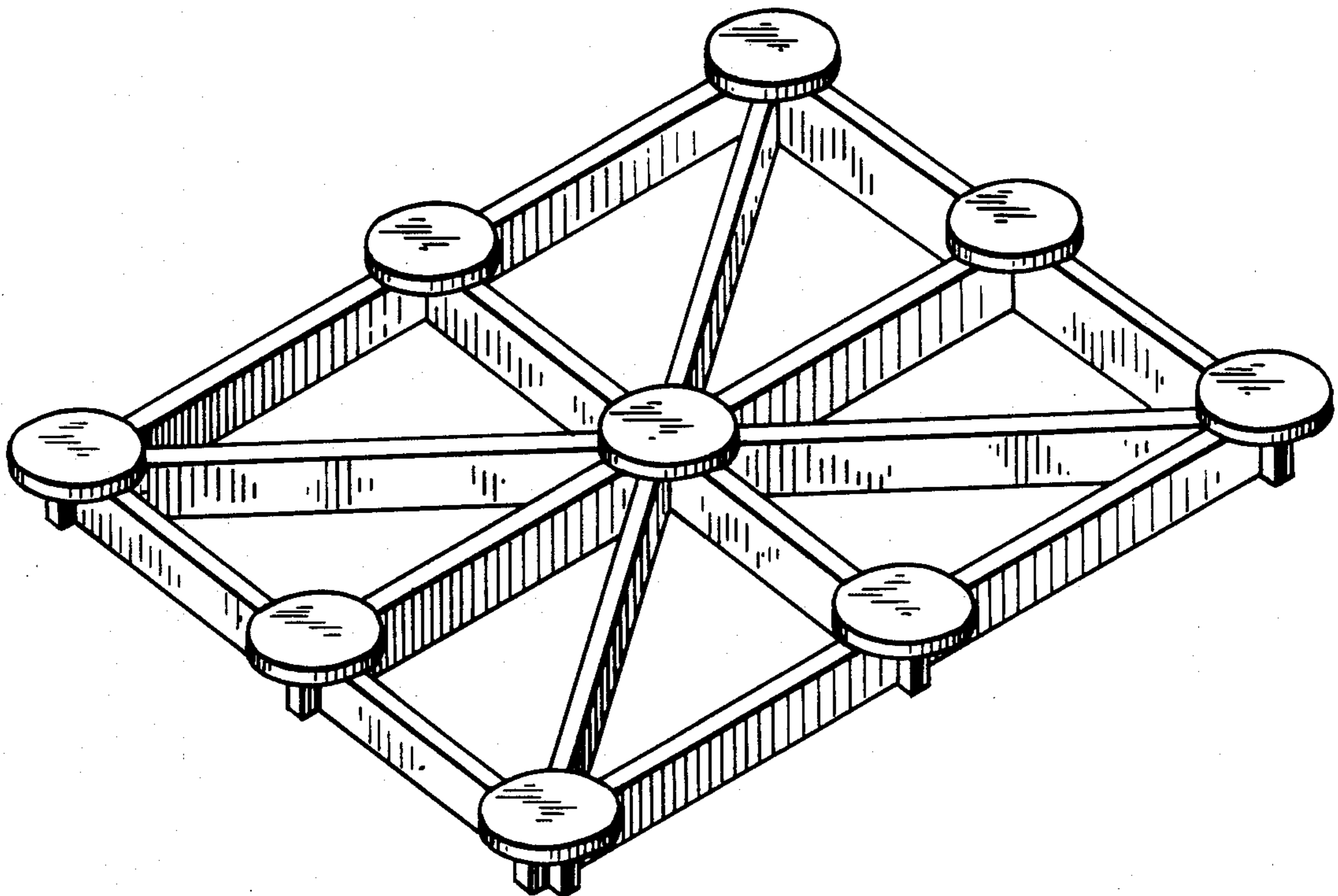

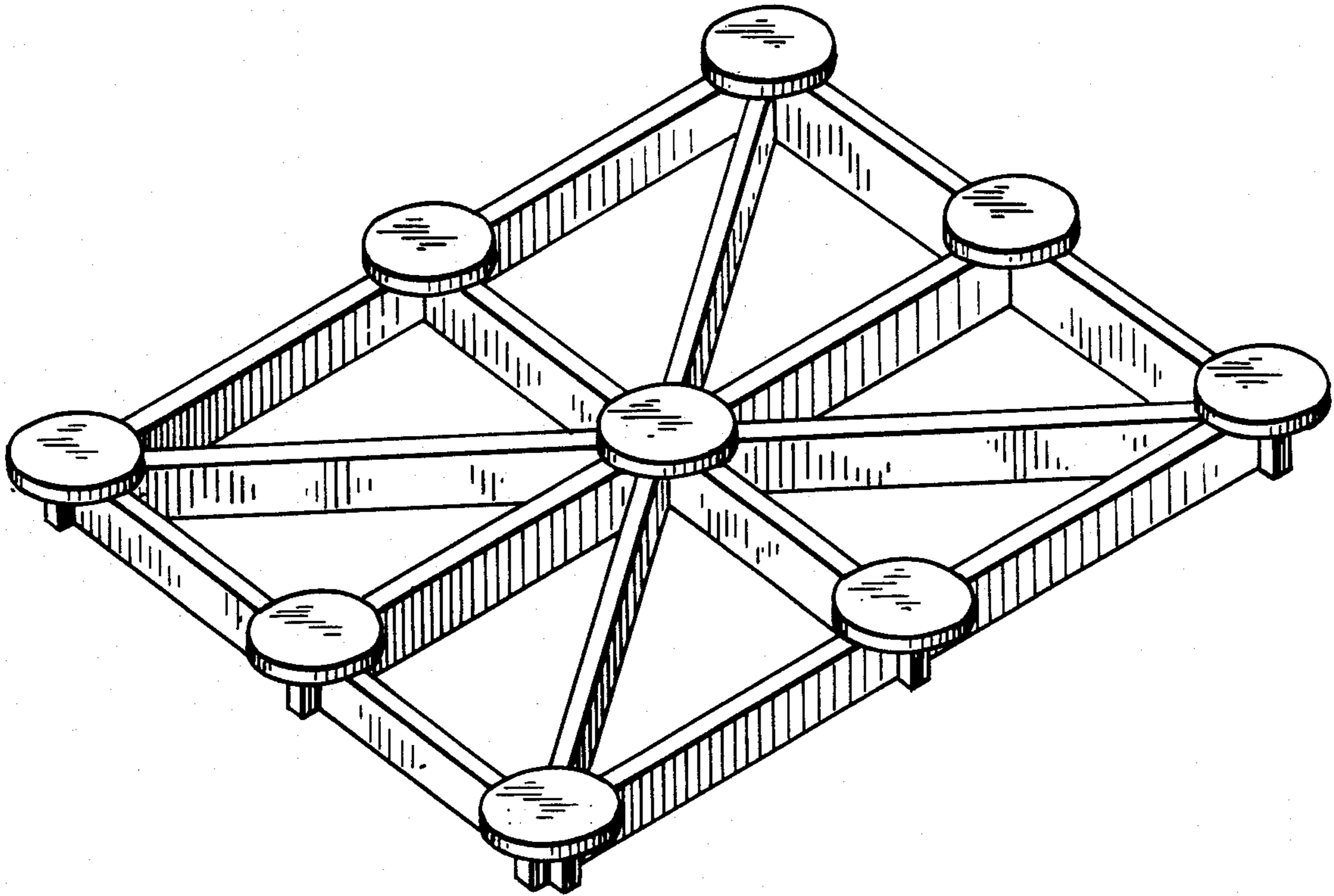
The ornamental design for an elevated path-way educational game device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

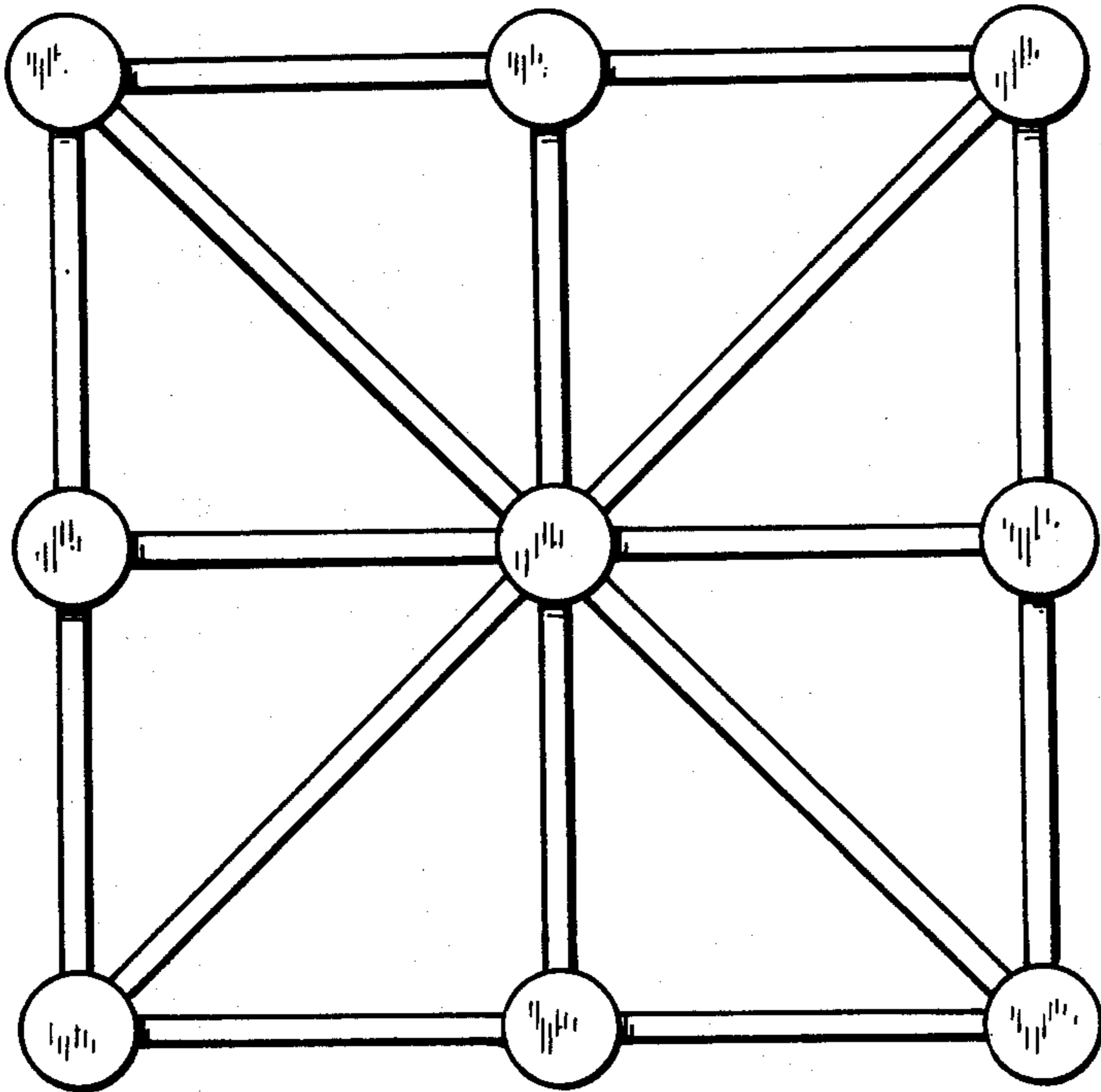
