[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a hole marking and scoring pin for miniature golf game, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a hole marking and scoring pin for miniature golf game embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the pin of FIG. 1, showing its tilted position.

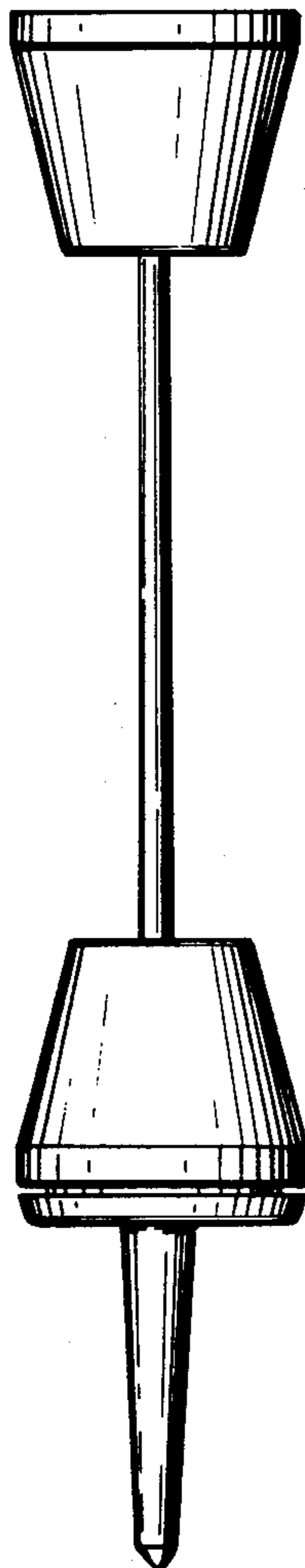

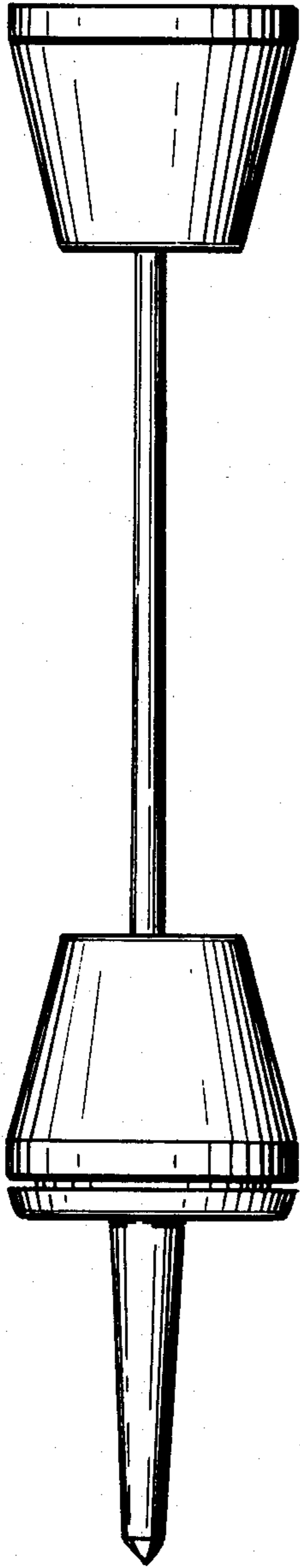

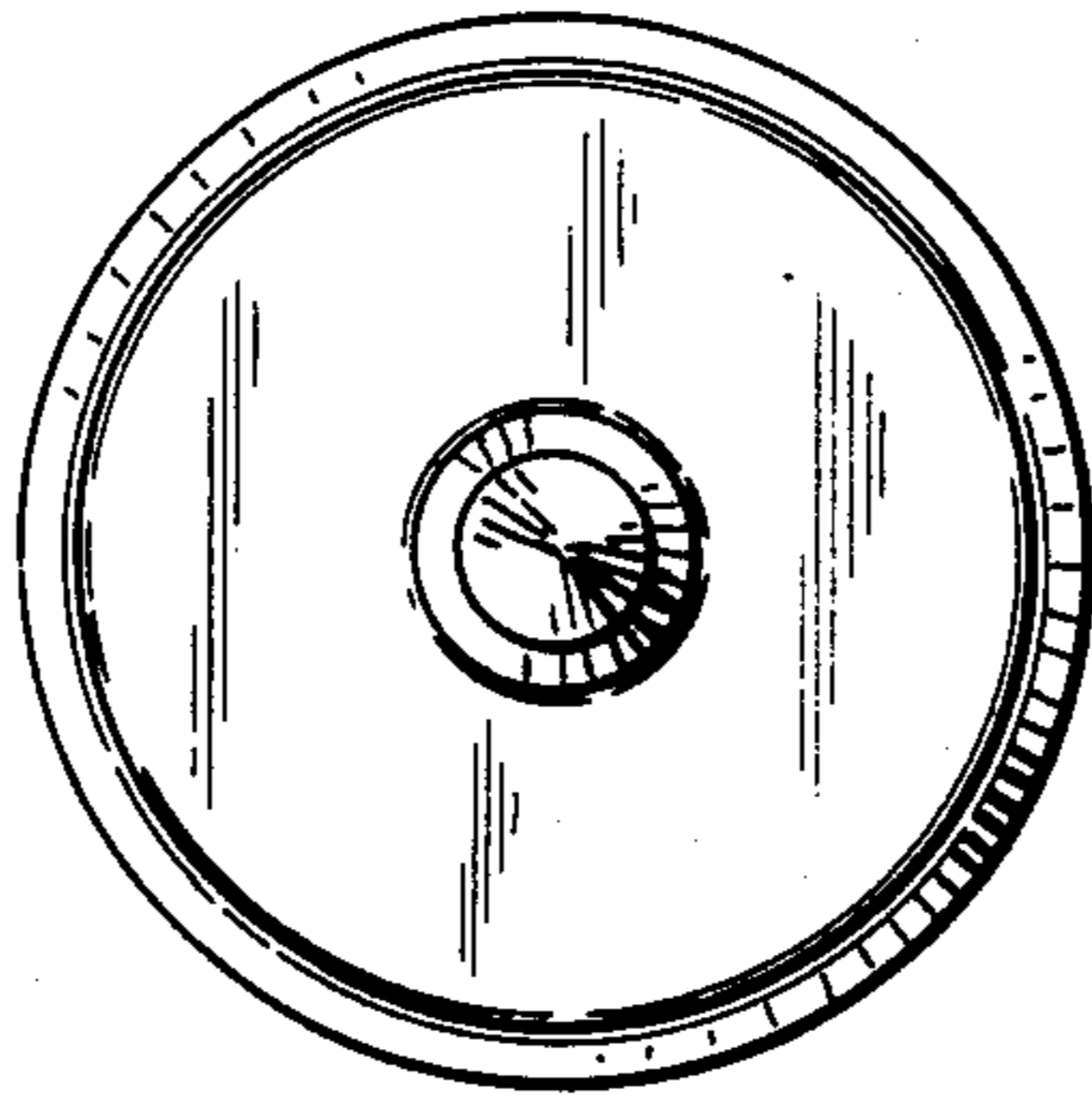
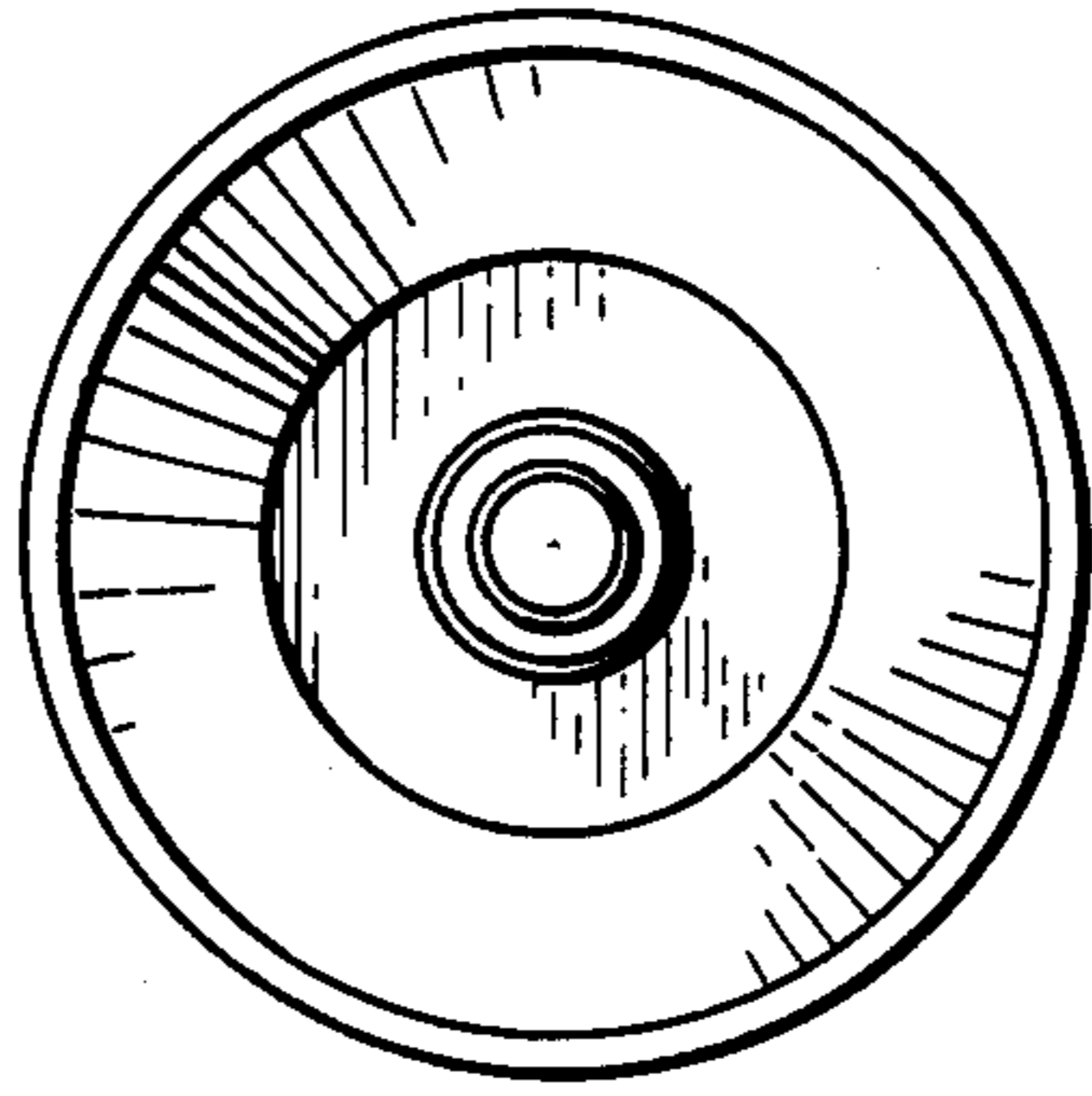

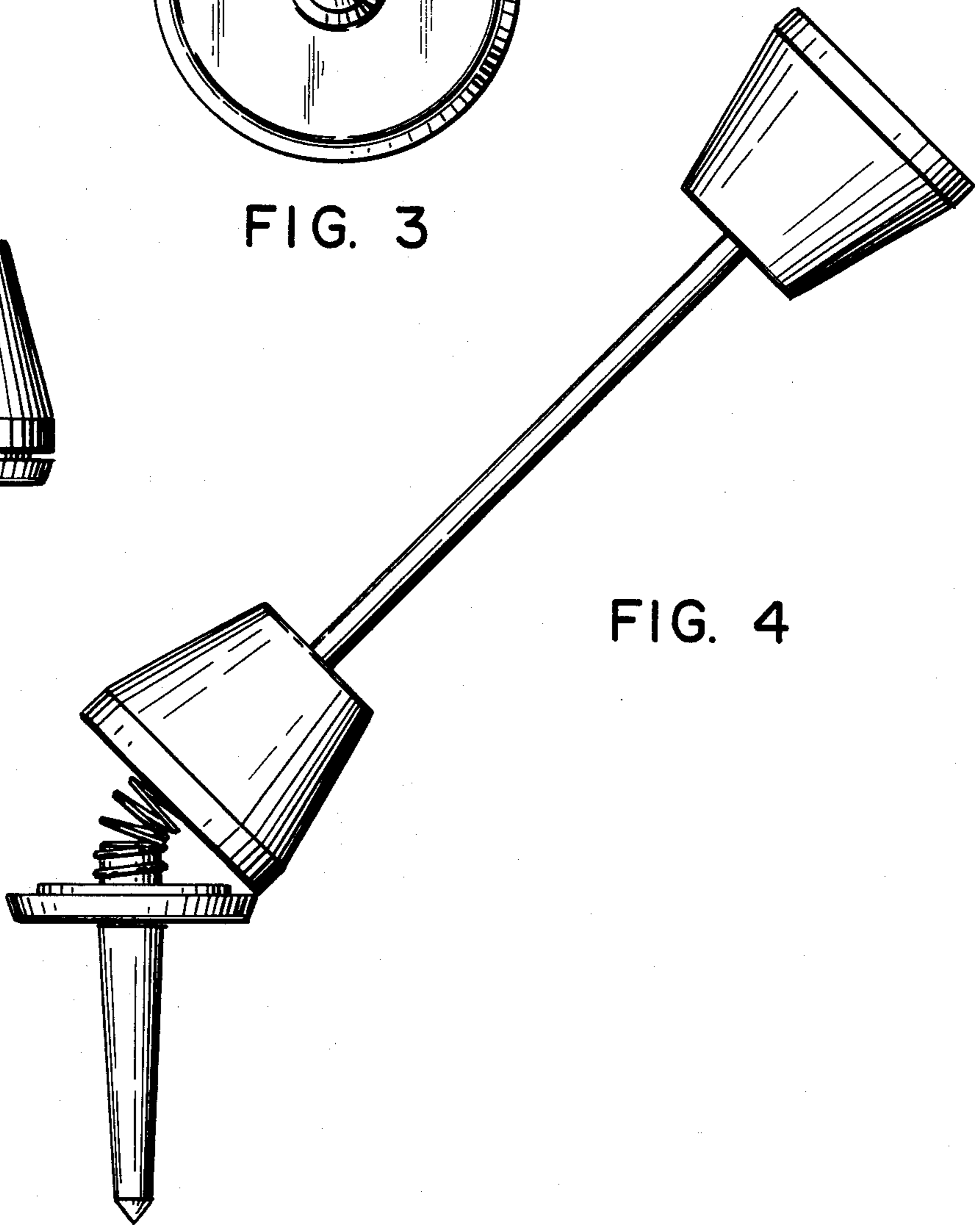
