[57] **CLAIM**


The ornamental design for a game board, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of a game board showing our new design; and

FIG. 2 is a plan view of an embodiment of the game board of FIG. 1 in which the shading indicates contrasting colors.

The surface features are flush and the article is of no appreciable thickness.






