The ornamental design for a flower pot, substantially as shown and described.

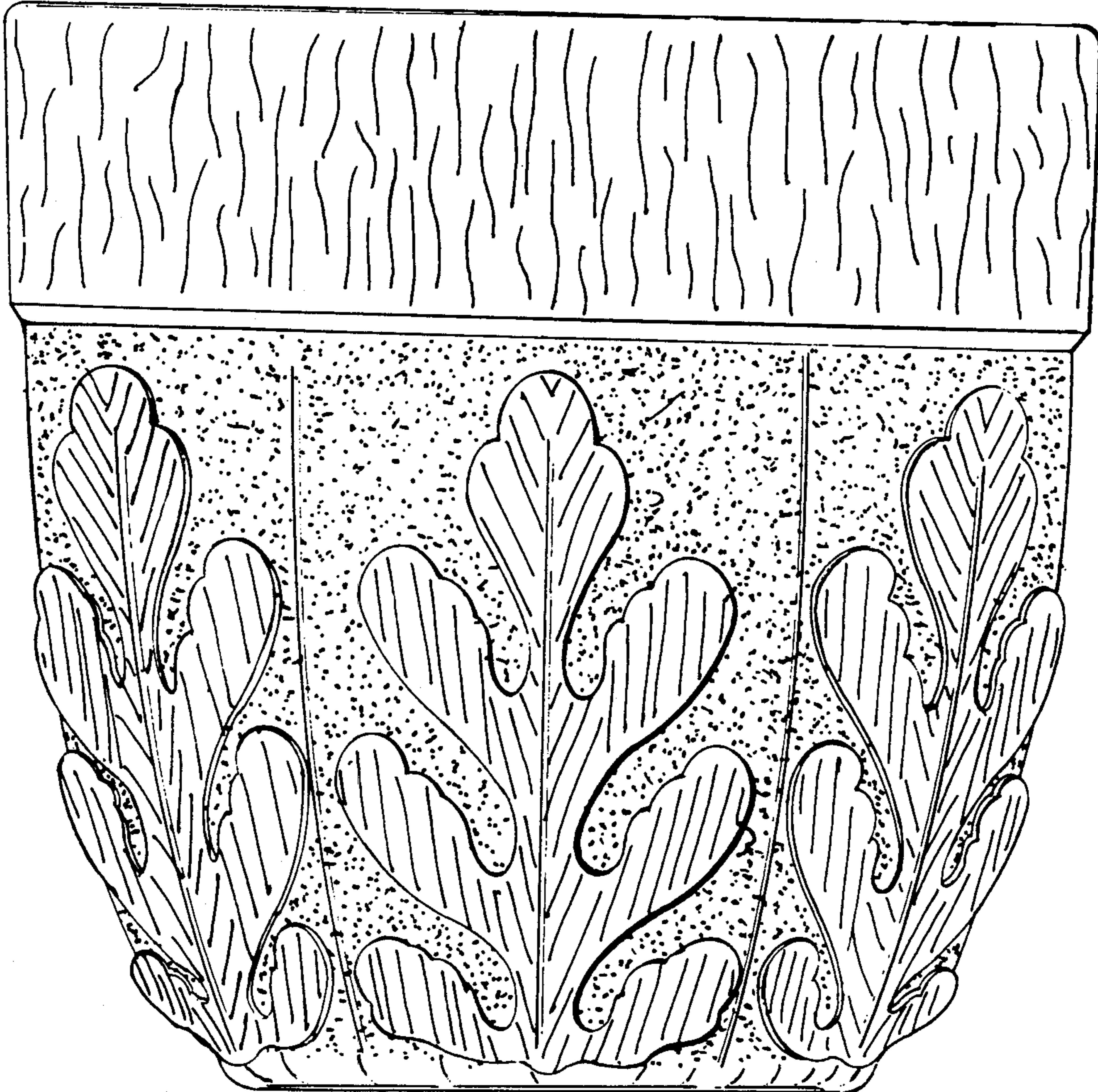
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a flower pot embodying our new design.

FIG. 2 is a sectional view taken through the center of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.

The surface ornamentation shown in FIG. 1 is continuous around the entire periphery of the pot.



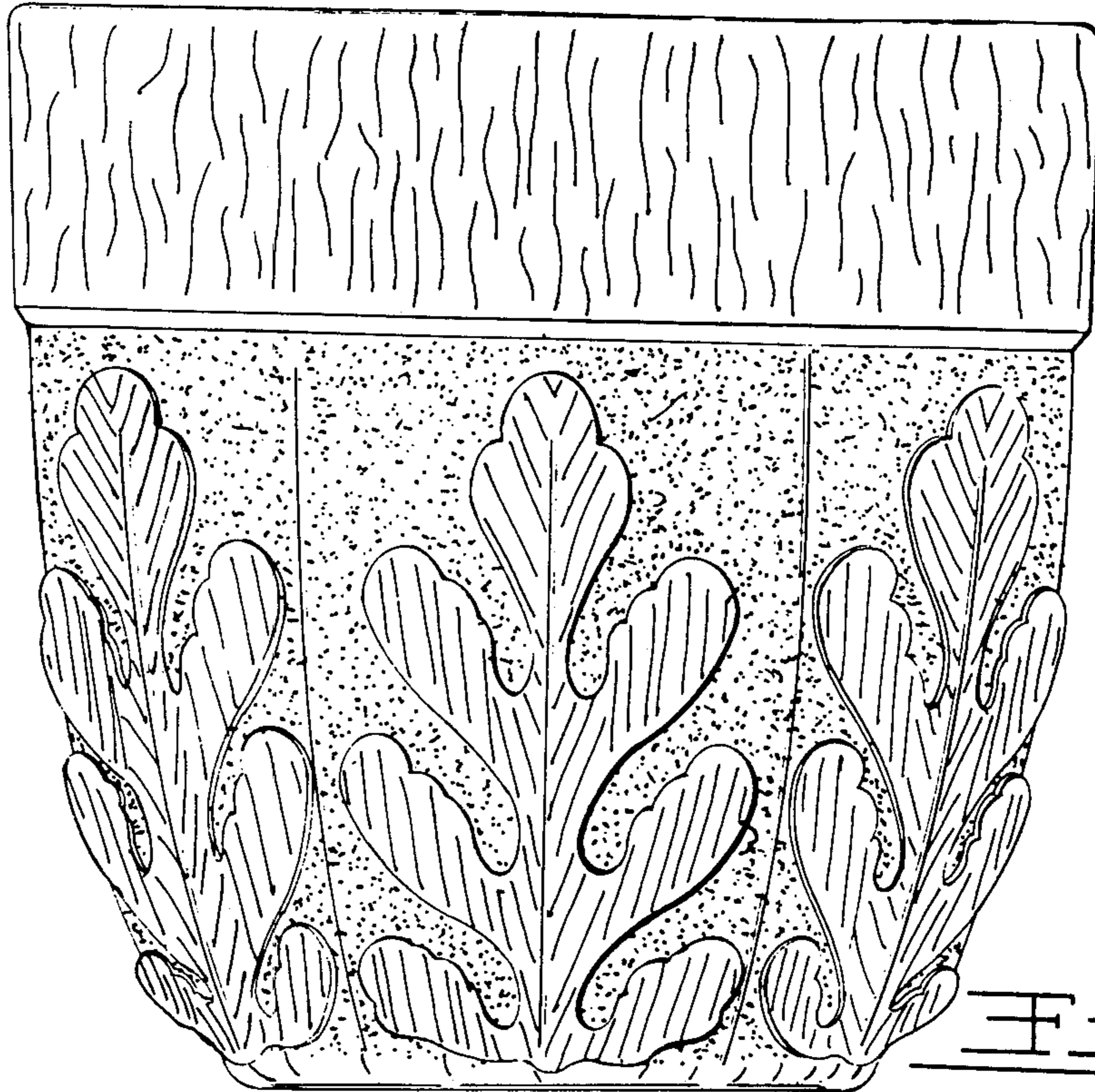

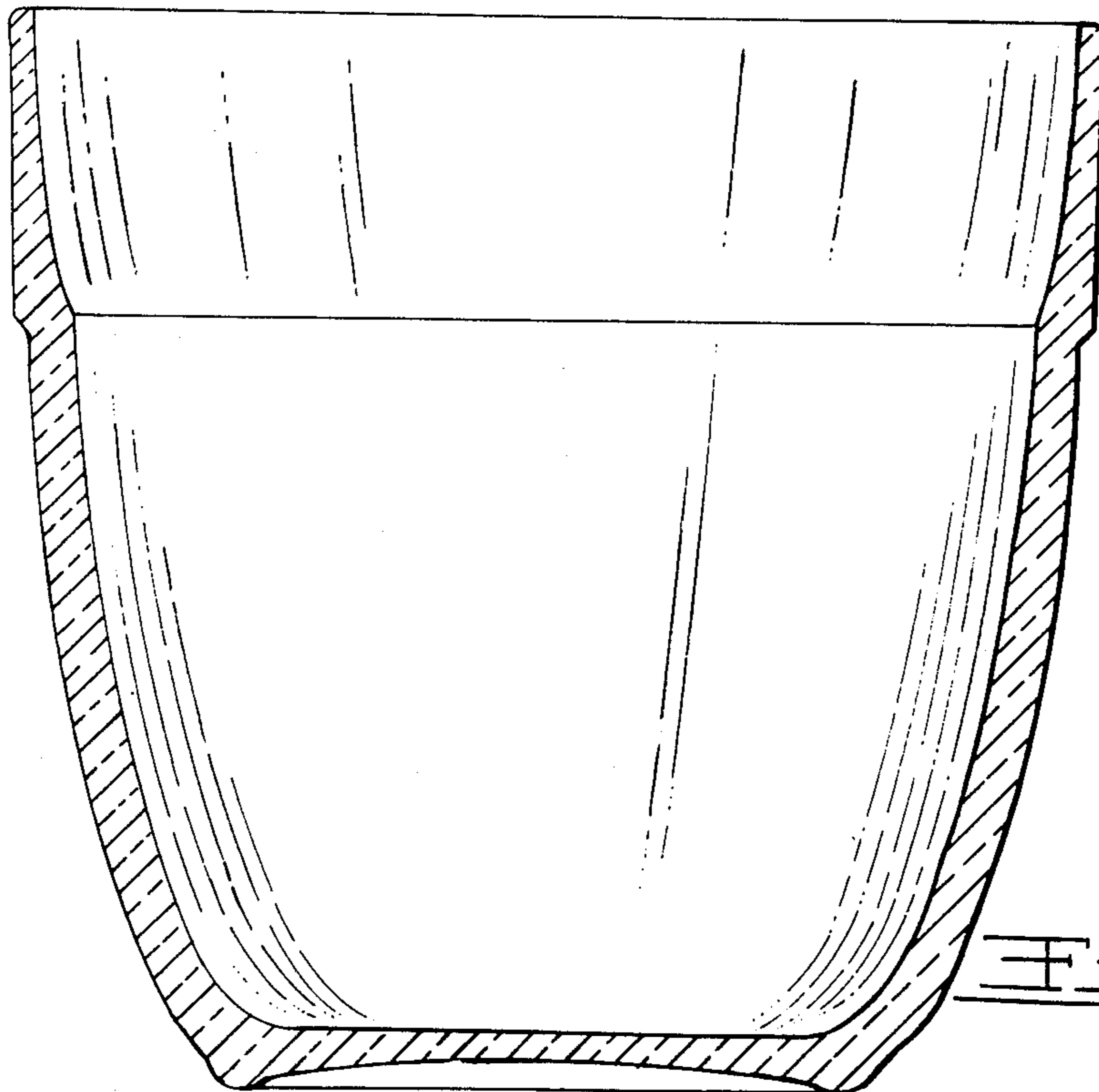

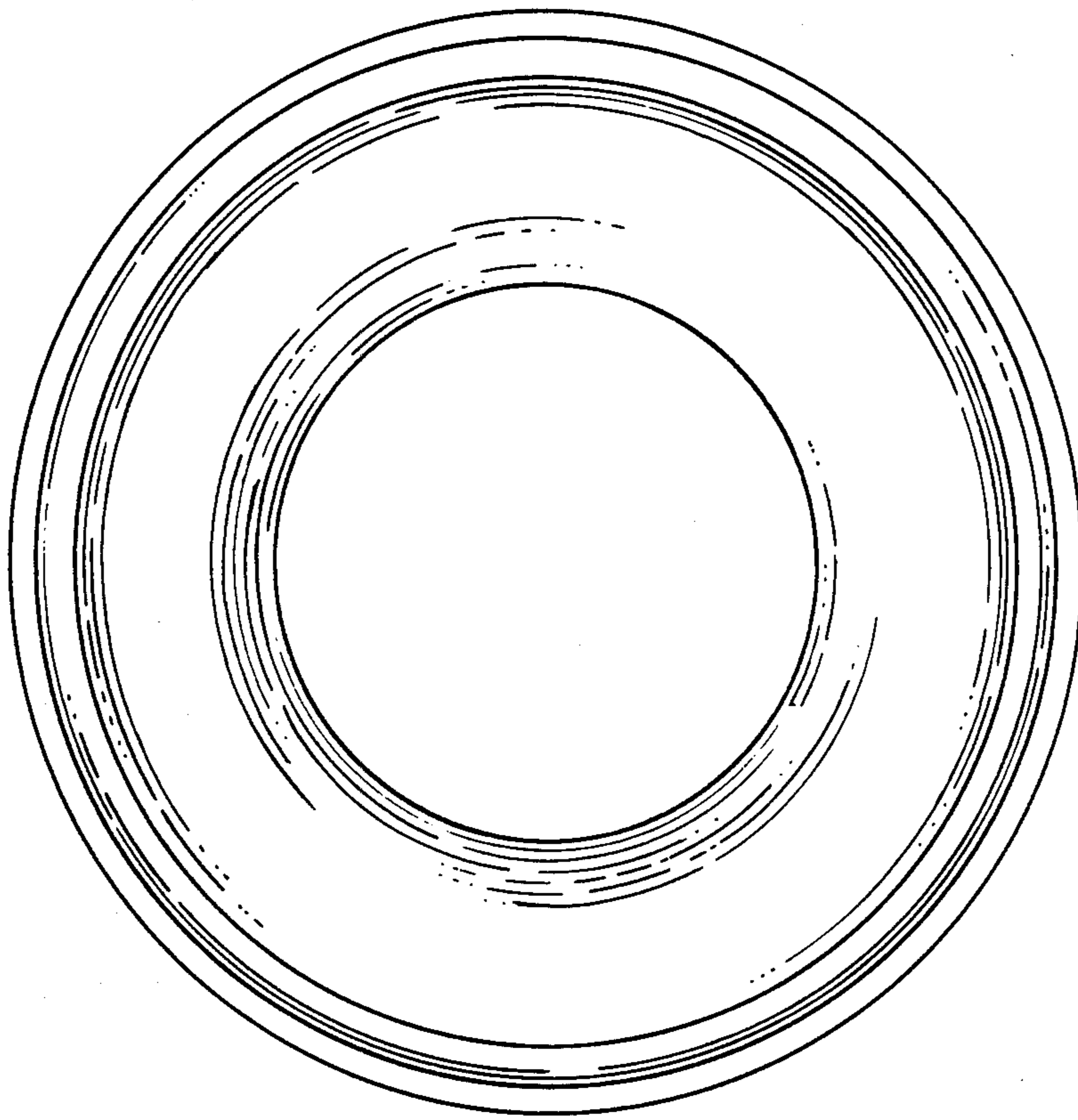
