DESCRIPTION

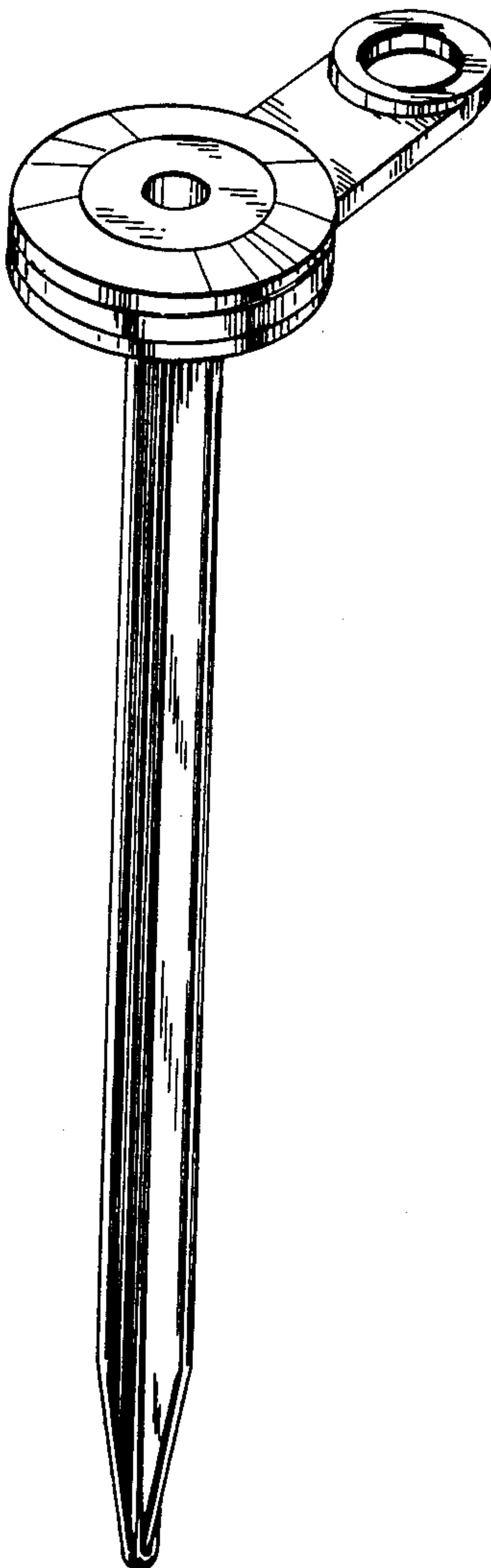
FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a tether embodying my new design.

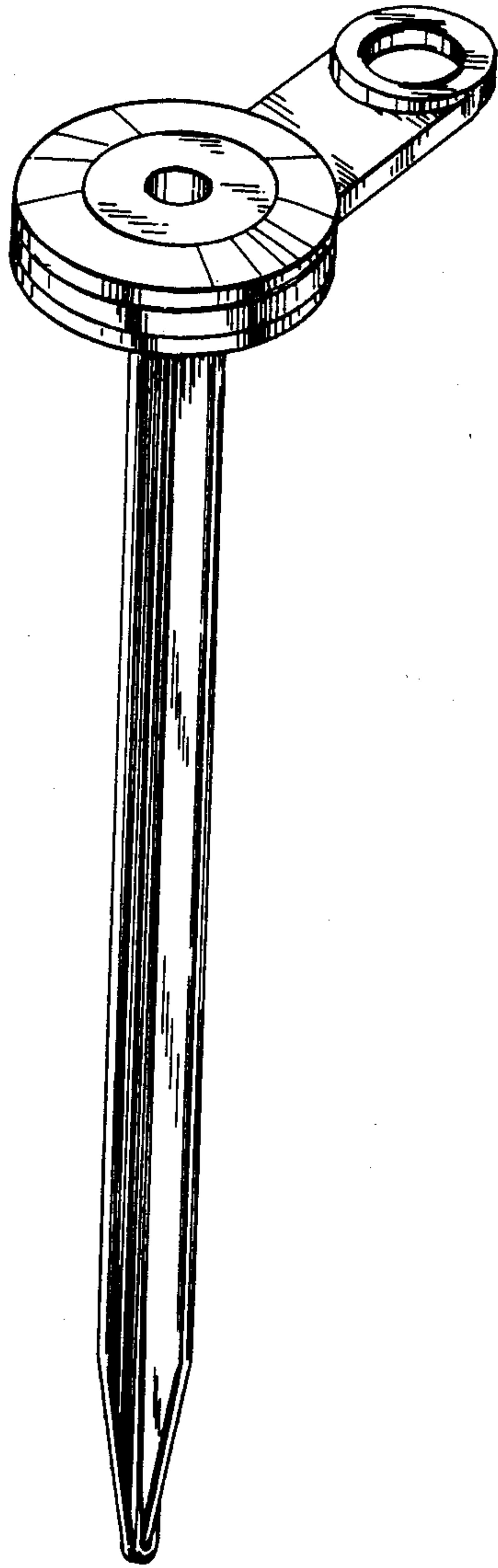
FIG. 2 is a side elevation view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof.

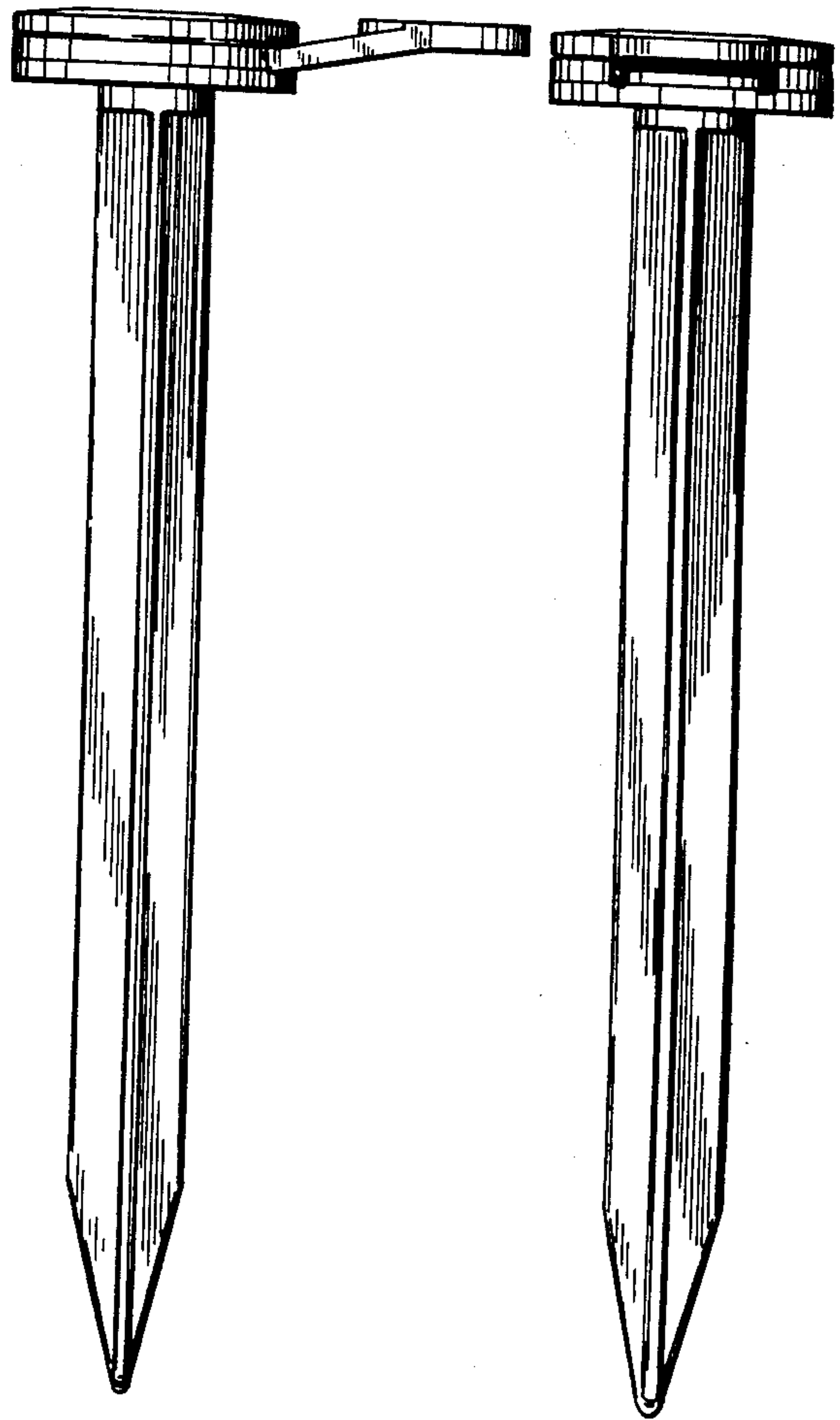
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.



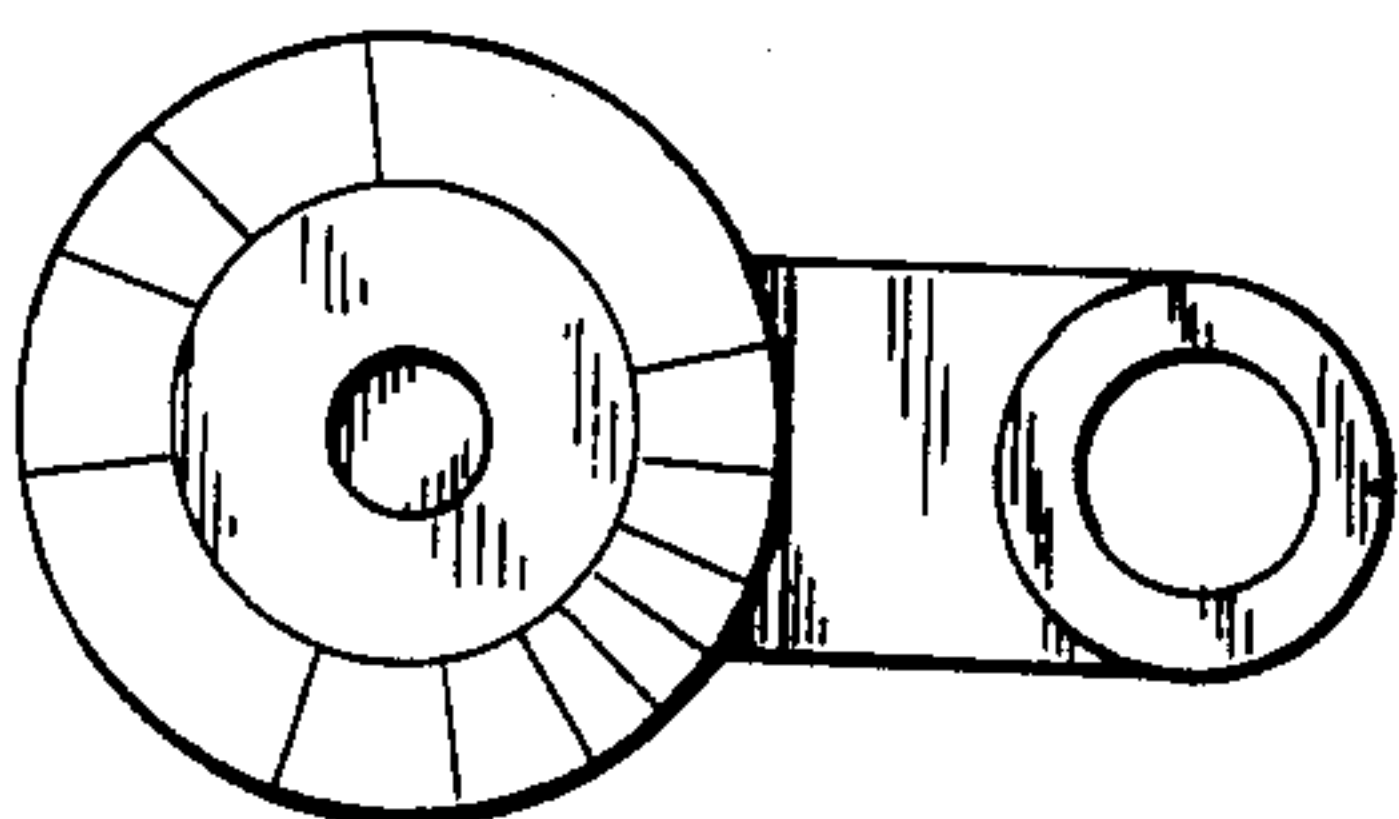

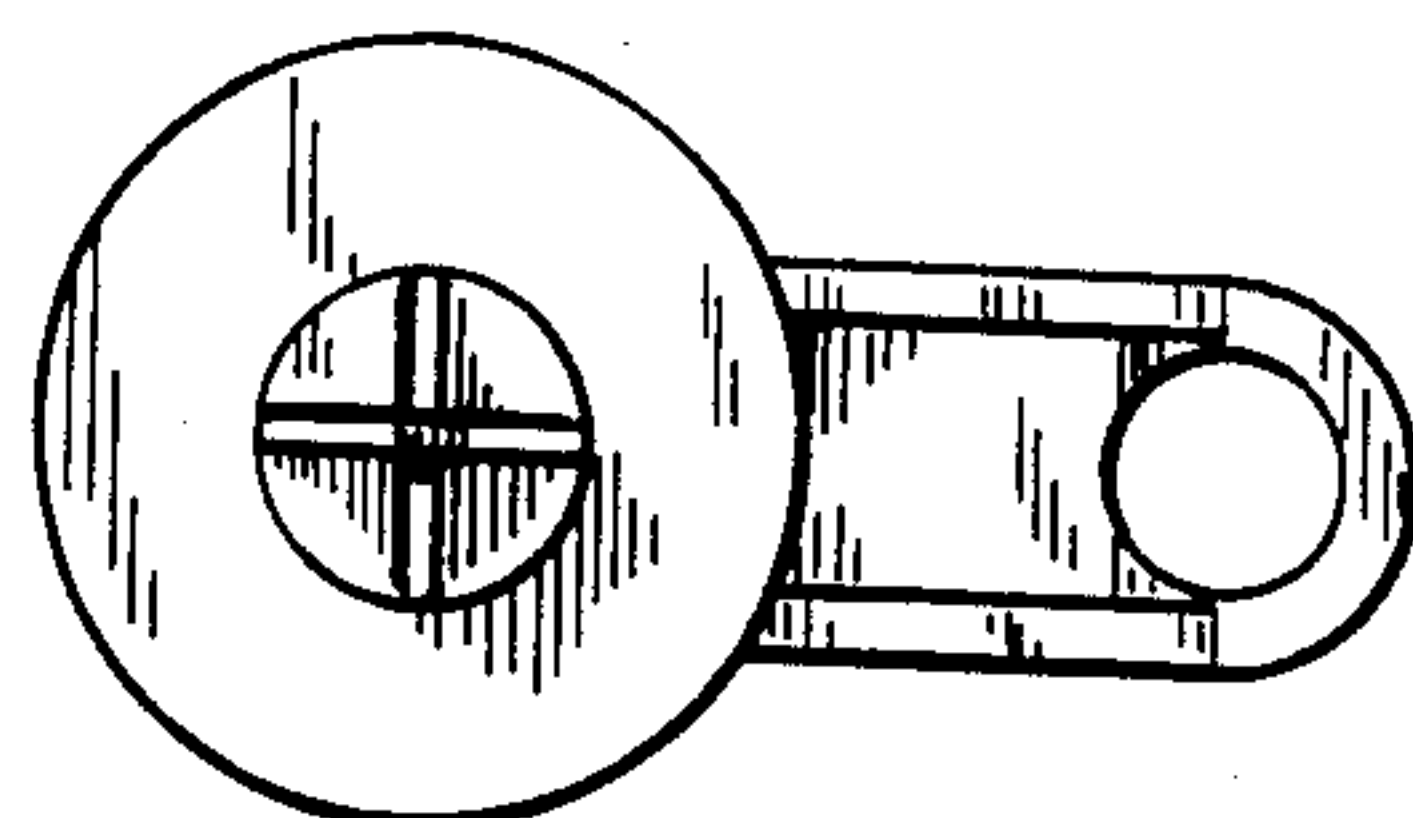
