FIG. 1 is a rear elevational view of a luggage carrier showing my new design;

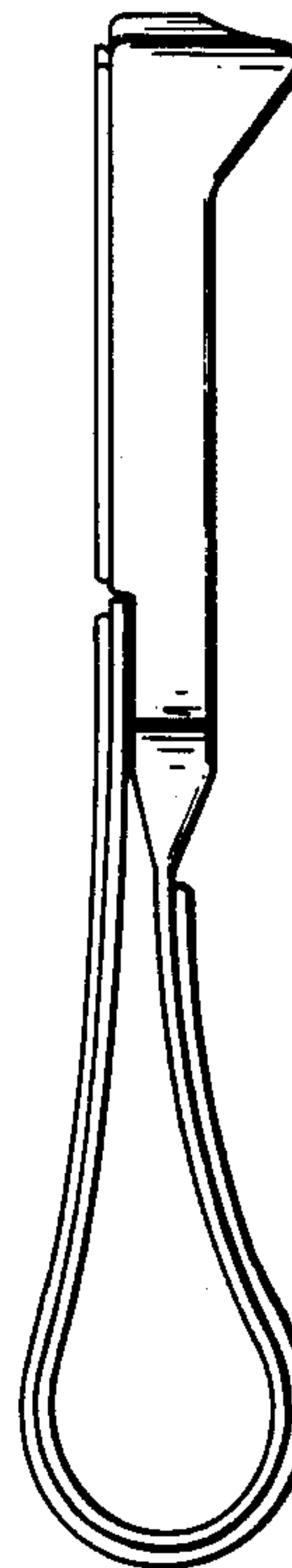
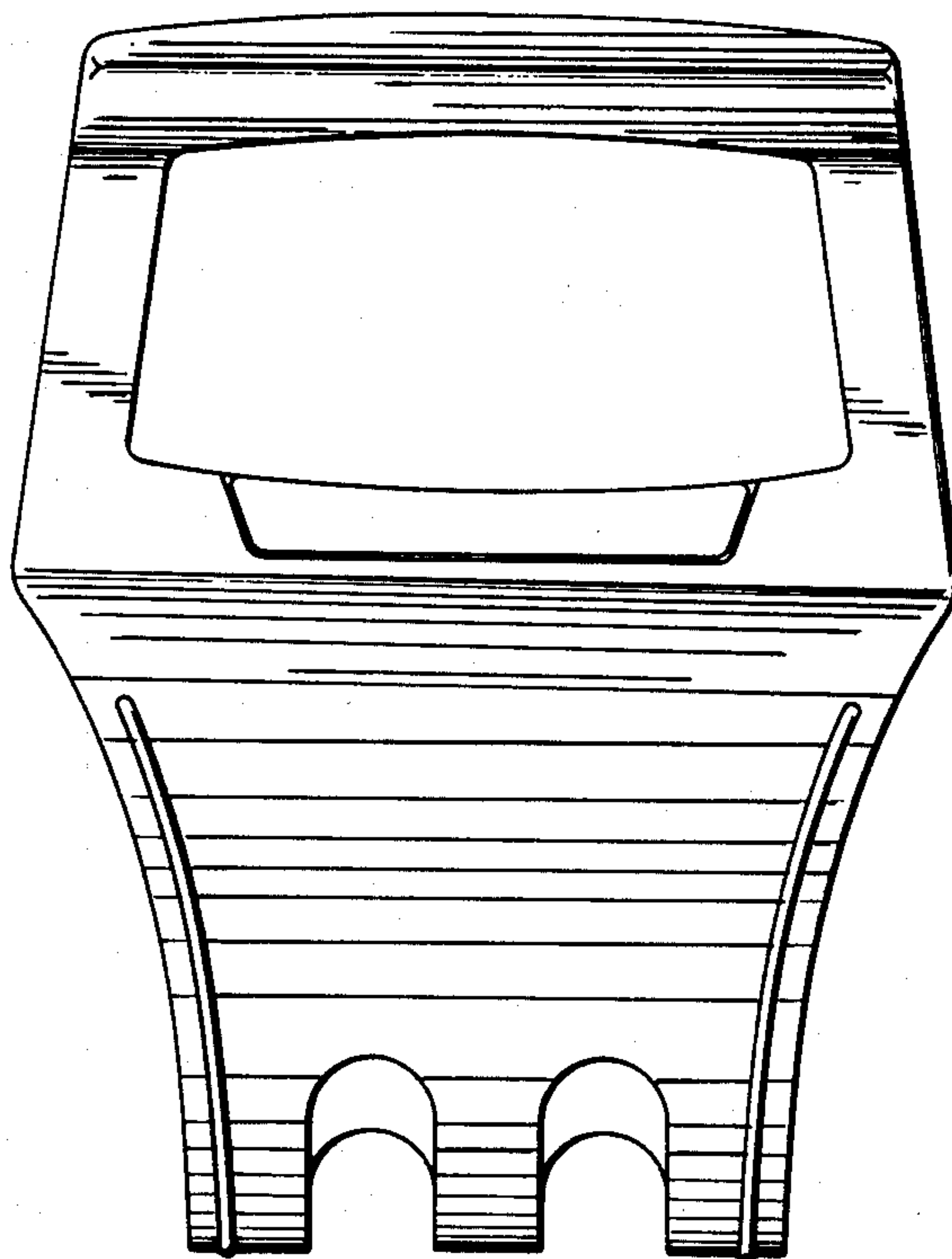
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view;

The appearance of the side opposite that shown in FIG. 2 is a mirror image of FIG. 2.



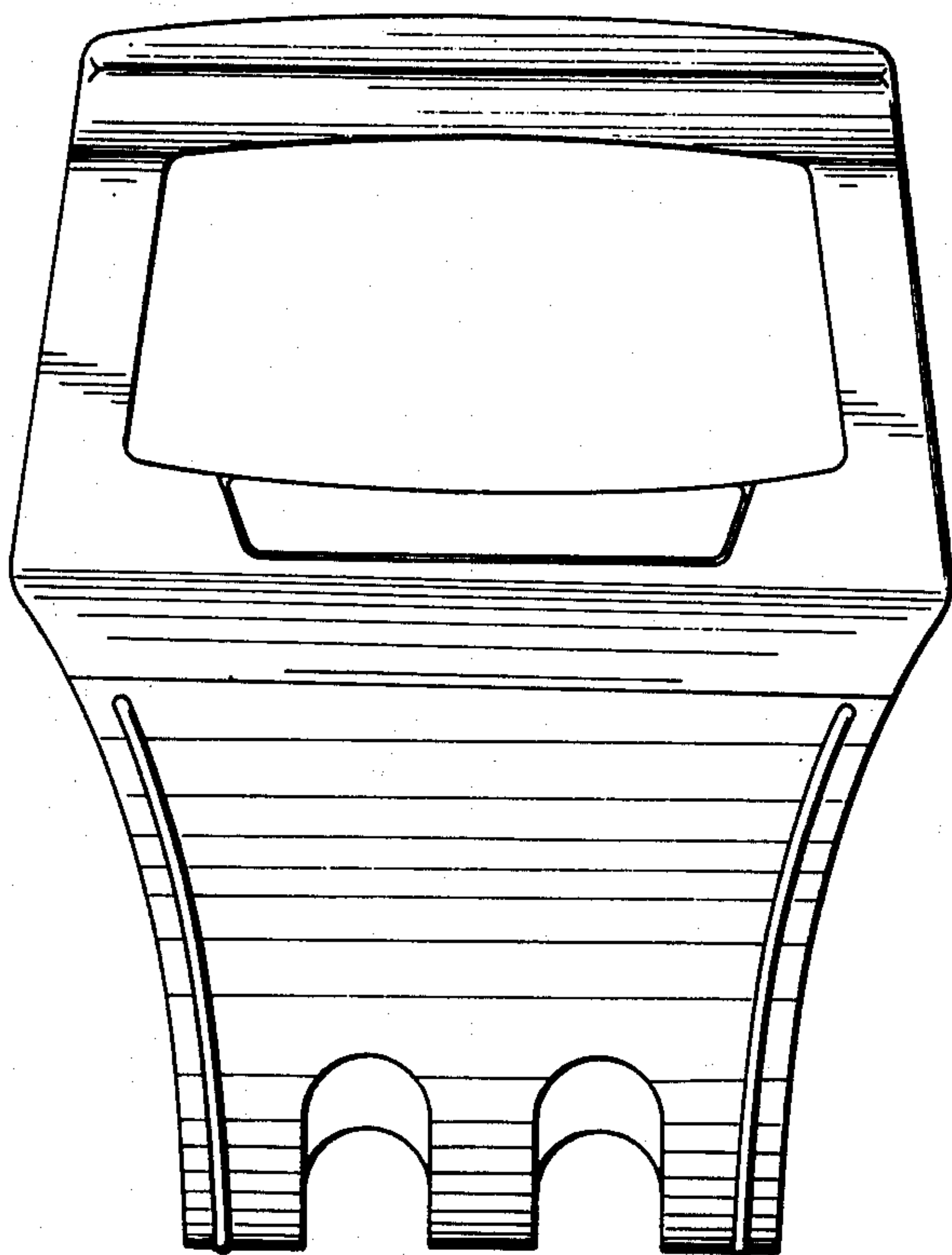

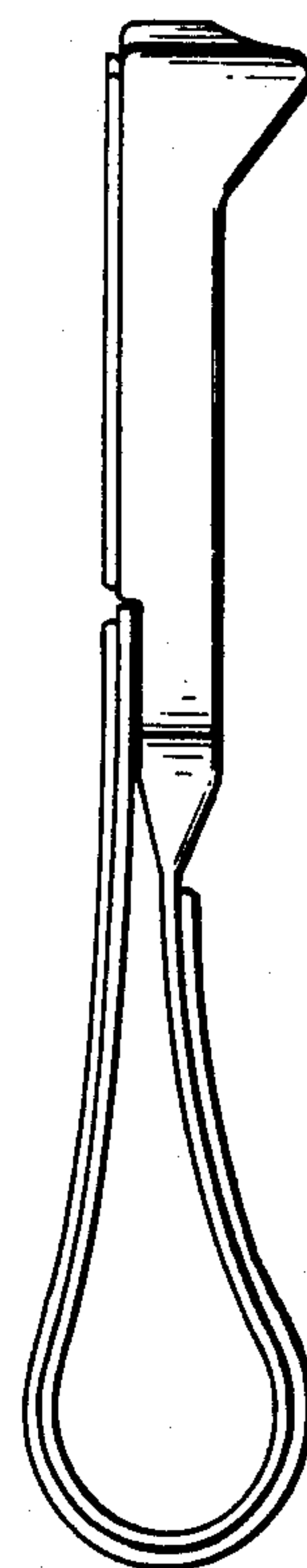

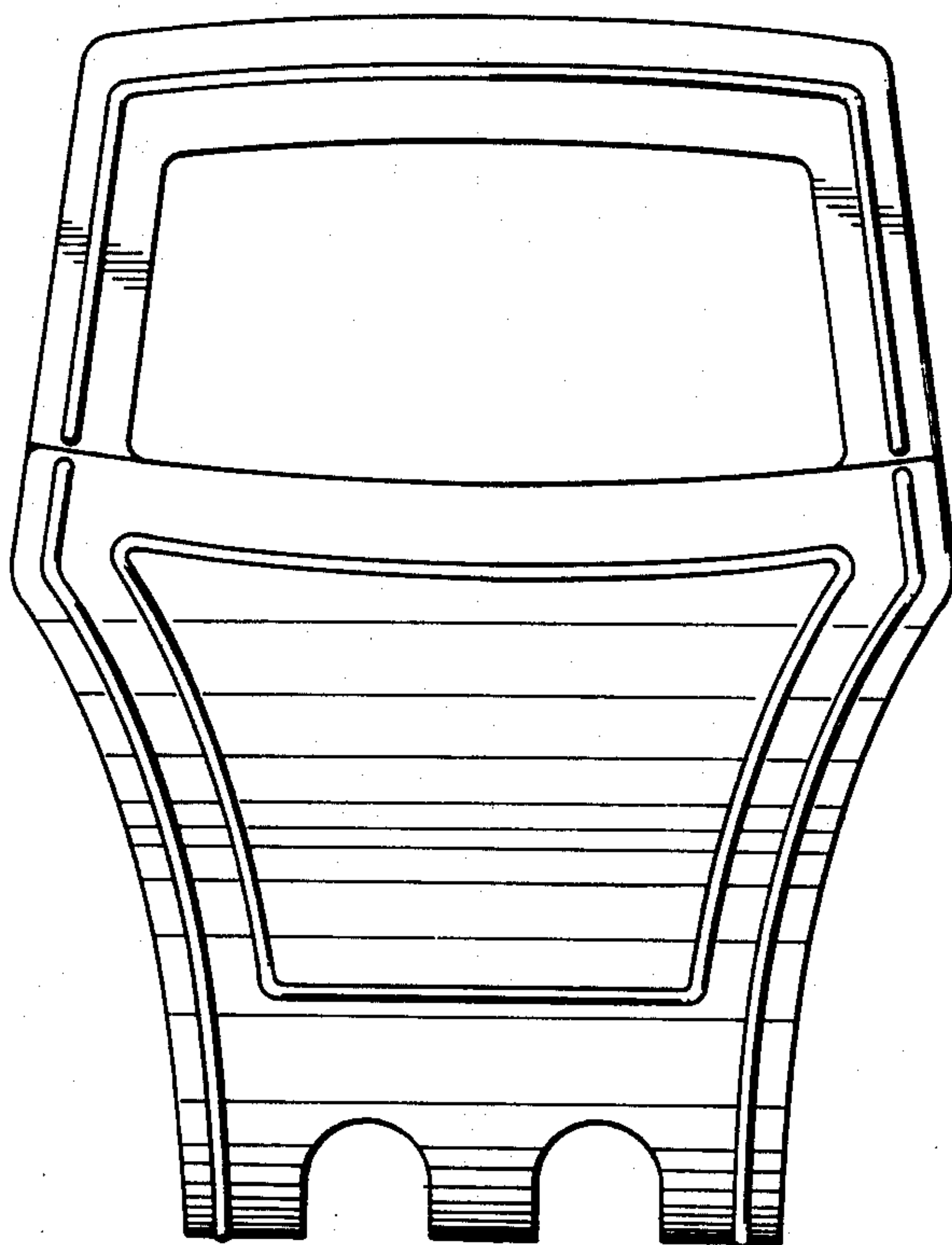

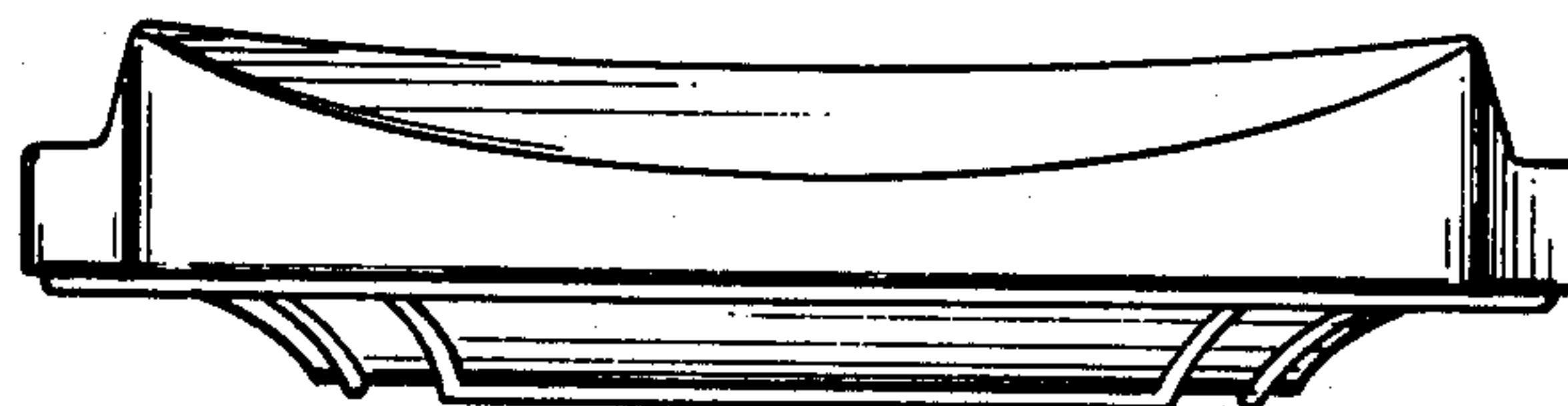

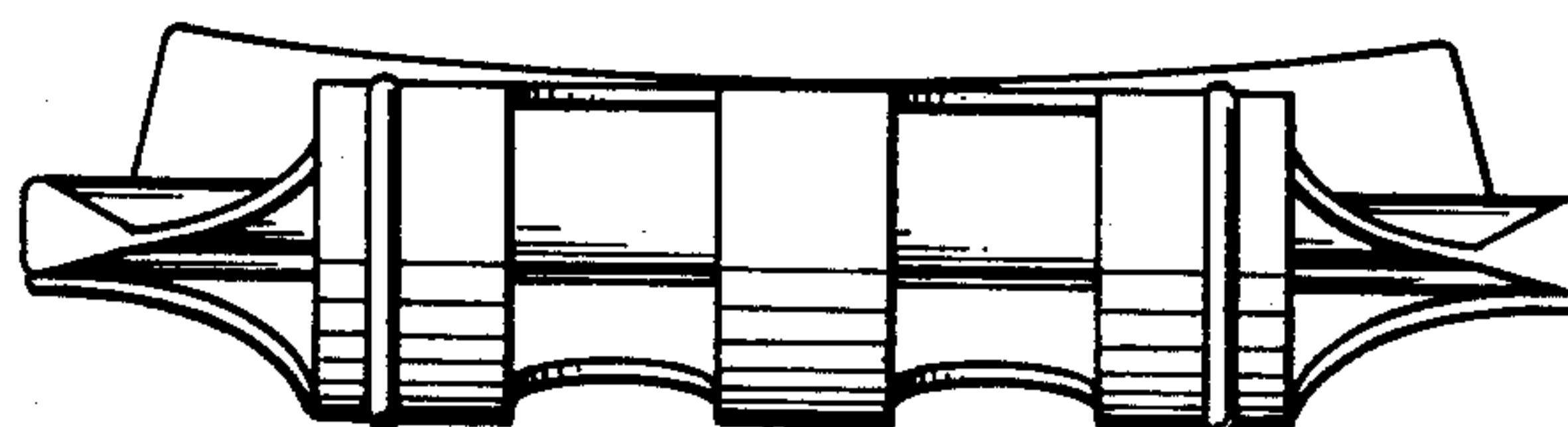
