FIG. 2 is a perspective view showing the bottom, rear and left side of the roof-mounted building fresh air ventilator of FIG. 1.

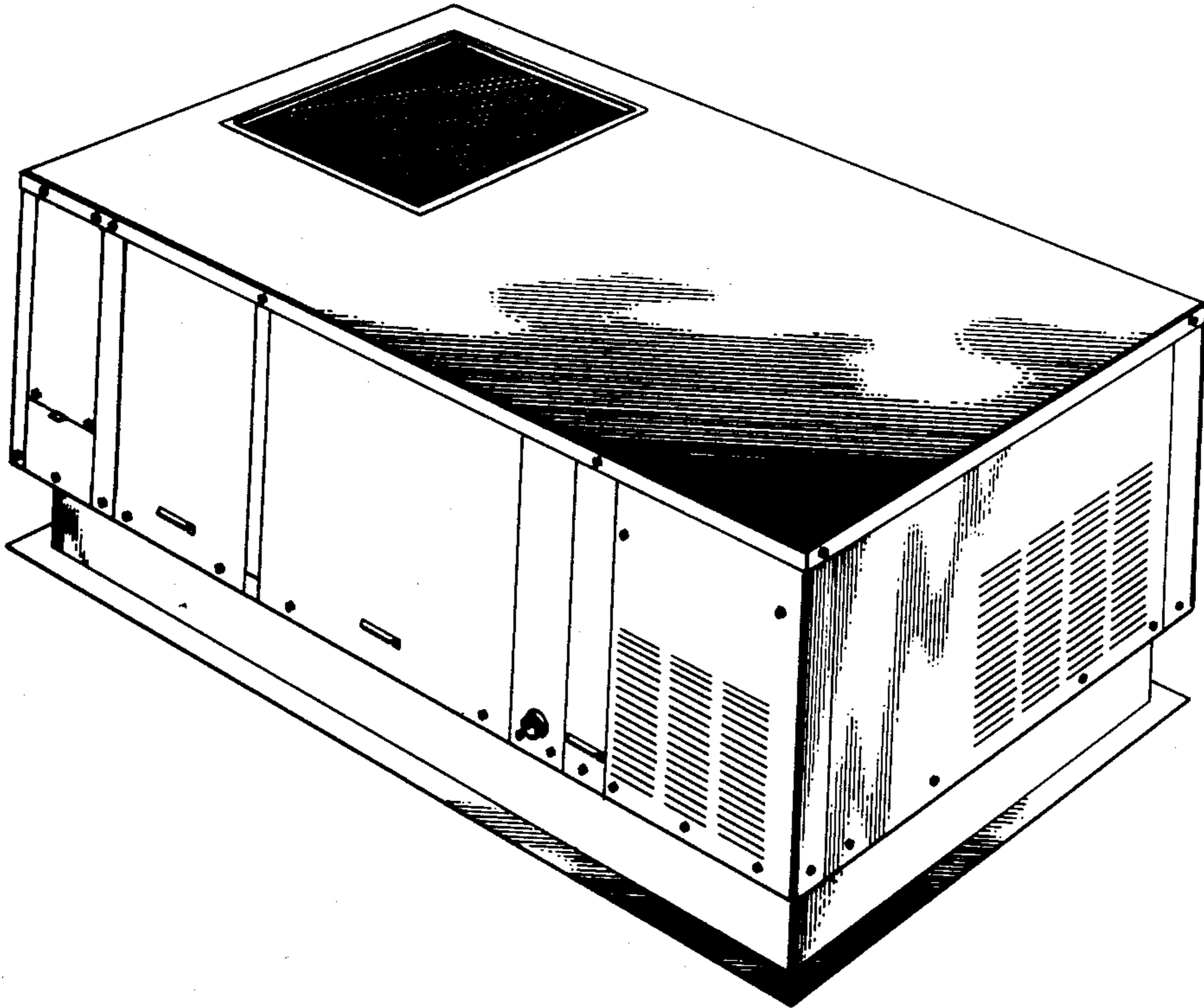

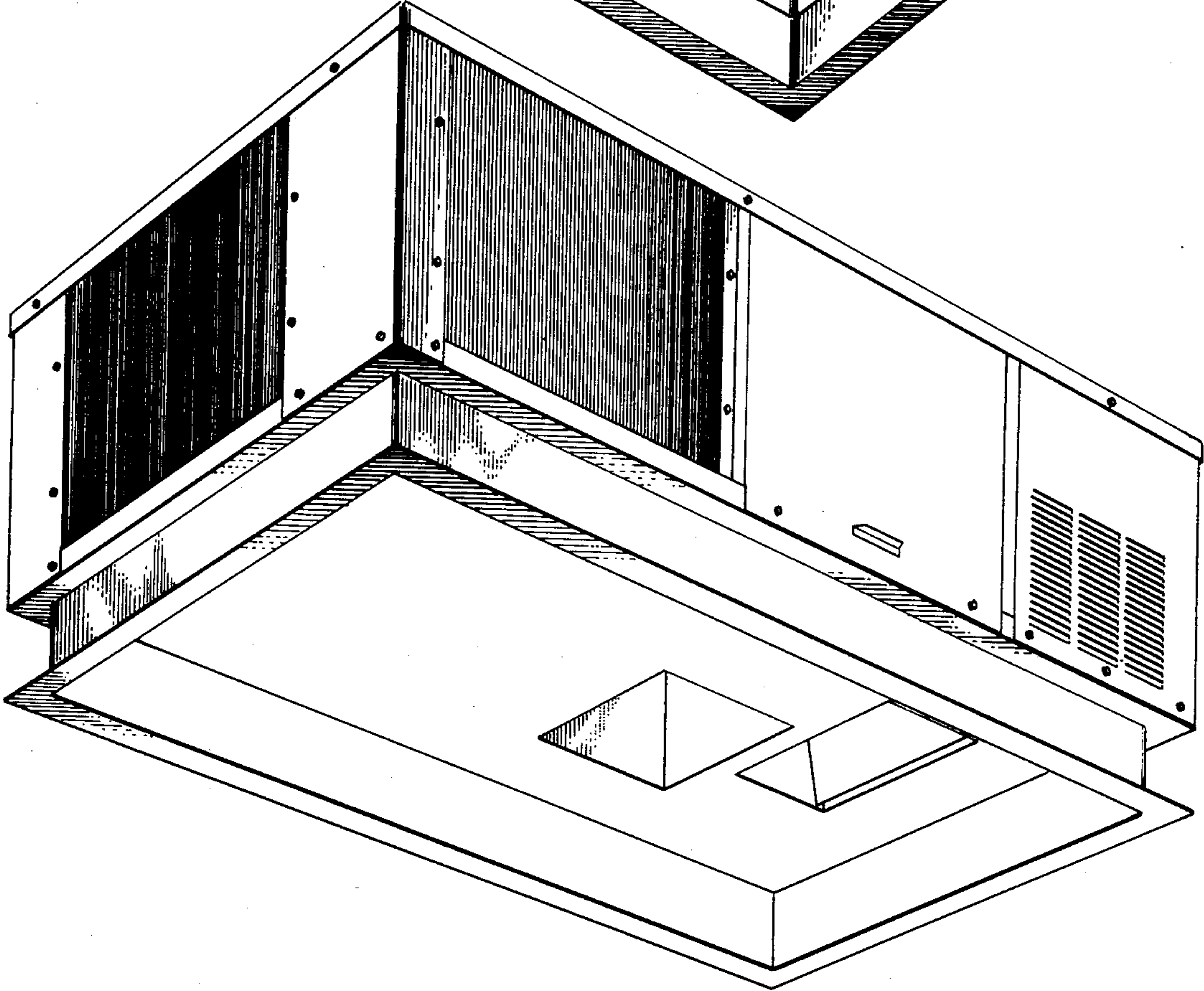
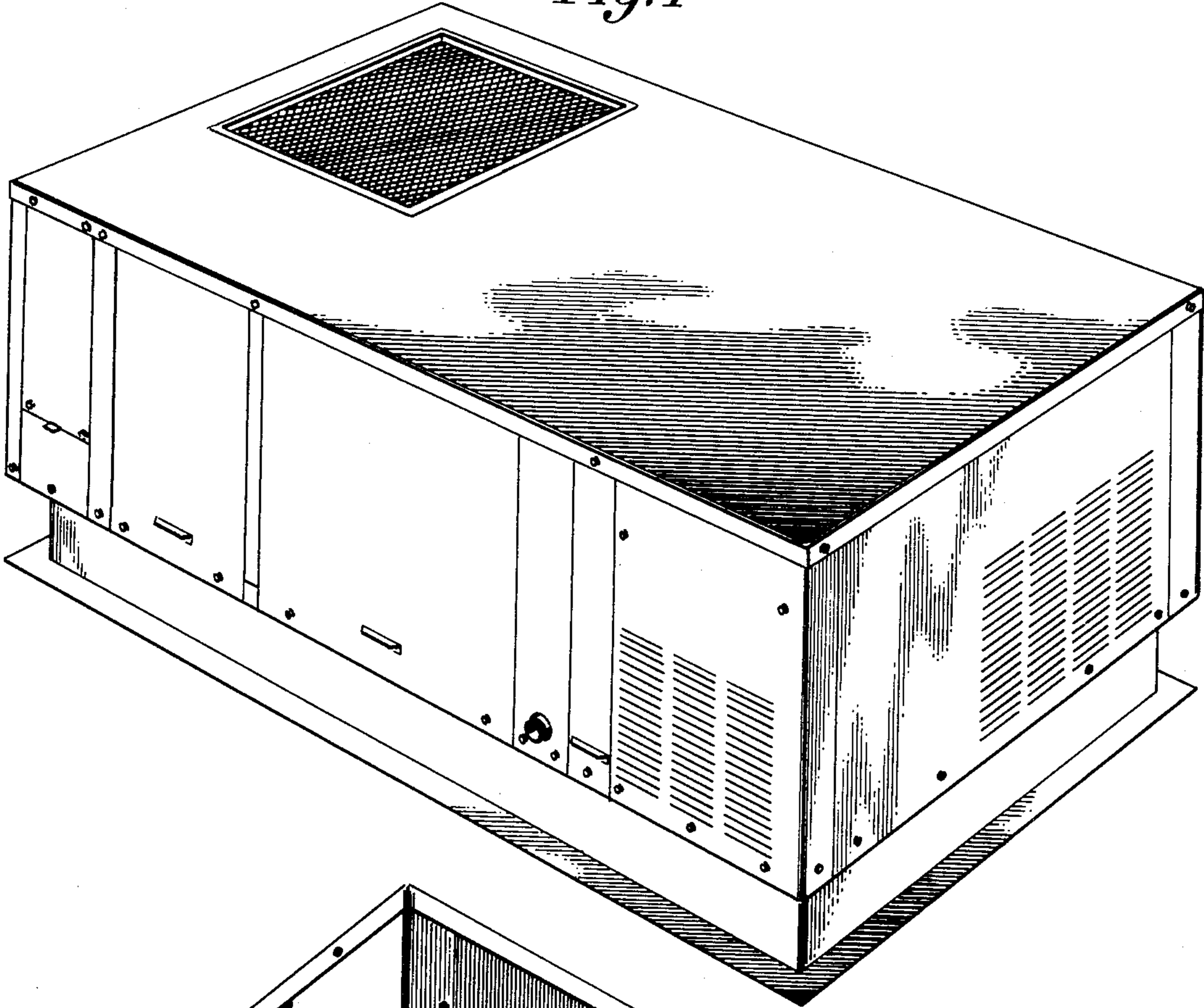
