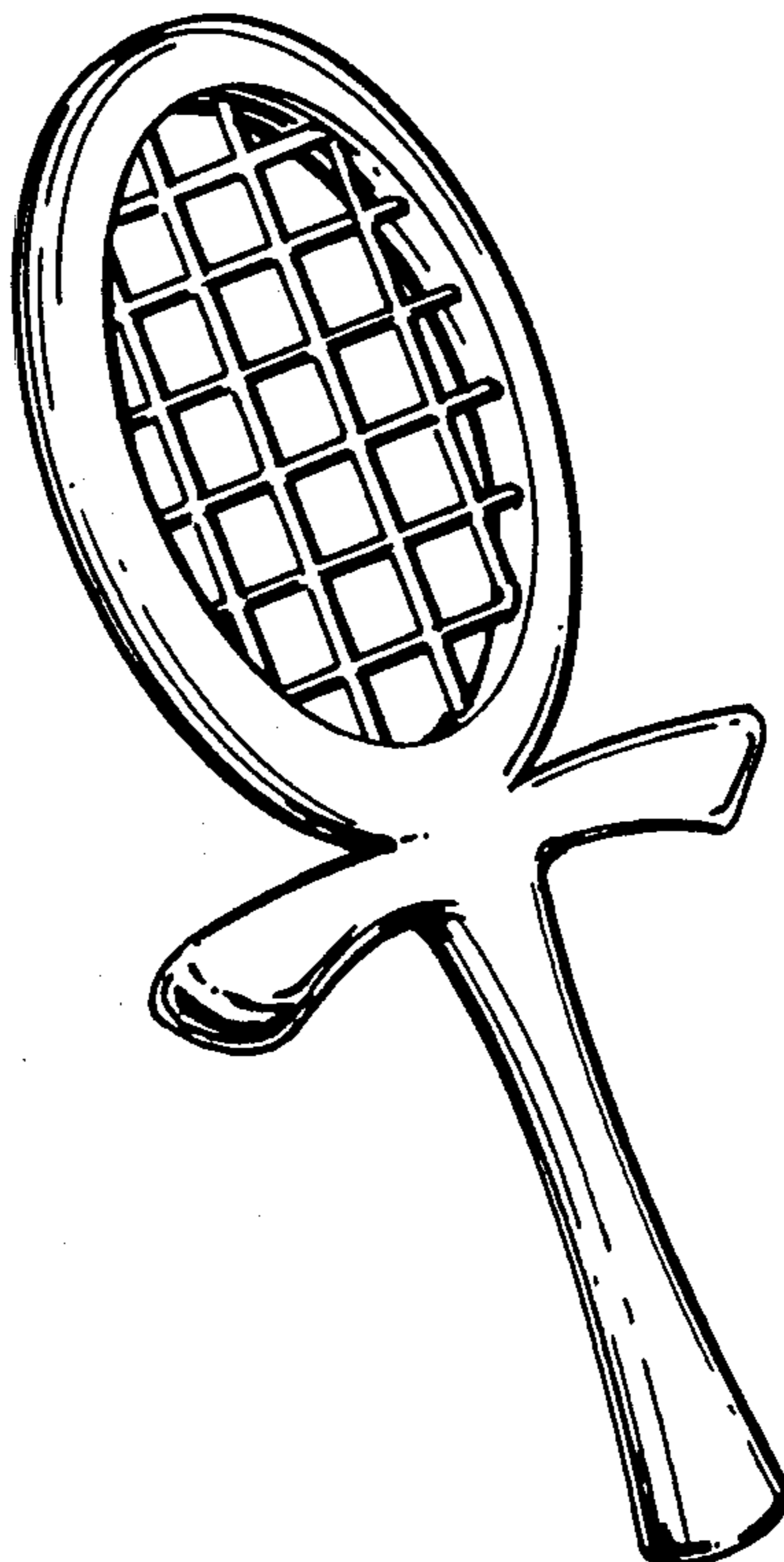
[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, and FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof.



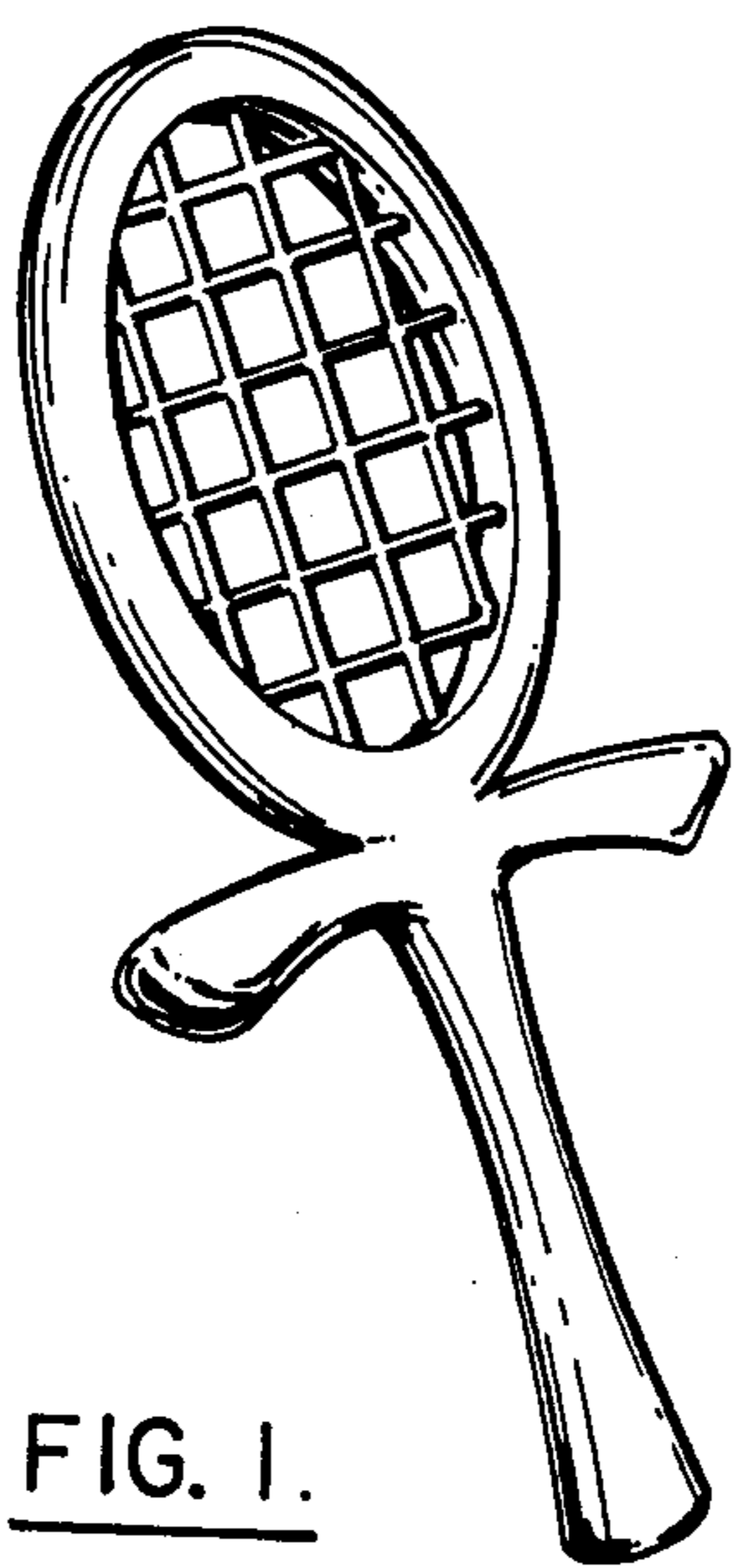

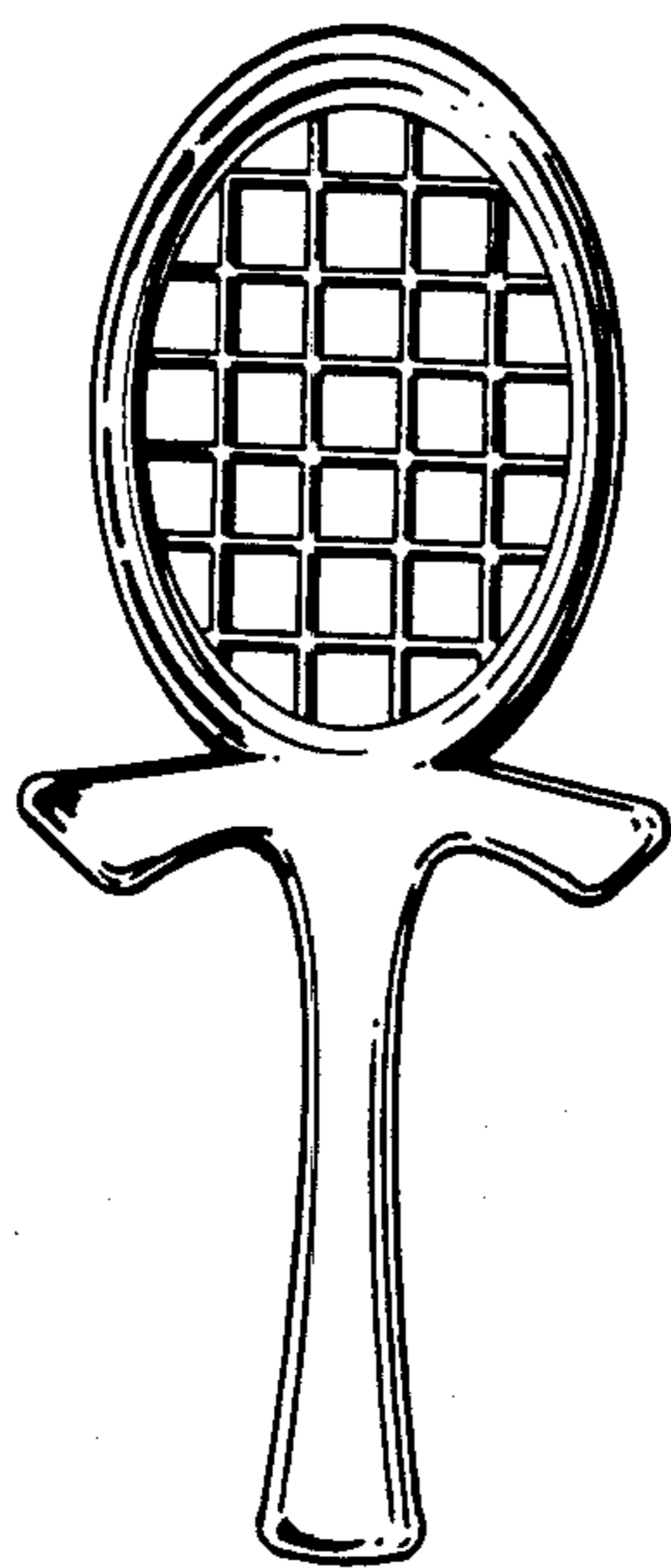
