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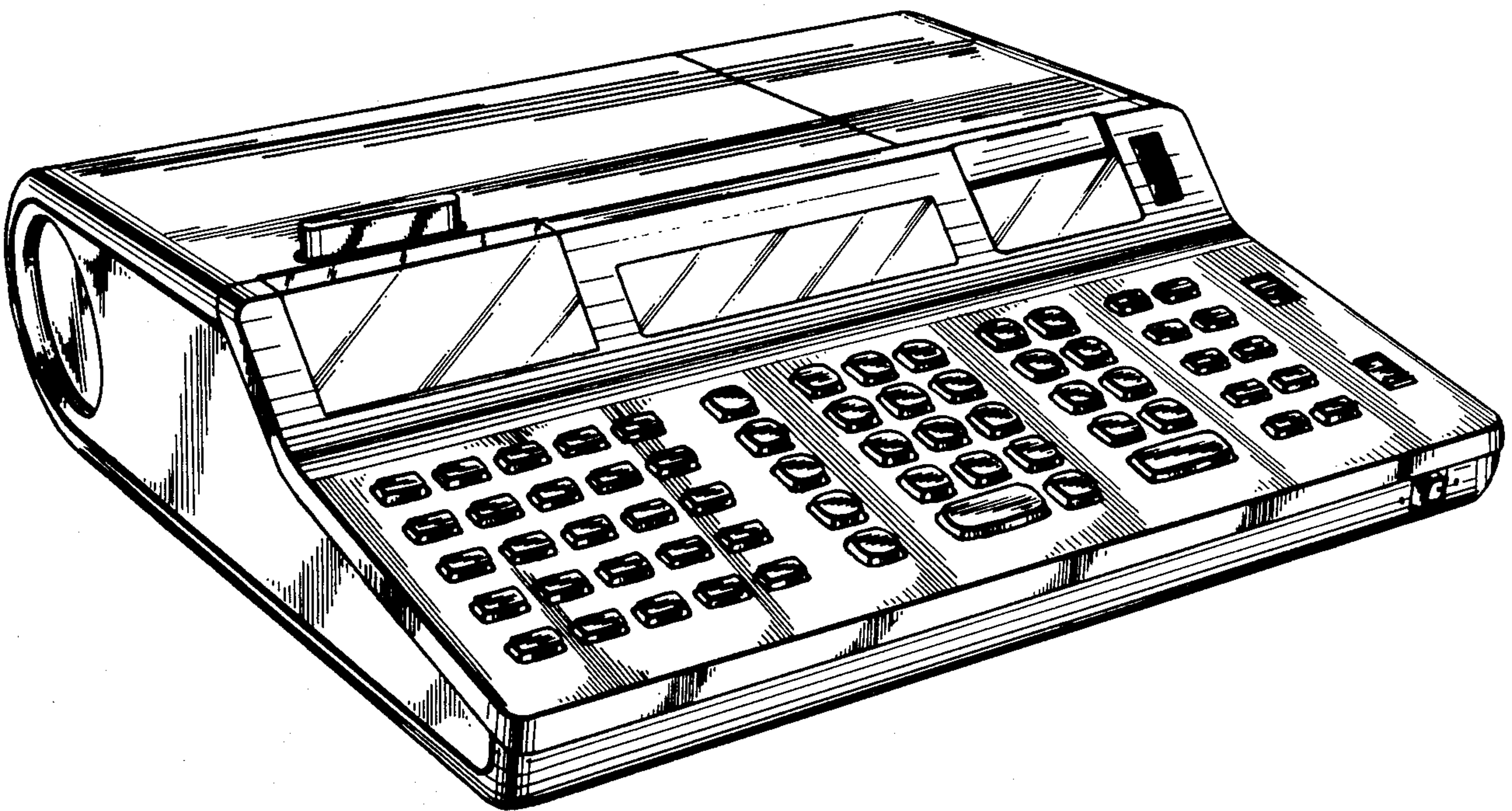

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.



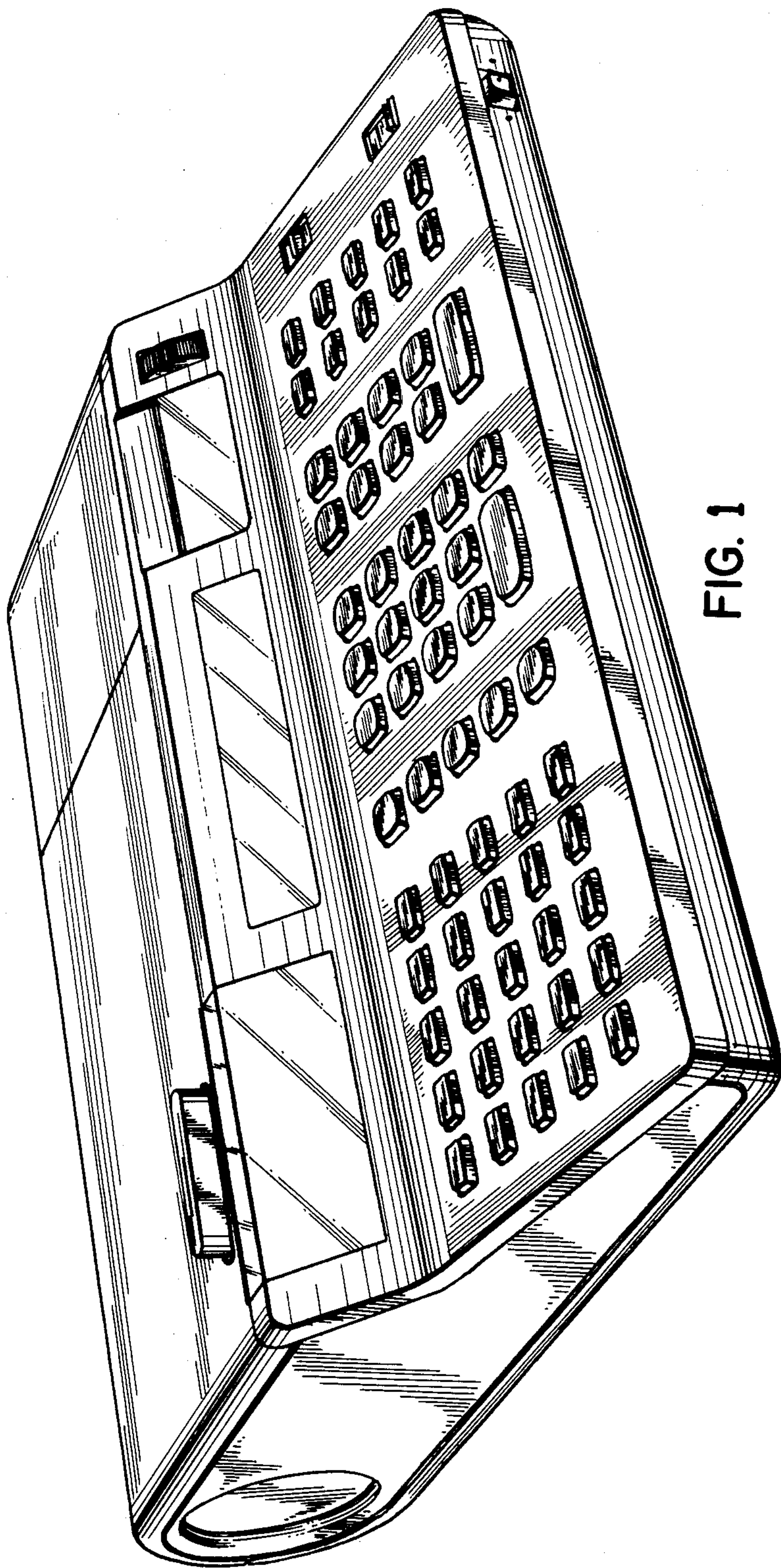

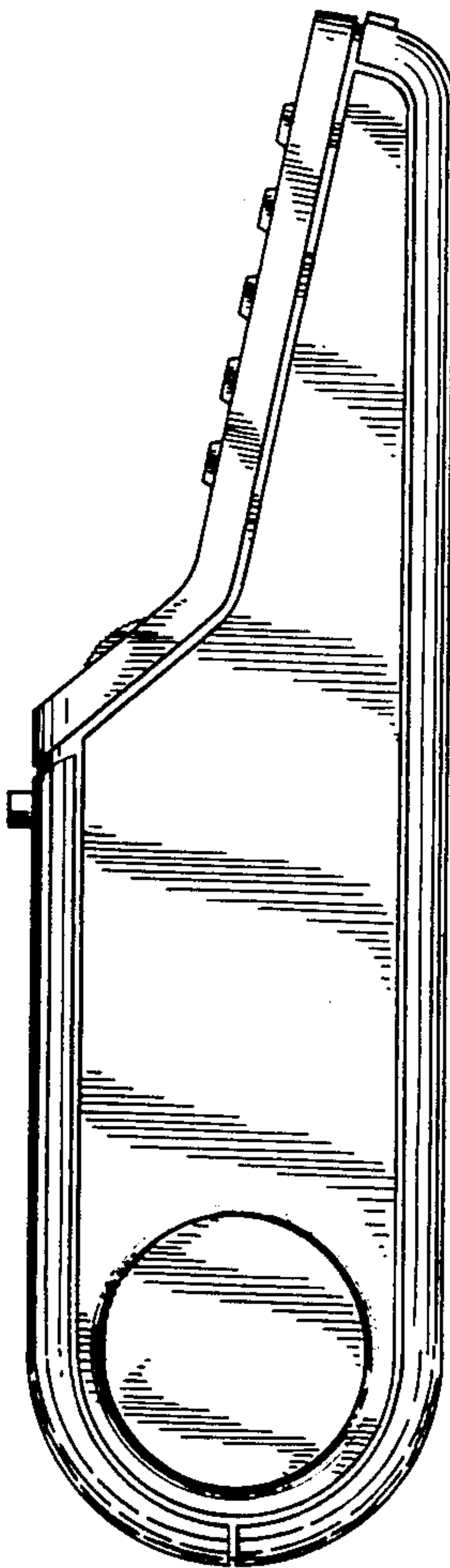
