[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a discotheque building, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front side elevational view of a discotheque building, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof as seen from the righthand end of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof as seen from the lefthand end of FIG. 1.

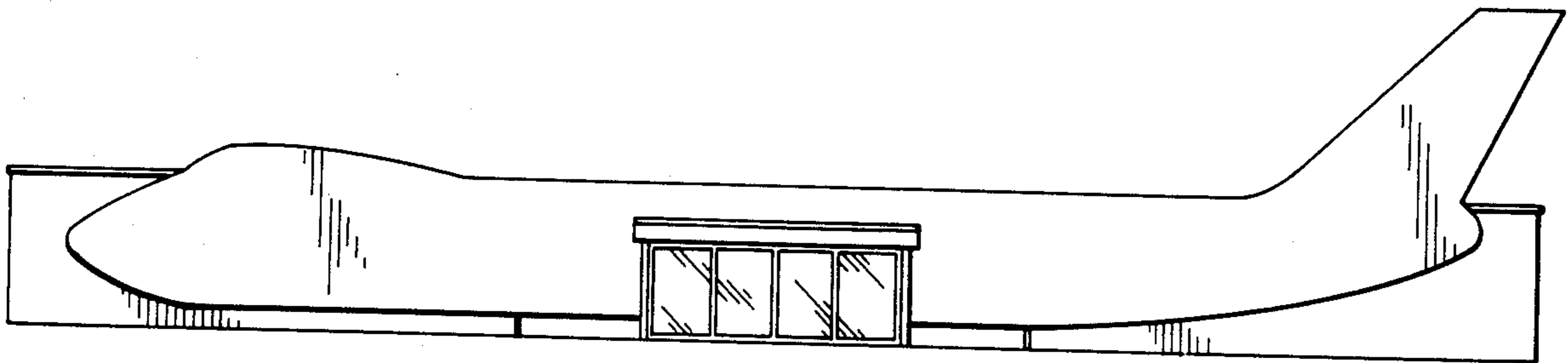

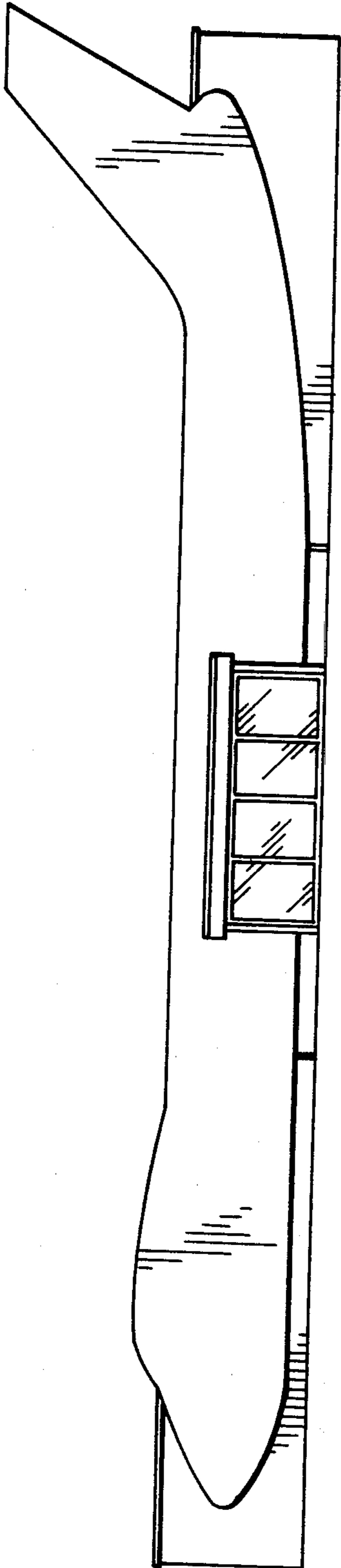
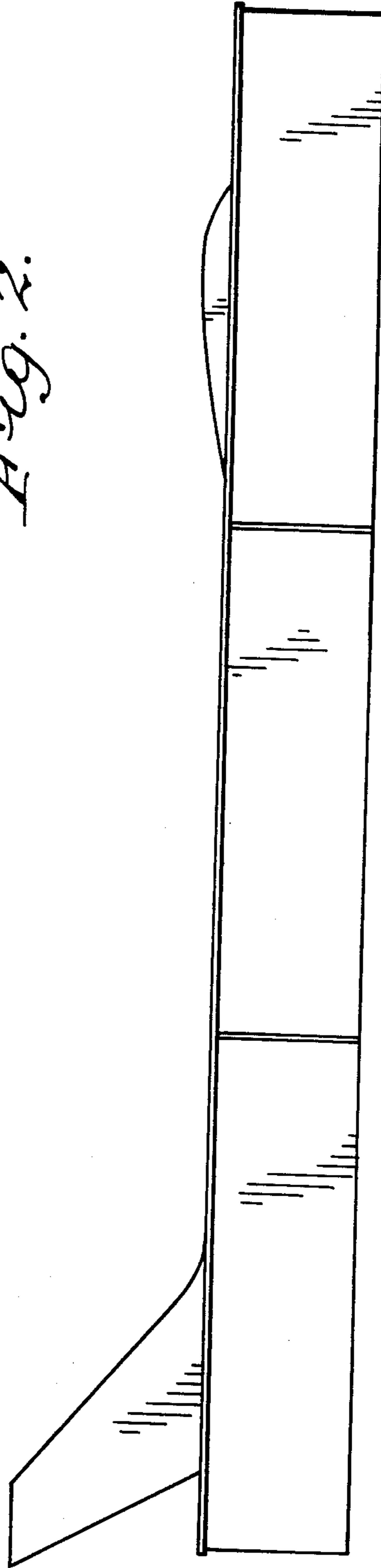

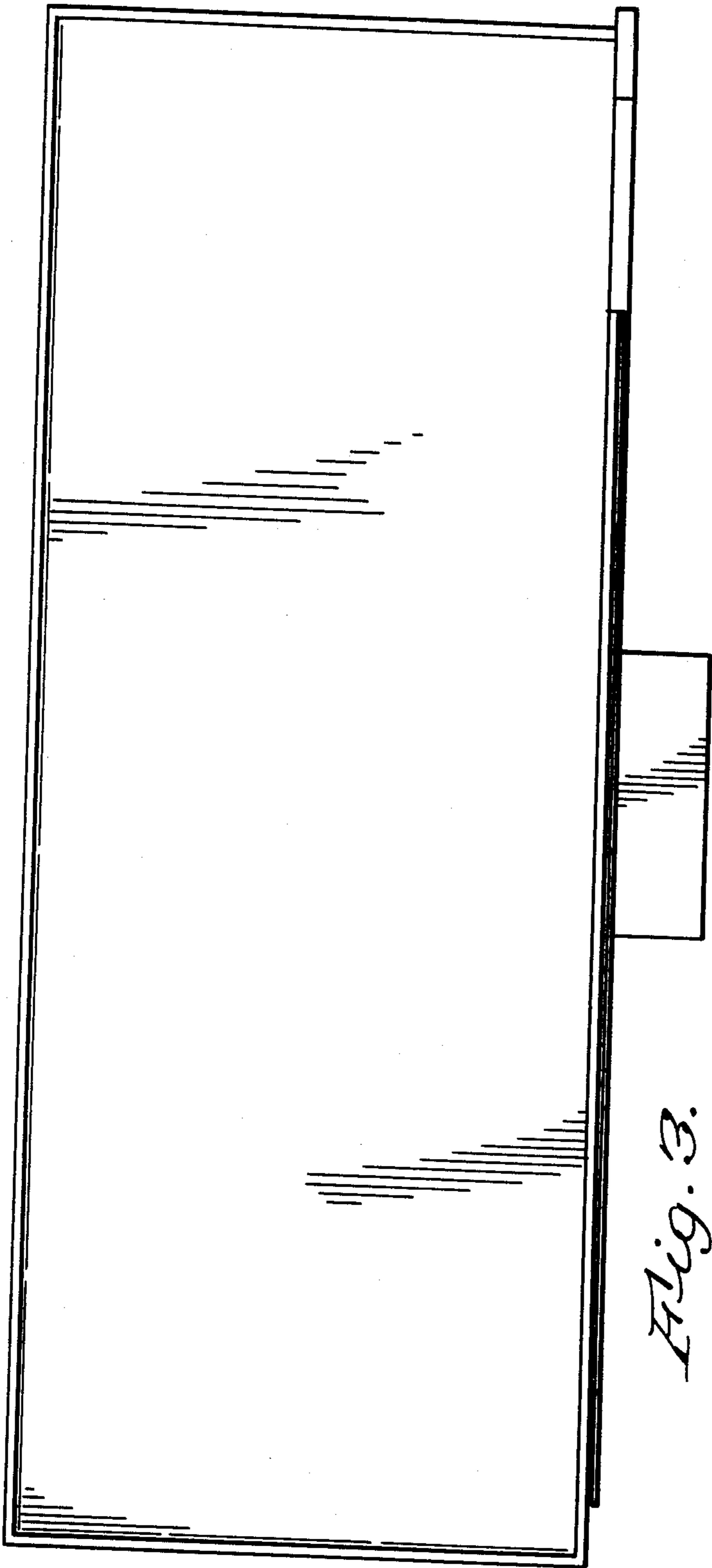

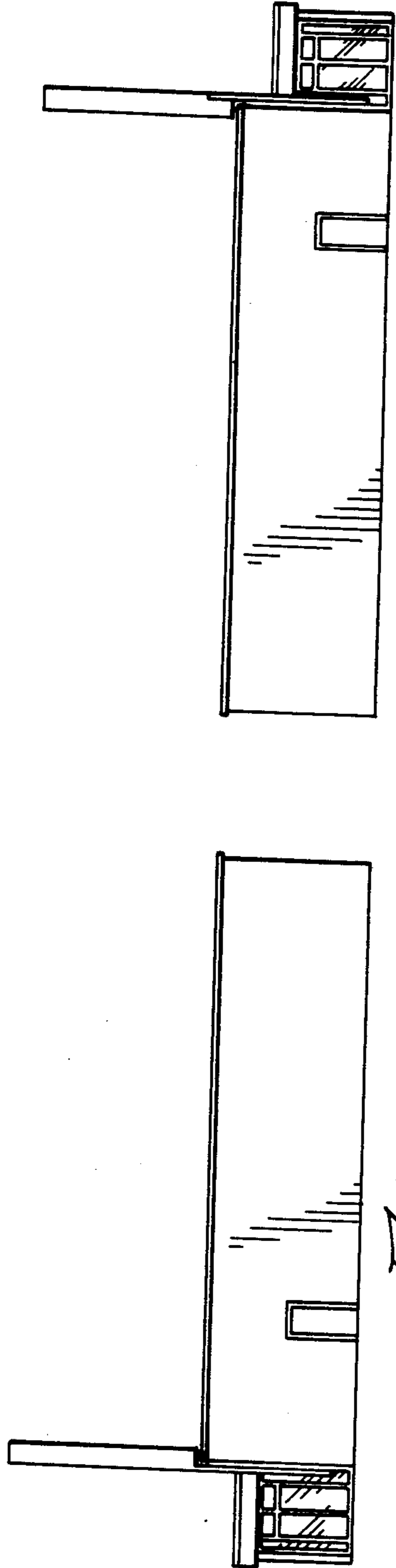
