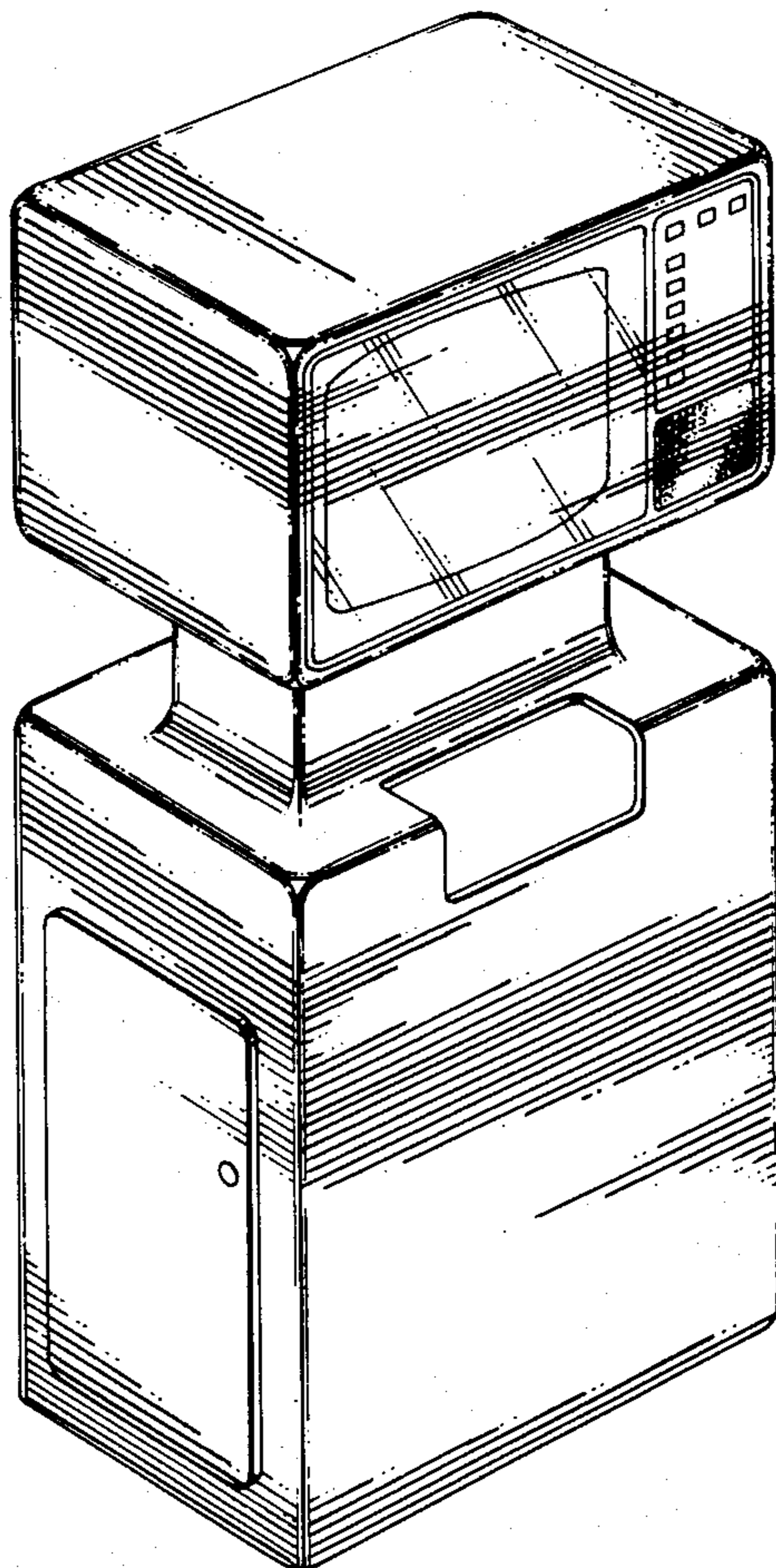

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a video program selection and display system showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof.



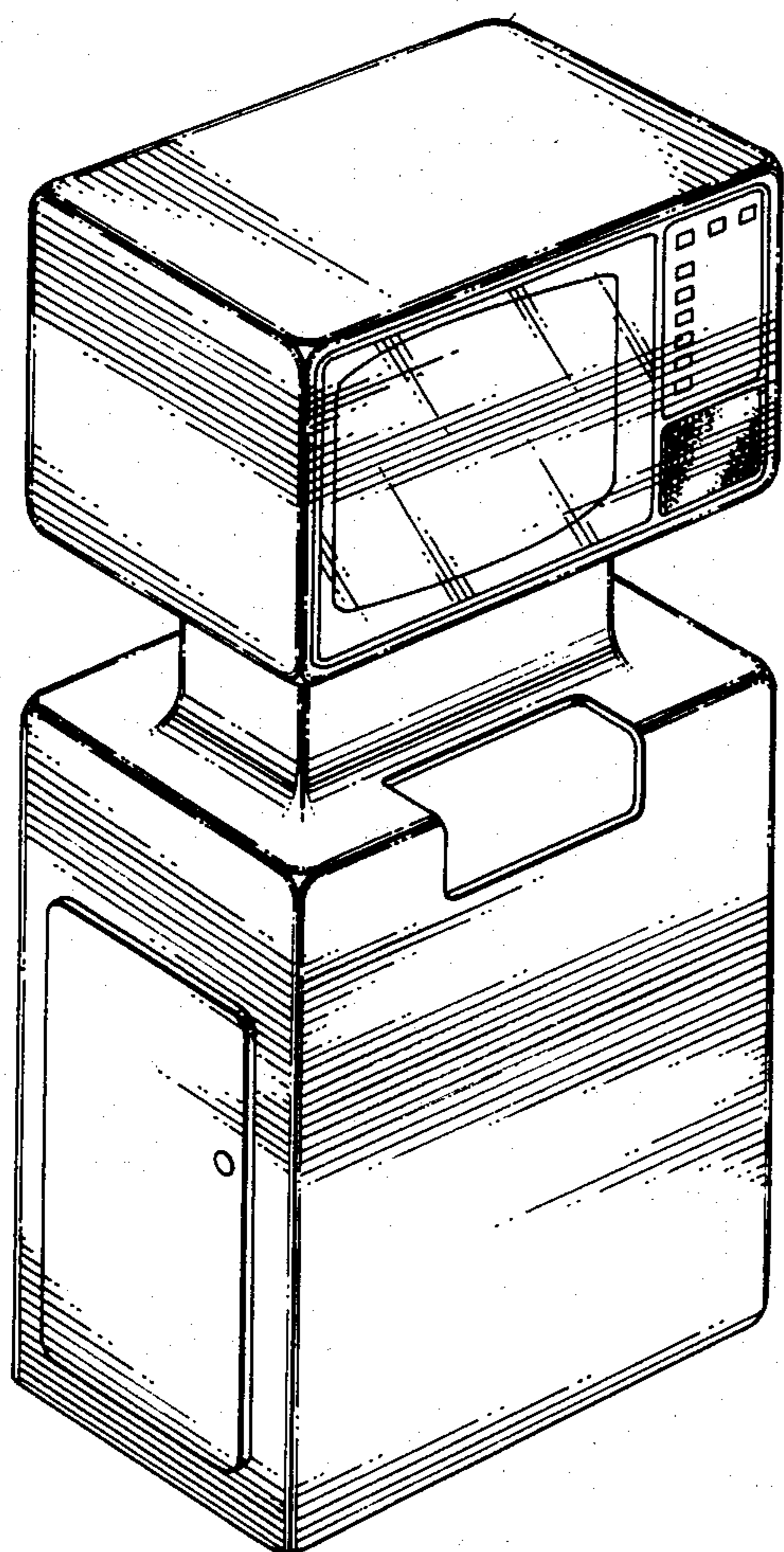

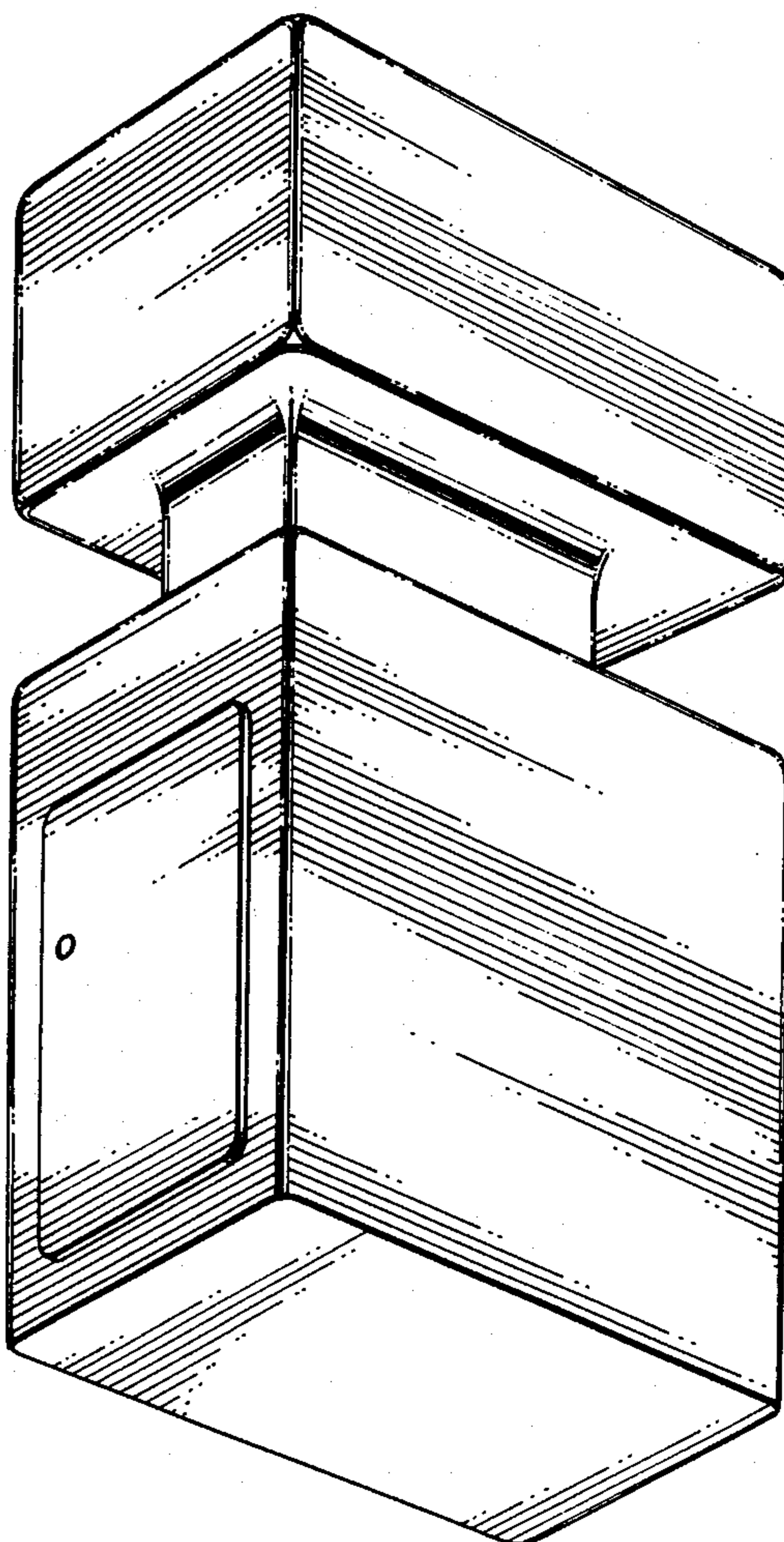
