DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bag showing my new design, the rear being identical thereto; FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 3 is a top plan view; and FIG. 4 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being identical thereto.

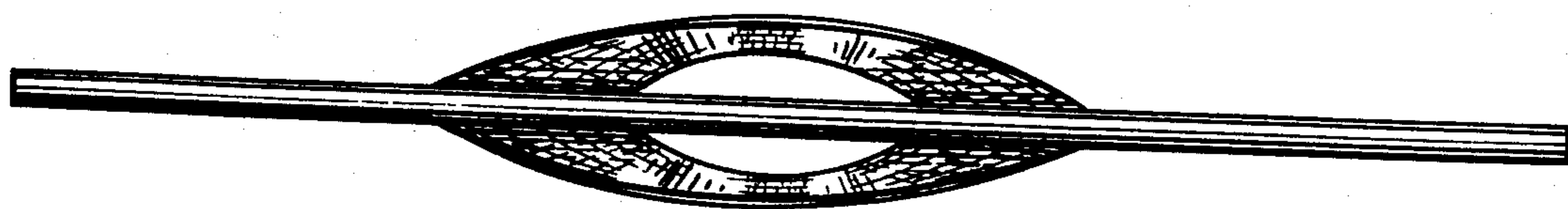

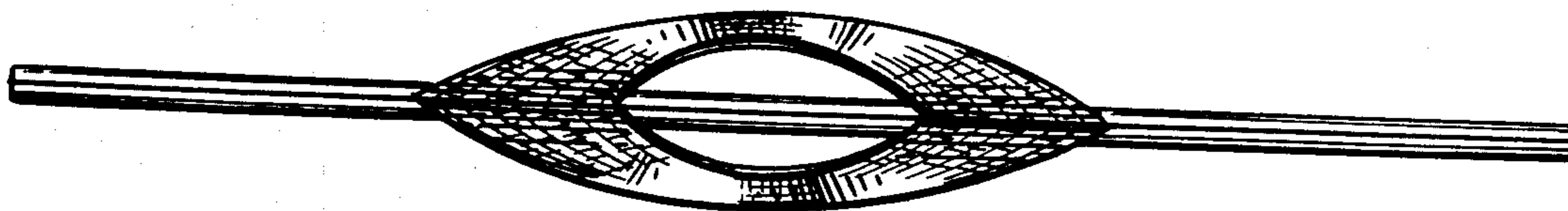
