DESCRIPTION

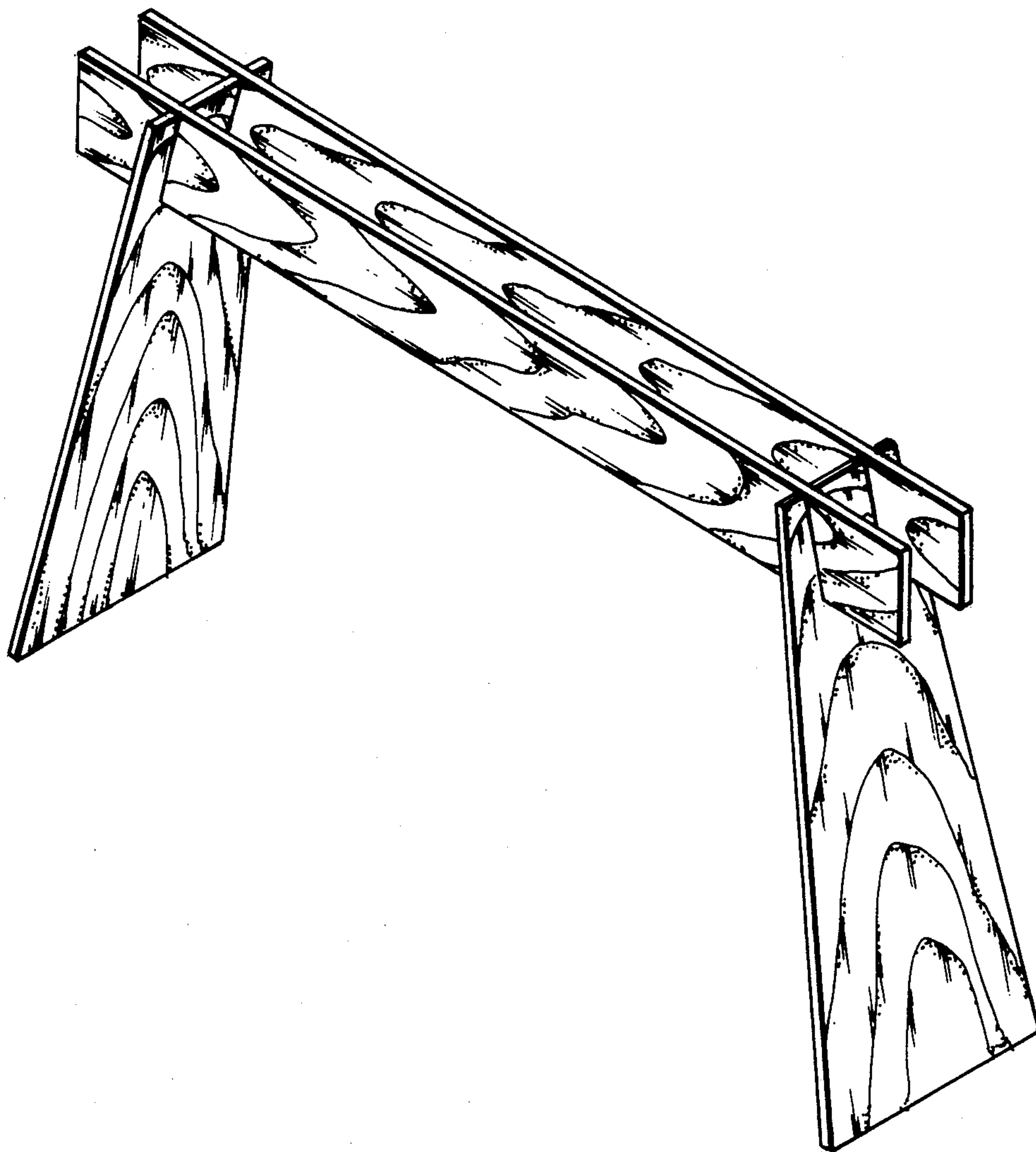
FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a saw horse showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



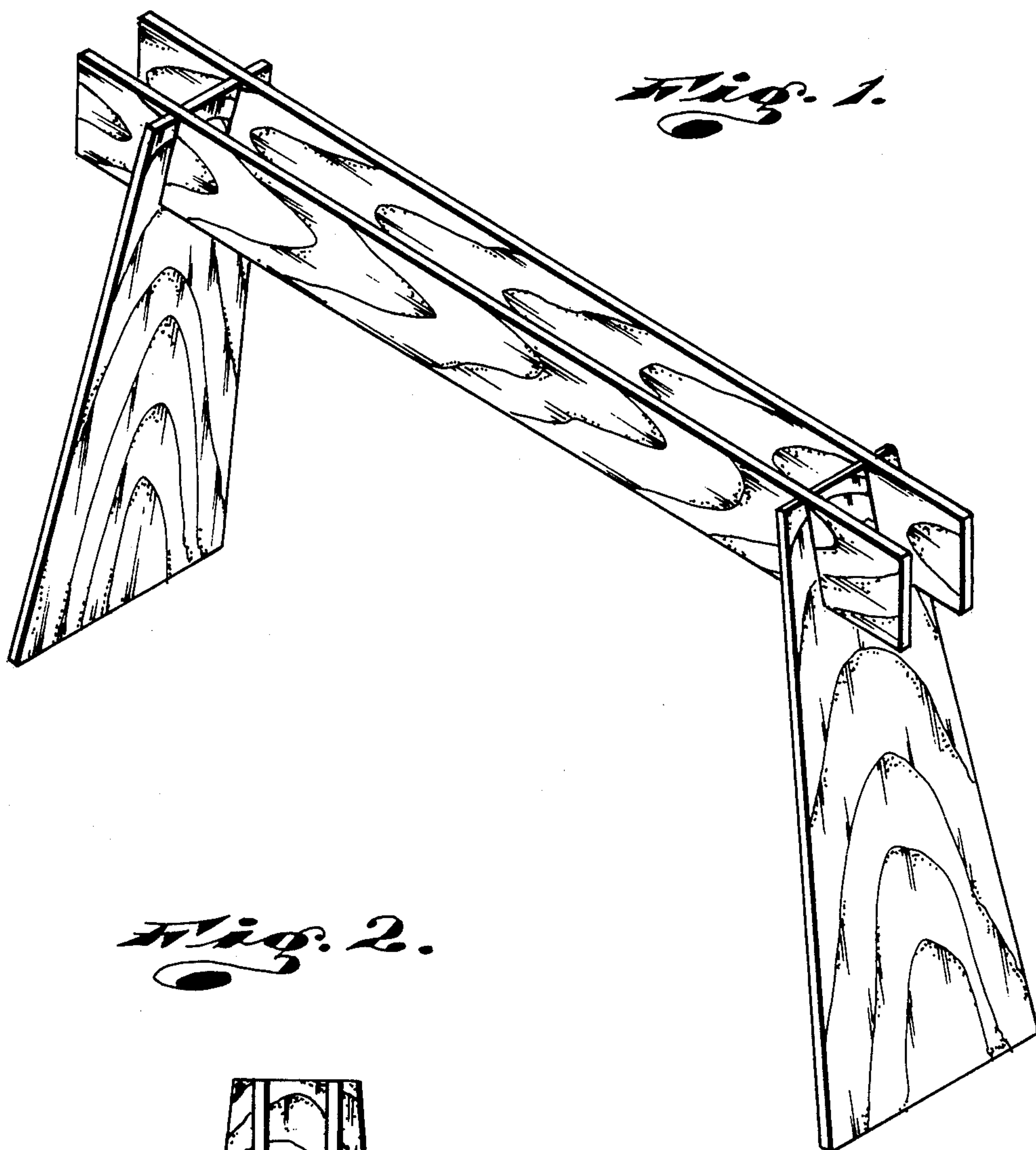

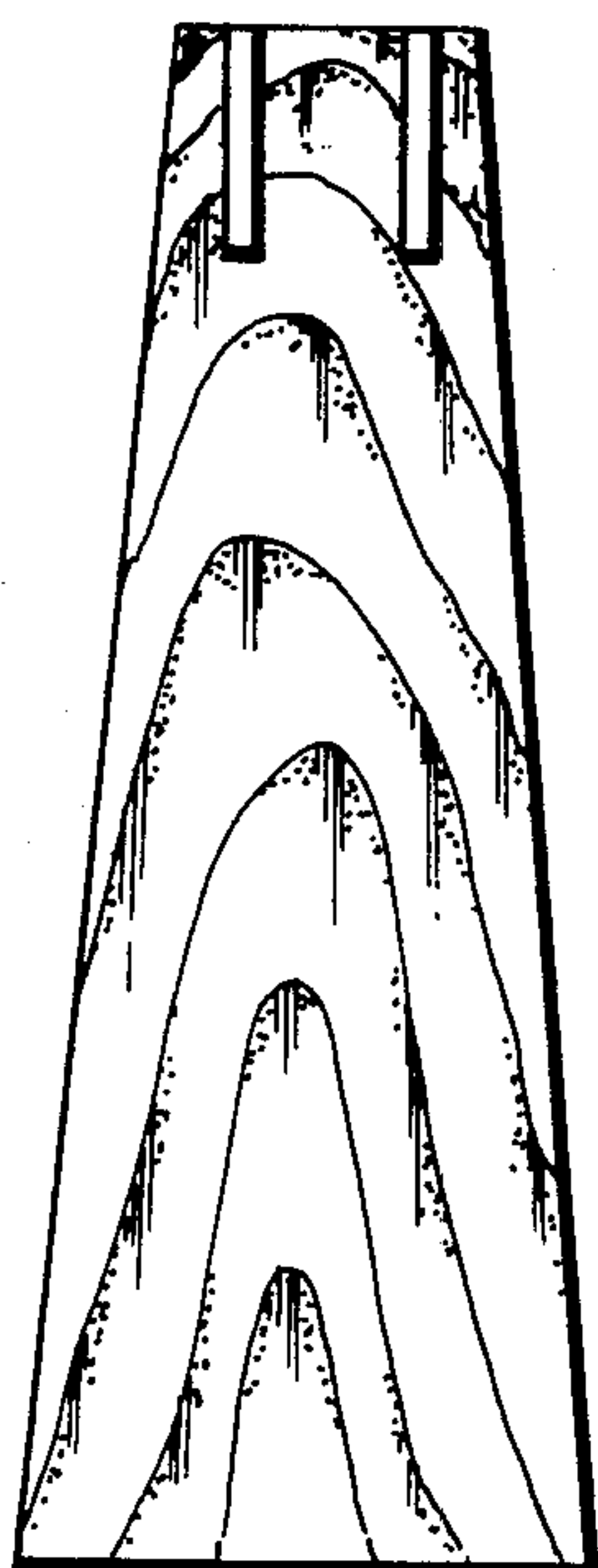

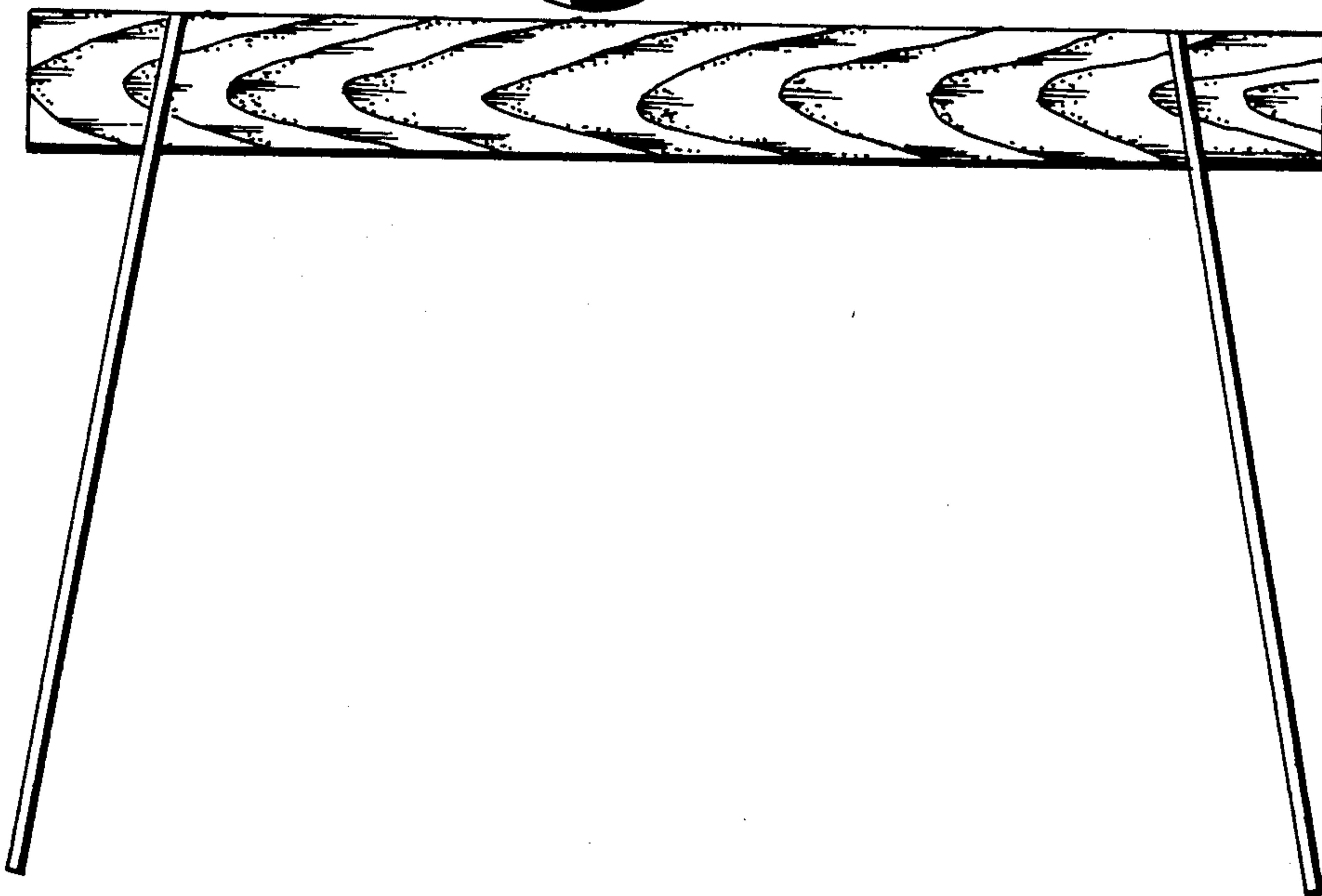

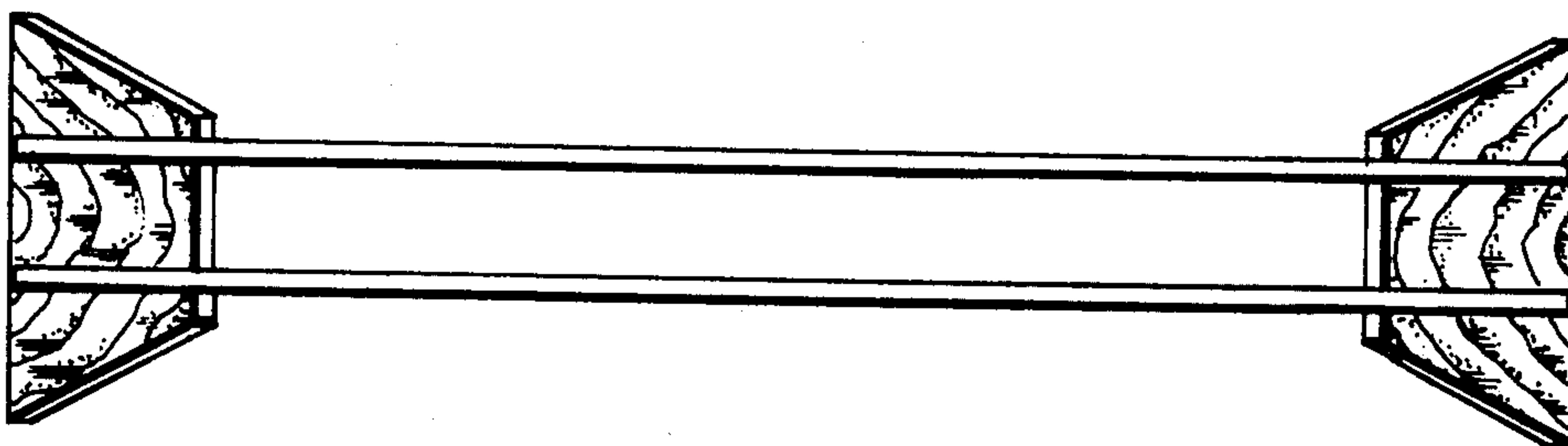
