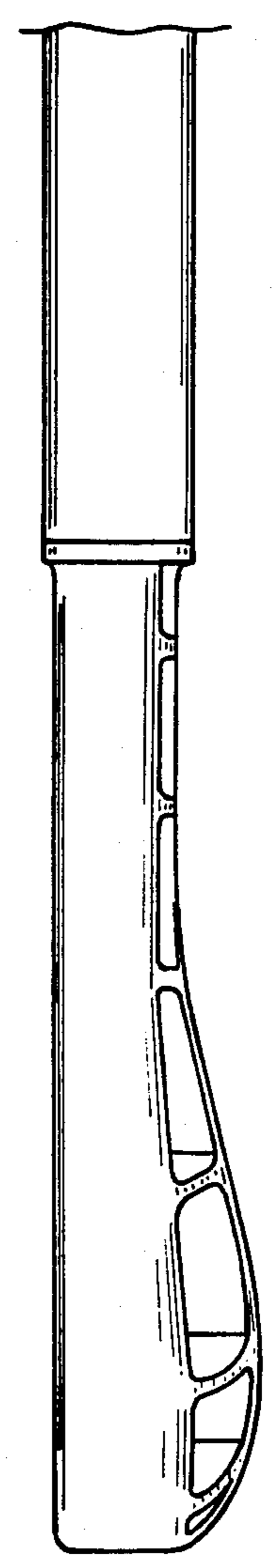
