FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the earring shown in FIG. 1.

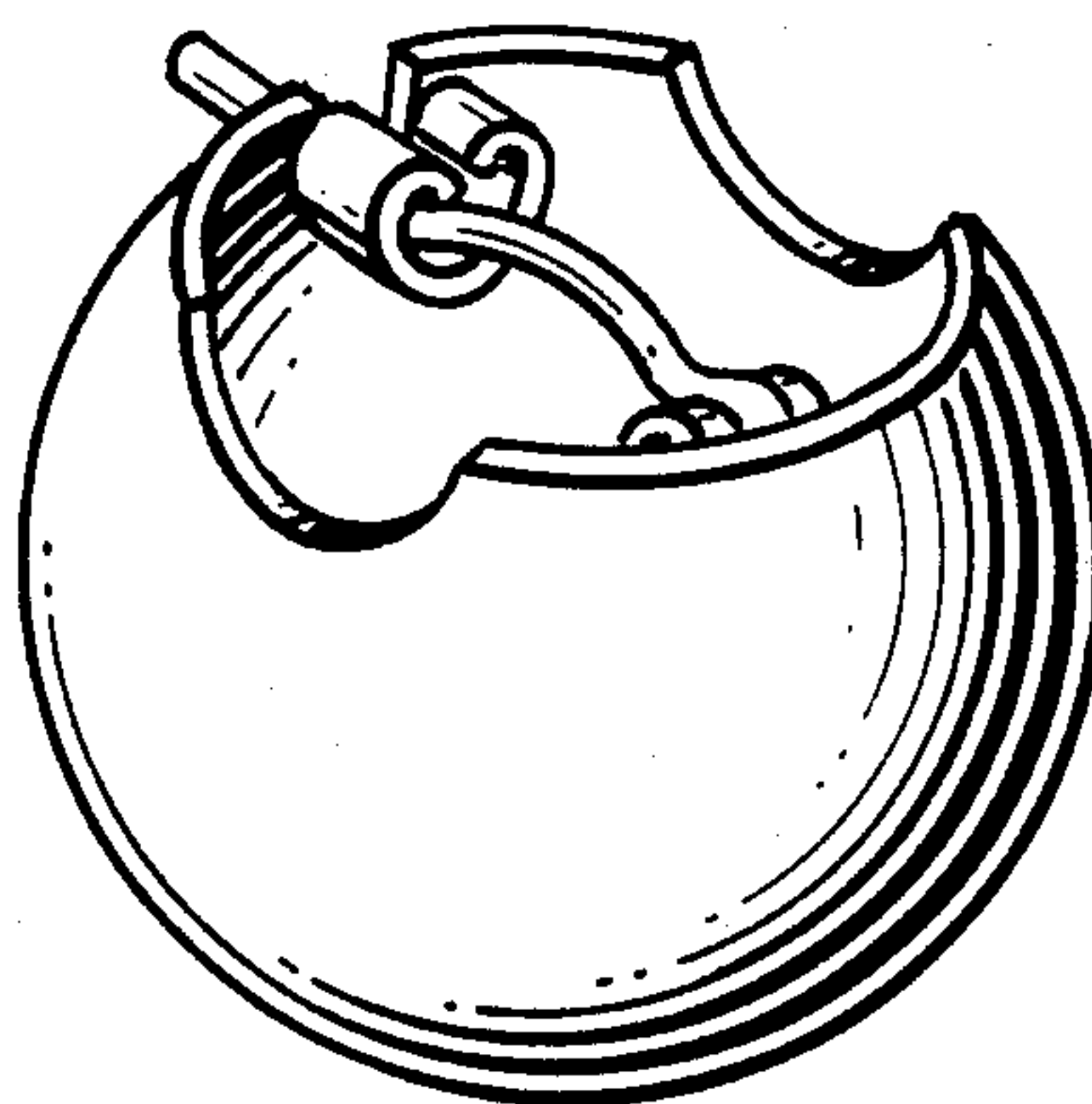

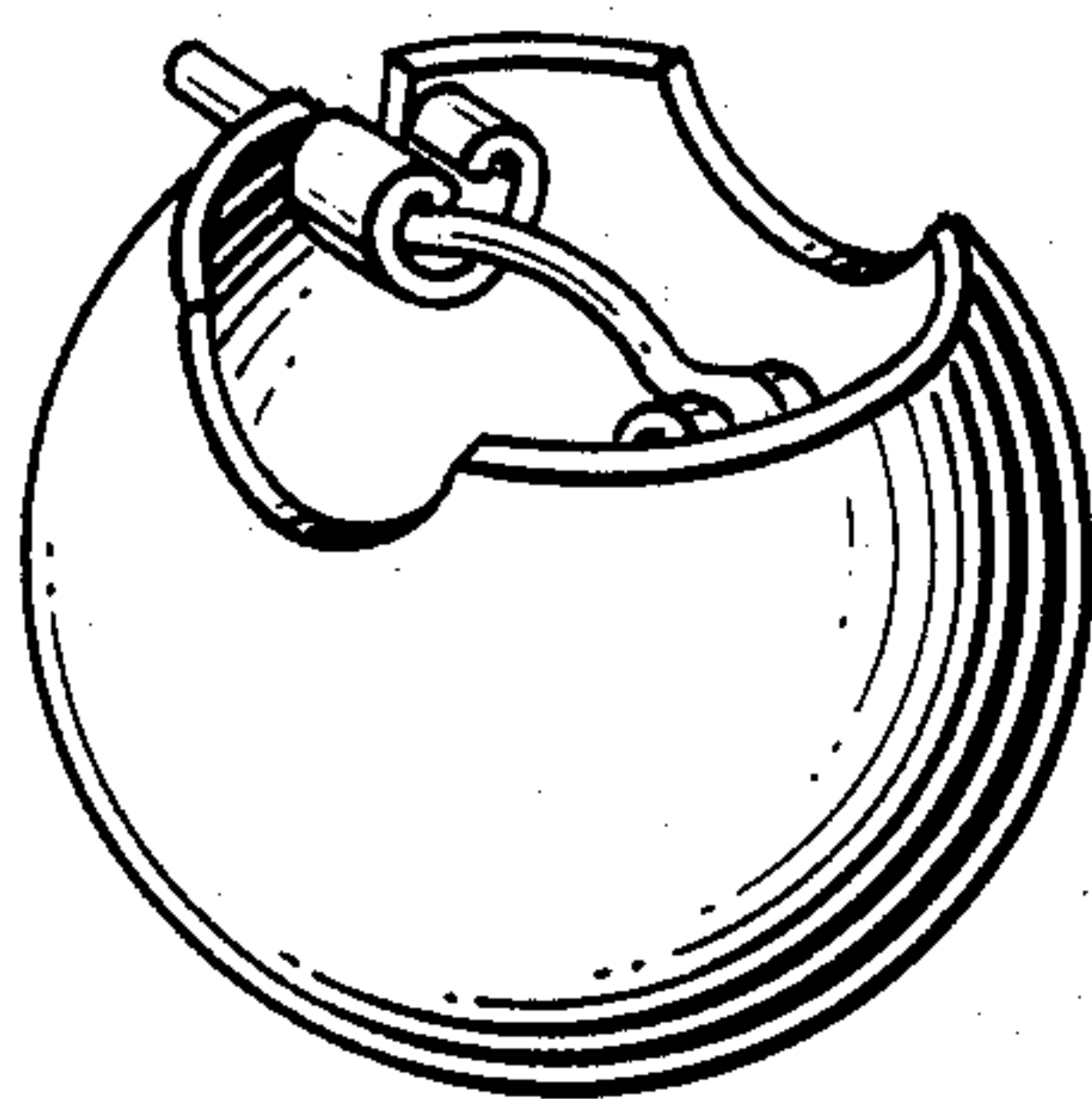

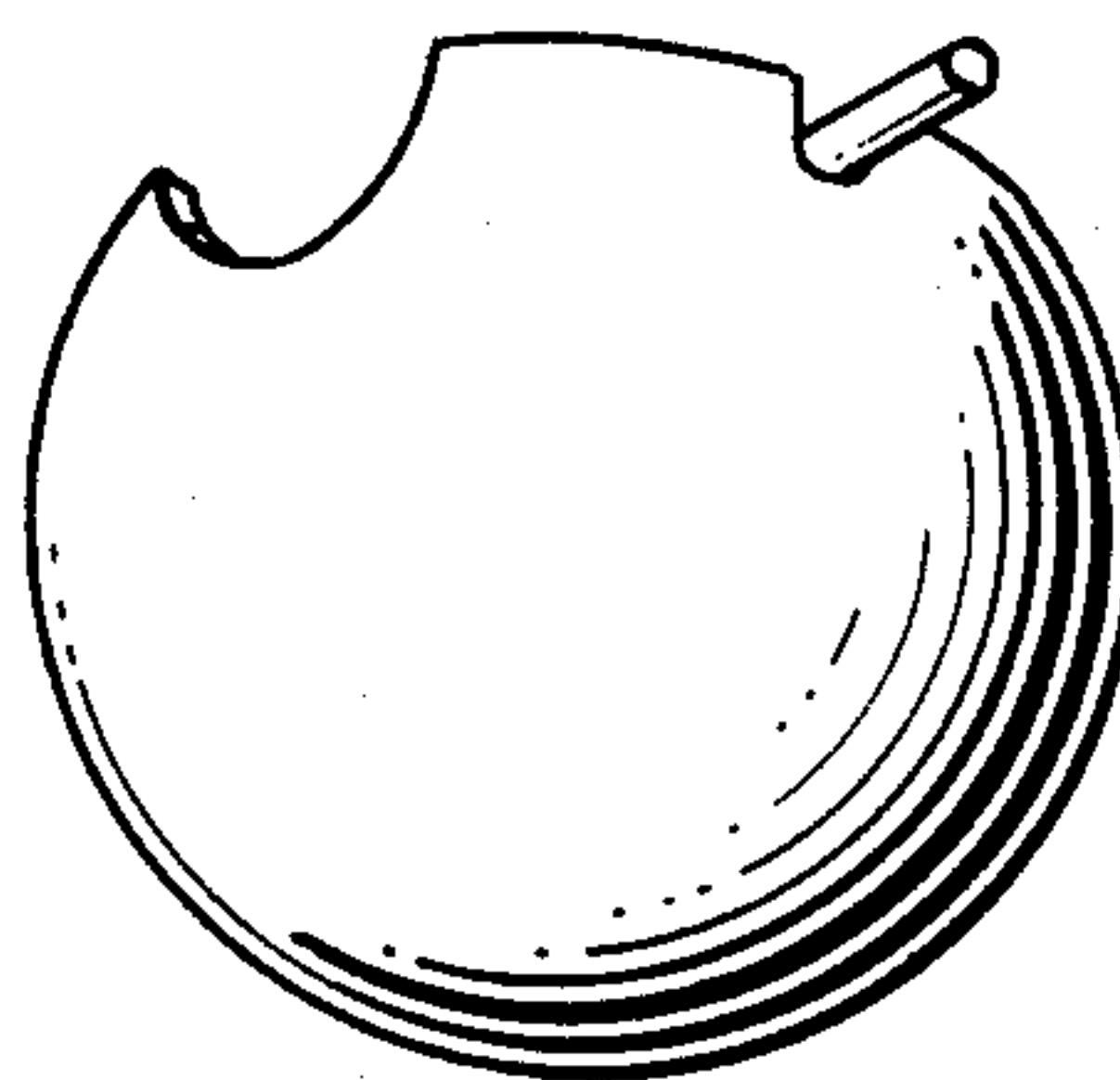

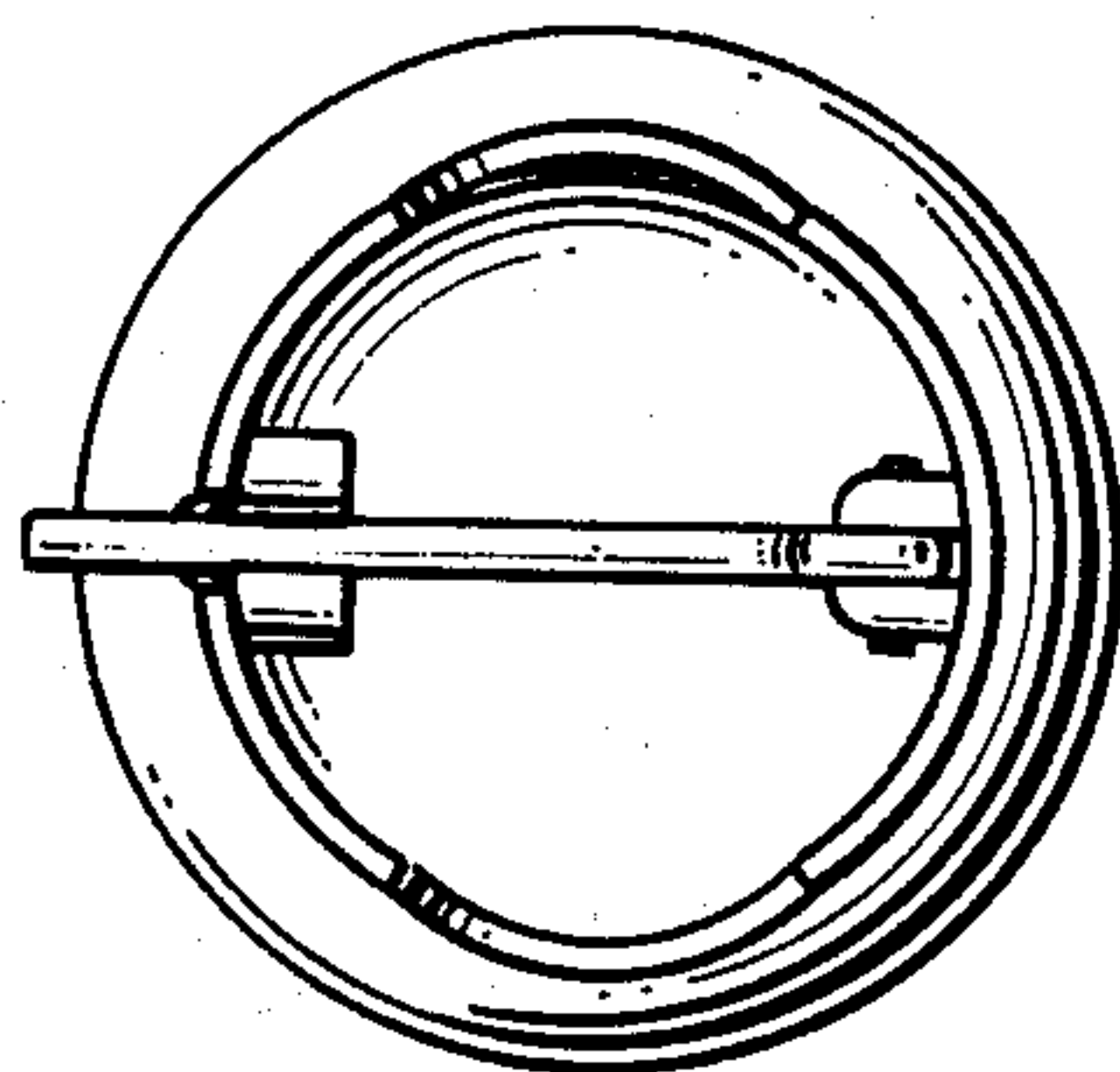
