 FIG. 2 is a side perspective view of the sofa of FIG. 1. The sofa back is plain and conventional.

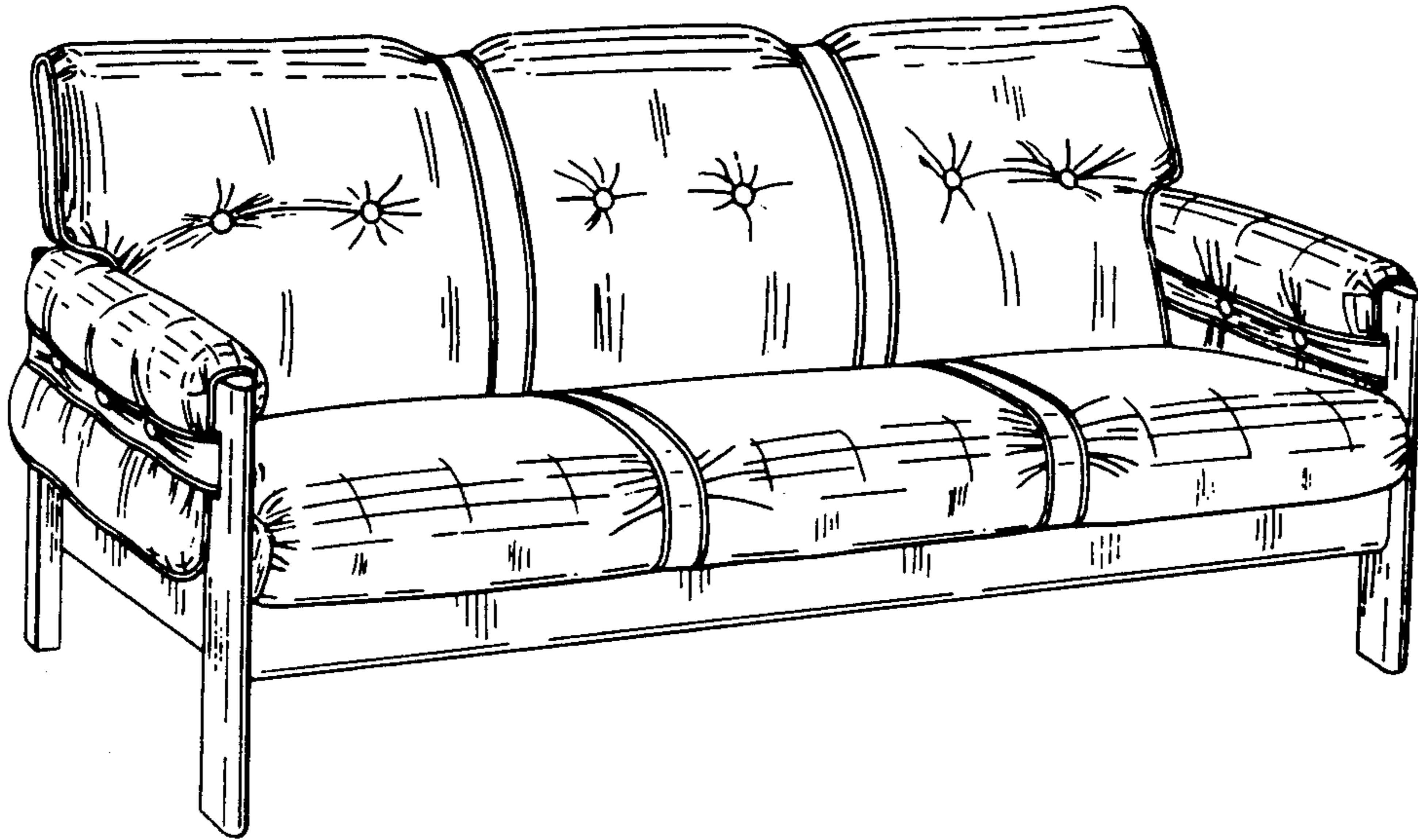

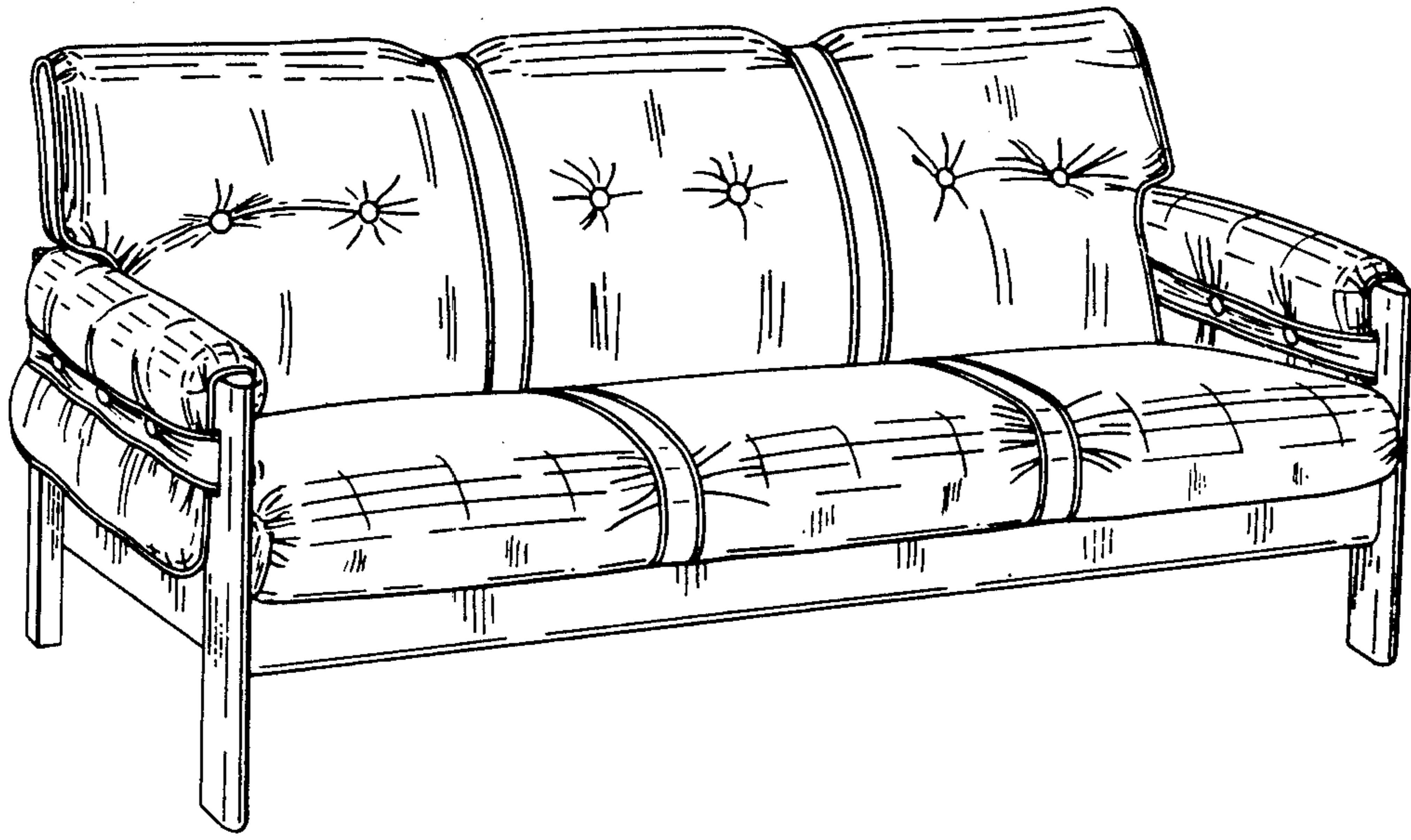
