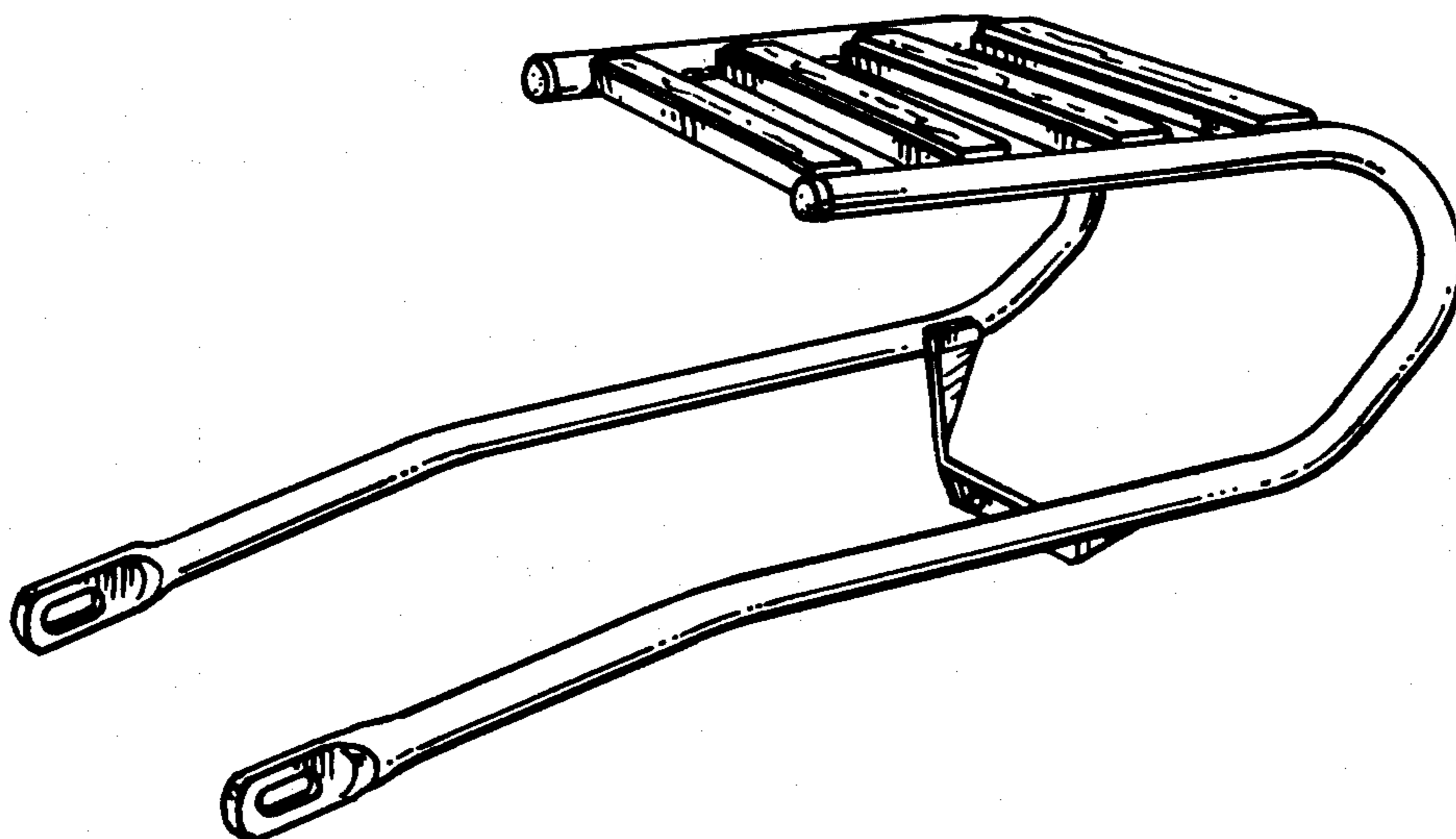

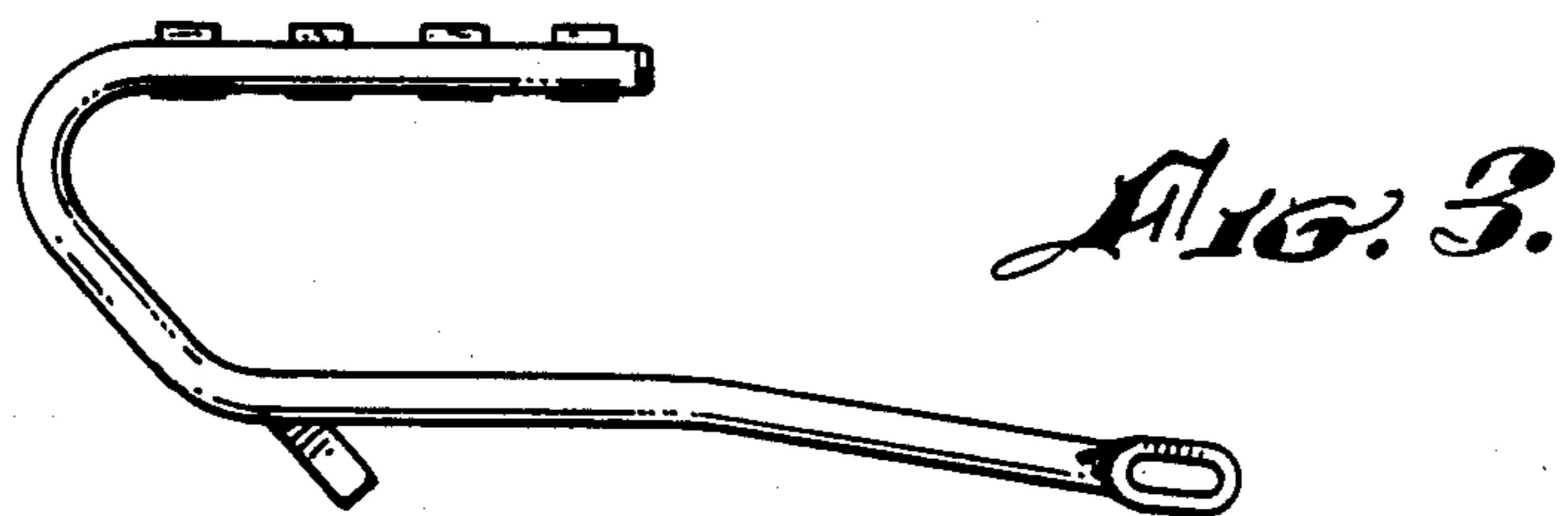
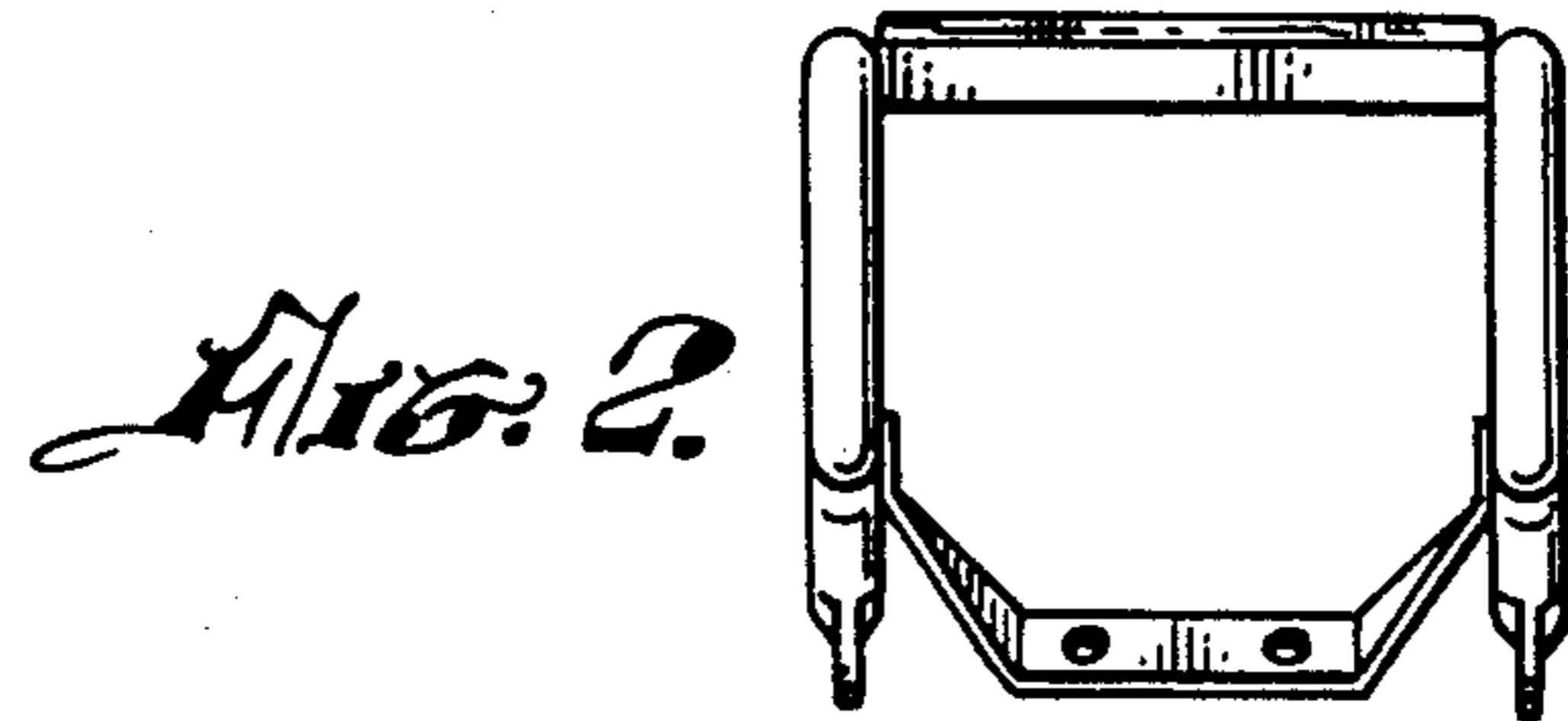
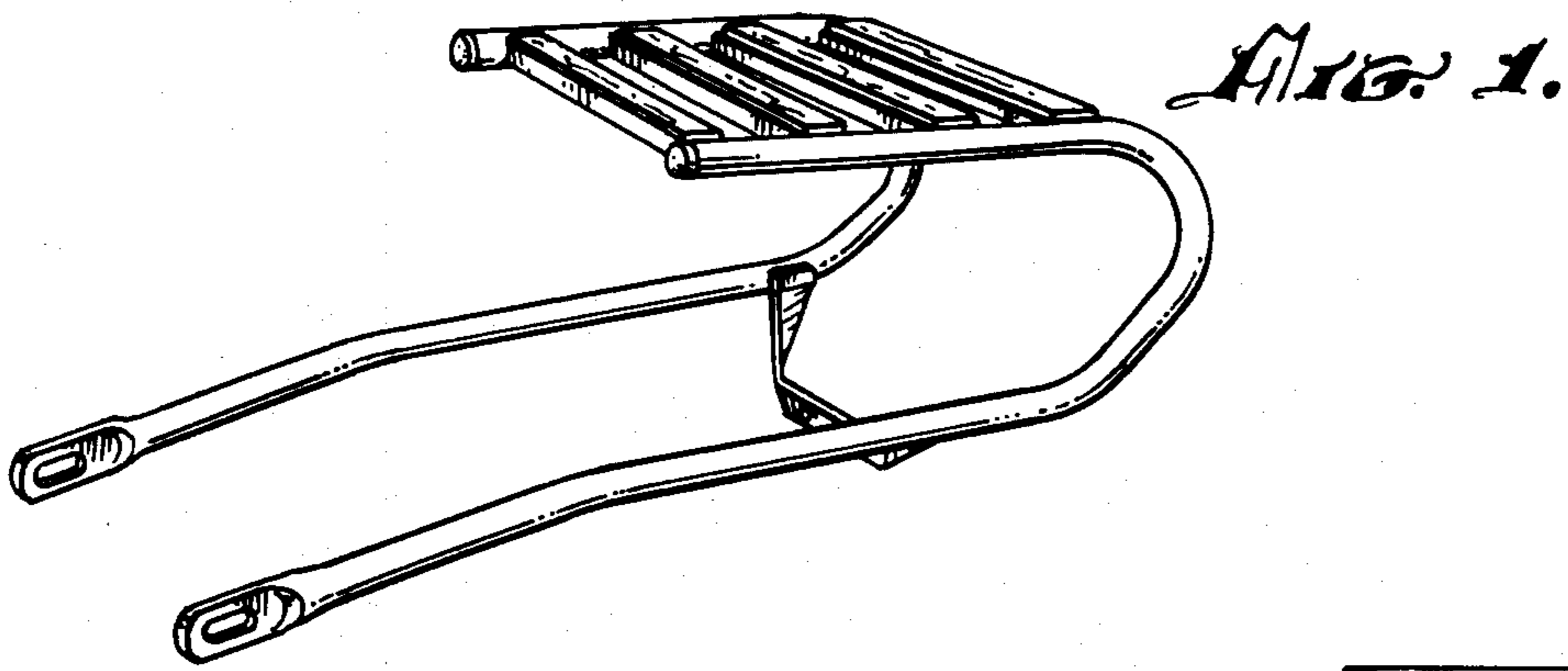
[57] CLAIM
