The ornamental design for a chair, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an oblique view of the chair; and FIG. 2 depicts the chair as it appears in elevation from either side.

The appearance of the fabric as seen in FIG. 1 is continuous throughout the undepicted front and rear portions of the chair.

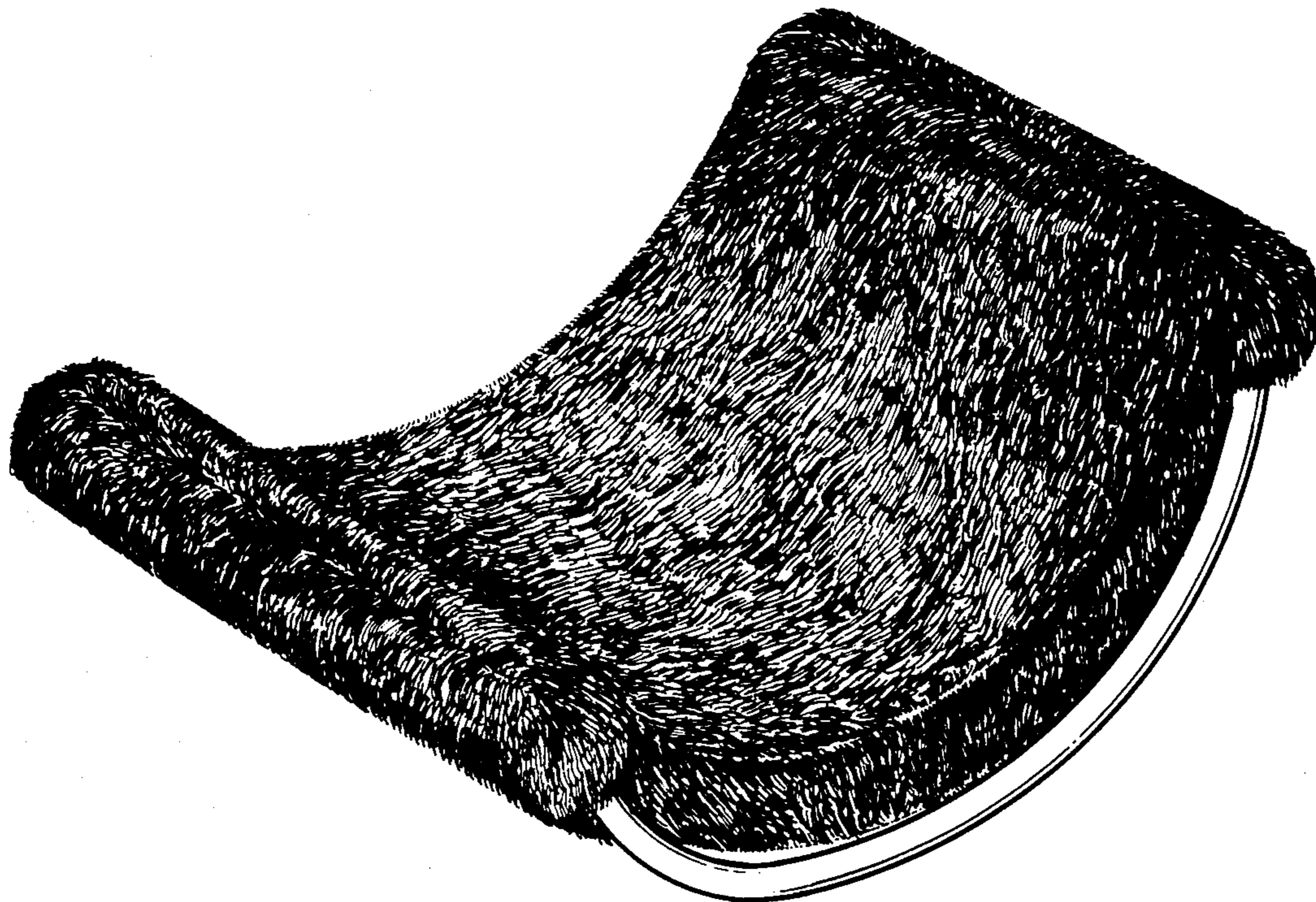

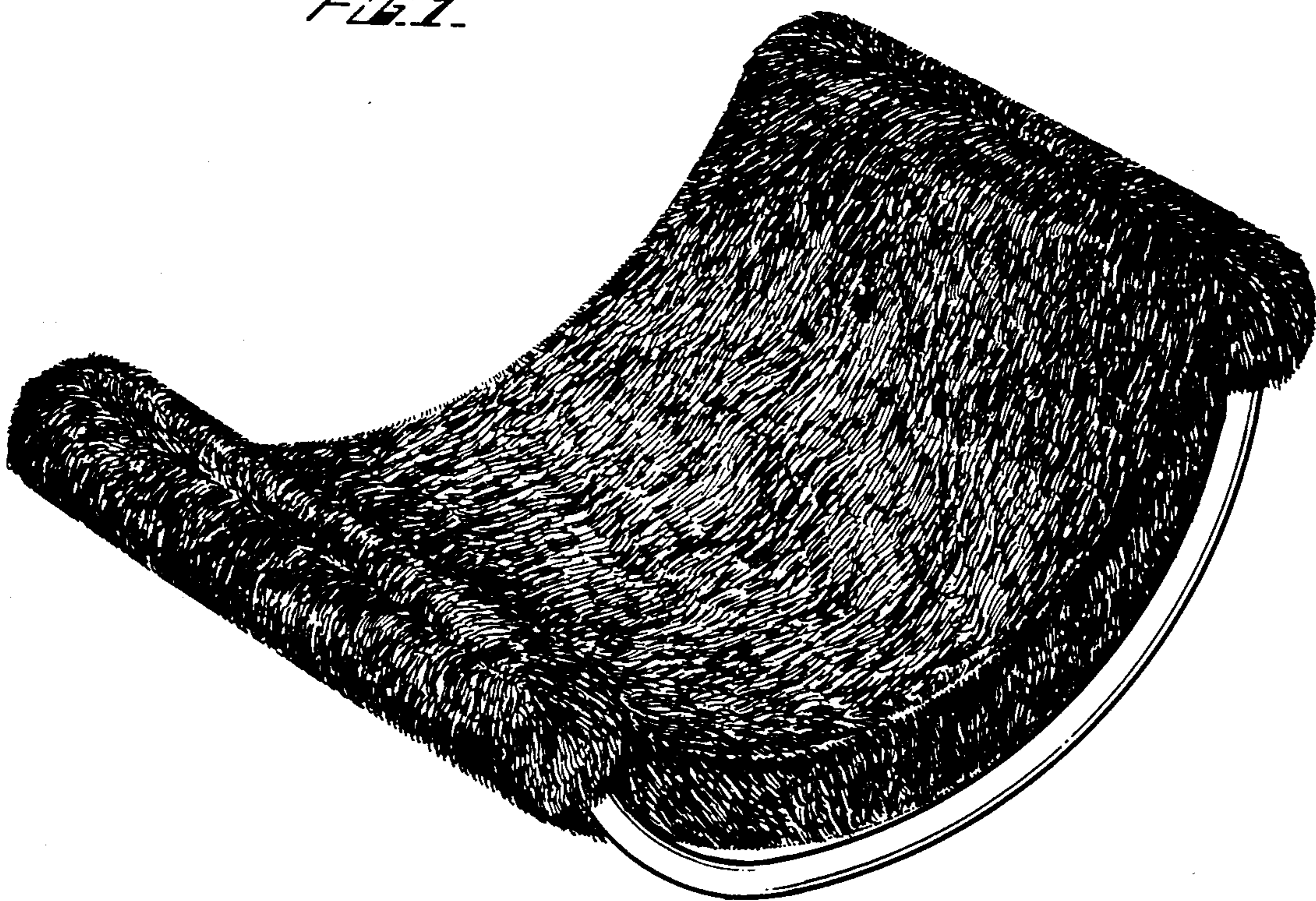
