The ornamental design for foldable religious tablet, as shown and described.

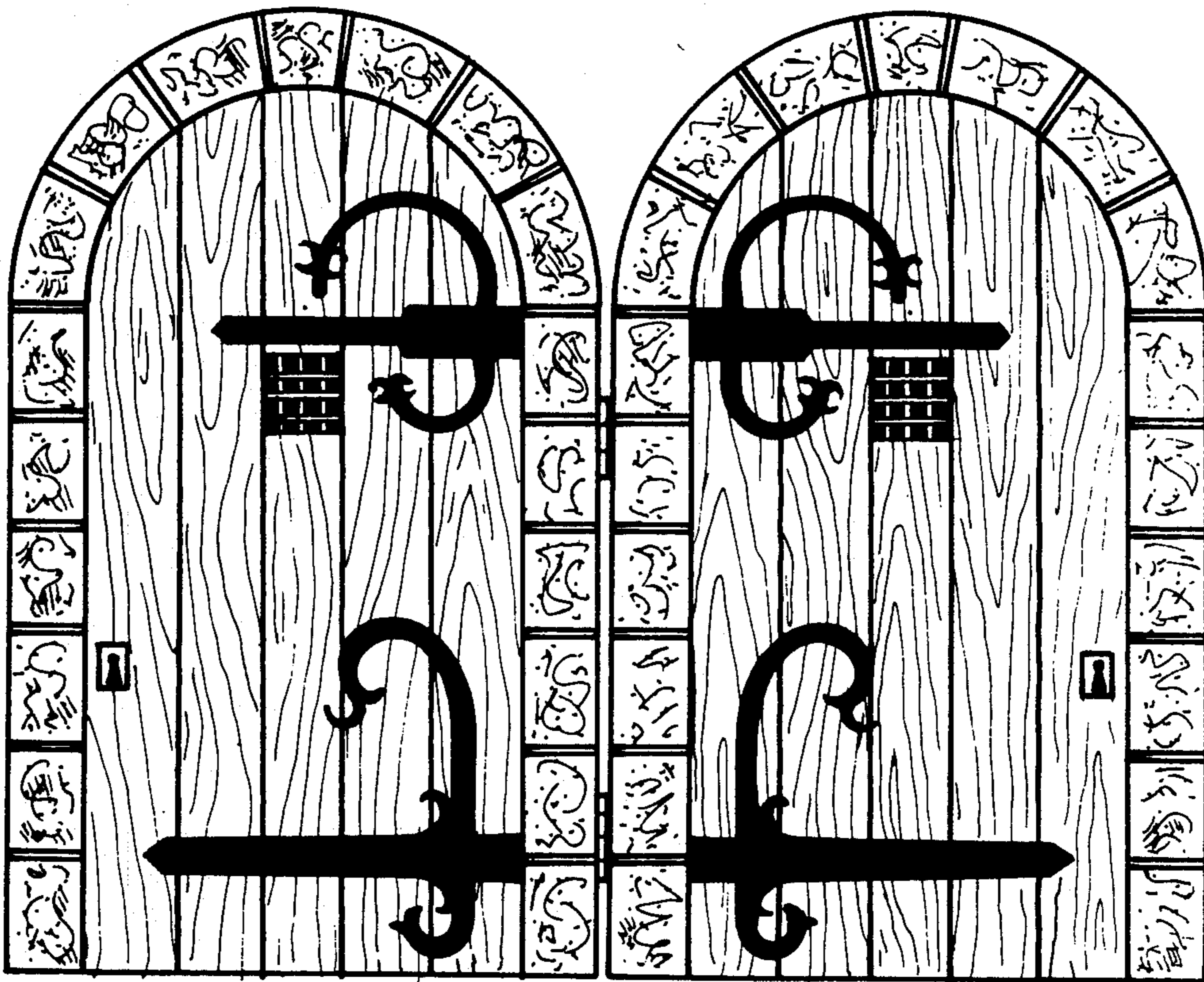
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof with the two tablet members folded together.



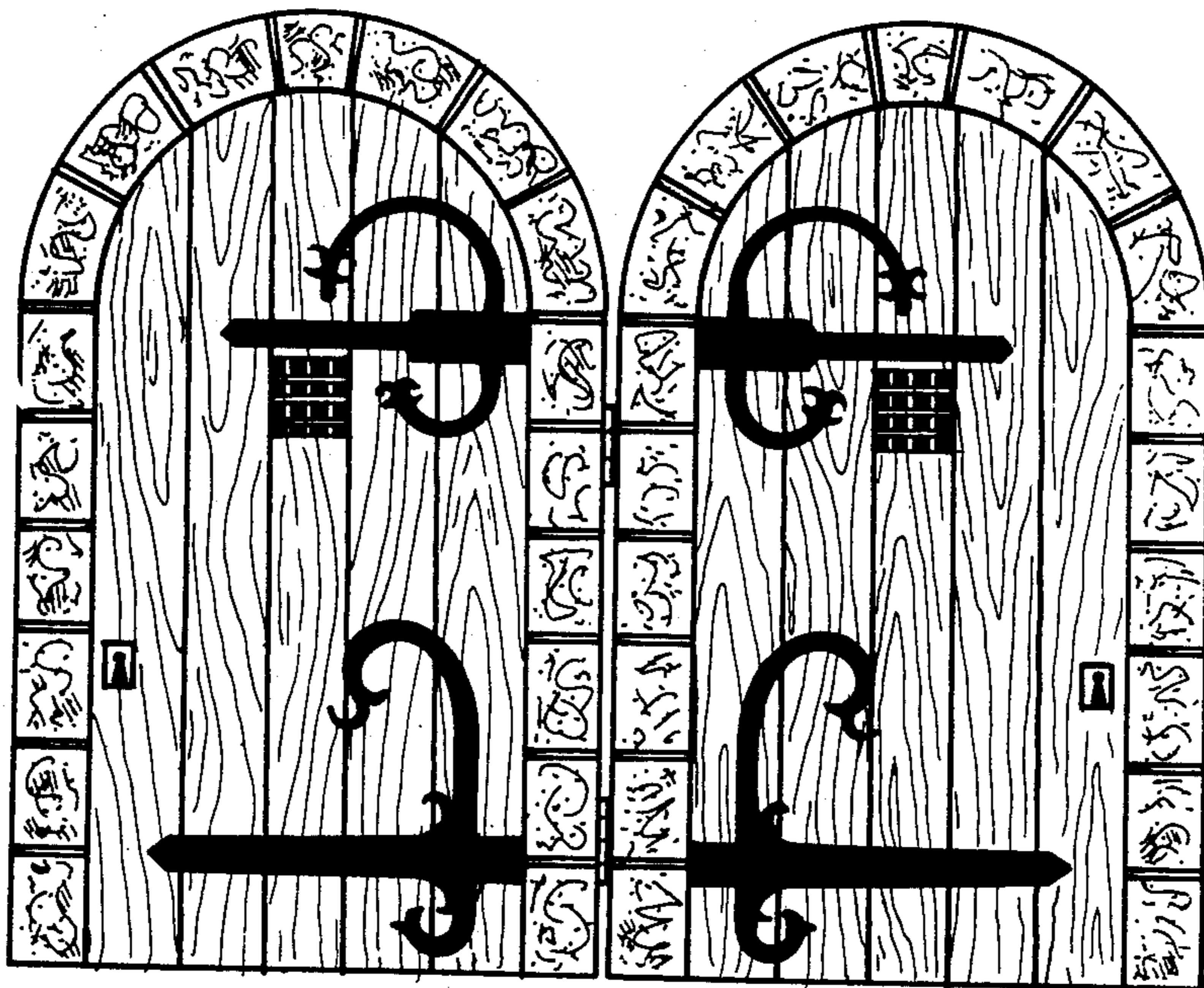

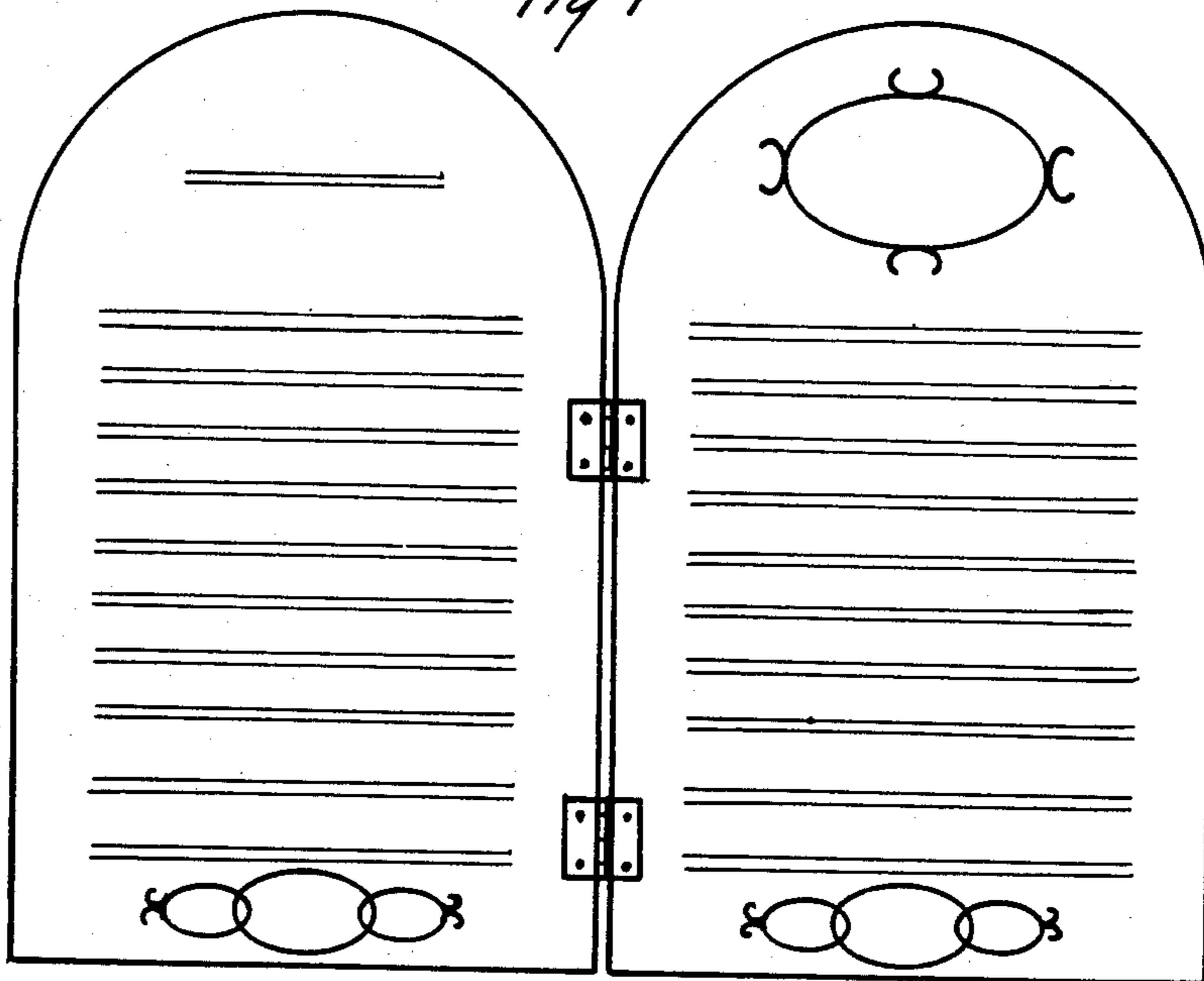

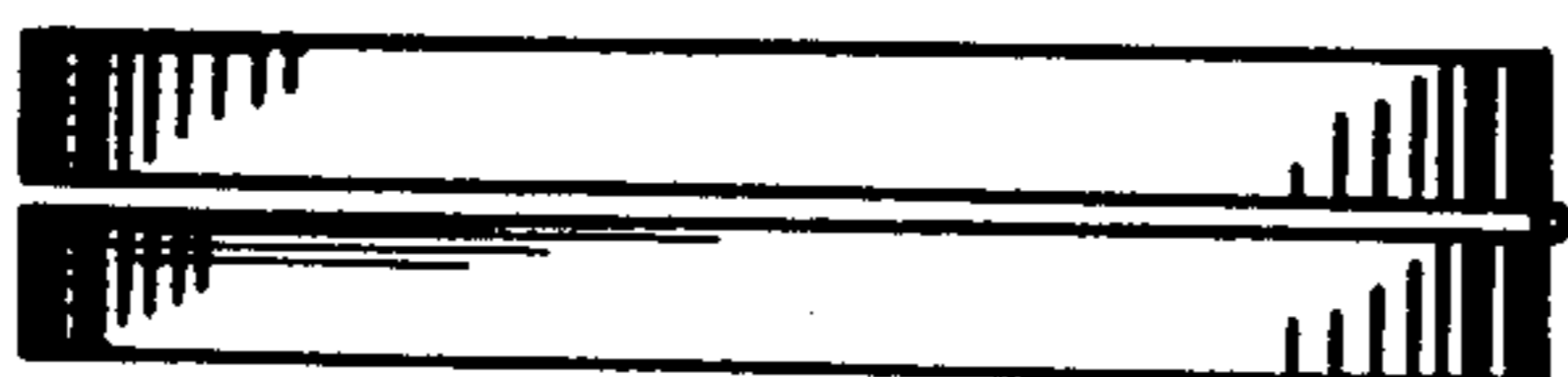
