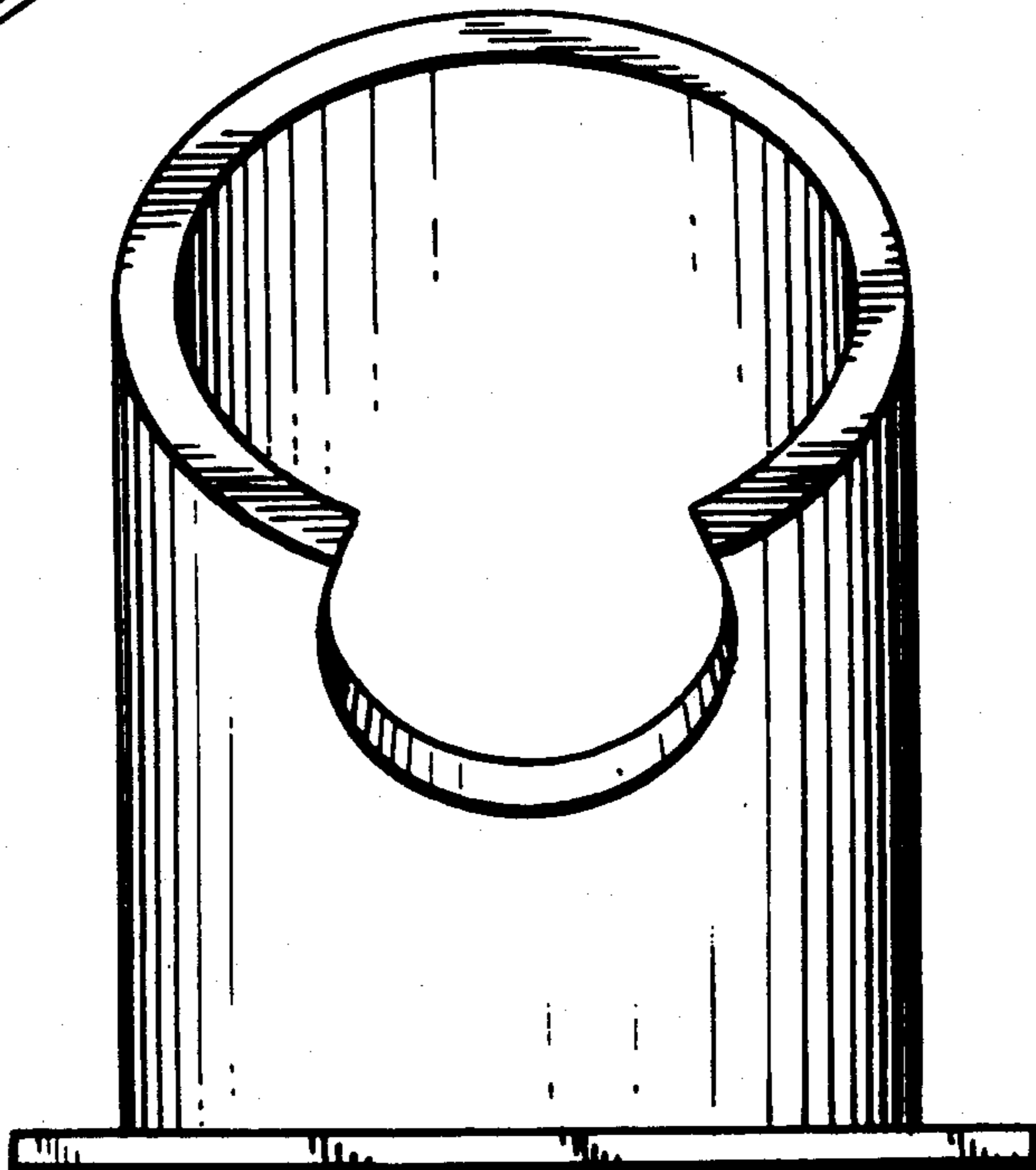
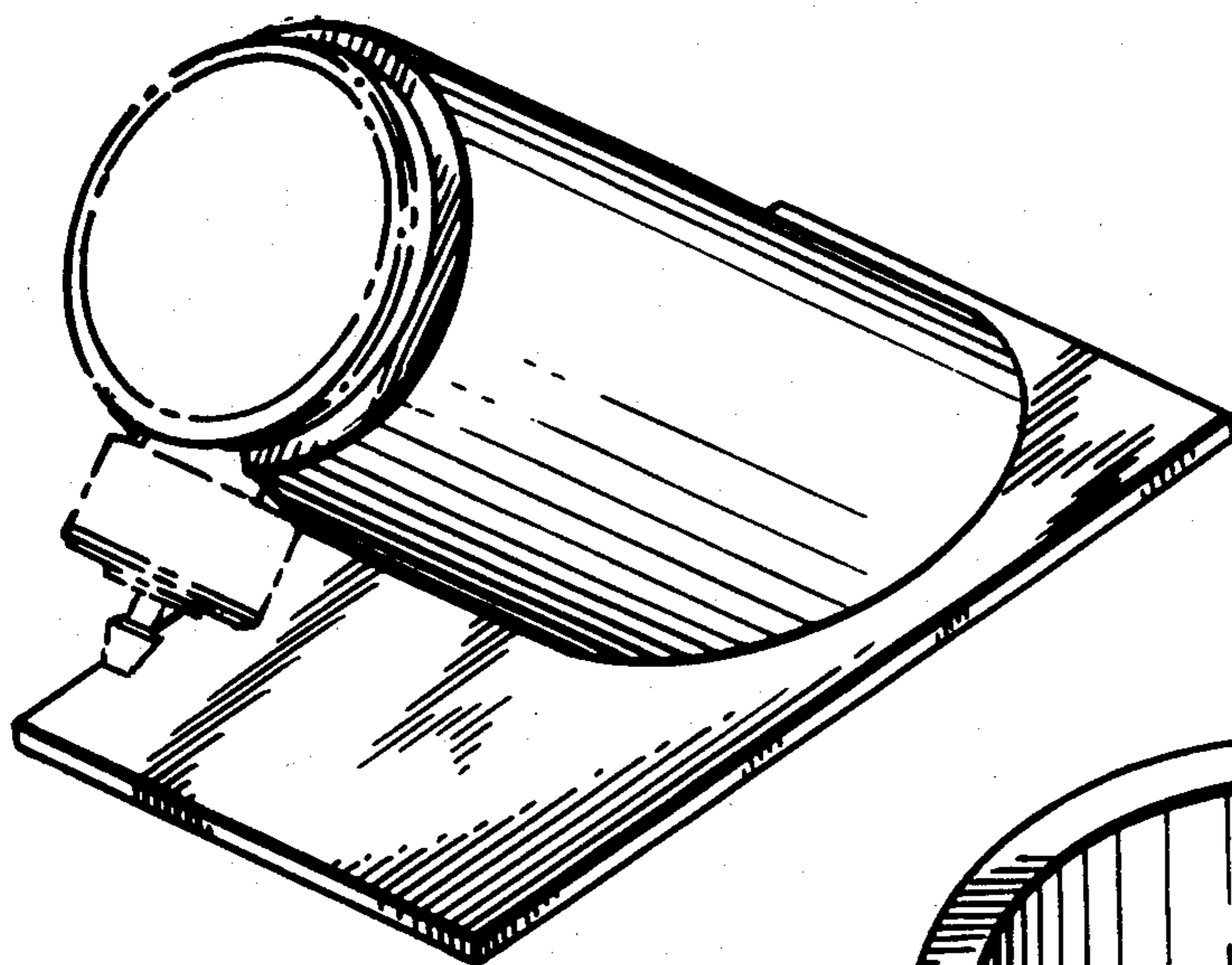

The ornamental design for a sphygmomanometer stand, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sphygmomanometer stand showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevation thereof; and FIG. 4 is a rear elevation thereof. The broken lines are shown for illustrative purposes only.



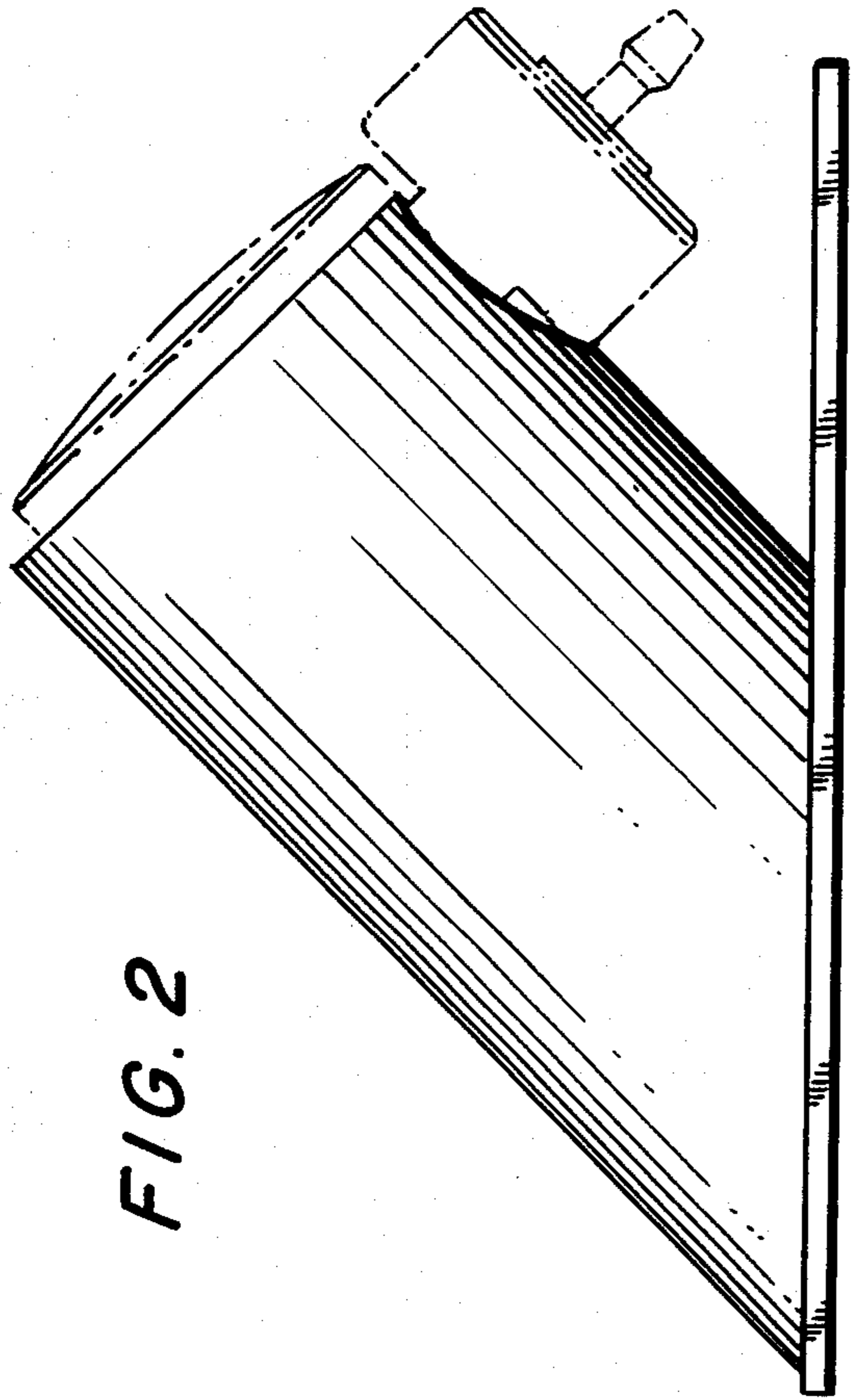

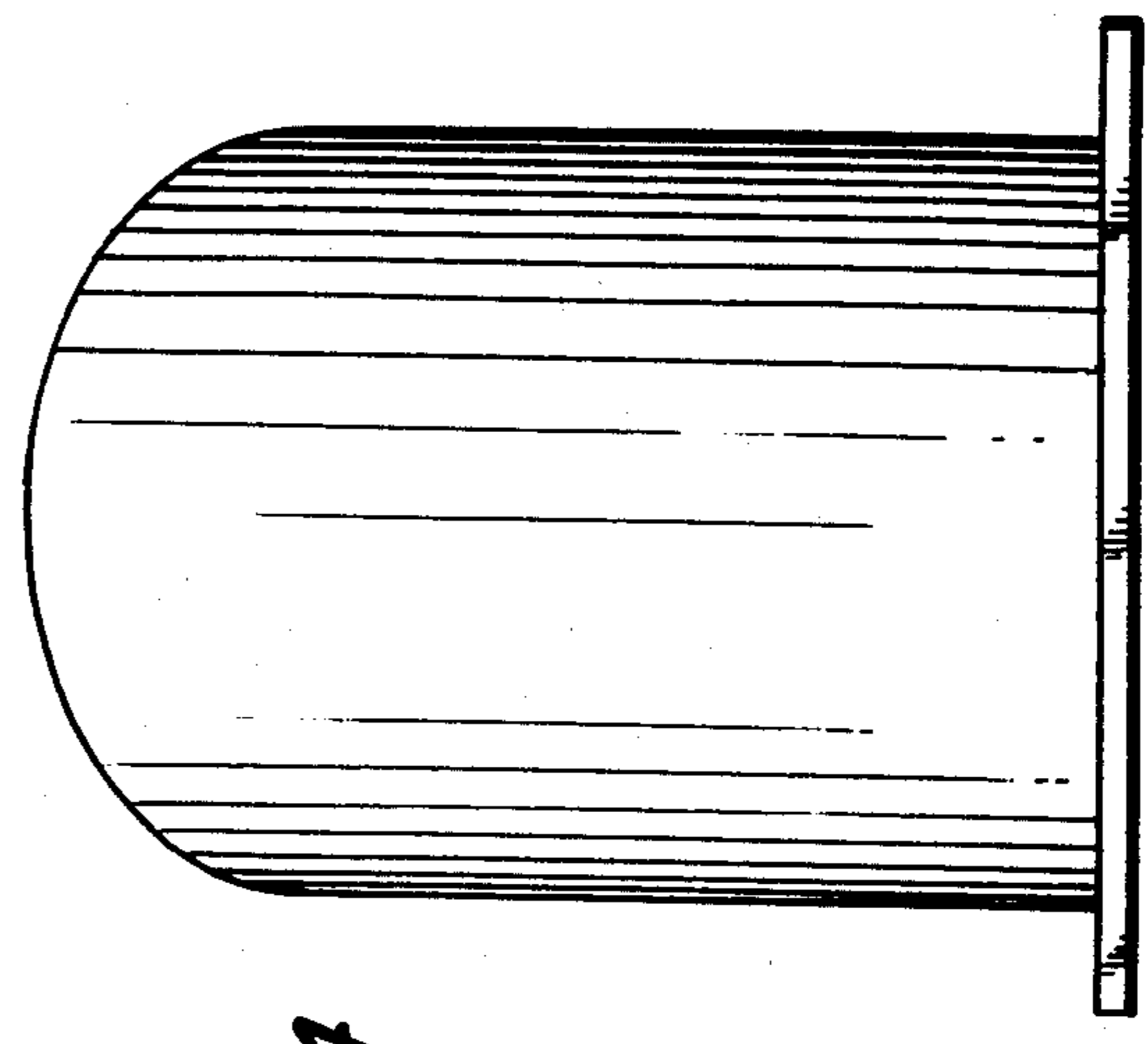

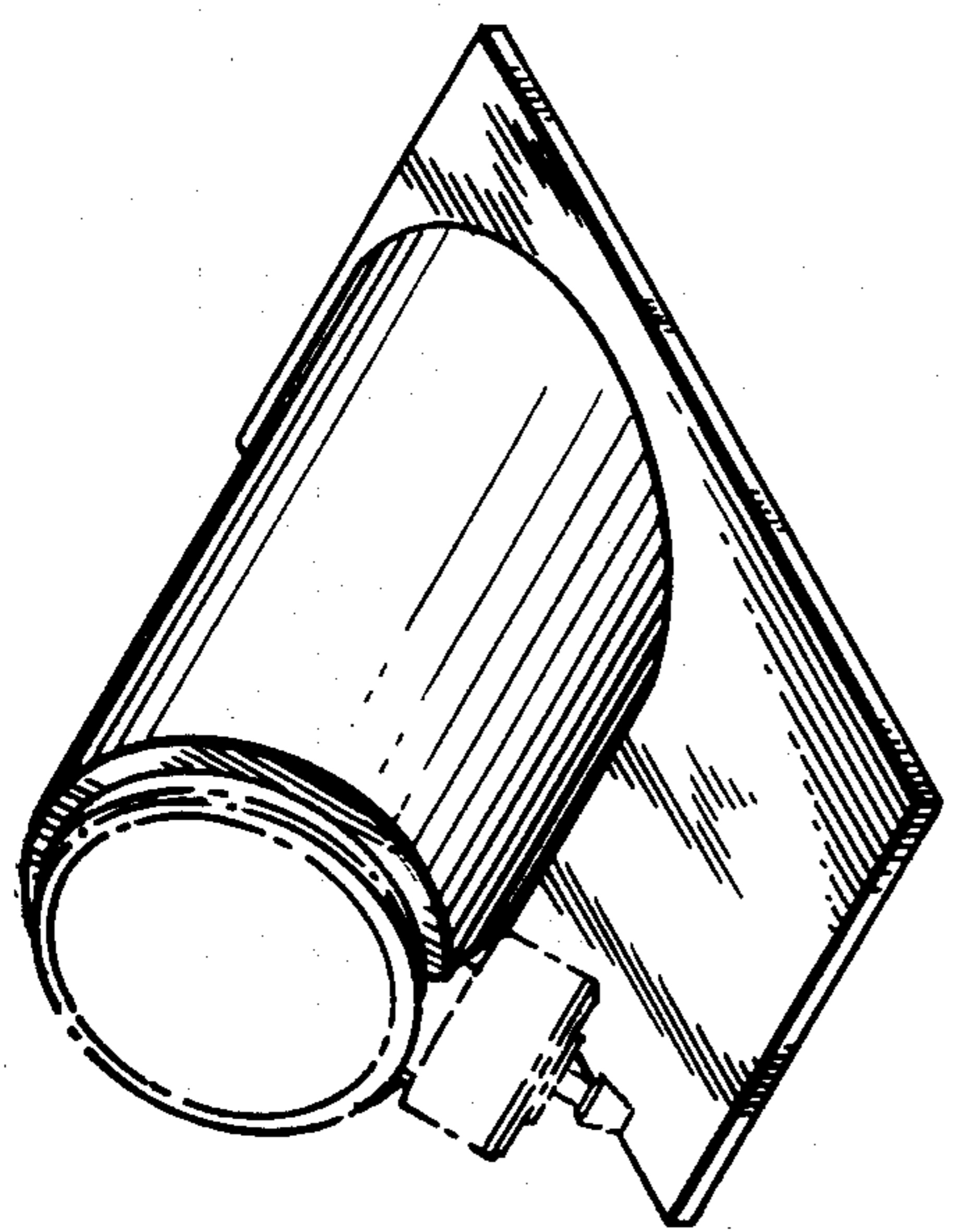

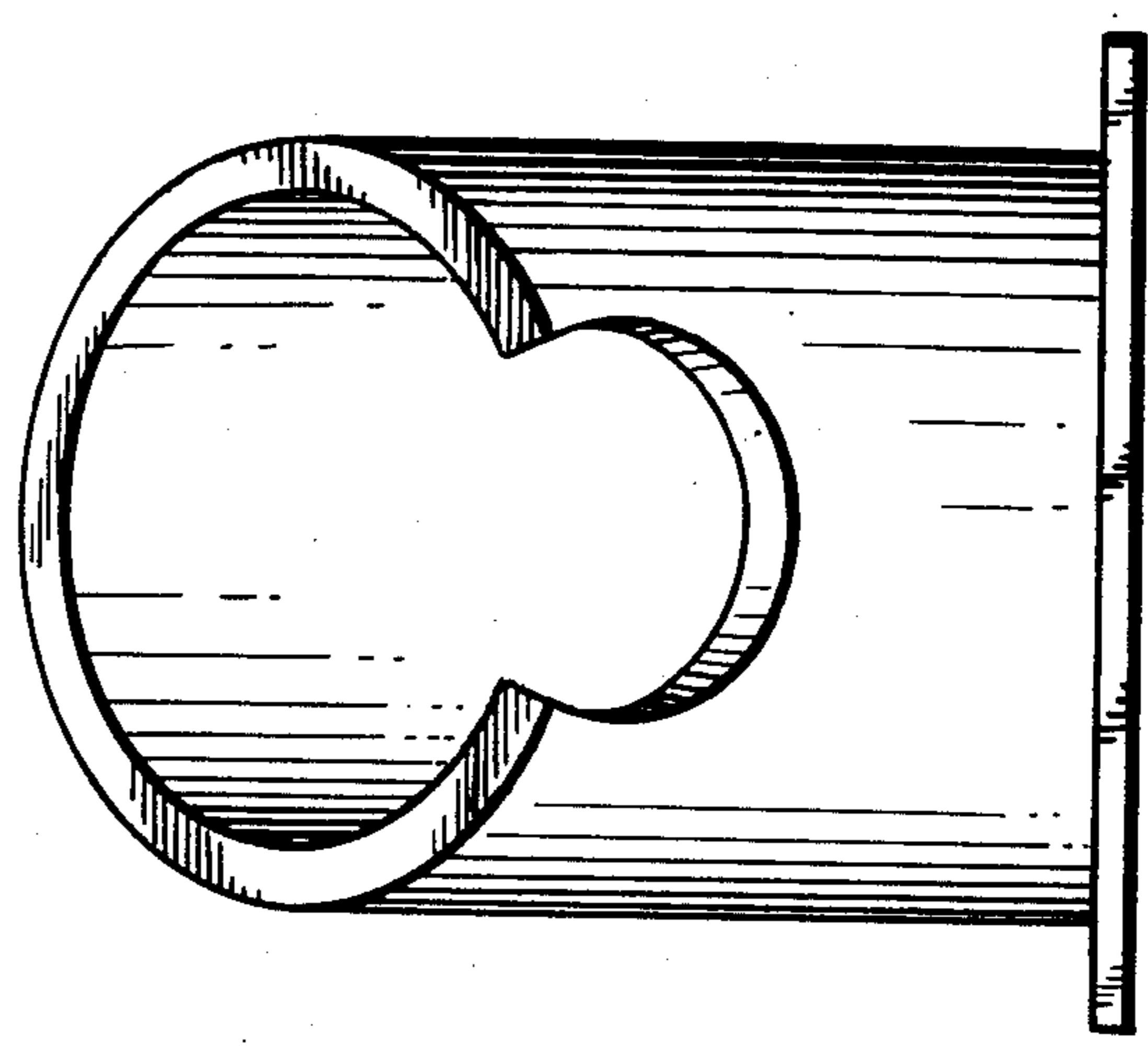
