FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a portable mount for citizen band radios embodying the present design;

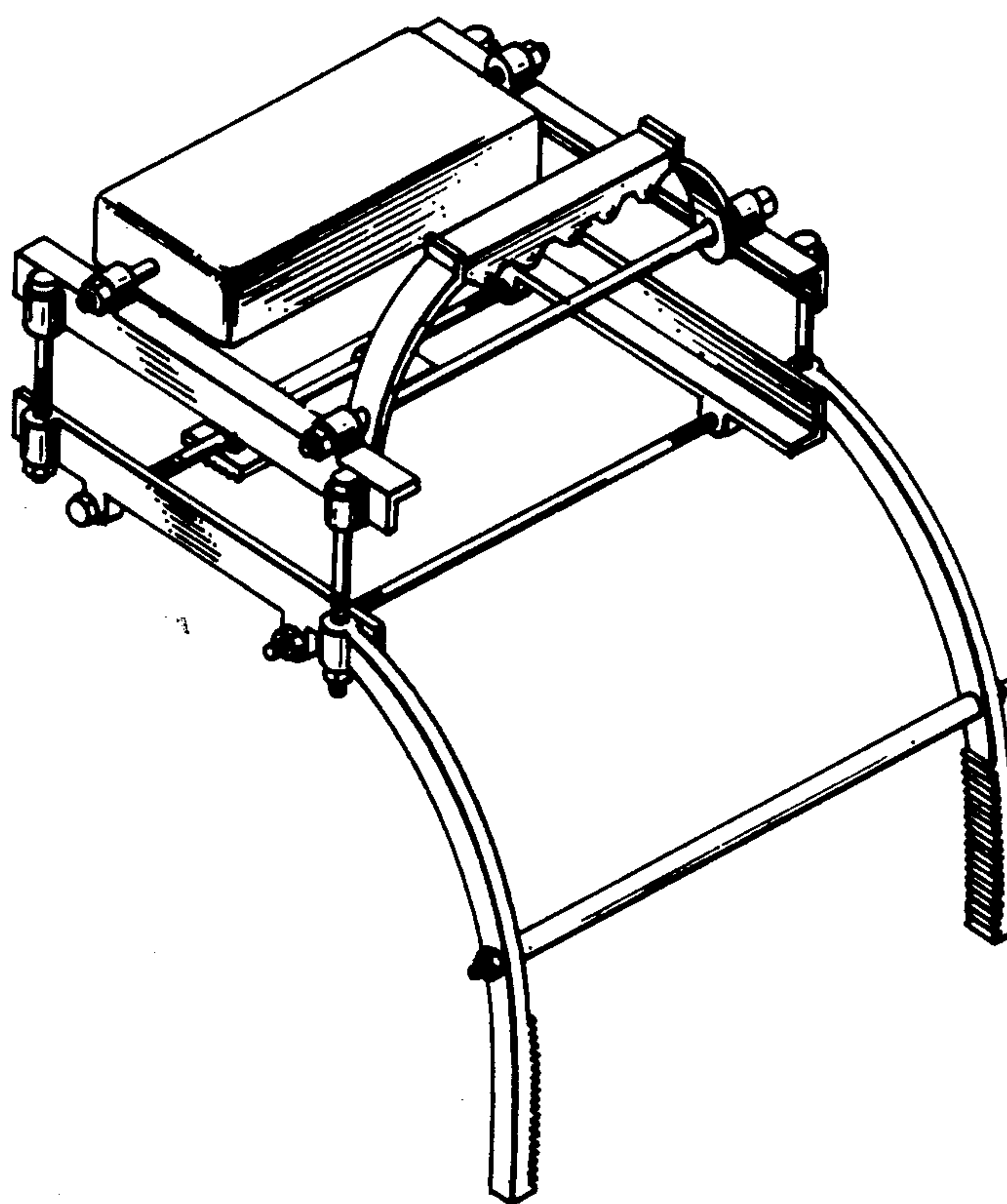
FIG. 2 is an elevational view thereof of the side opposite to that shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.



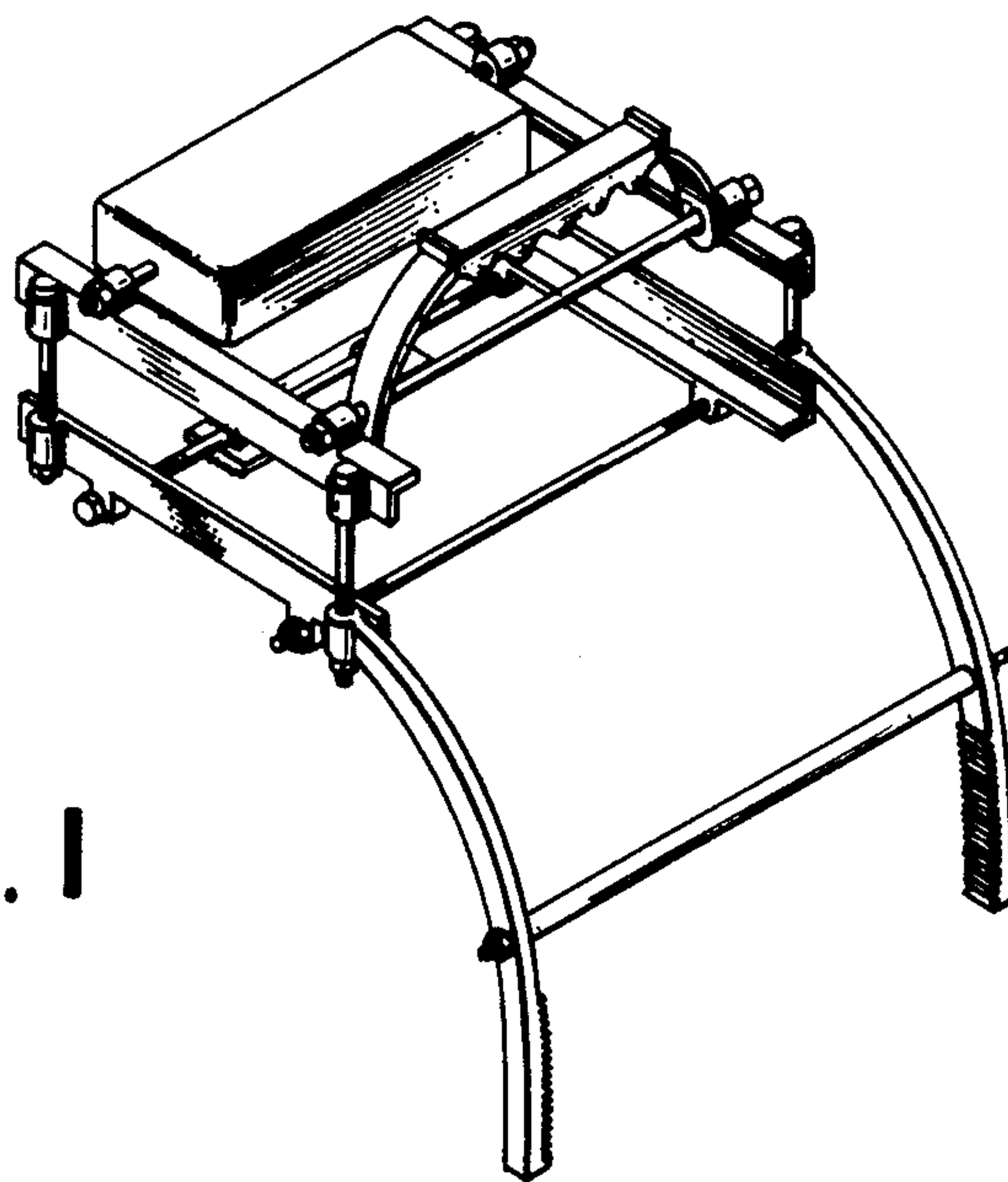

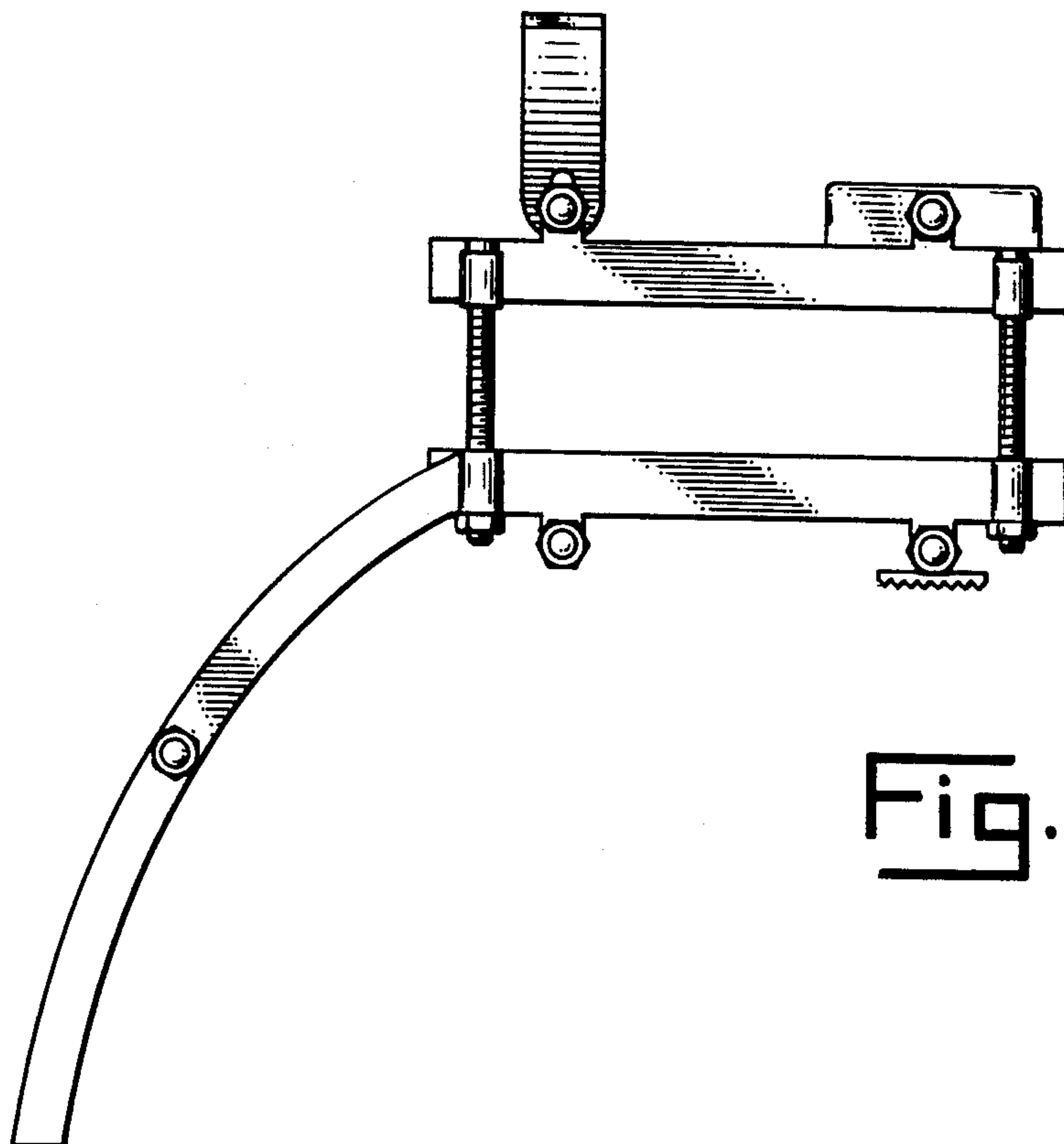

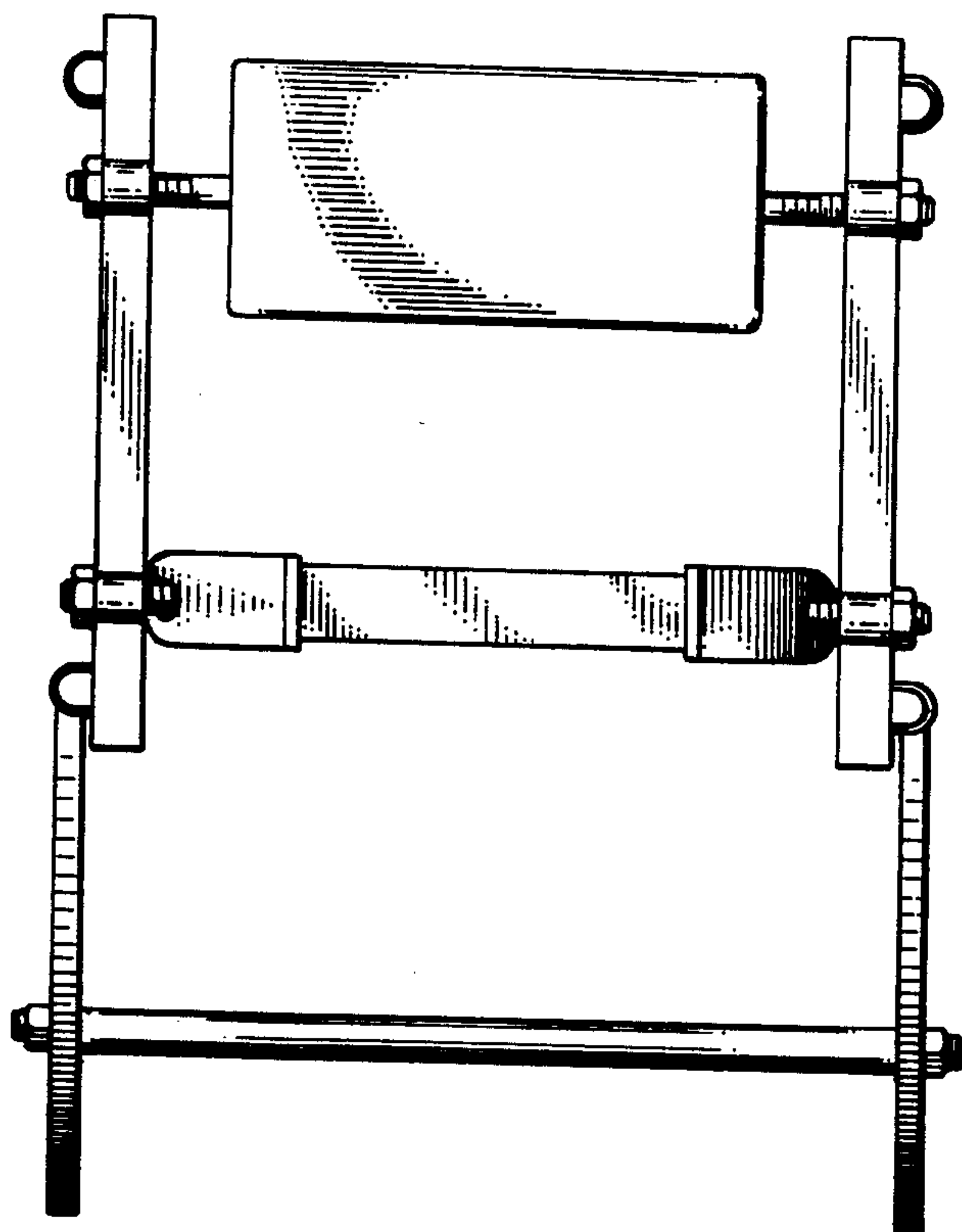

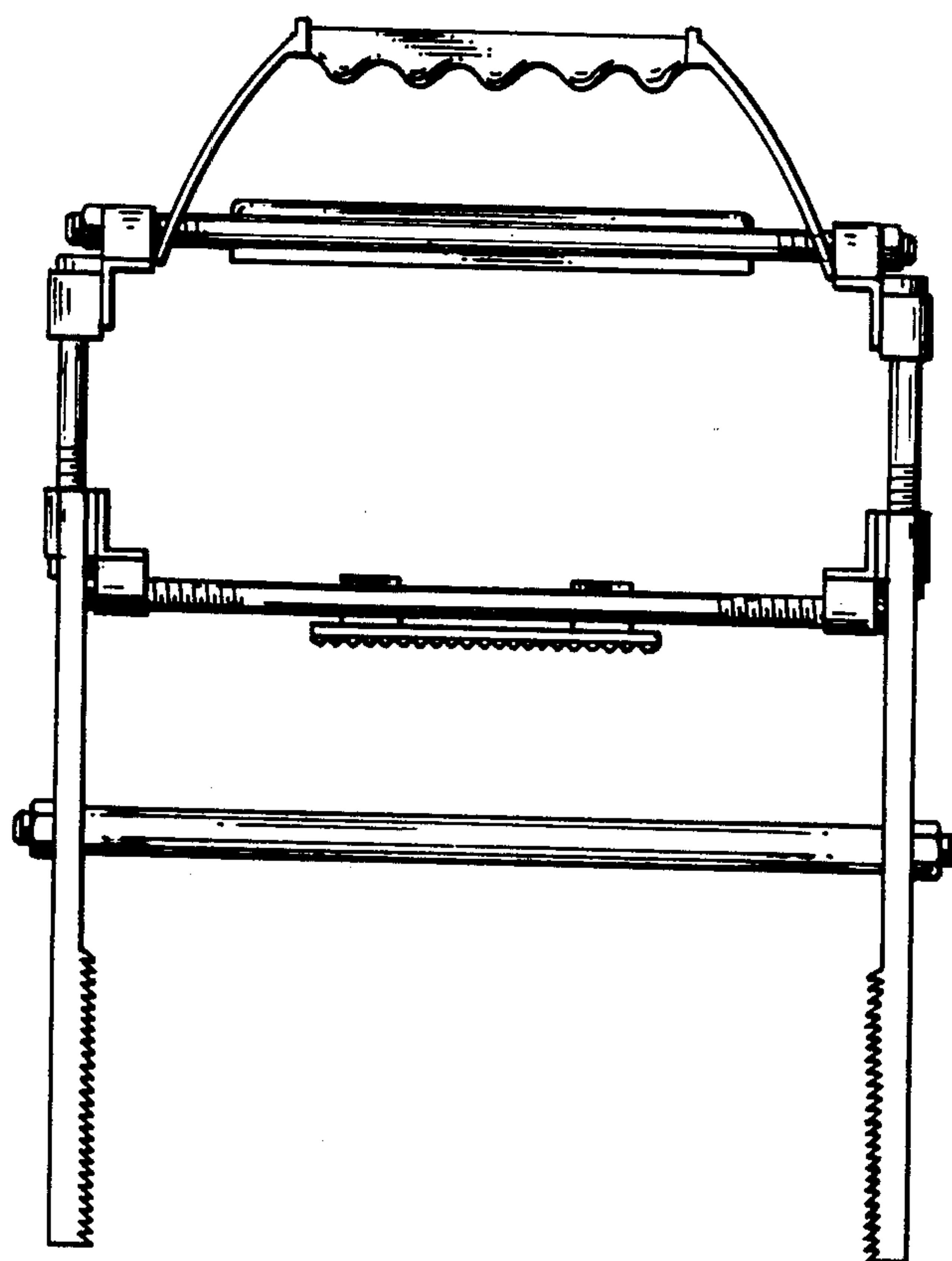

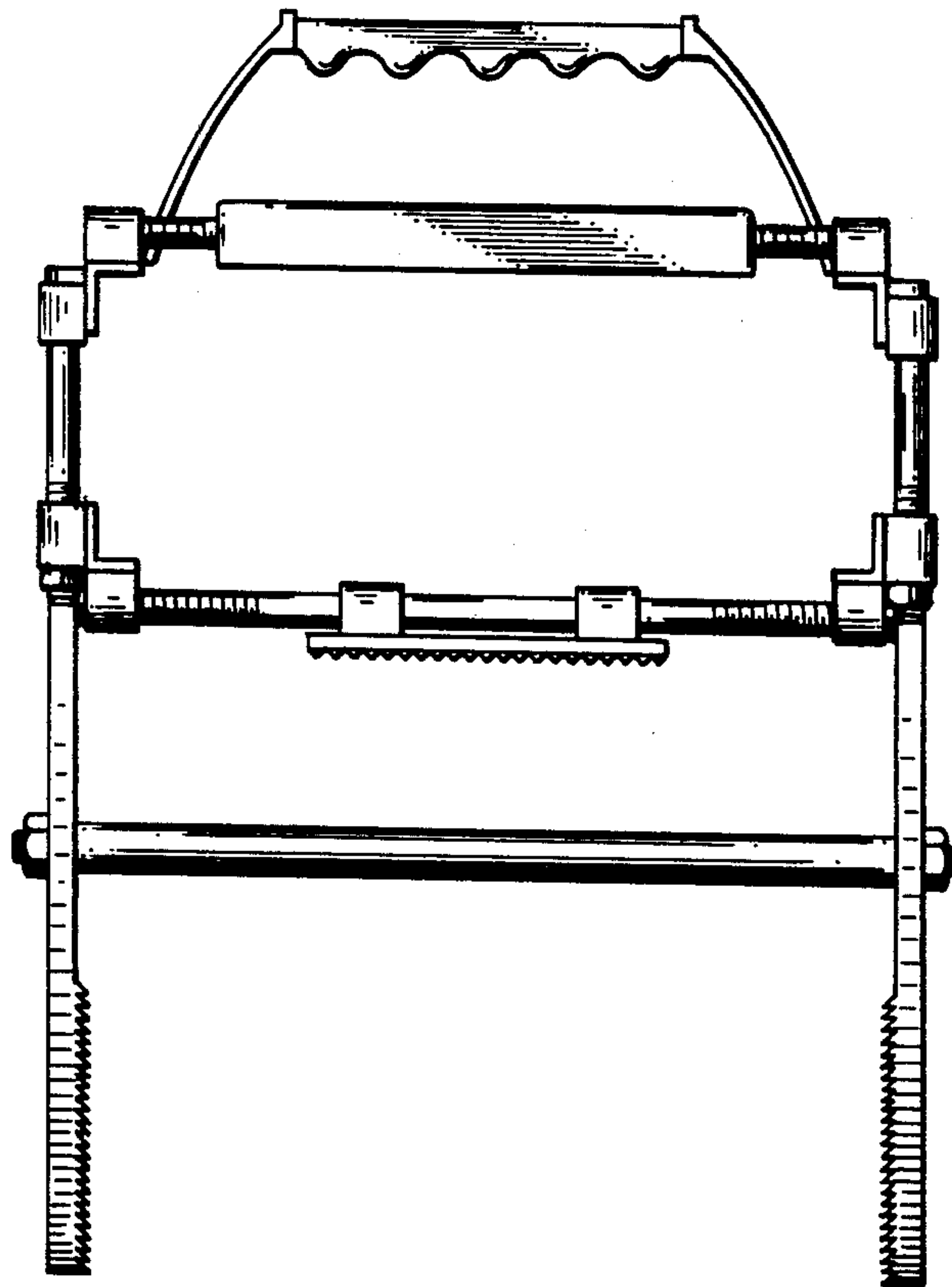
