[57] CLAIM

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.

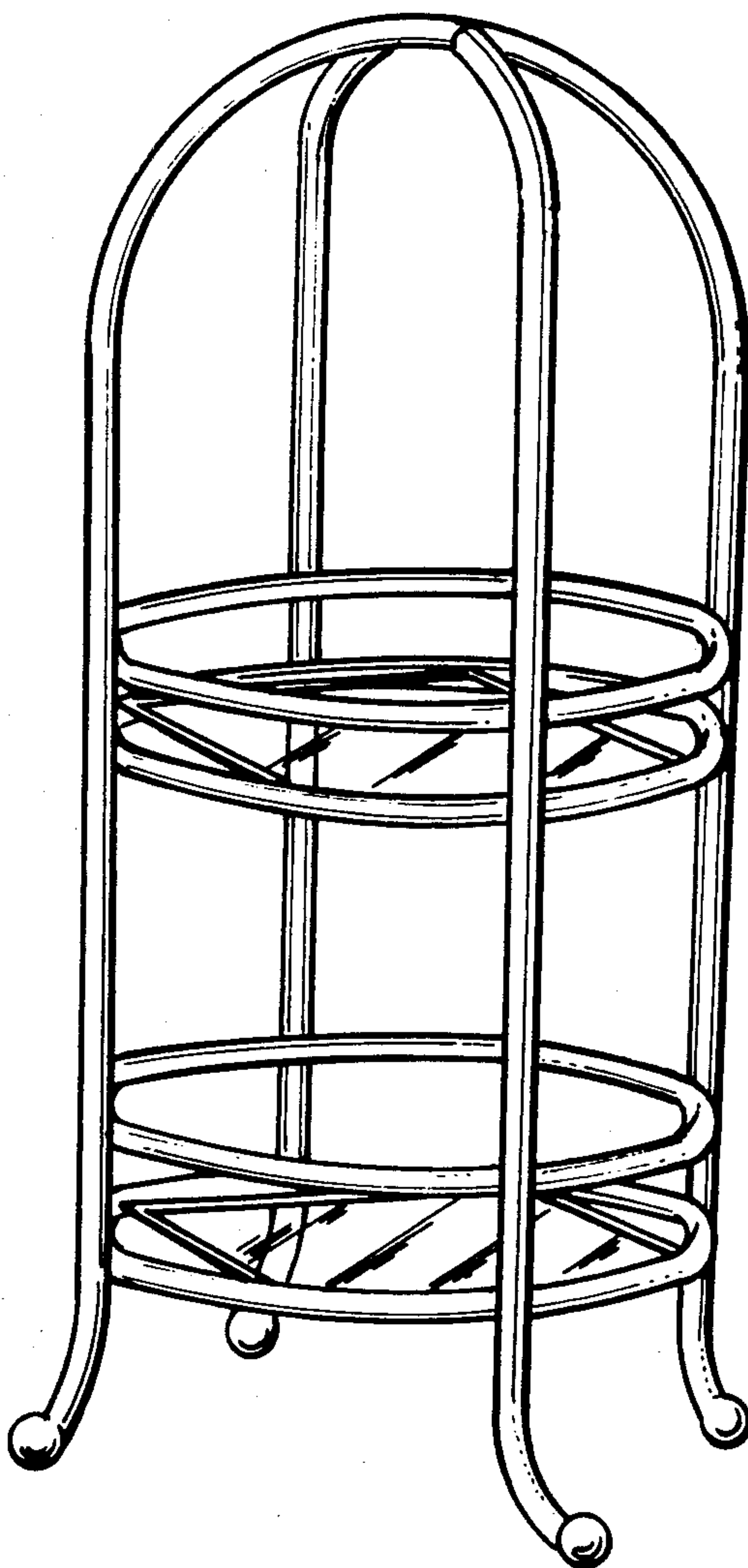

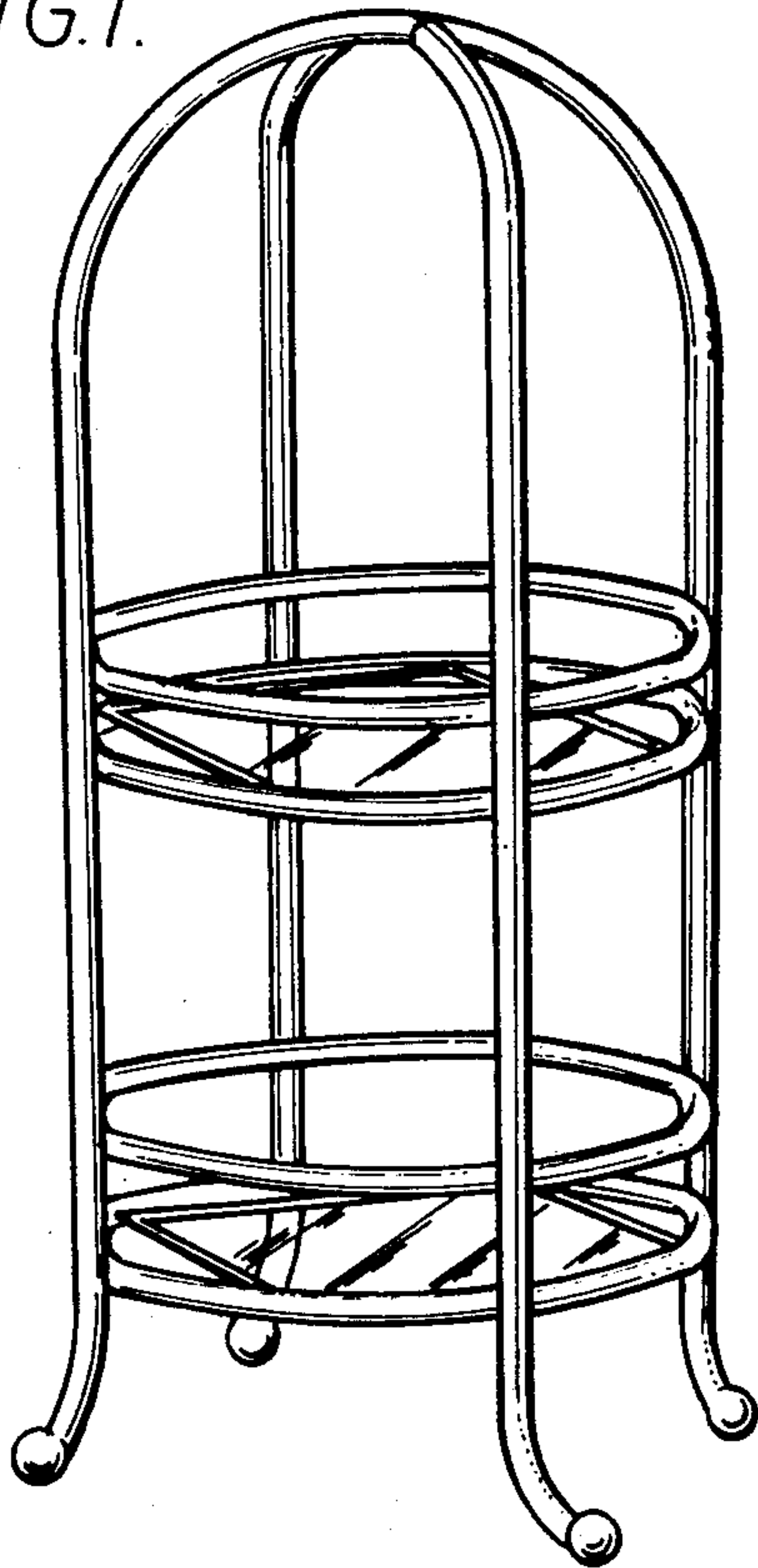

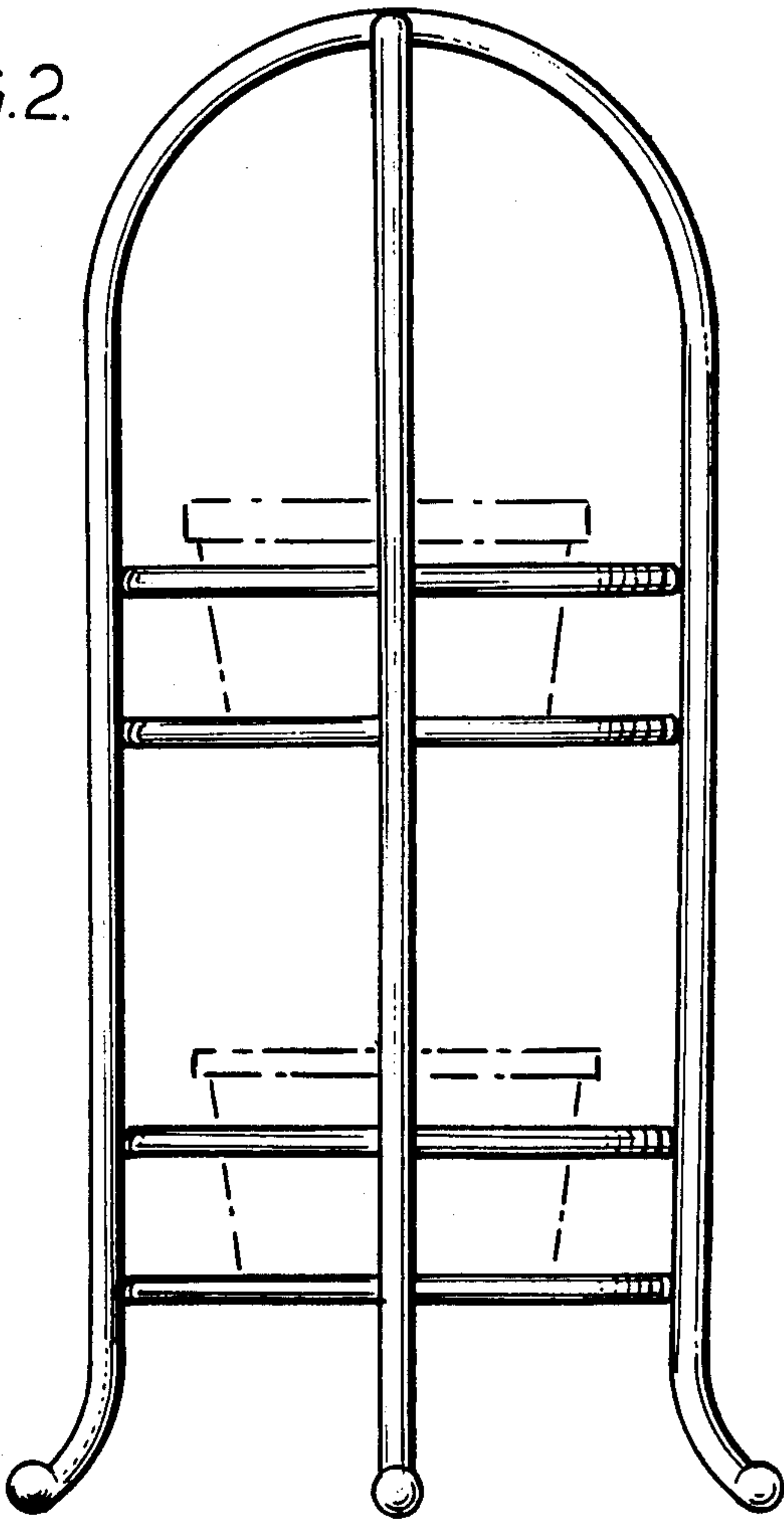
