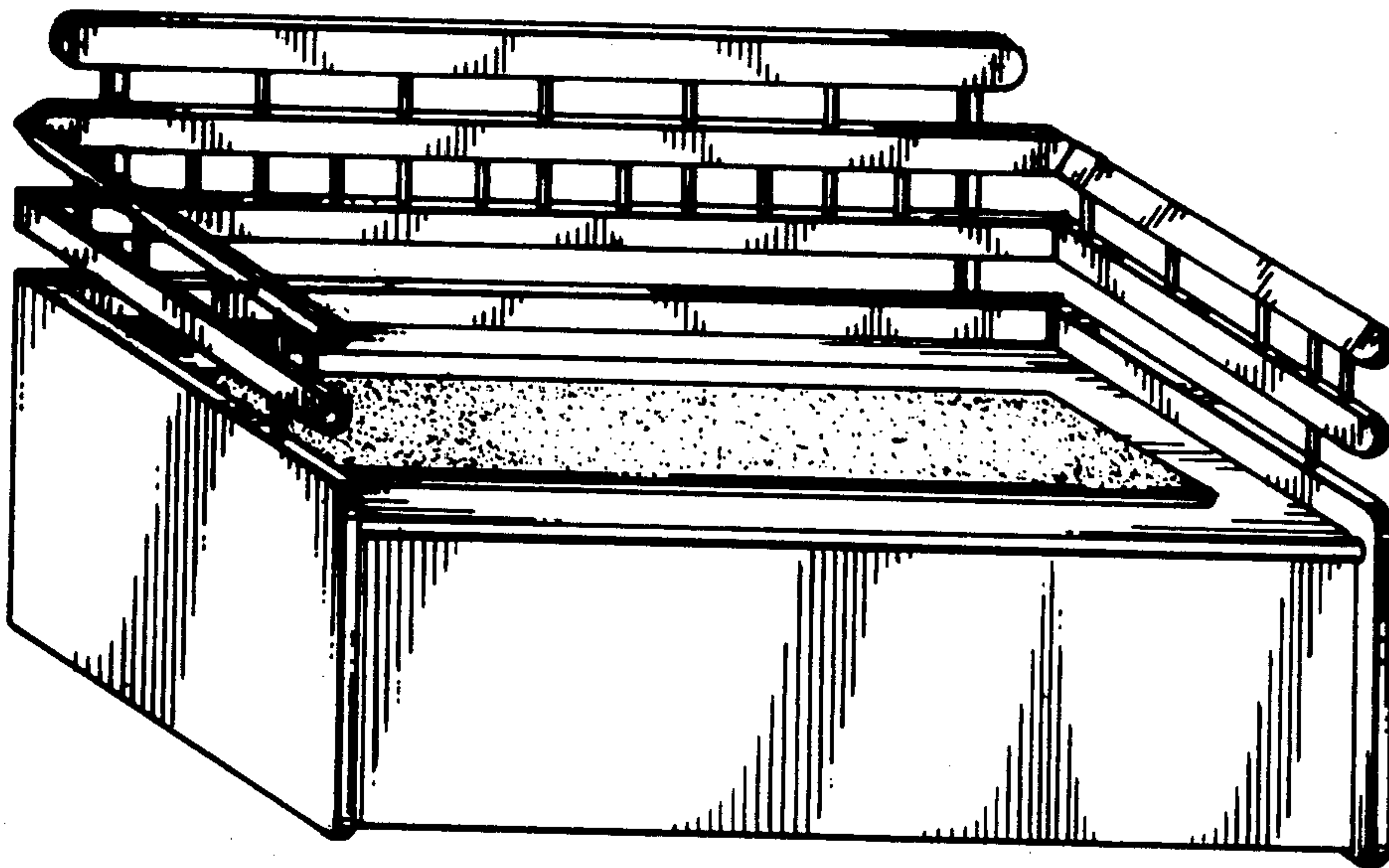

FIG. 2 is a rear view of the same.



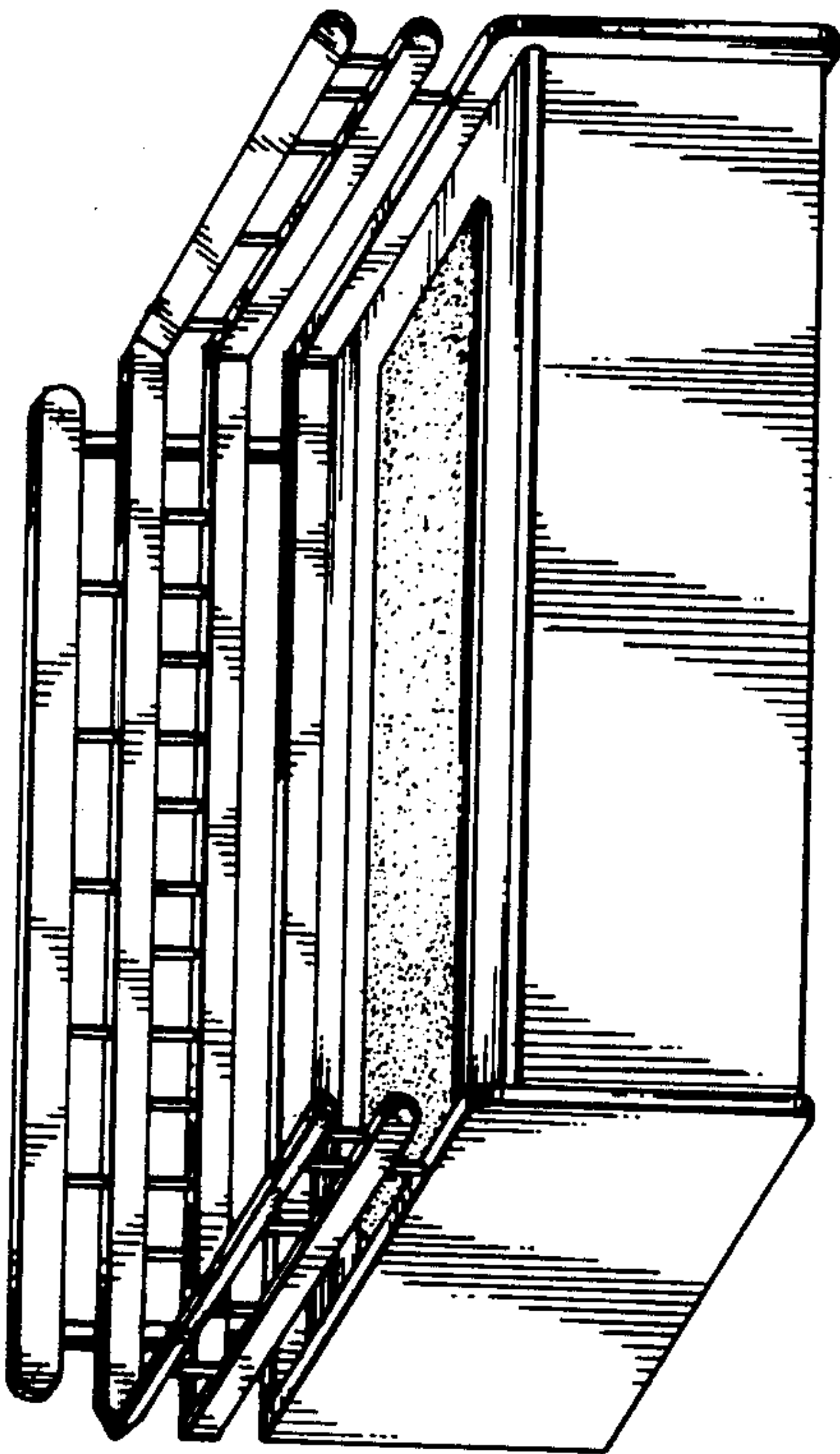

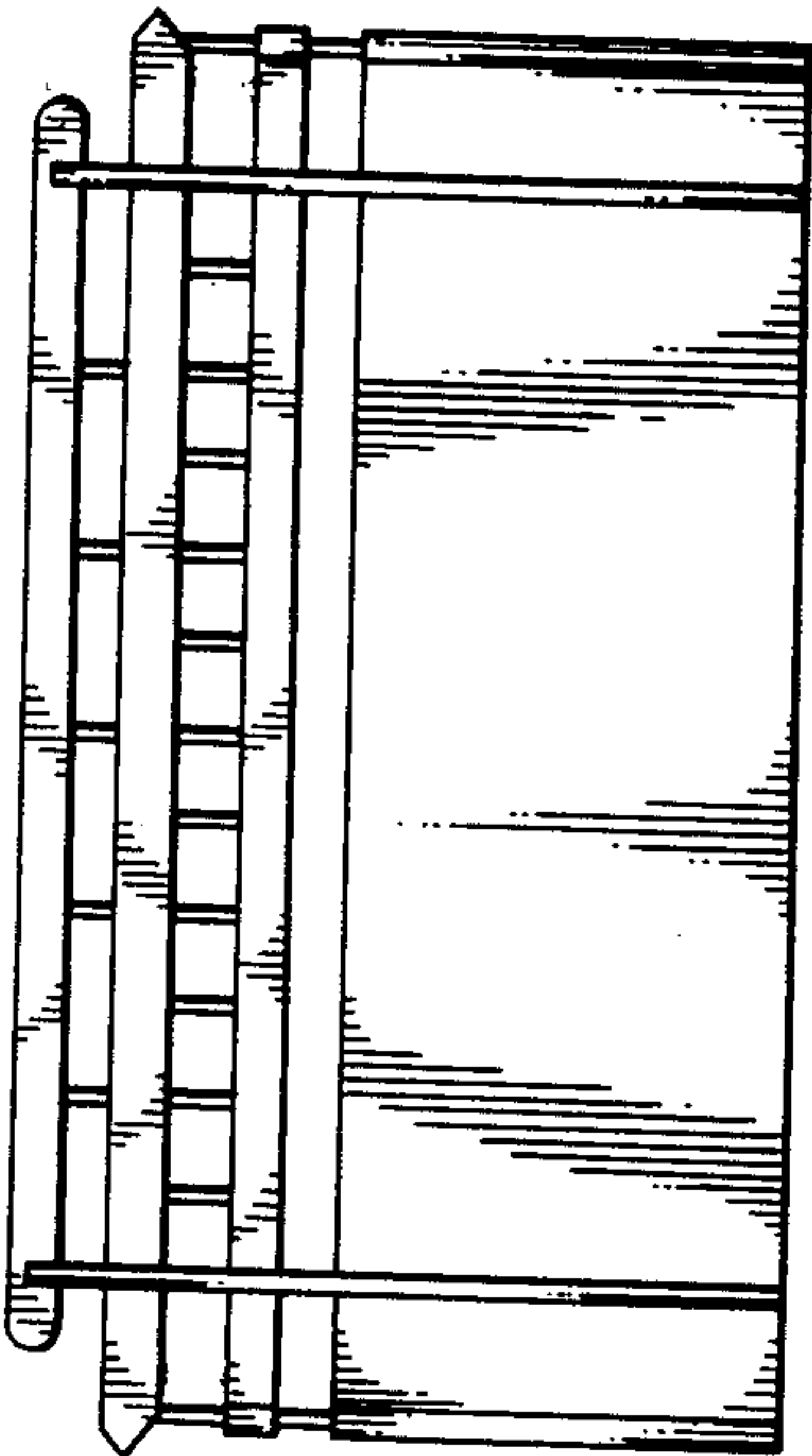
