DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cushion embodying my new design, the dashed lines indicating the stitching. FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof. FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof. FIG. 4 is an end view thereof, the opposite end being a mirror image.
