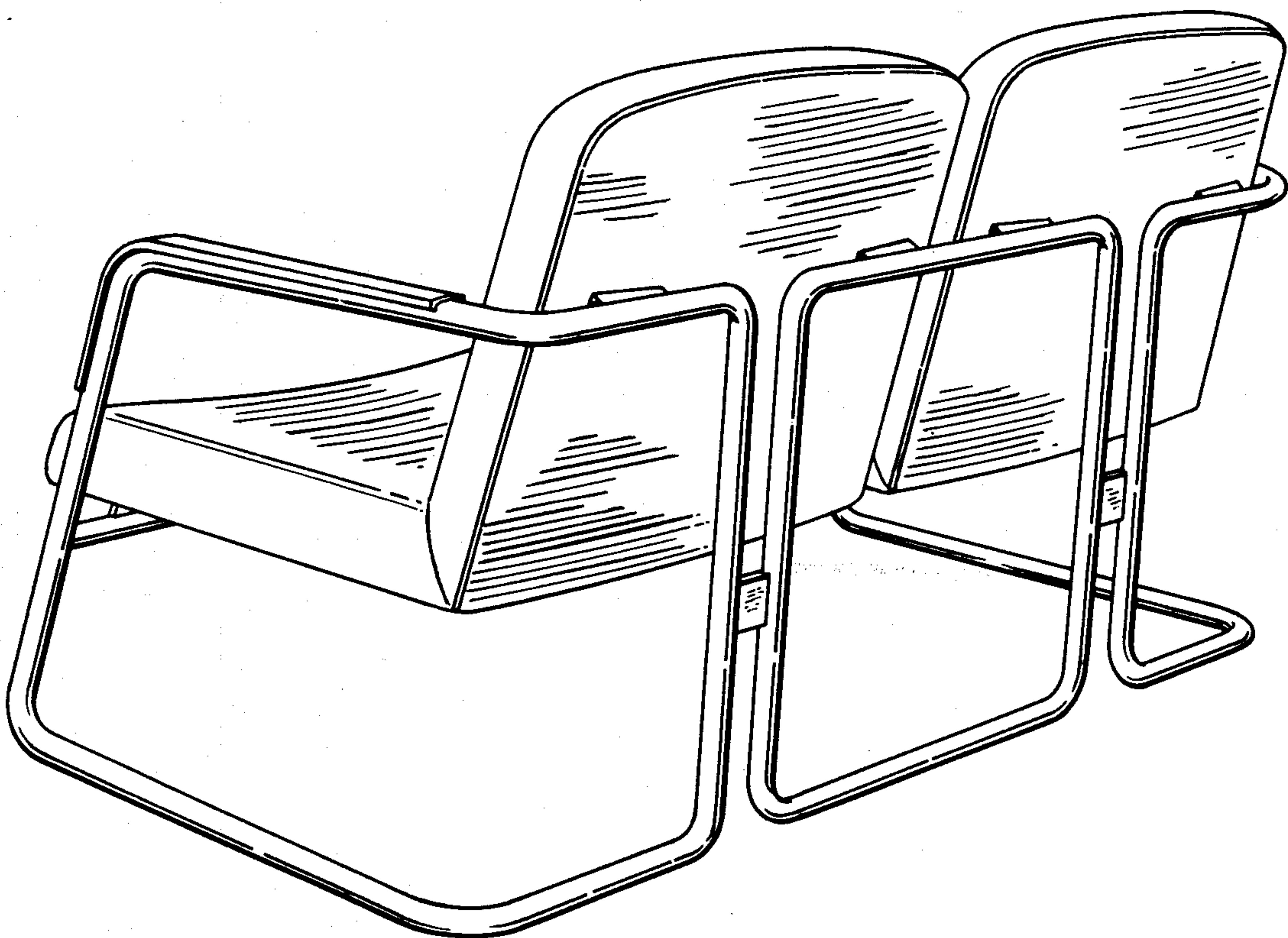

FIG. 2 is an oppositely directed perspective view.



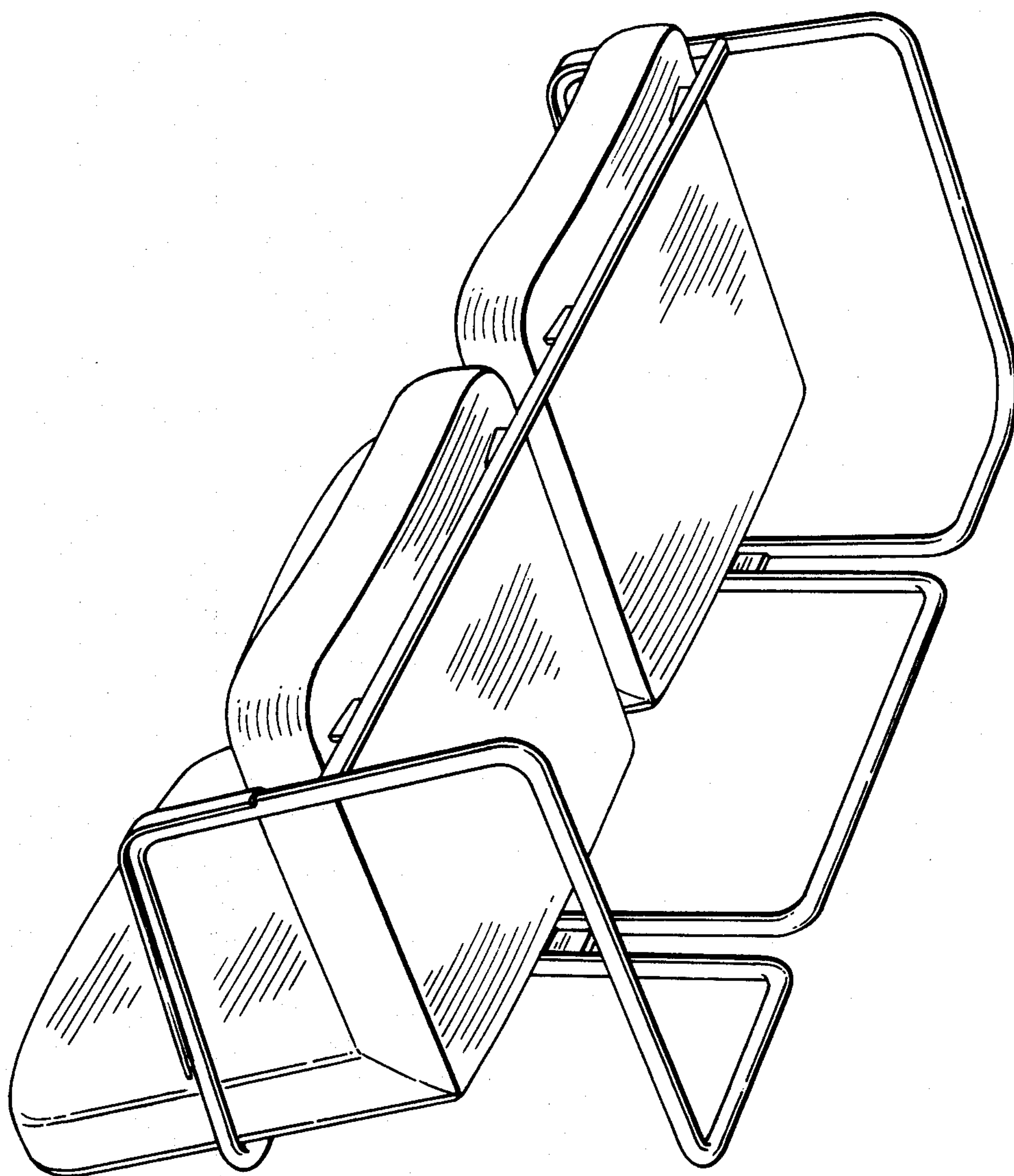
