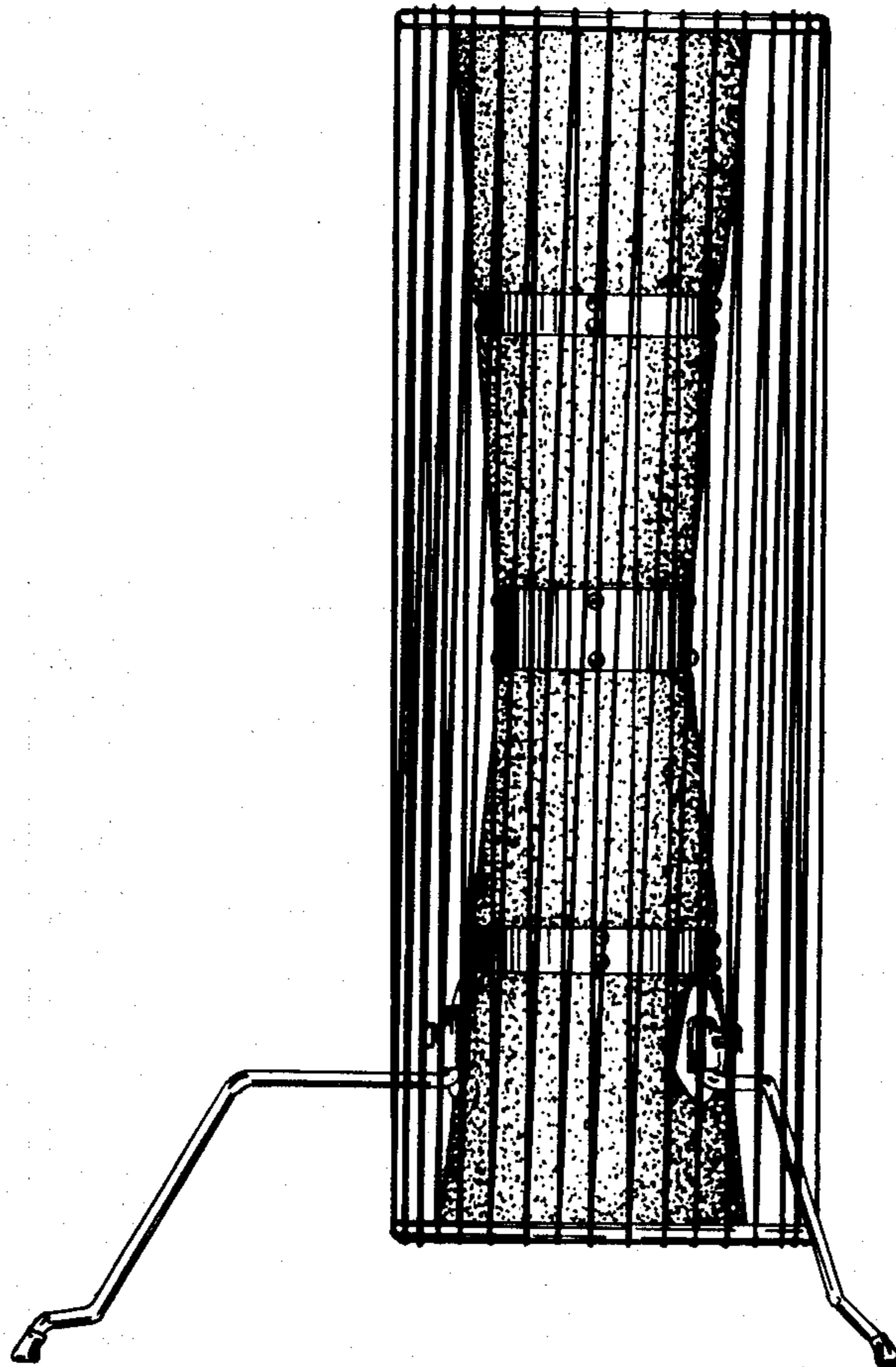
The ornamental design for the drum, as shown and described.

The side of the body of the drum opposite to the side shown in FIG. 1 is a mirror image thereof.



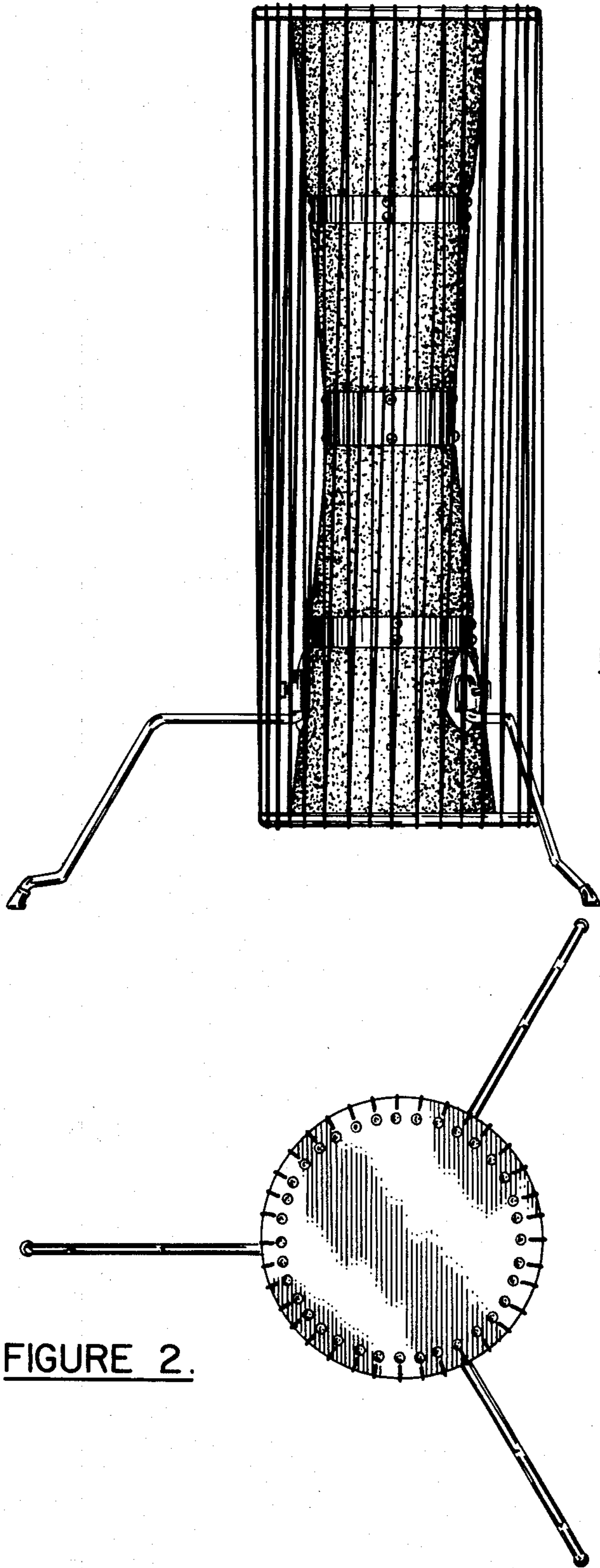
