The ornamental design for a compartmented storage box primarily for fishing lures or the like, as shown and described.

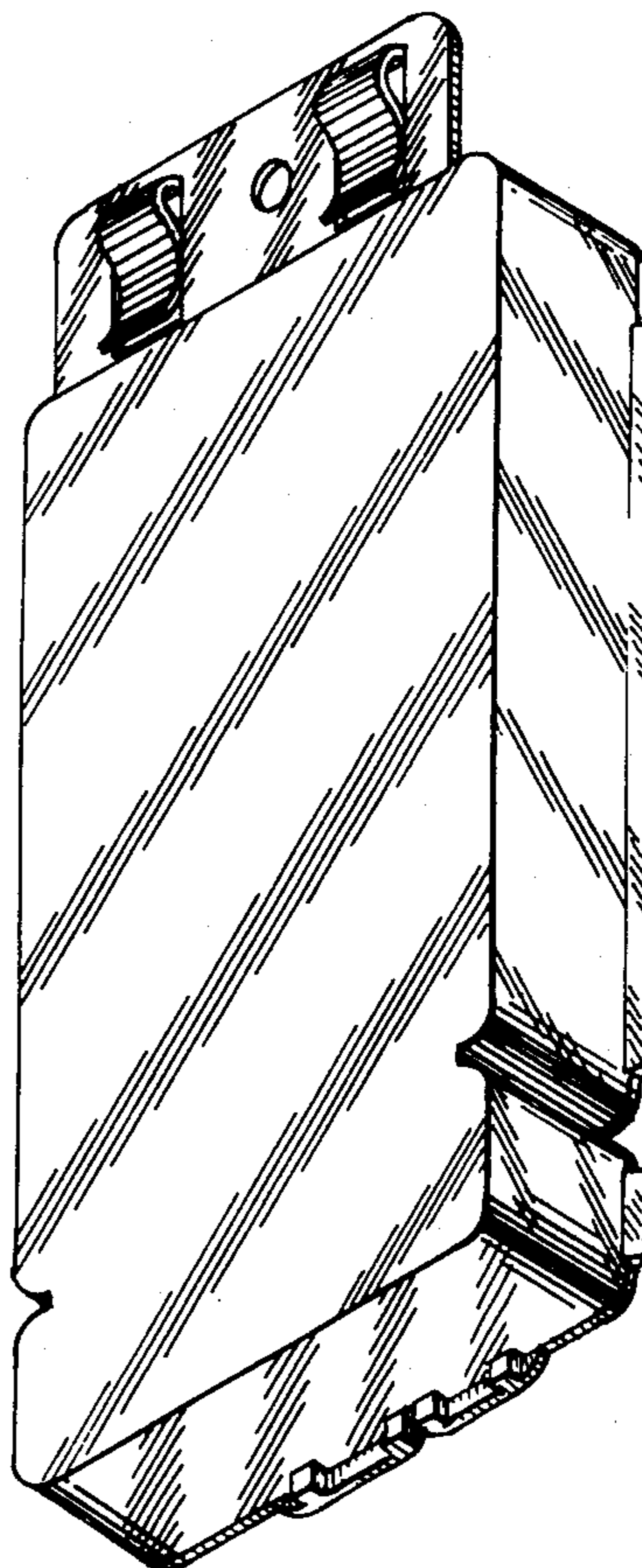
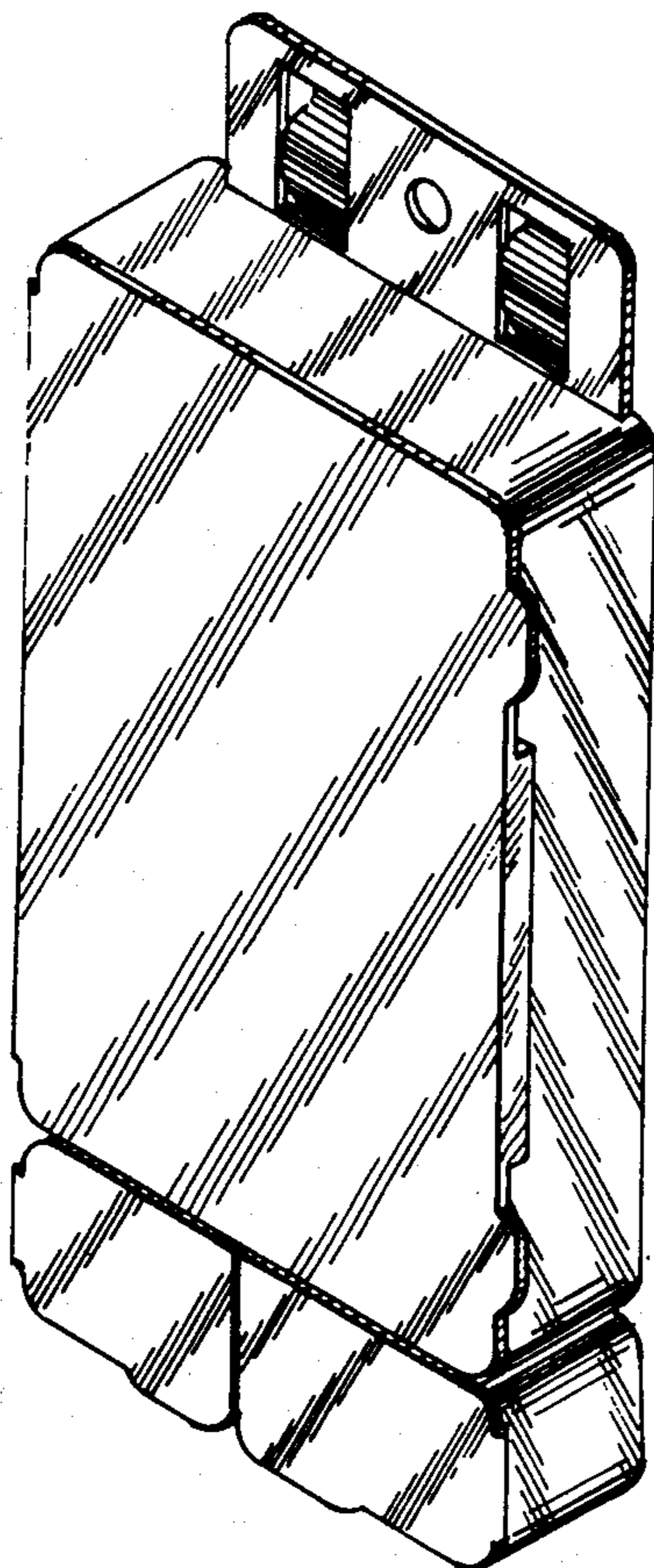
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a compartmented storage box primarily for fishing lures showing my new design;

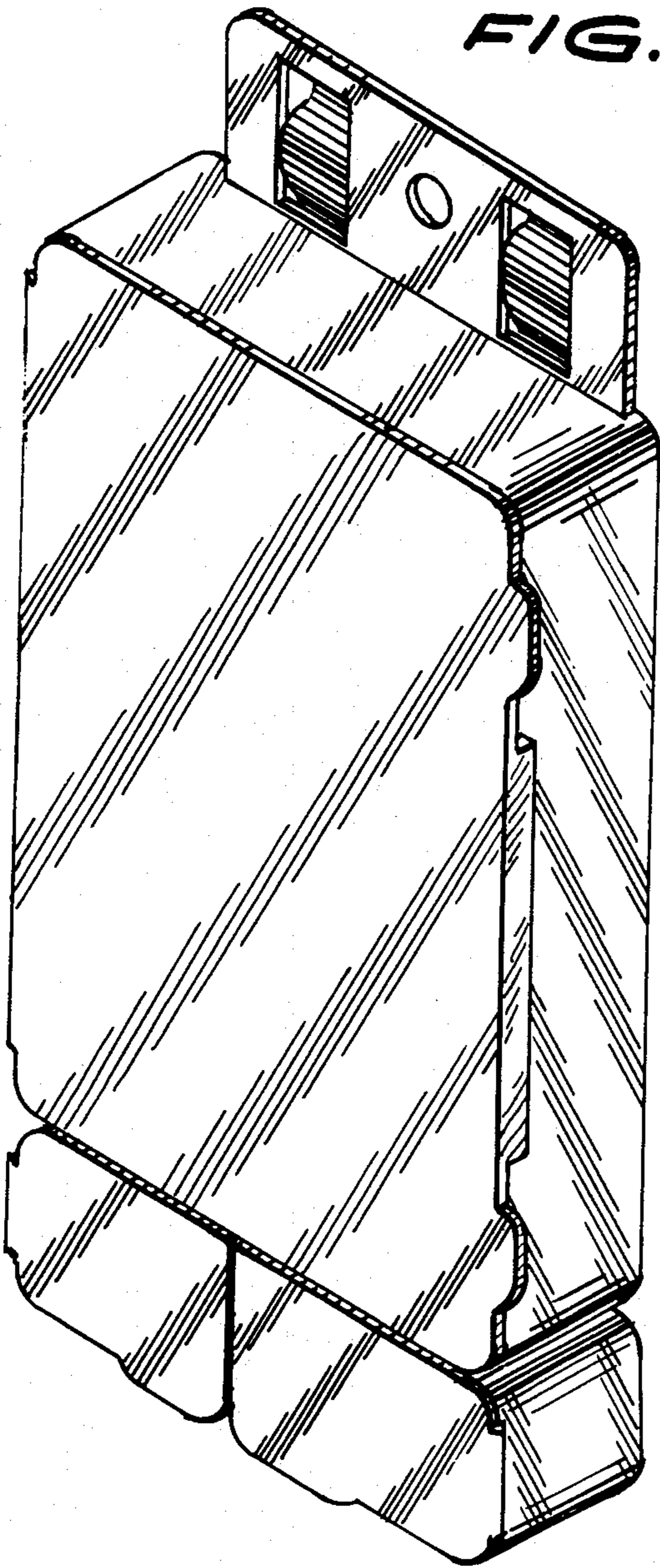
FIG. 2 is a bottom rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of a modified form of the compartmented storage box primarily for fishing lures; and

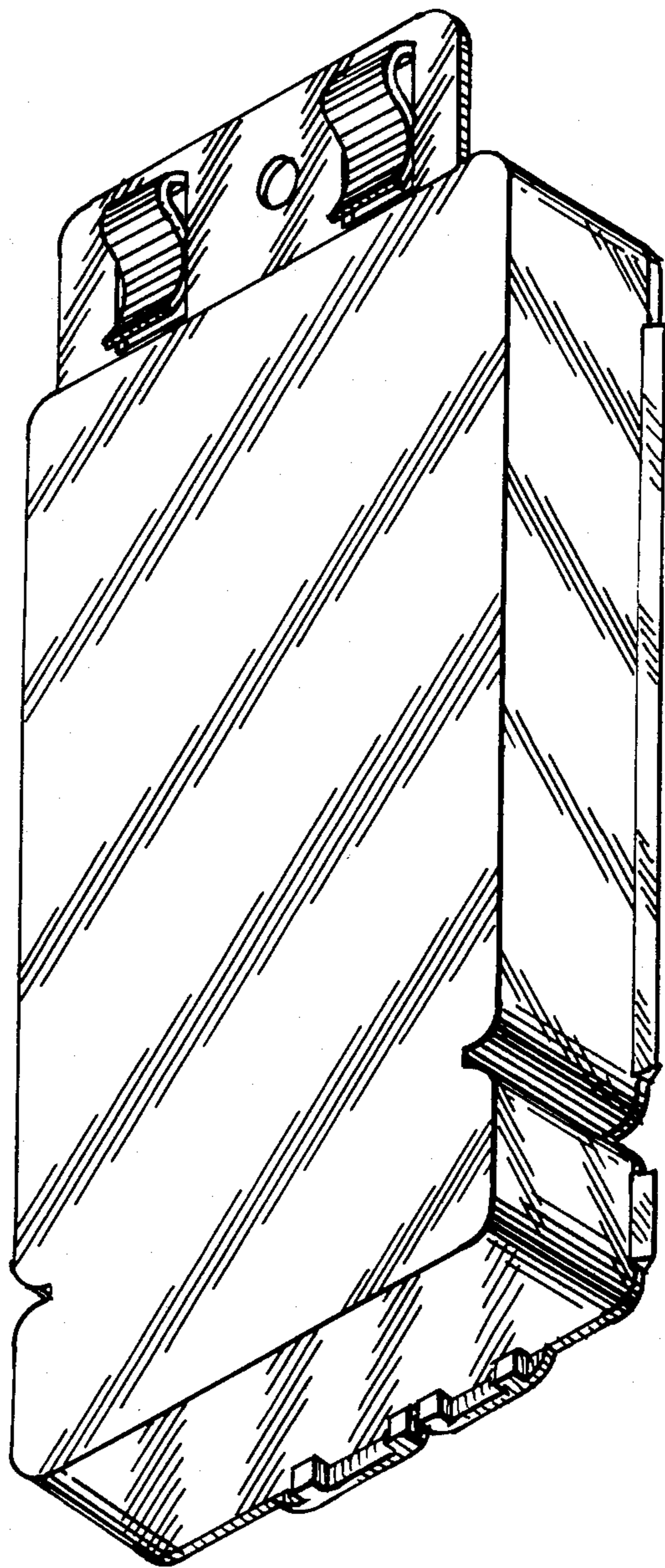
FIG. 4 is a bottom rear perspective view thereof.



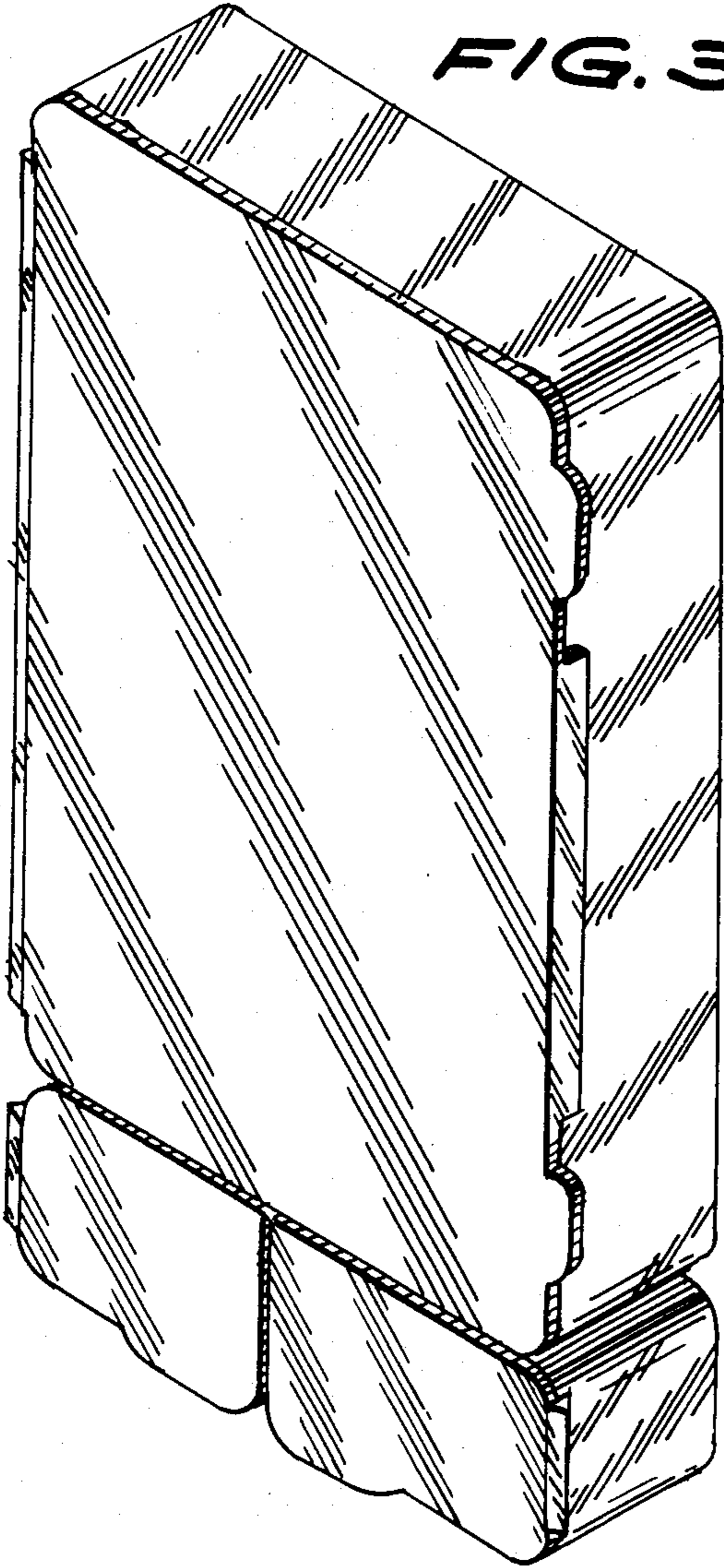
