The ornamental design for an automatic positioning system data processor, substantially as shown and described.

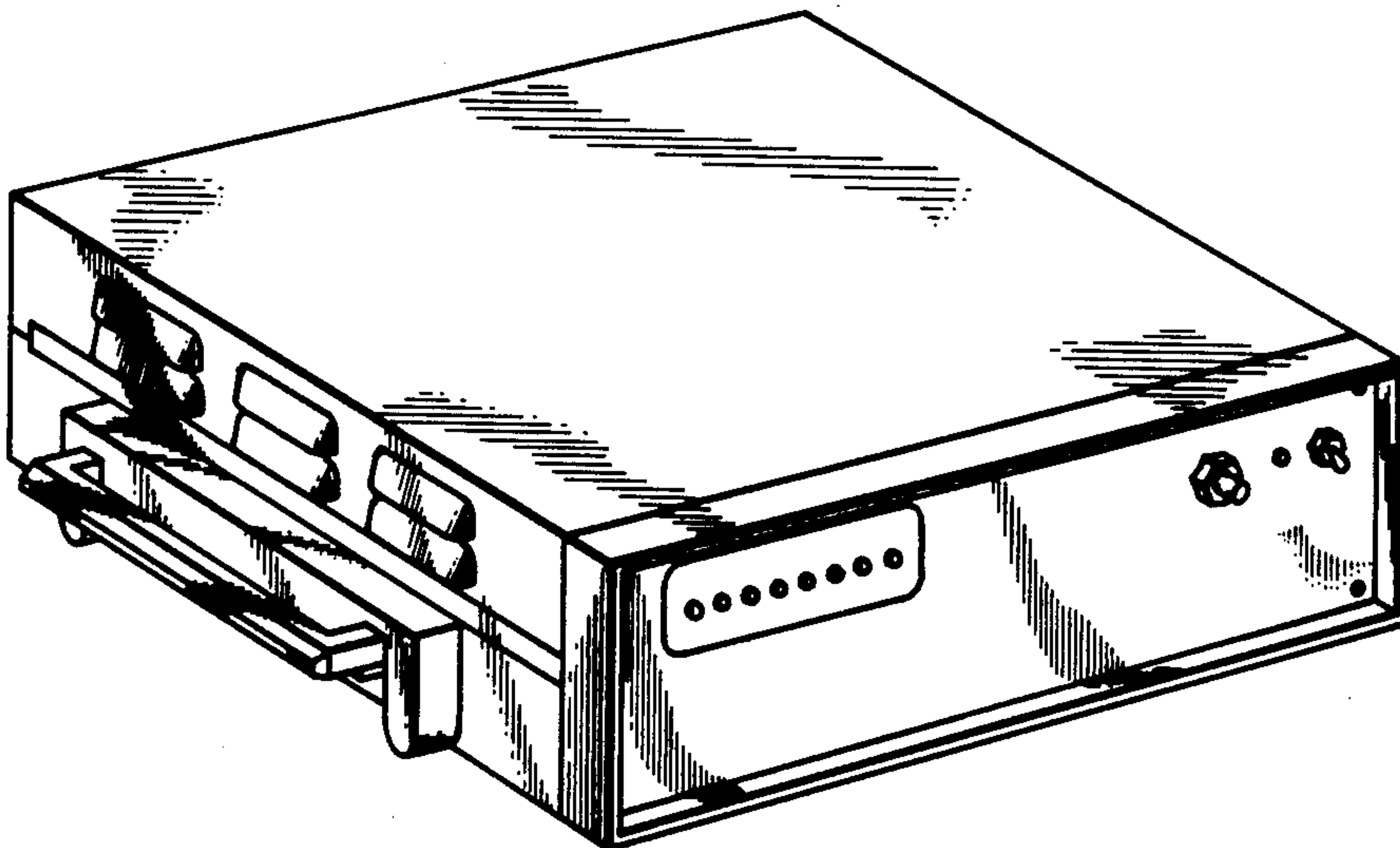
DESCRIPTION

The bottom of the device is substantially planar and unornamented.



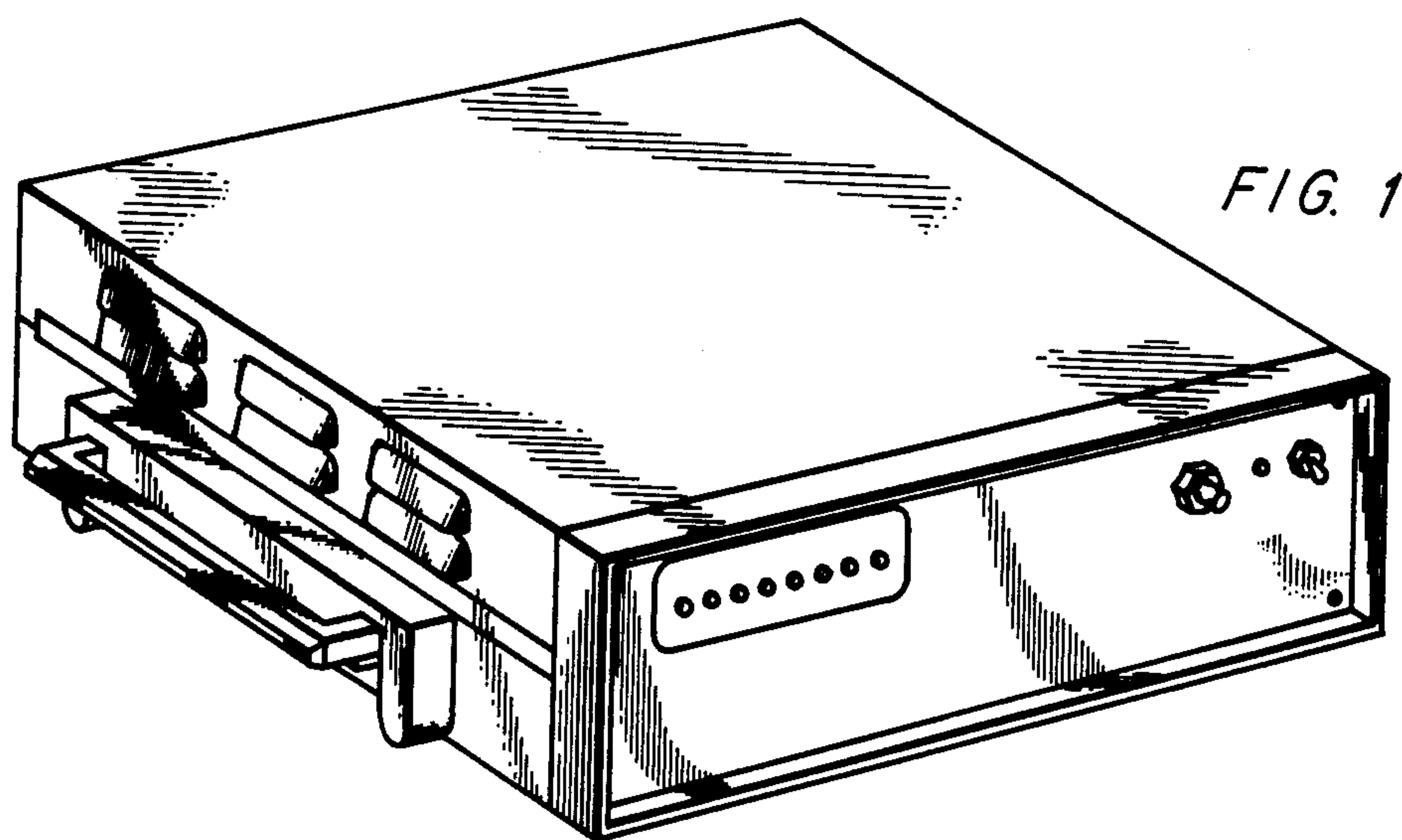
