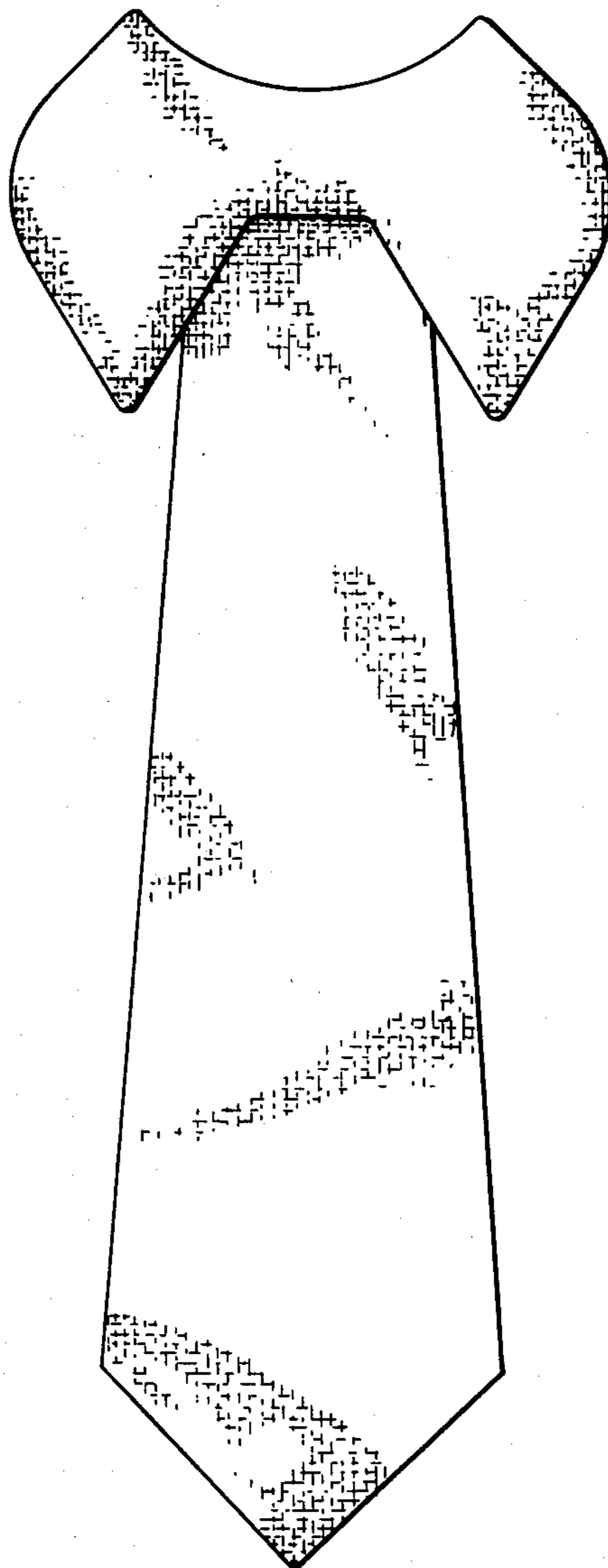

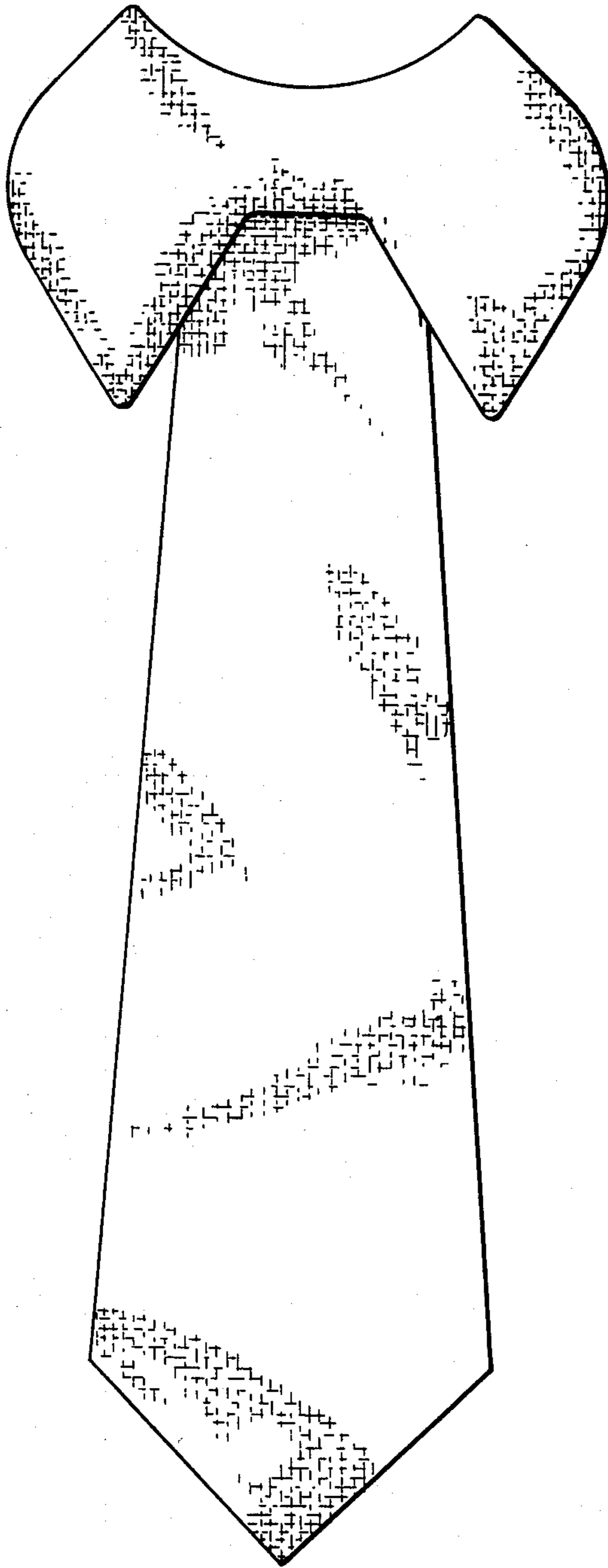
[57] CLAIM
