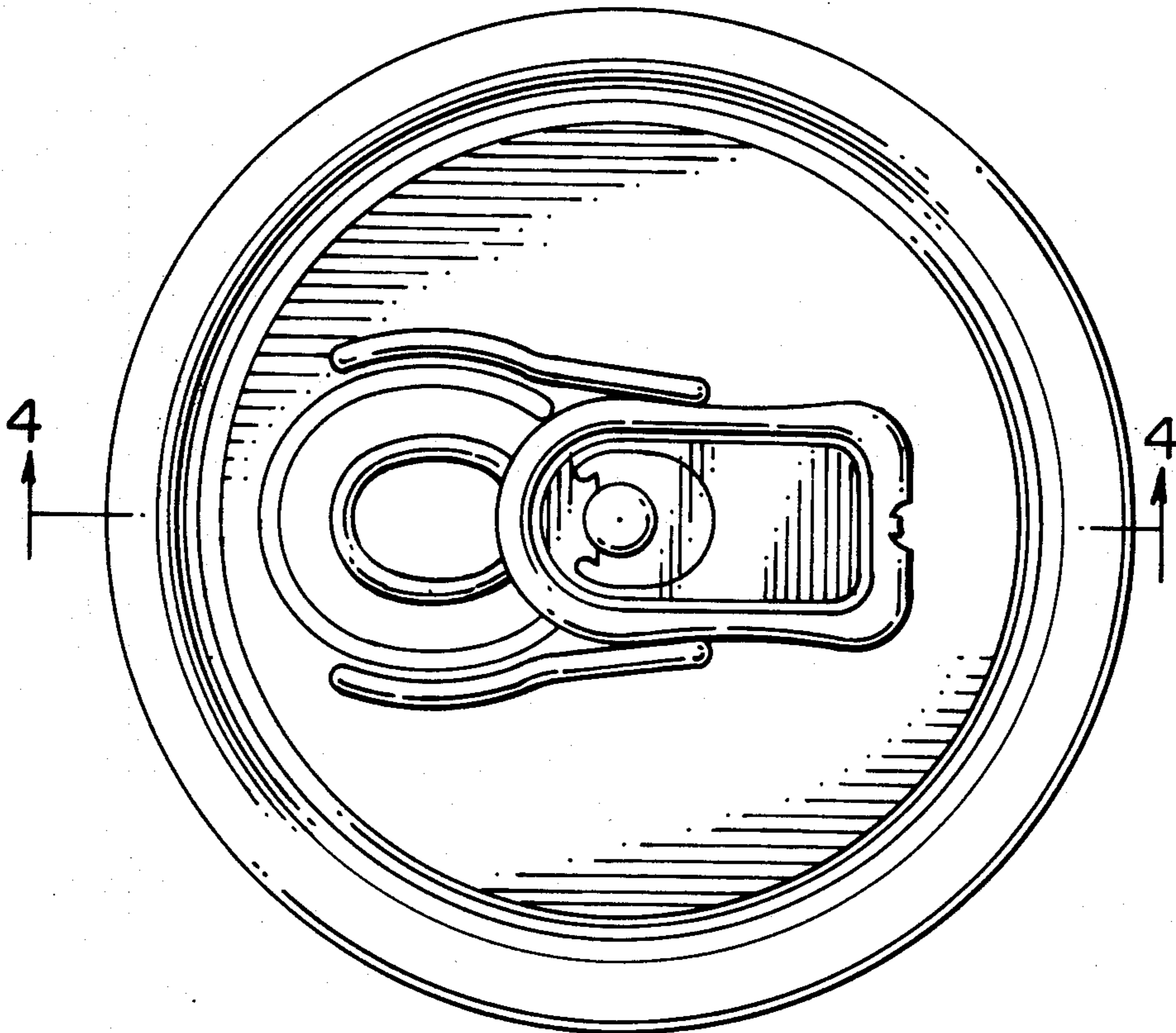

CLAIM

The ornamental design for an end closure for a container, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of an end closure for a container showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view on an enlarged scale;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken on the line 4-4 of FIG. 2.



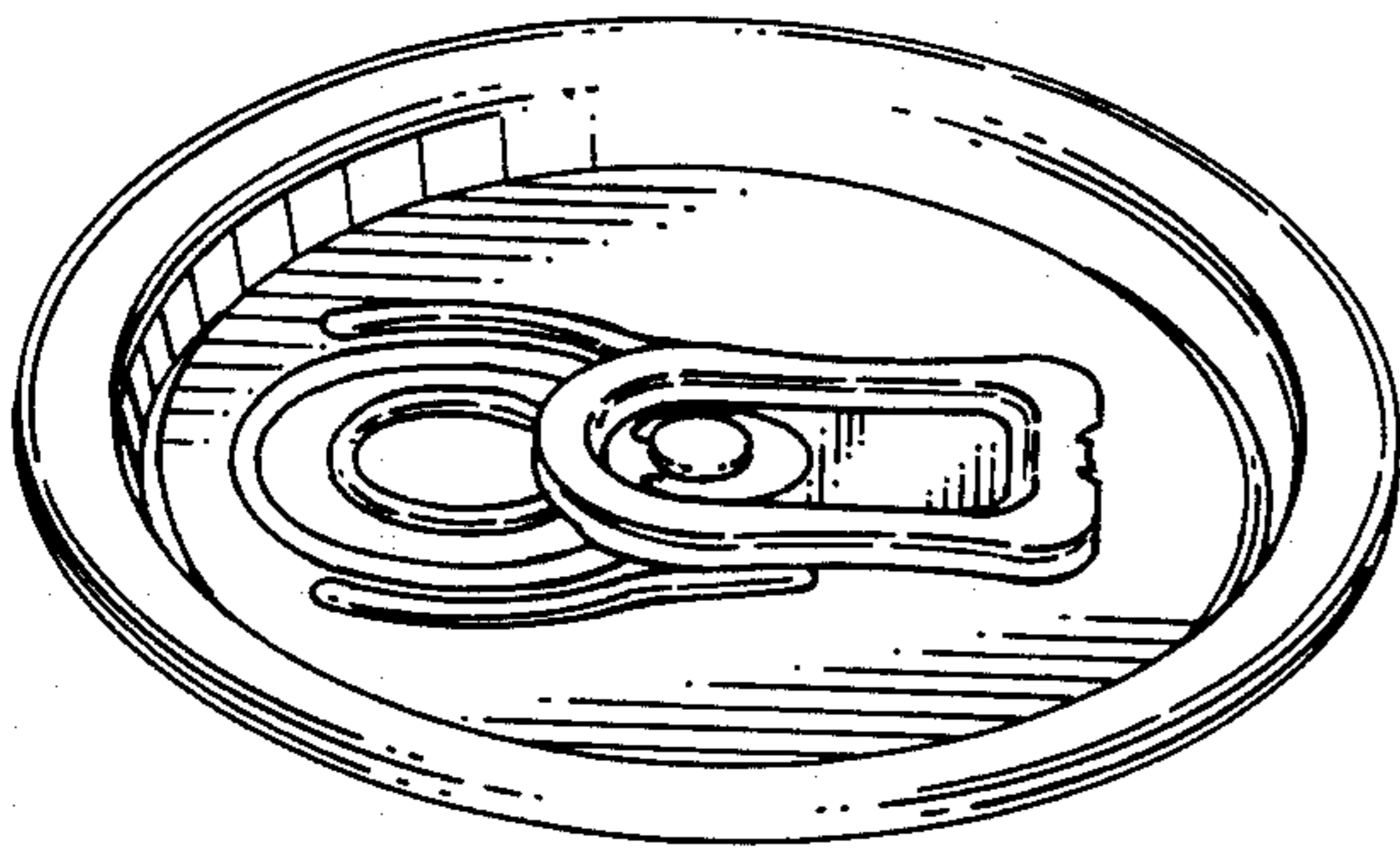

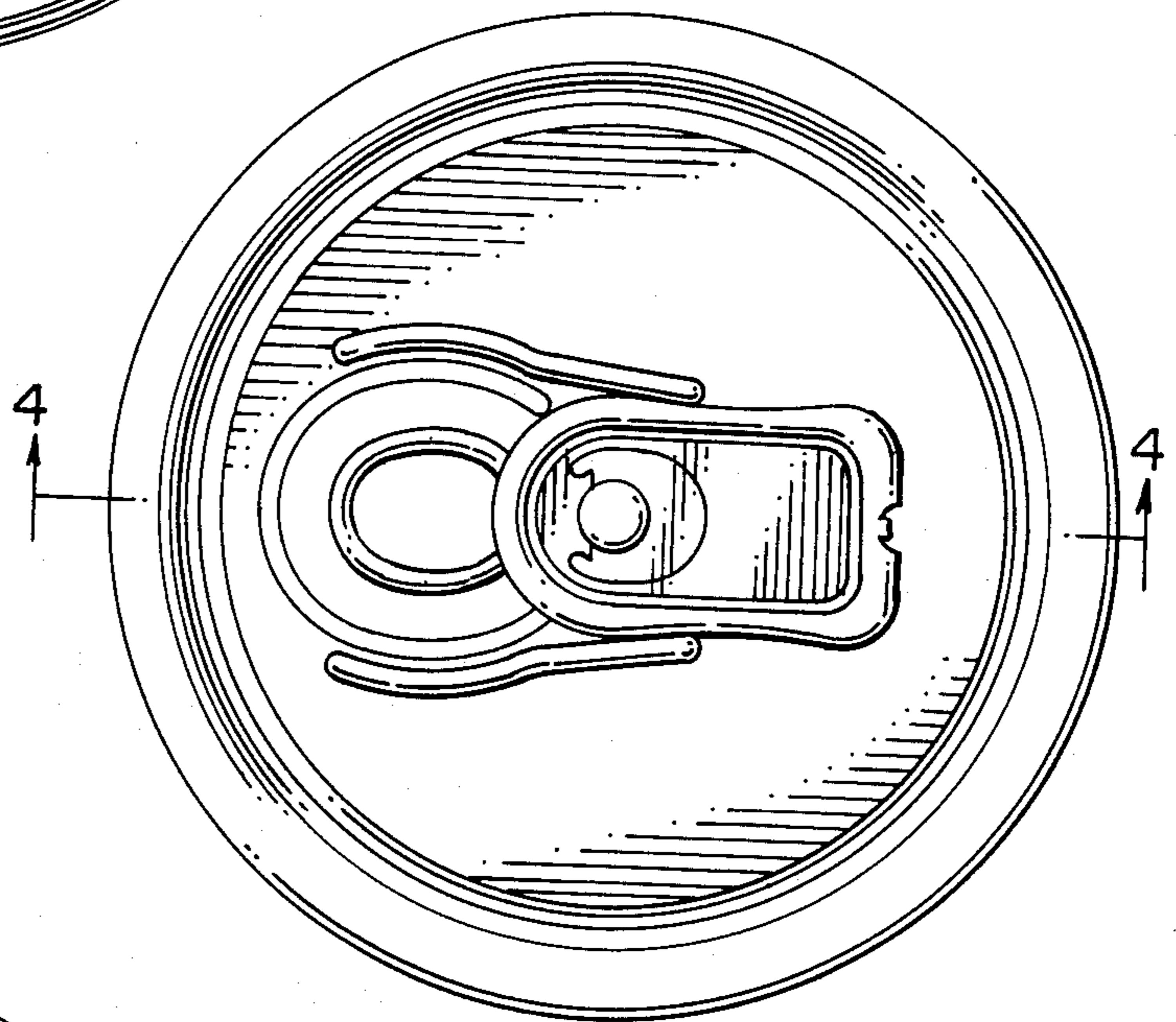

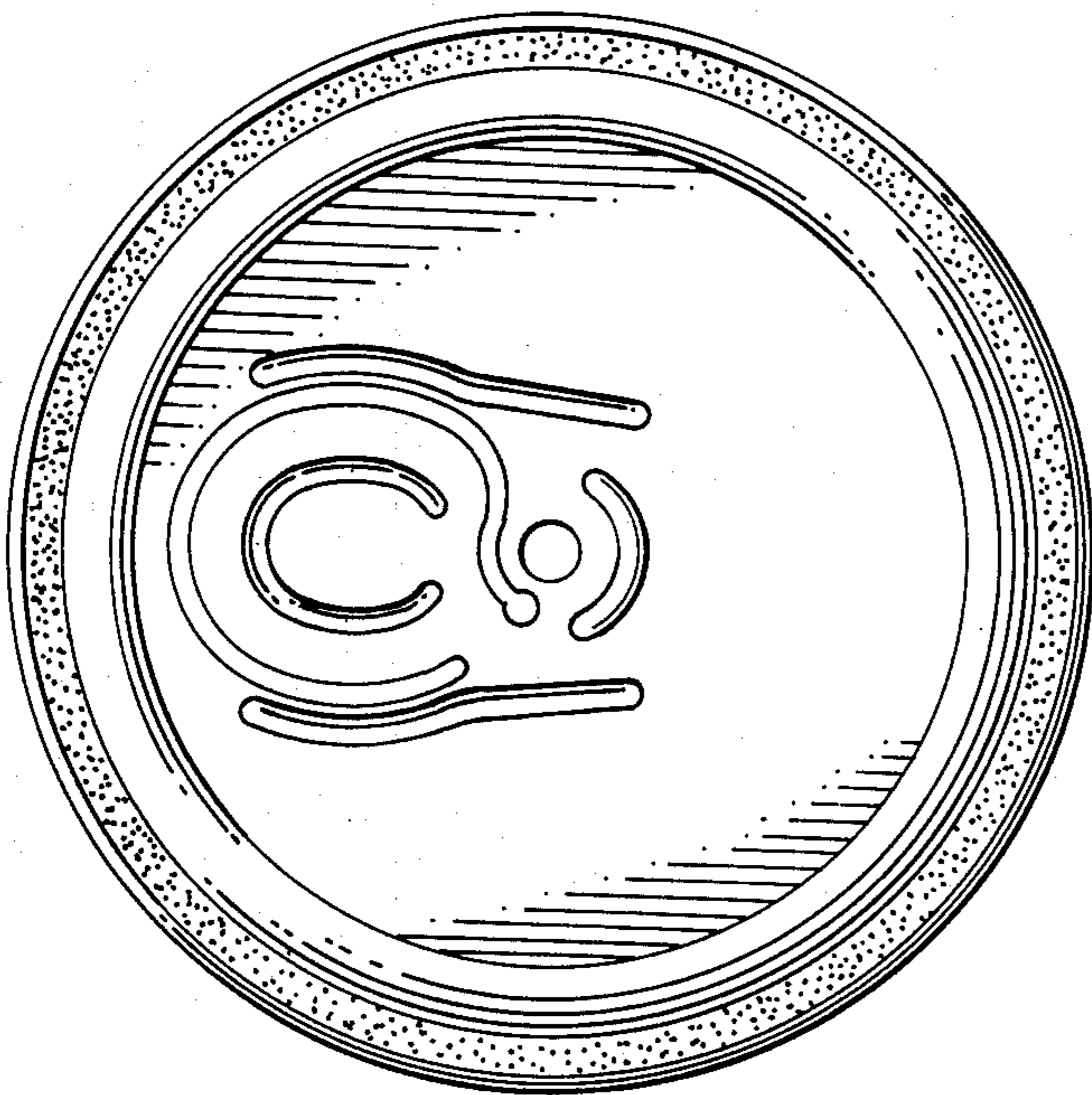

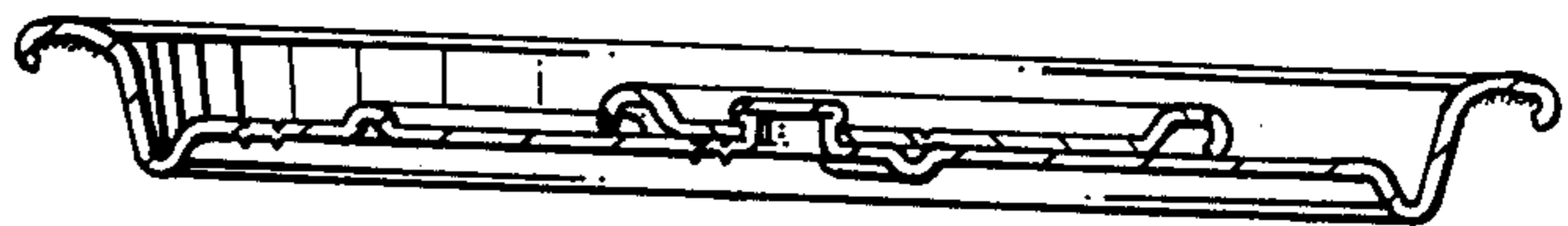
