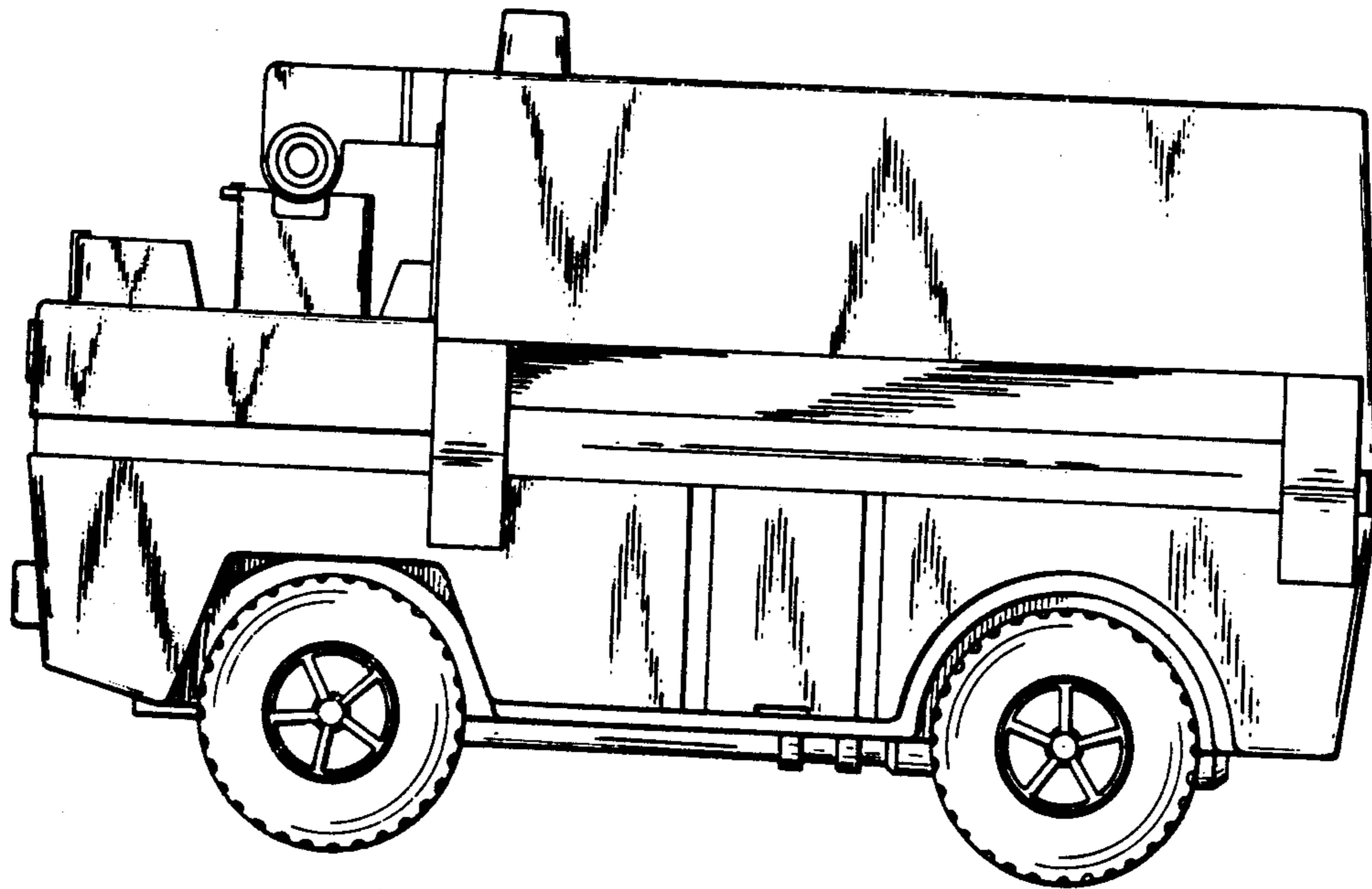

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left-side elevational view of a toy rescue truck showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



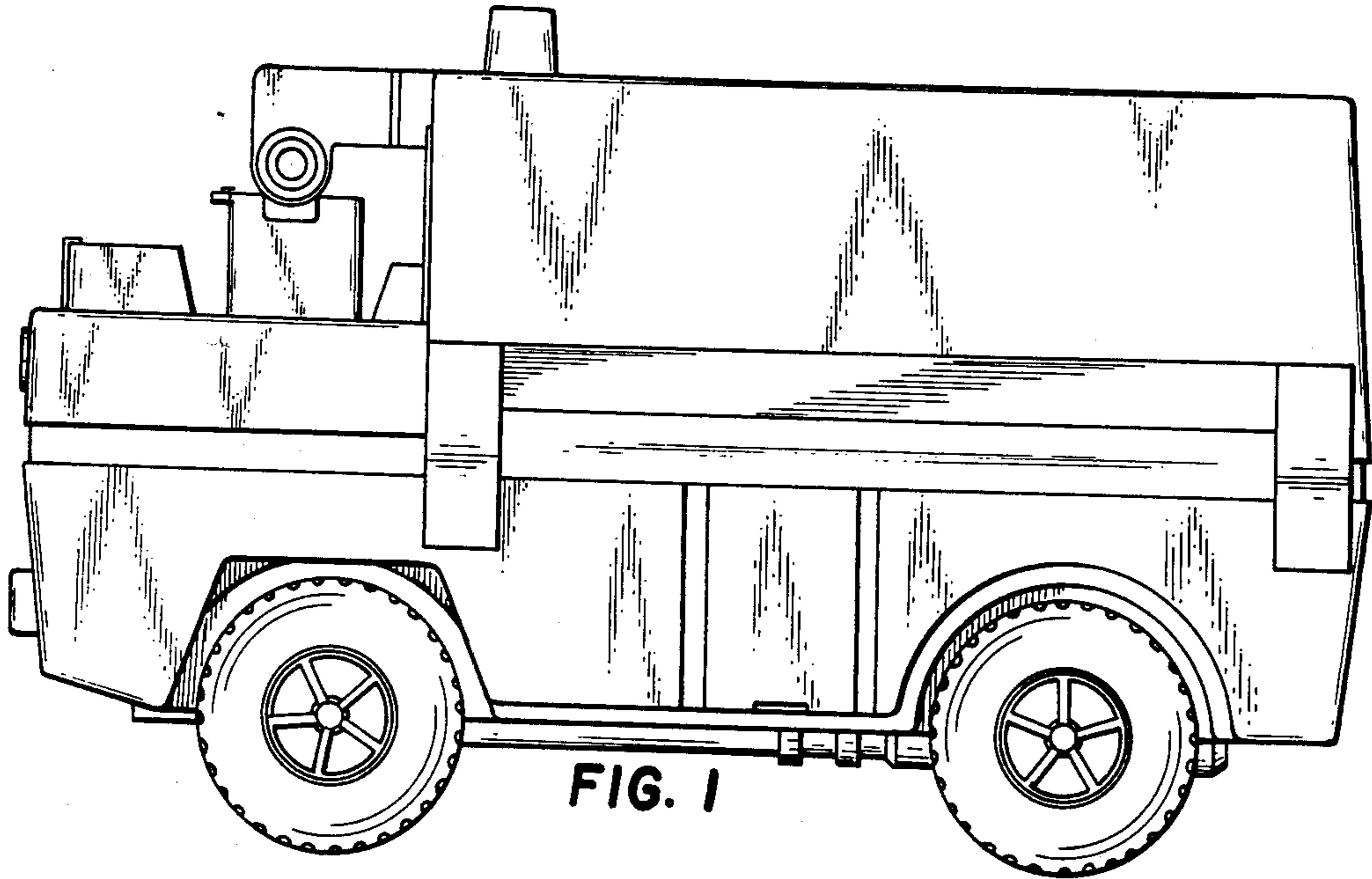

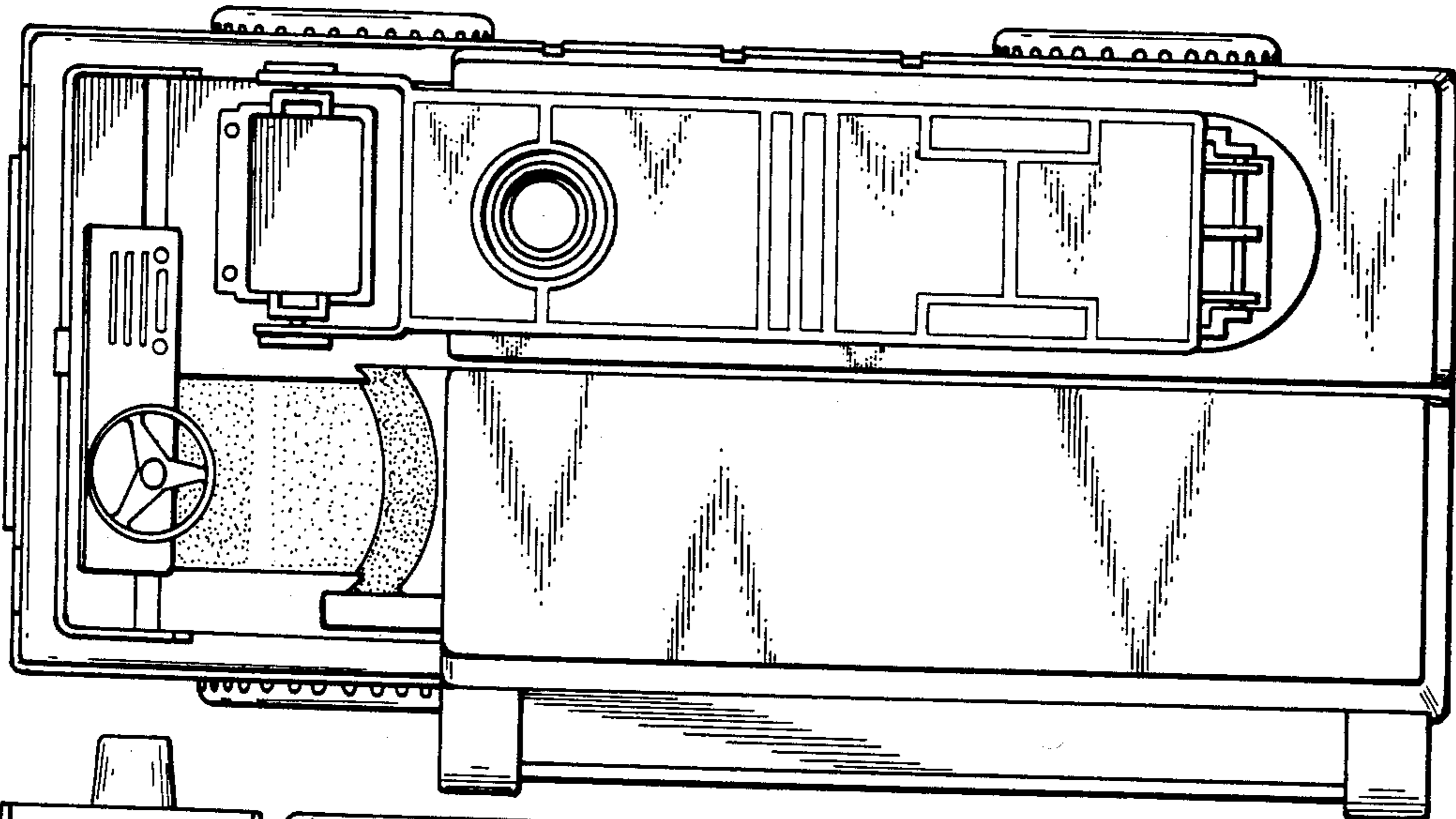

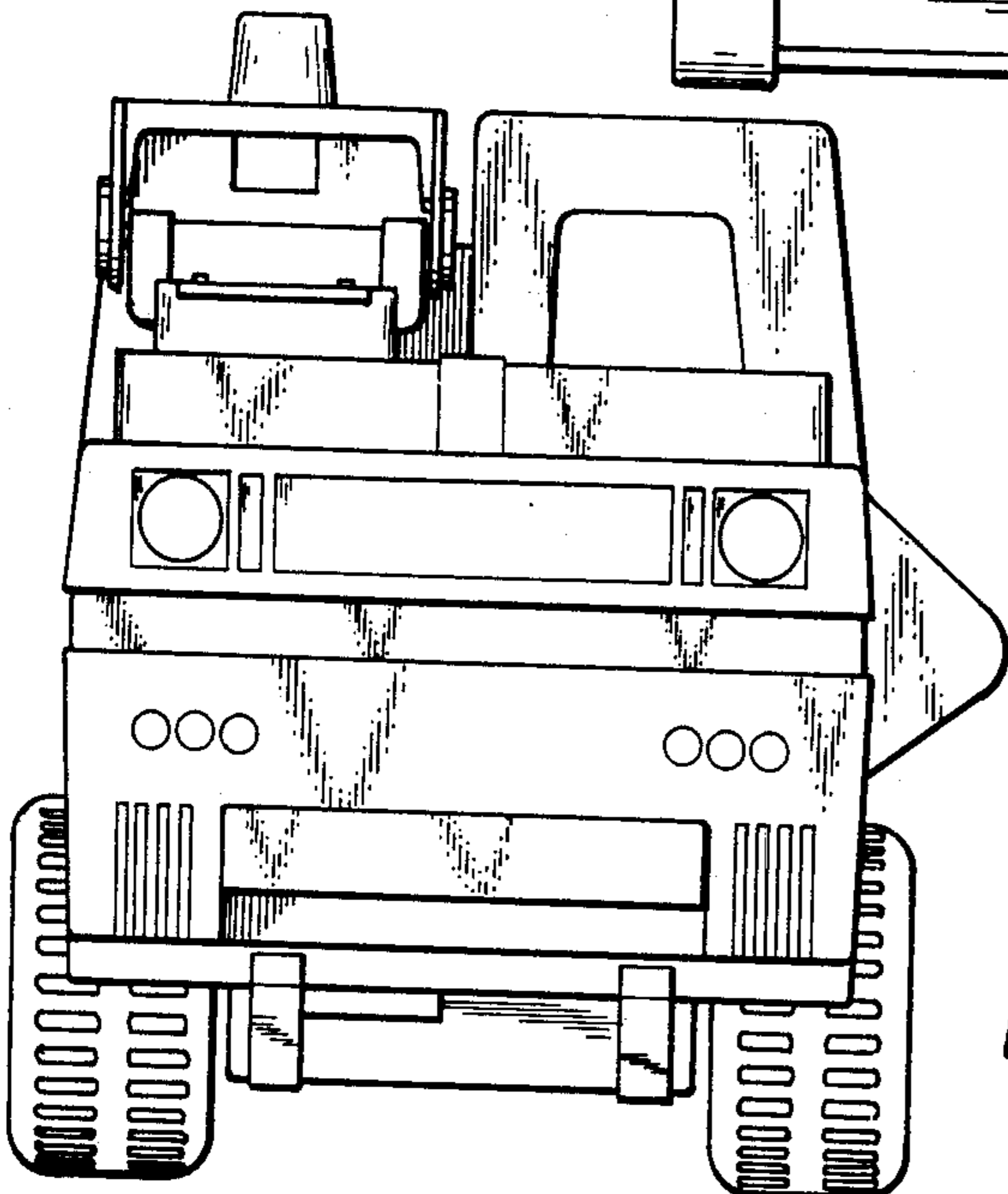

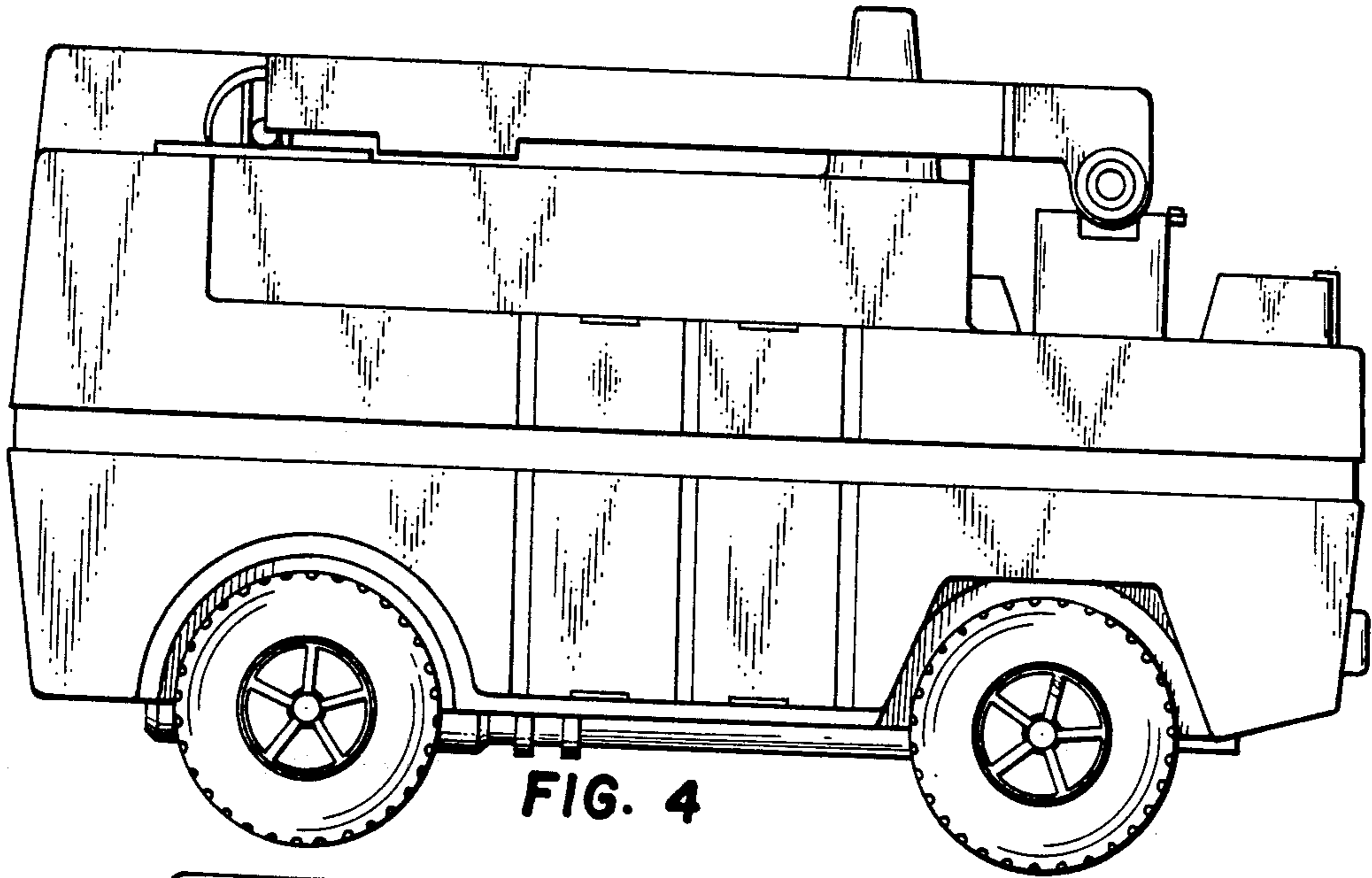

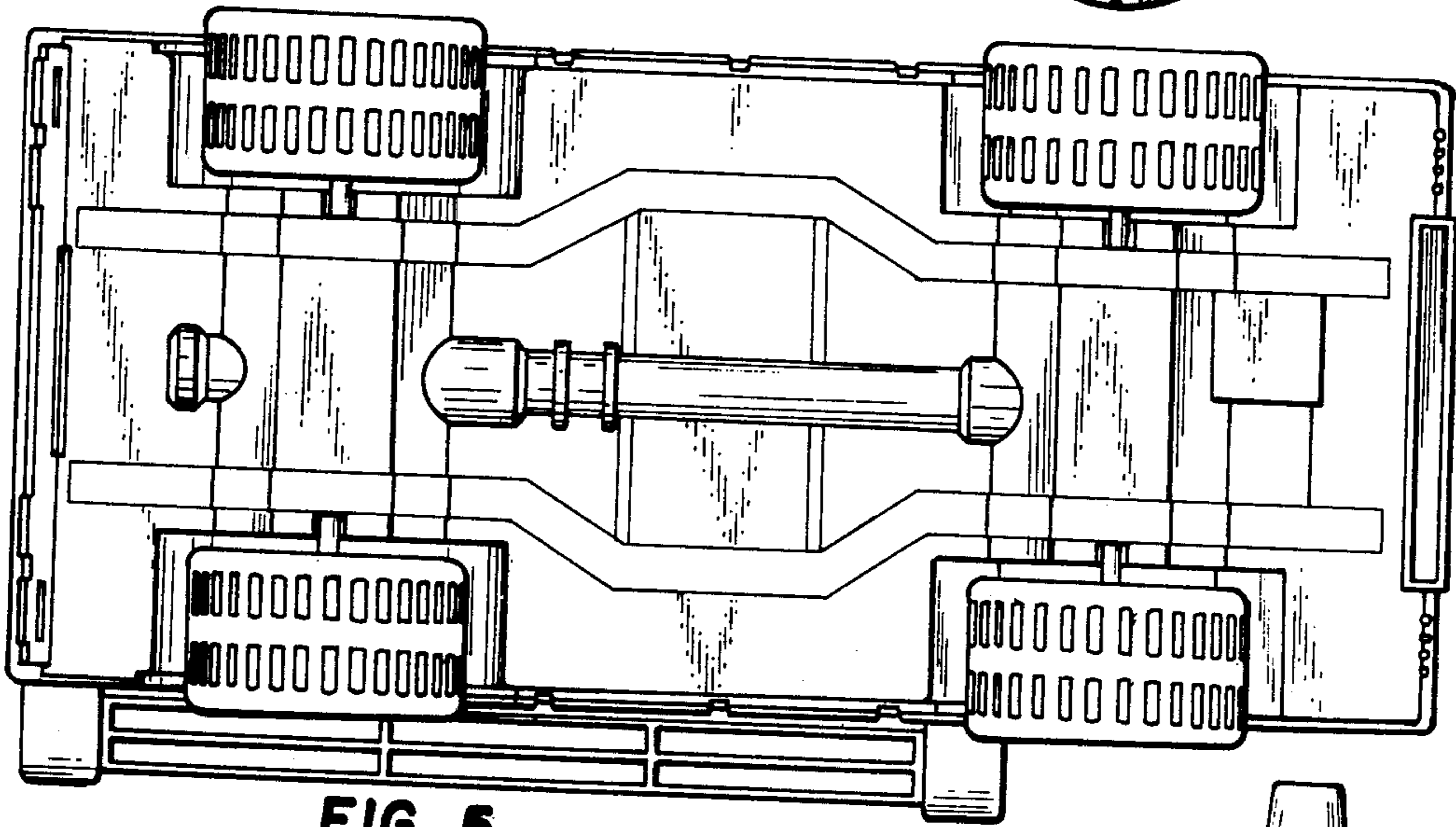

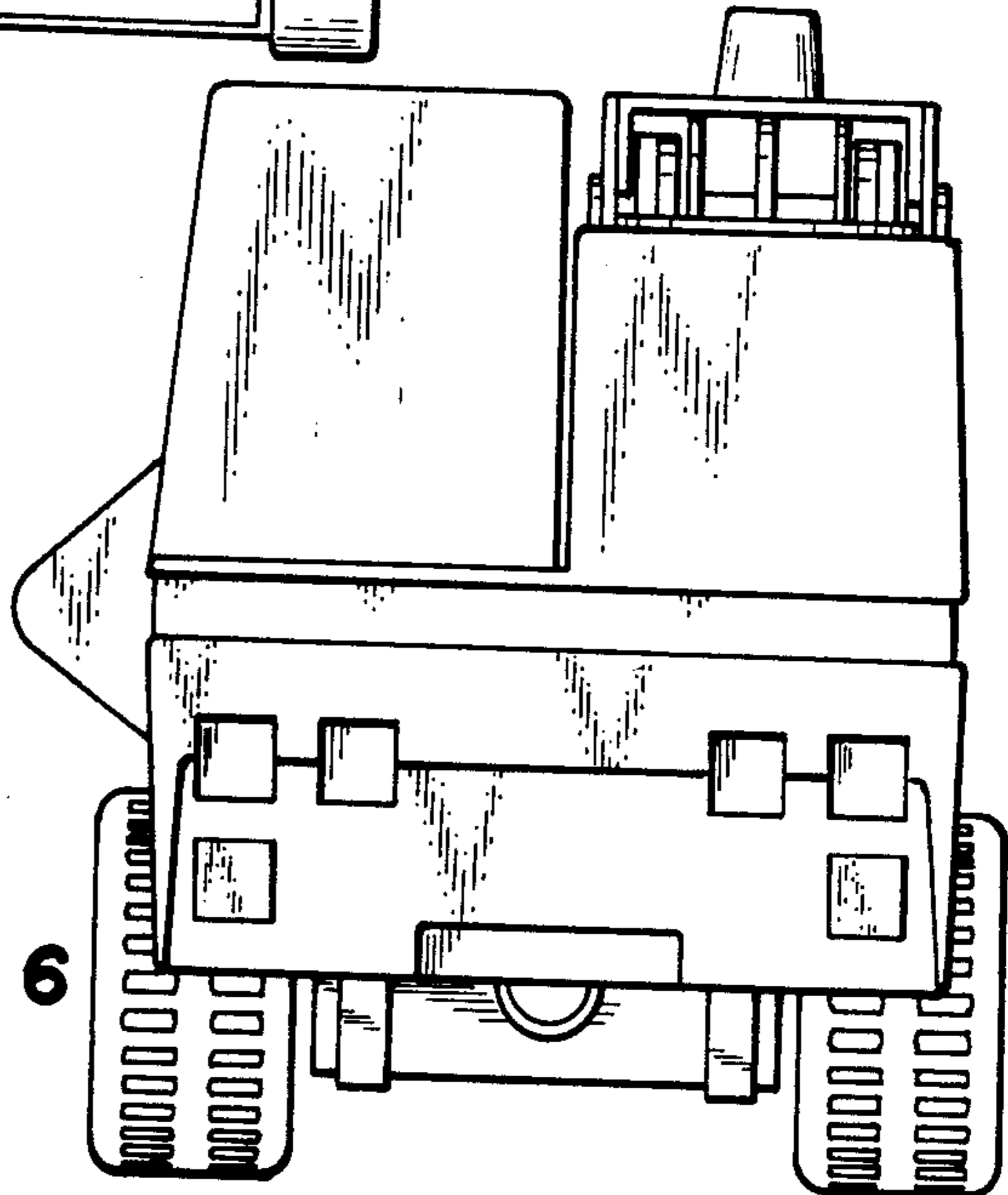
