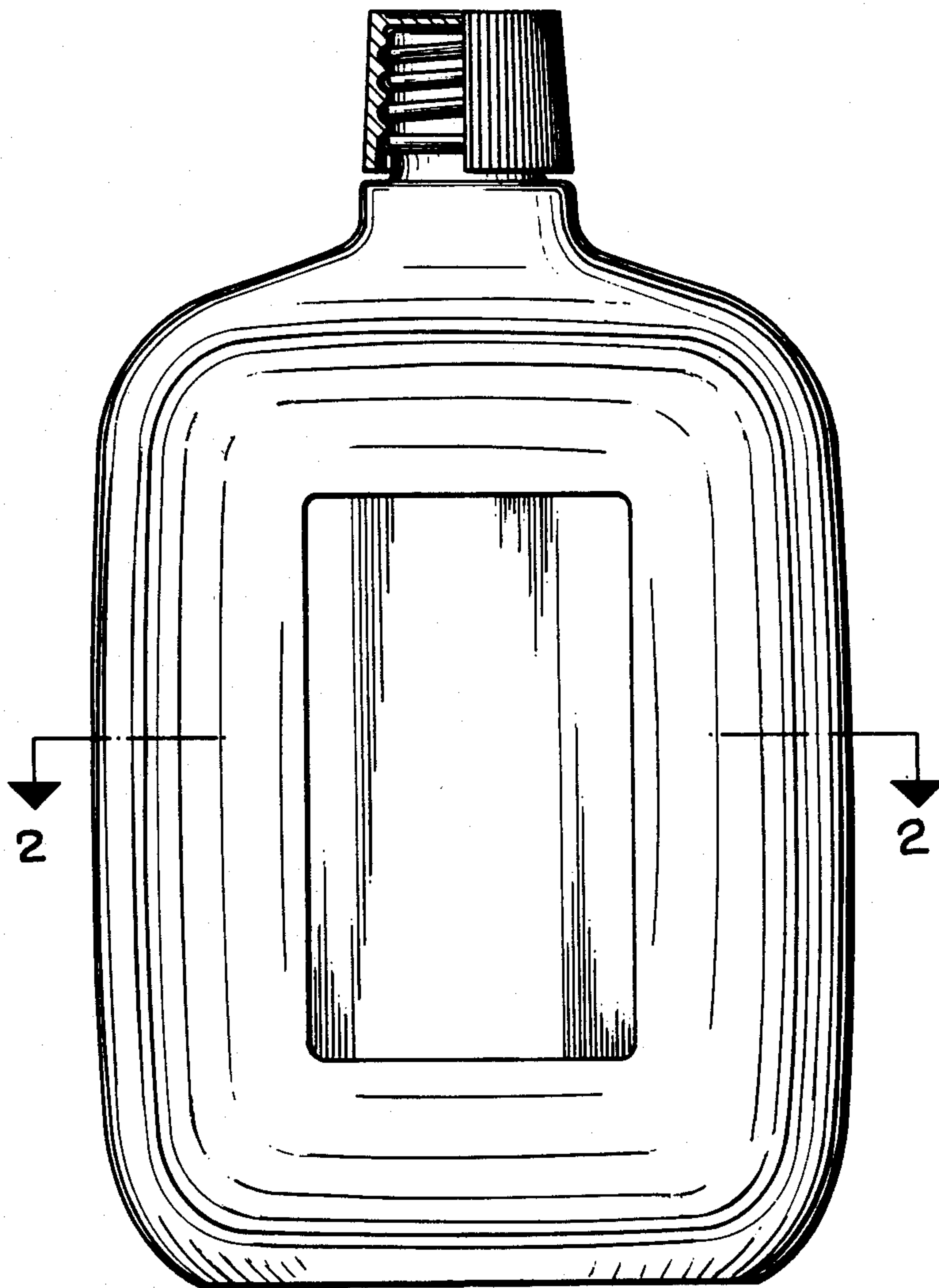
The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bottle embodying my new design with the left half of the cap shown in section;

FIG. 2 is a sectional view taken on the line 2-2 of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof with the right half shown in section.



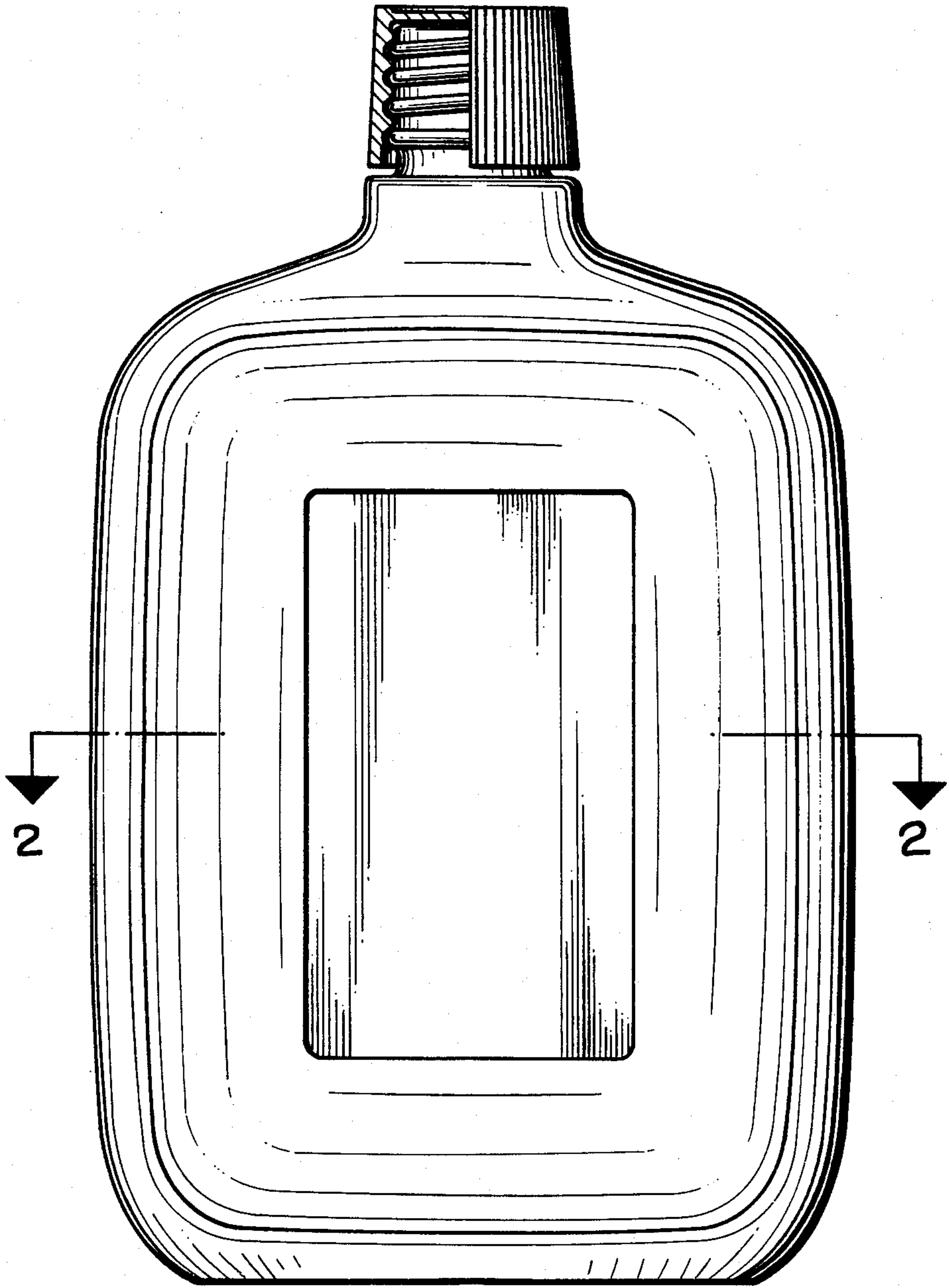

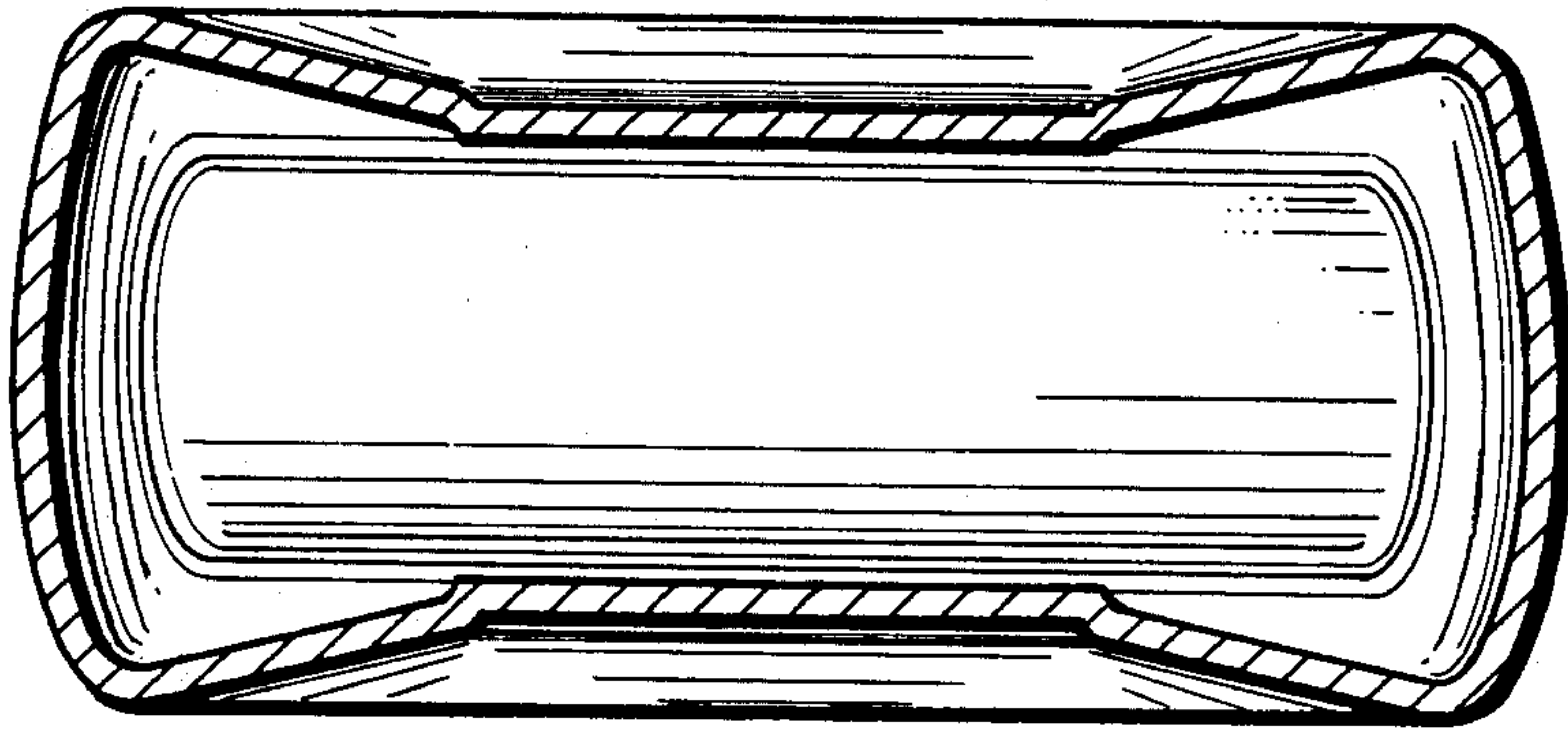

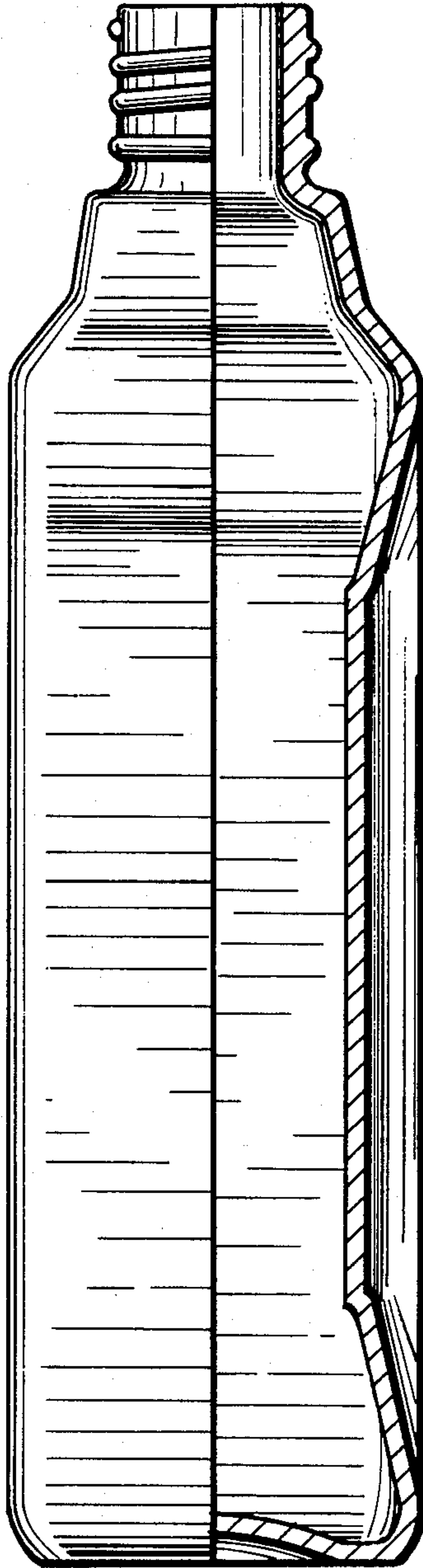
