[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a stand for potted plants, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a stand for potted plants showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the supporting element;

FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 2;

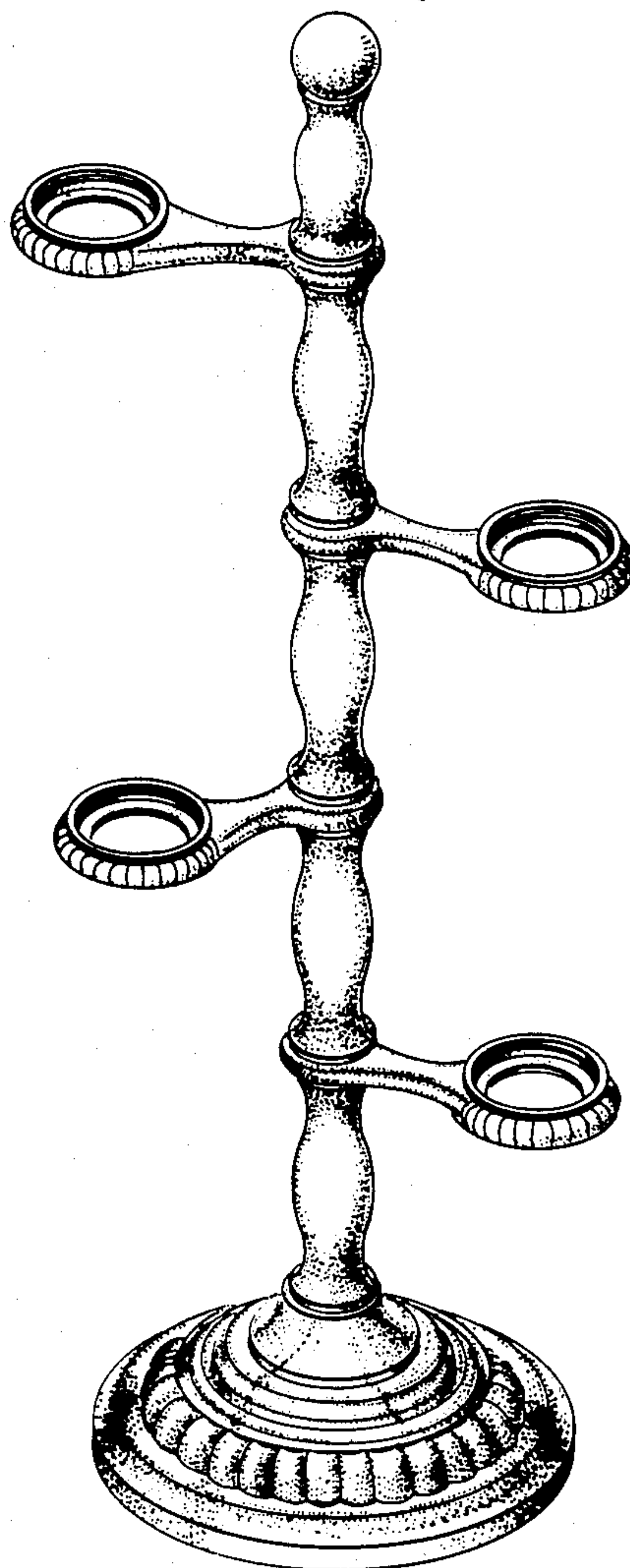
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the base section;

FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a top view of the saucer which fits into the supporting element shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 8 is a sectional view taken along line 8—8 of FIG. 7.

The flower pots in FIG. 1 which are shown in broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and do not form a part of the claimed design.



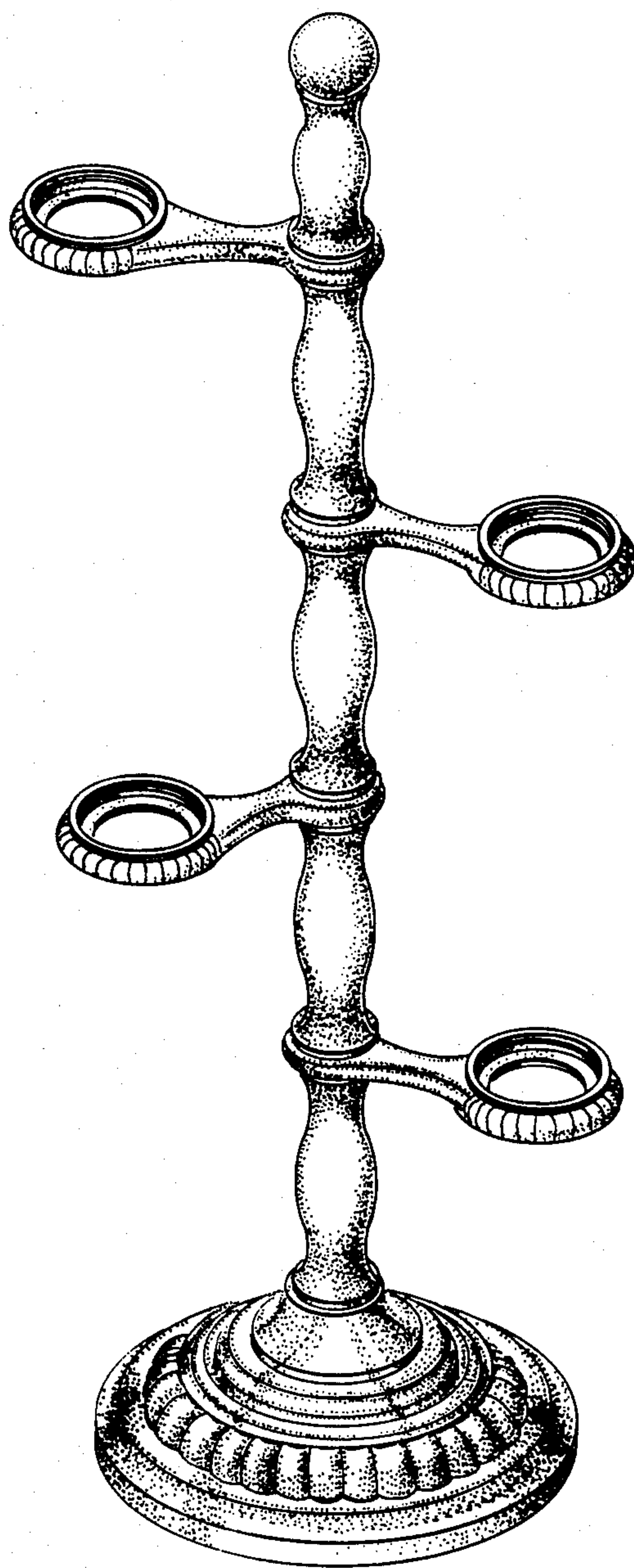

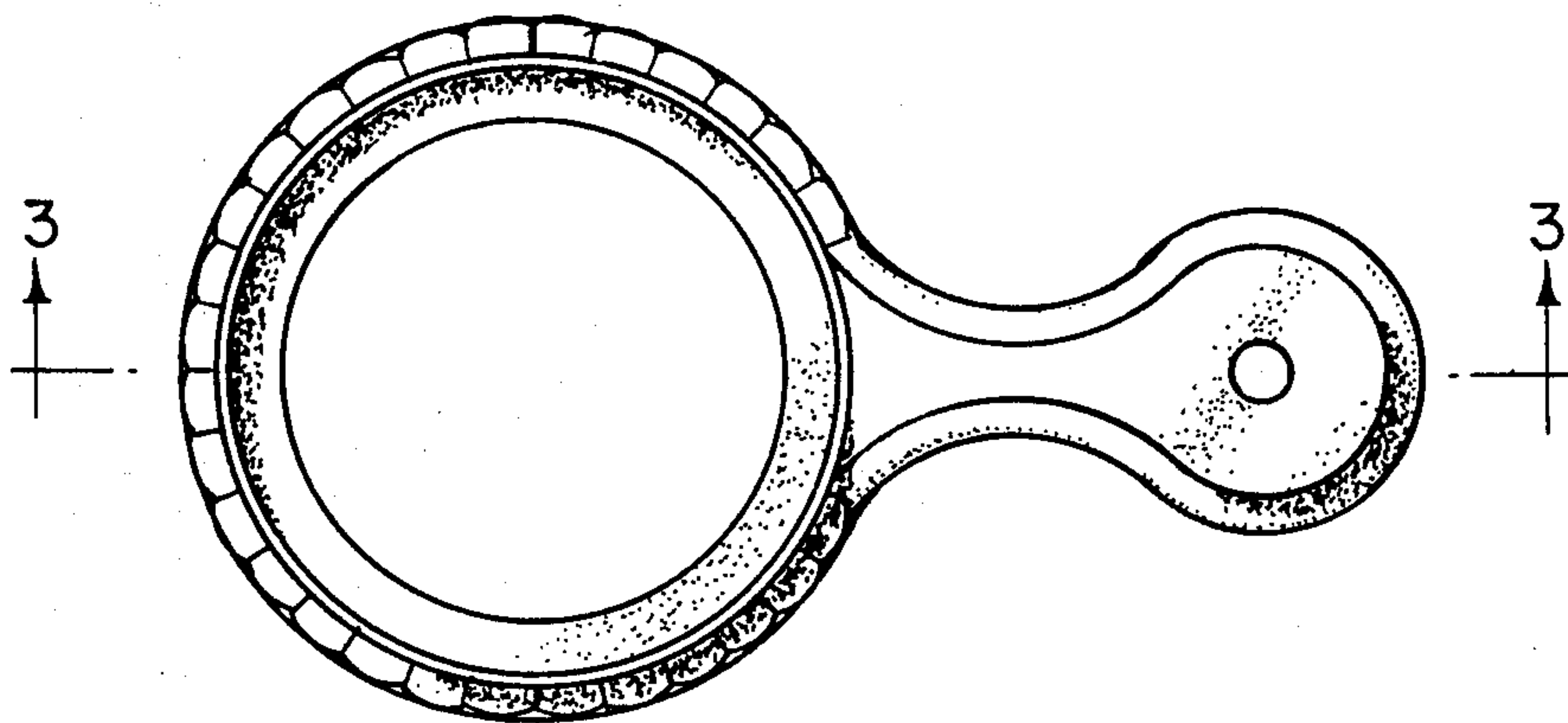

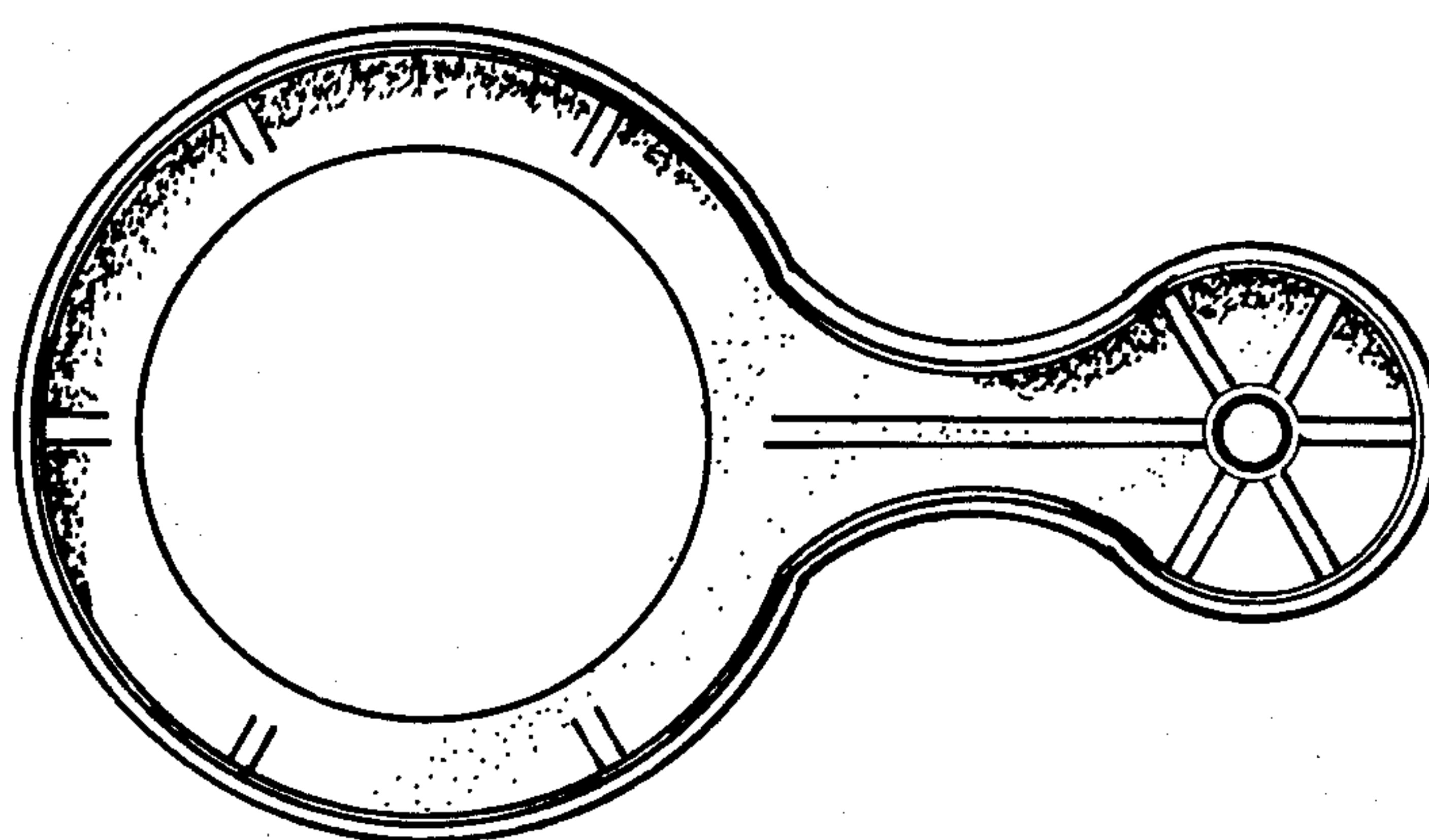

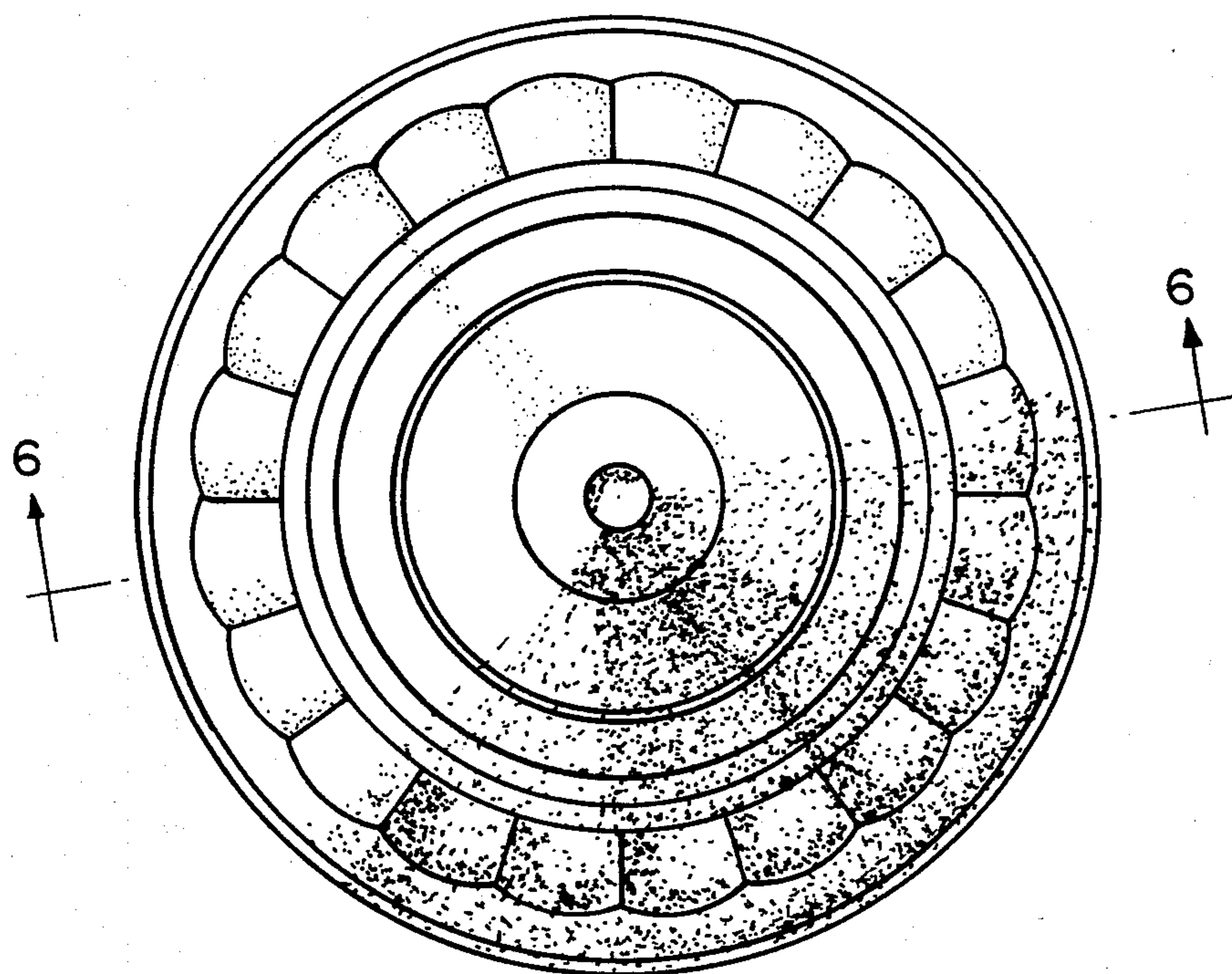

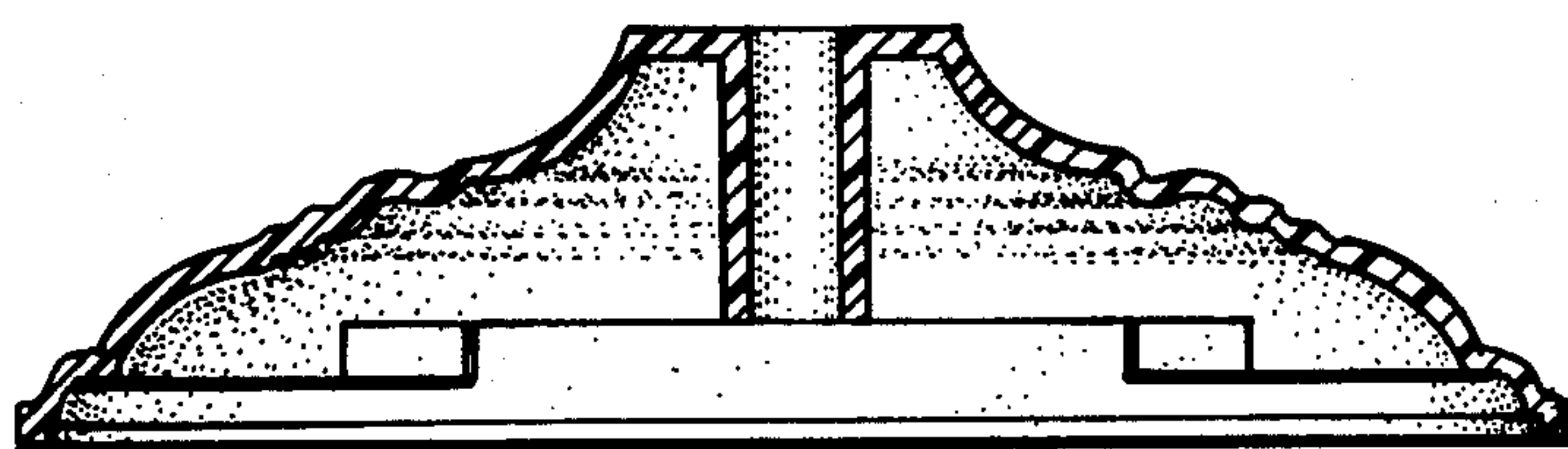

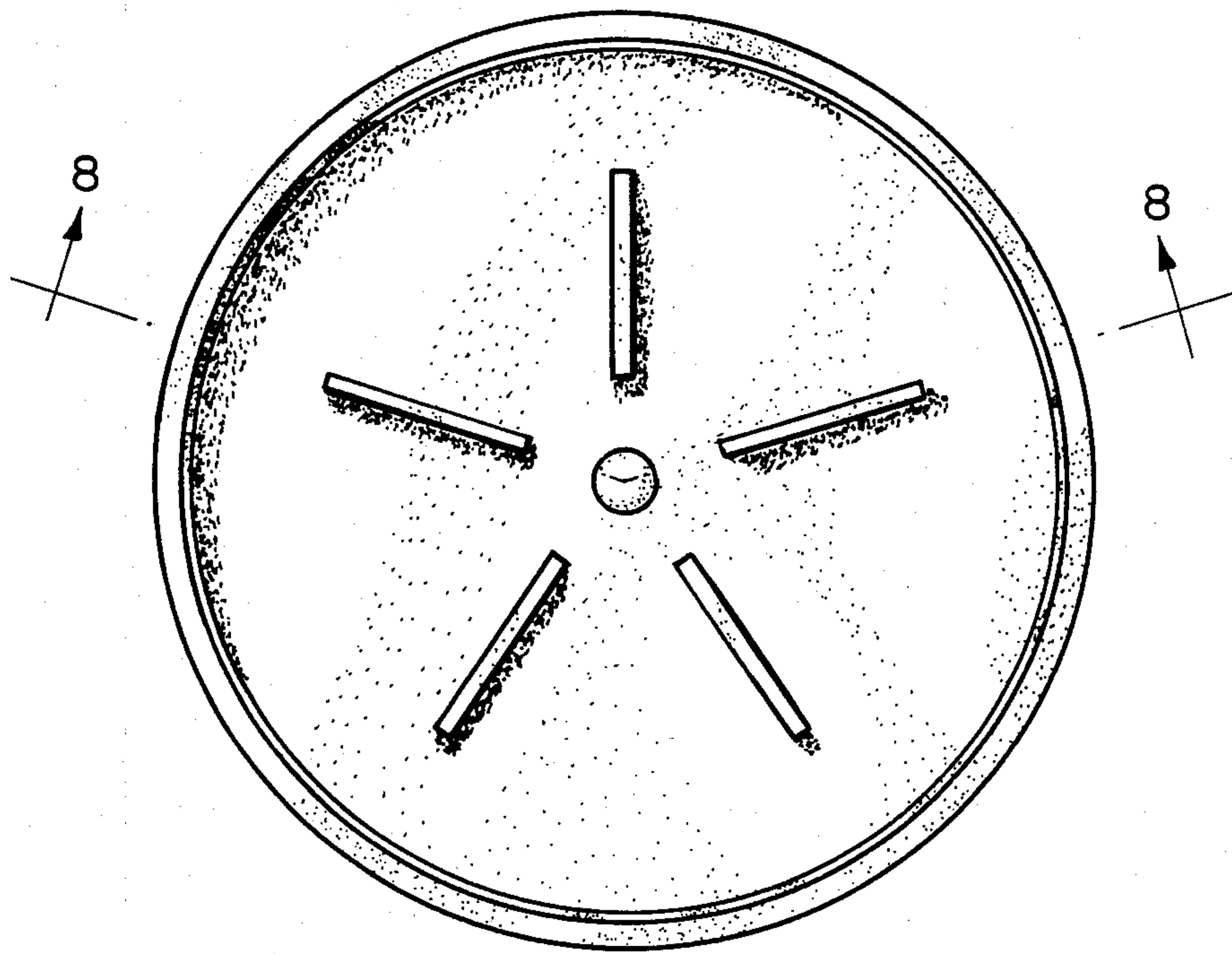
