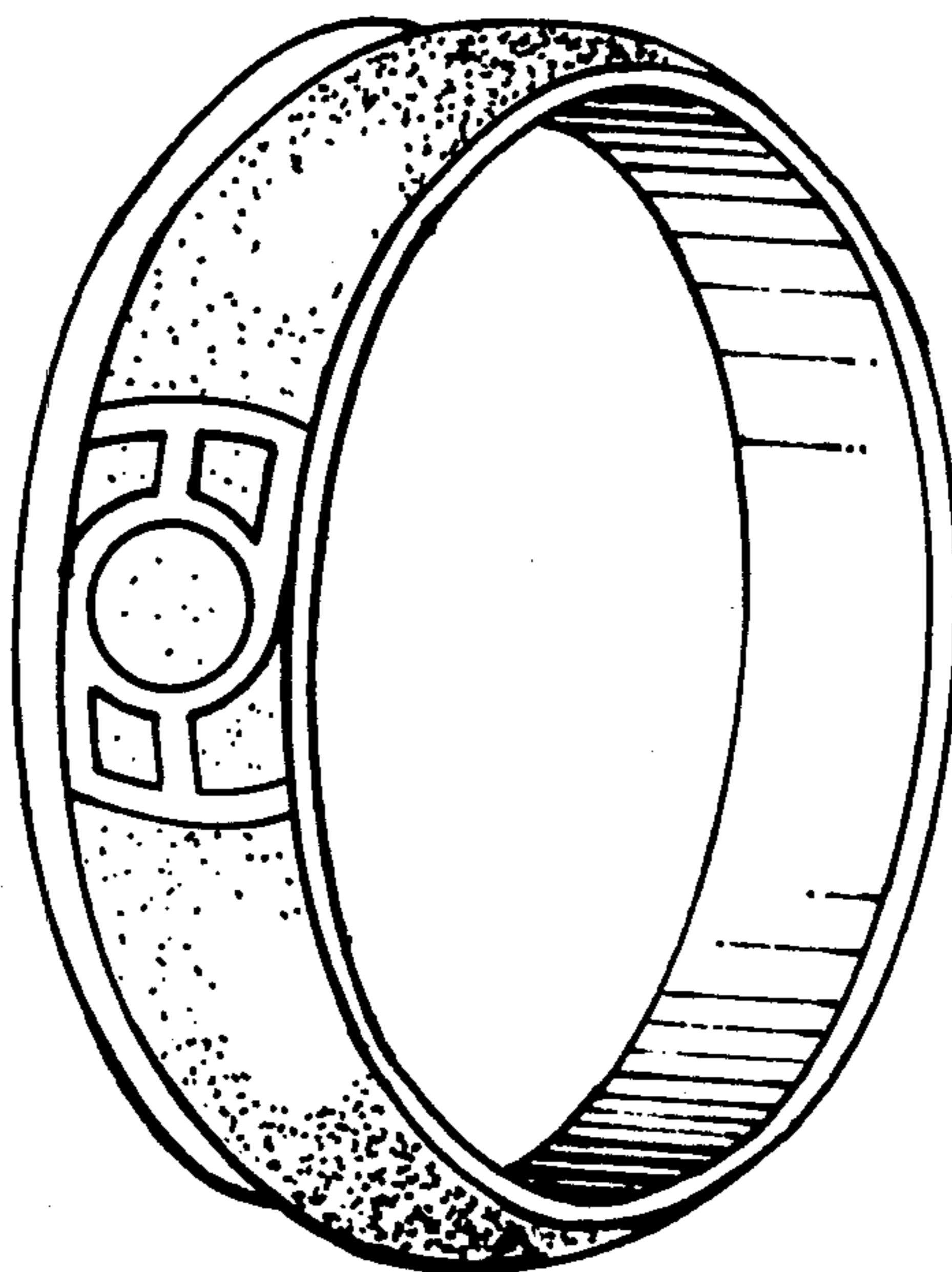

for the omission of the symbol.



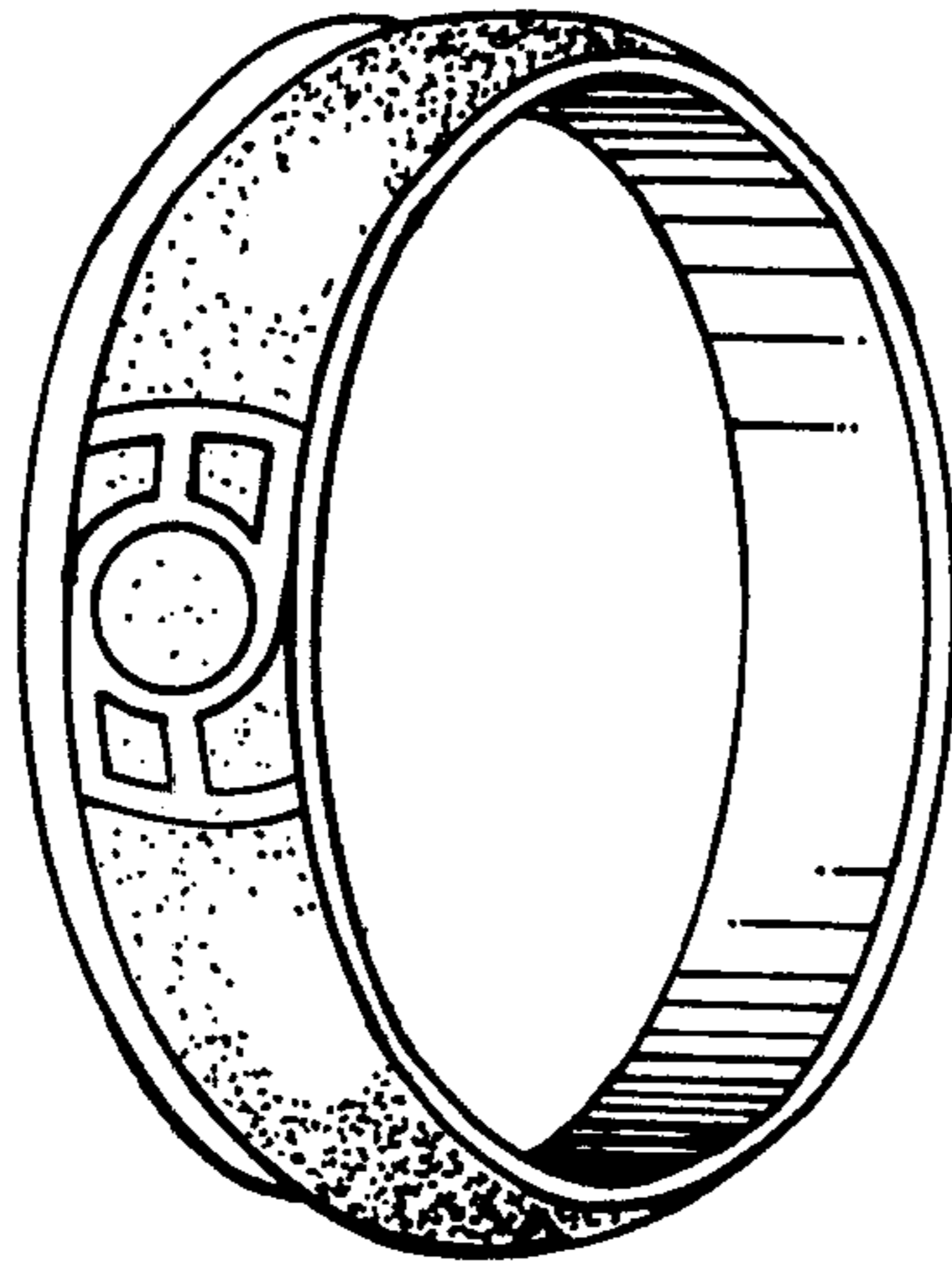

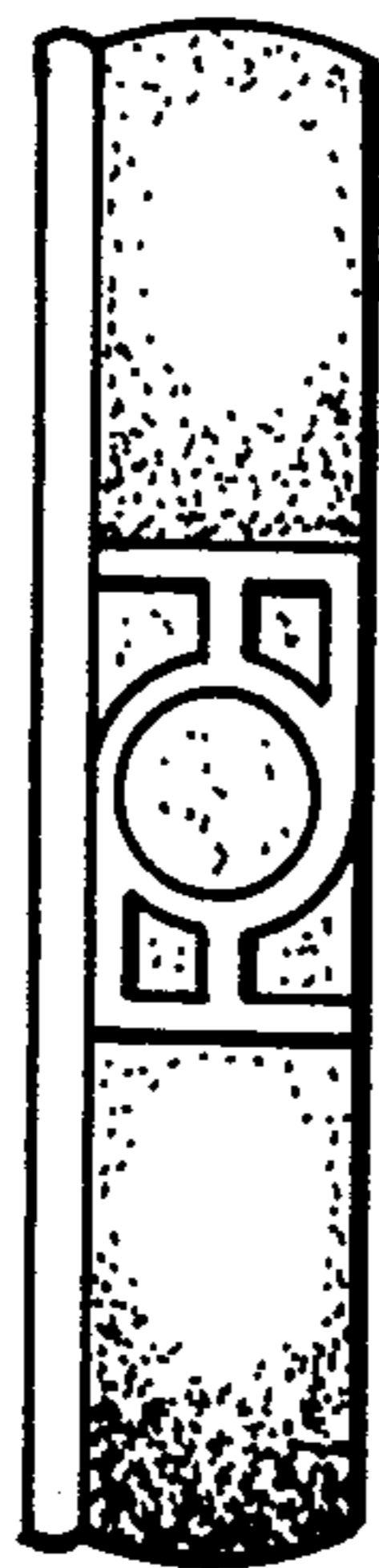
