DESCRIPTION

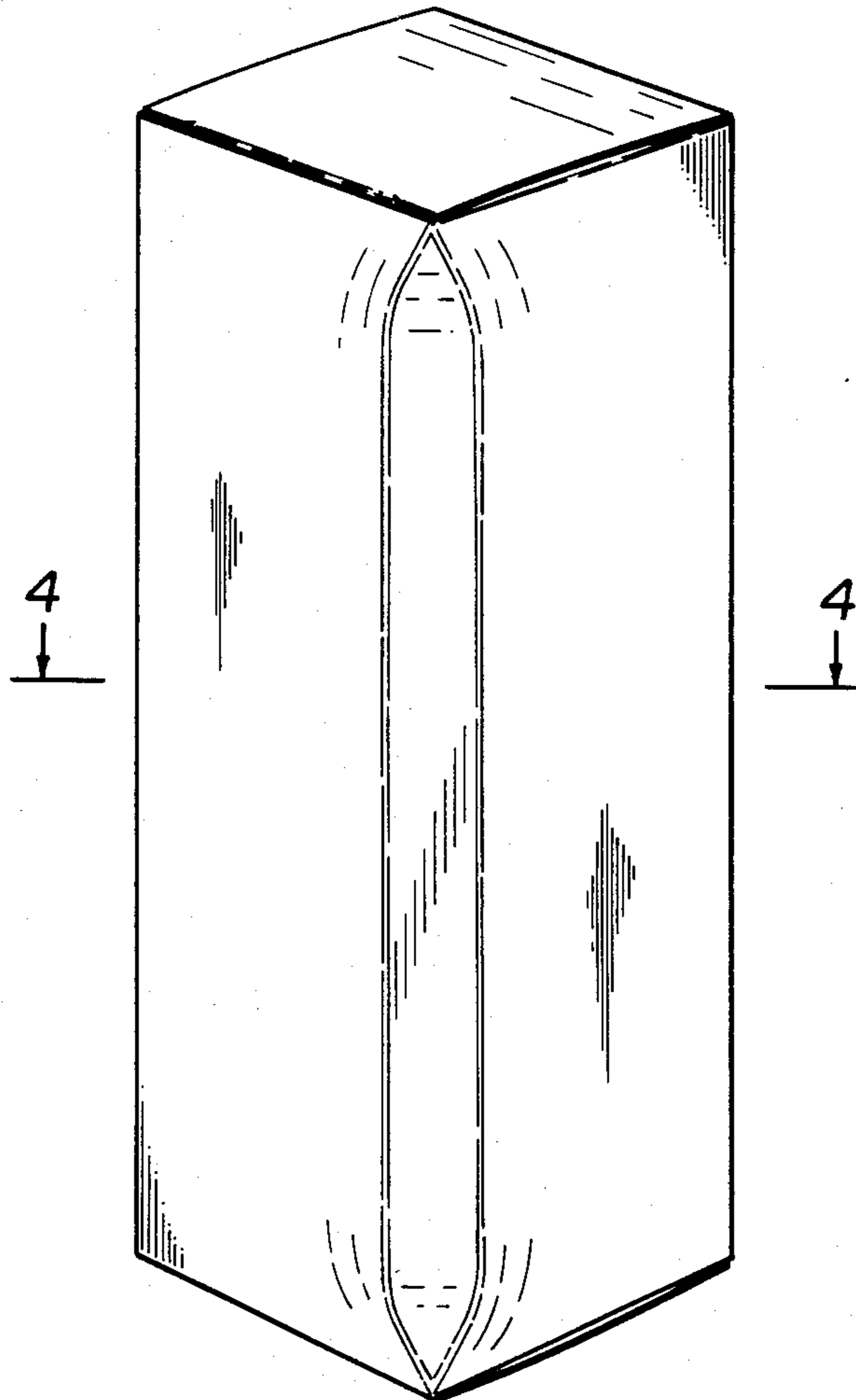
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a carton showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom perspective view on a reduced scale showing the sides not seen in FIG. 1.



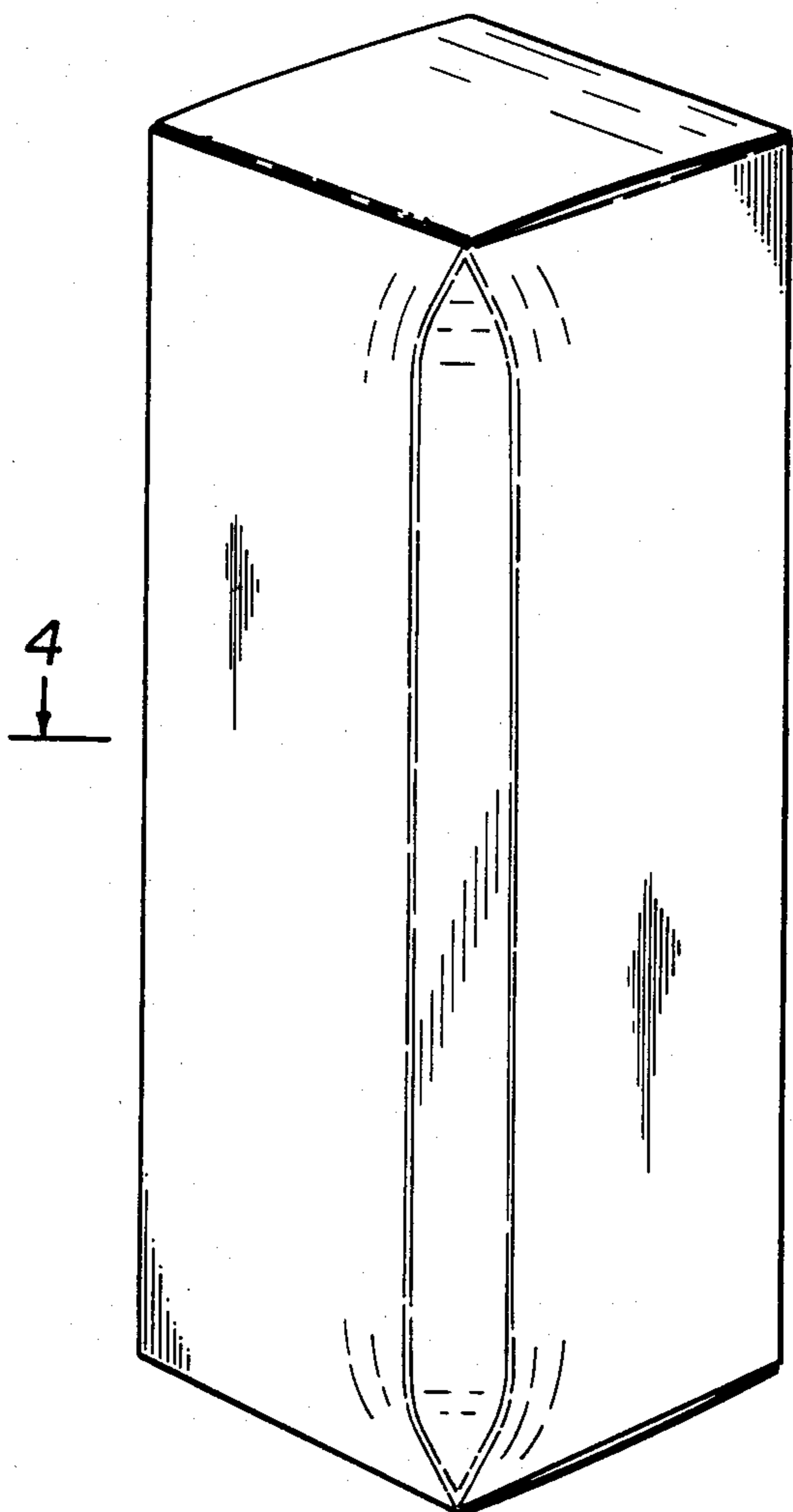

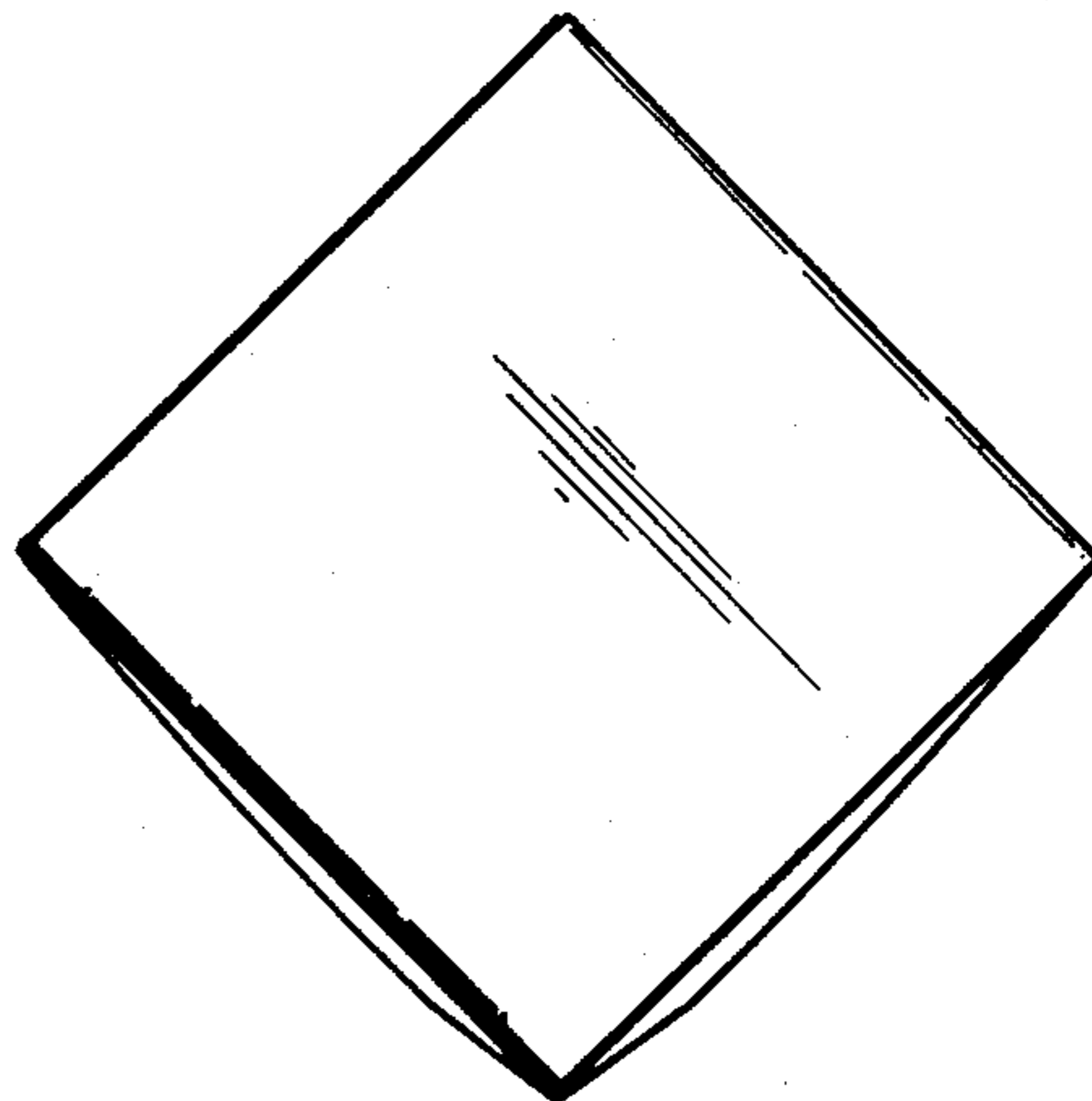

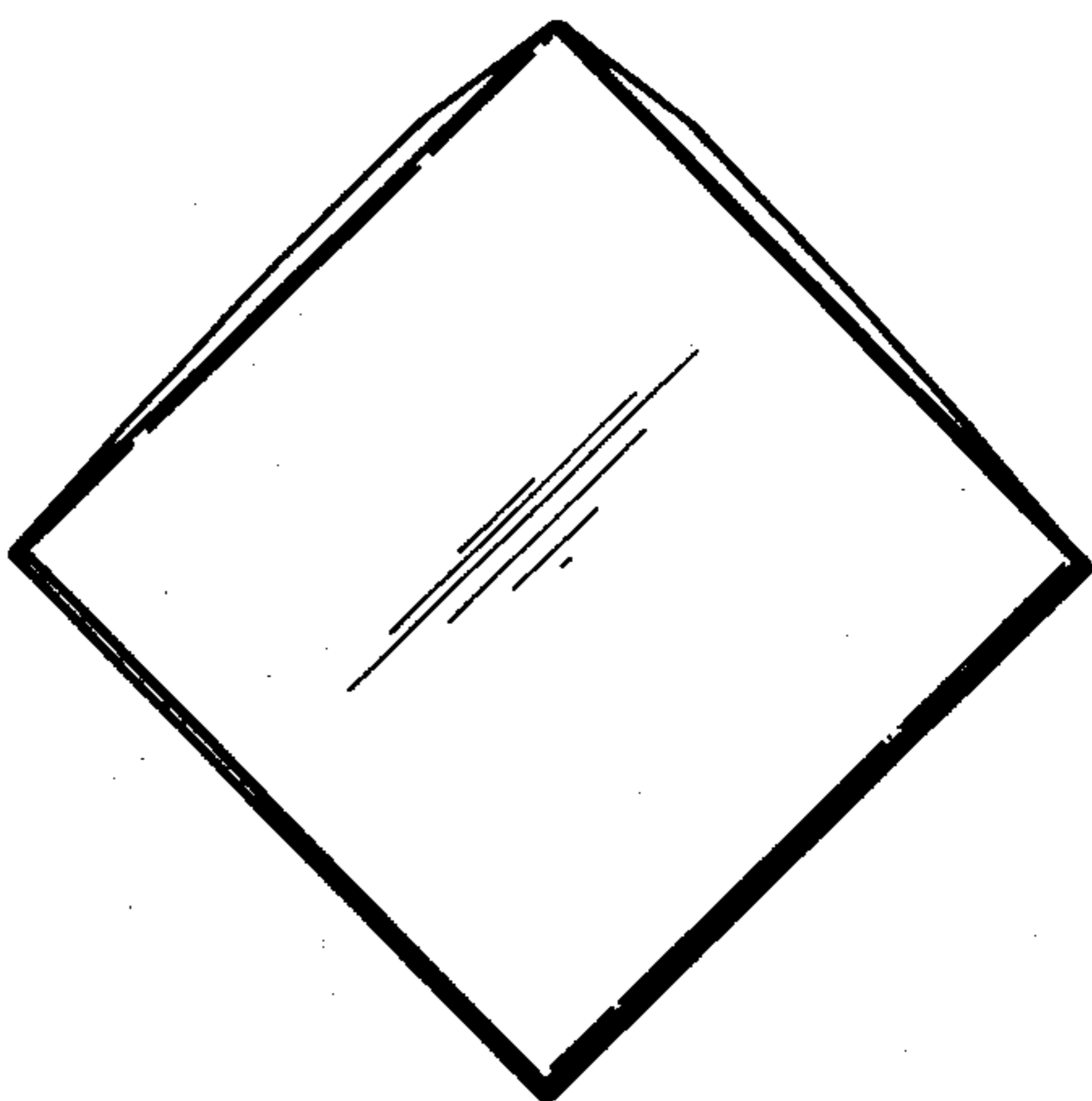

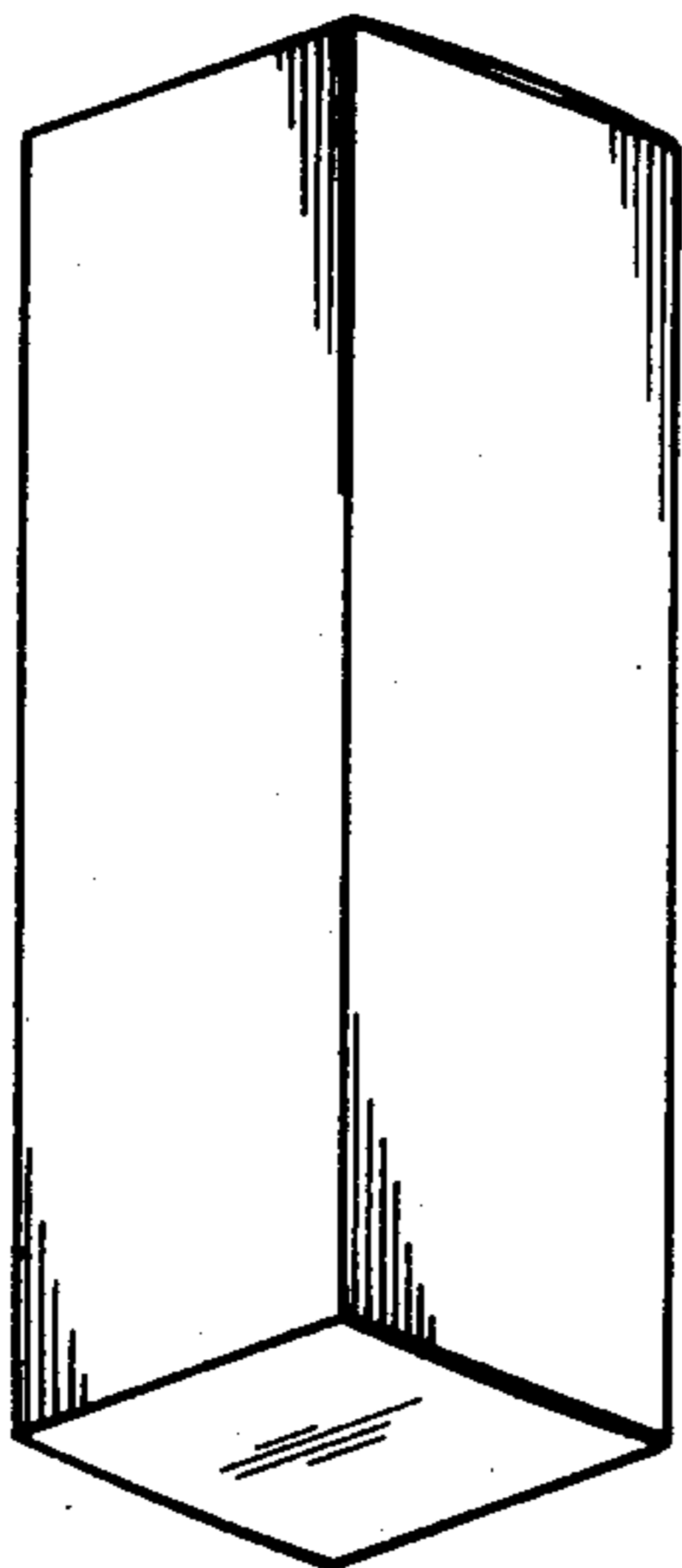

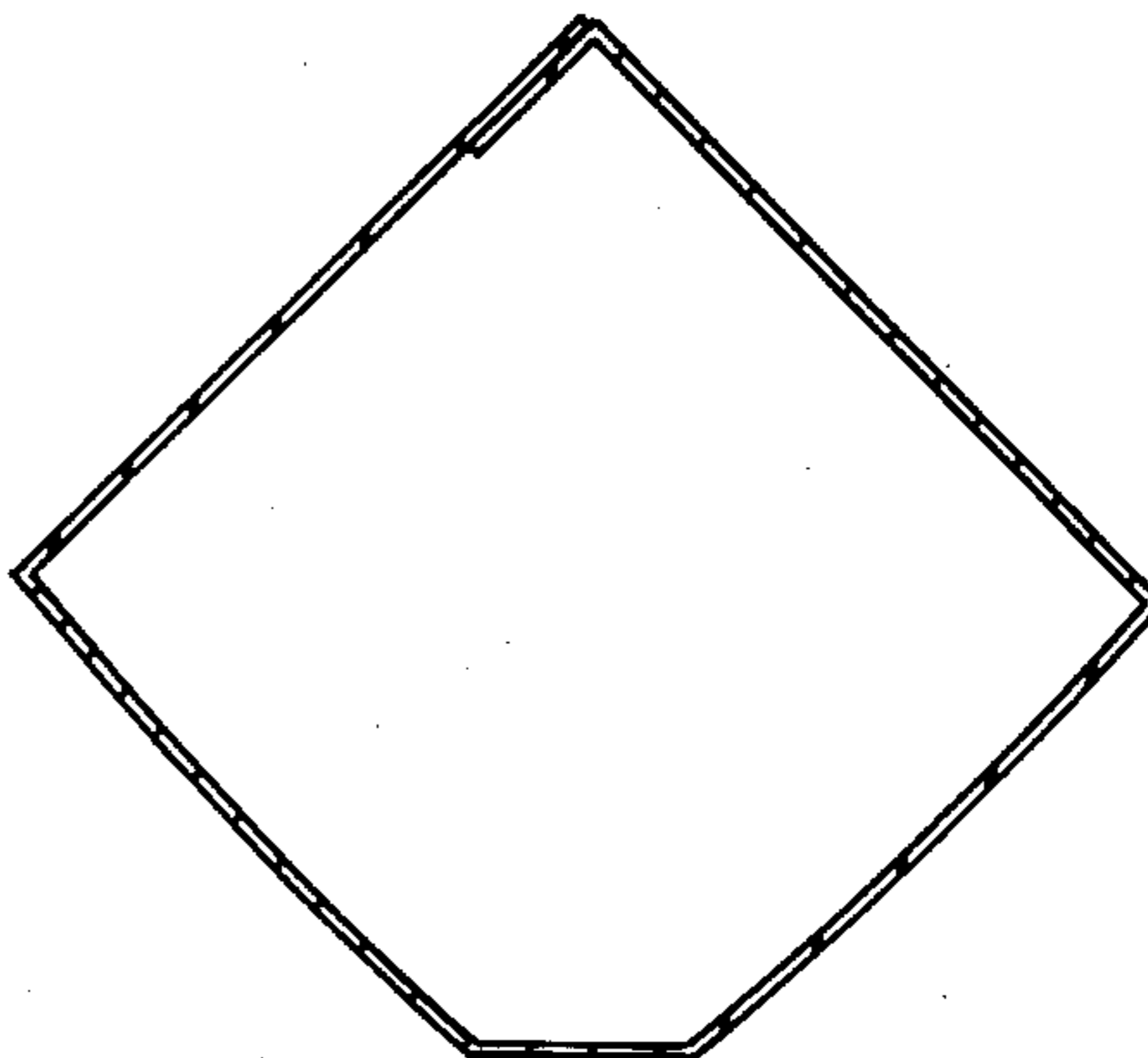
