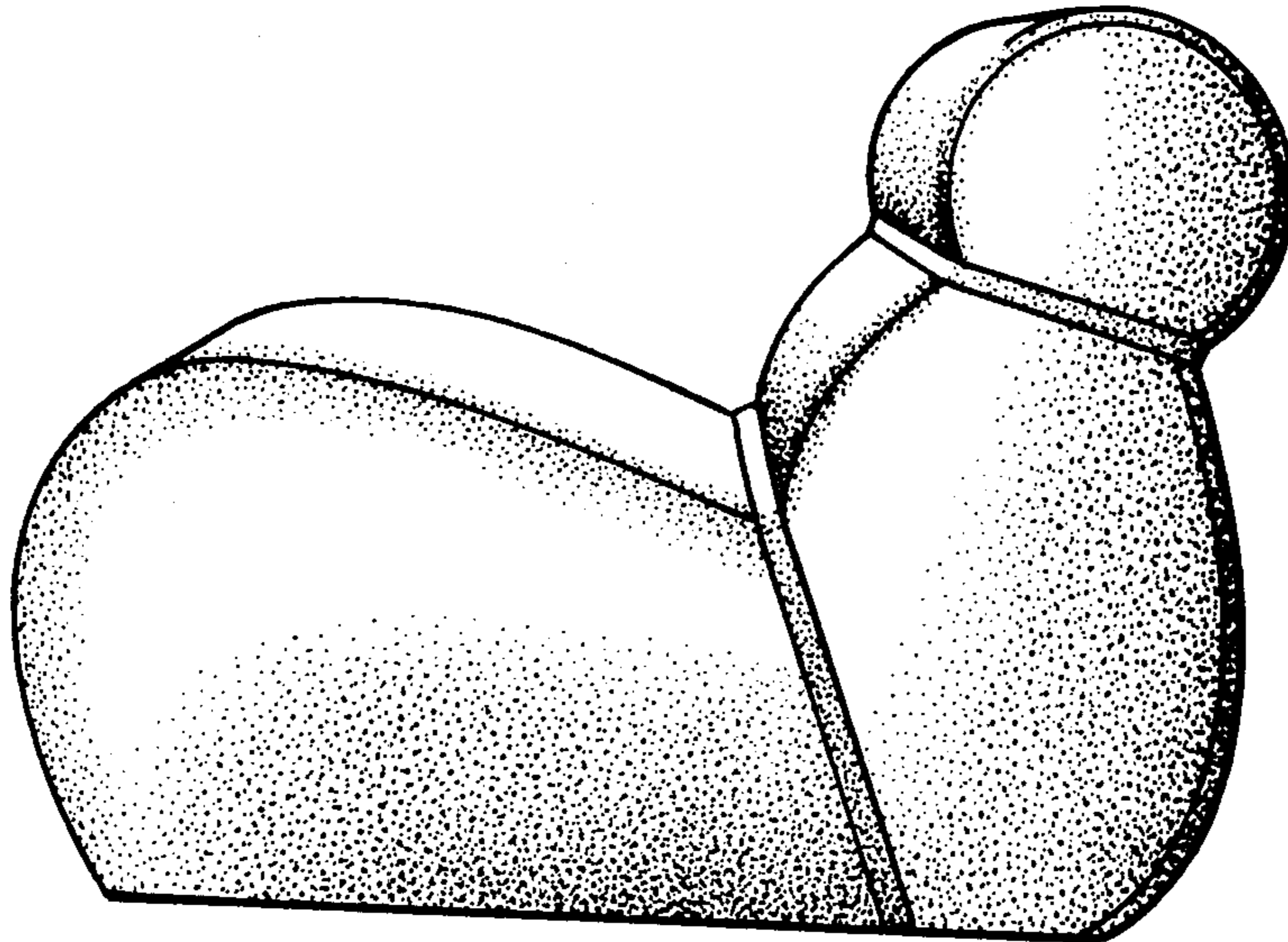
The ornamental design for a modular chair, as shown and described.

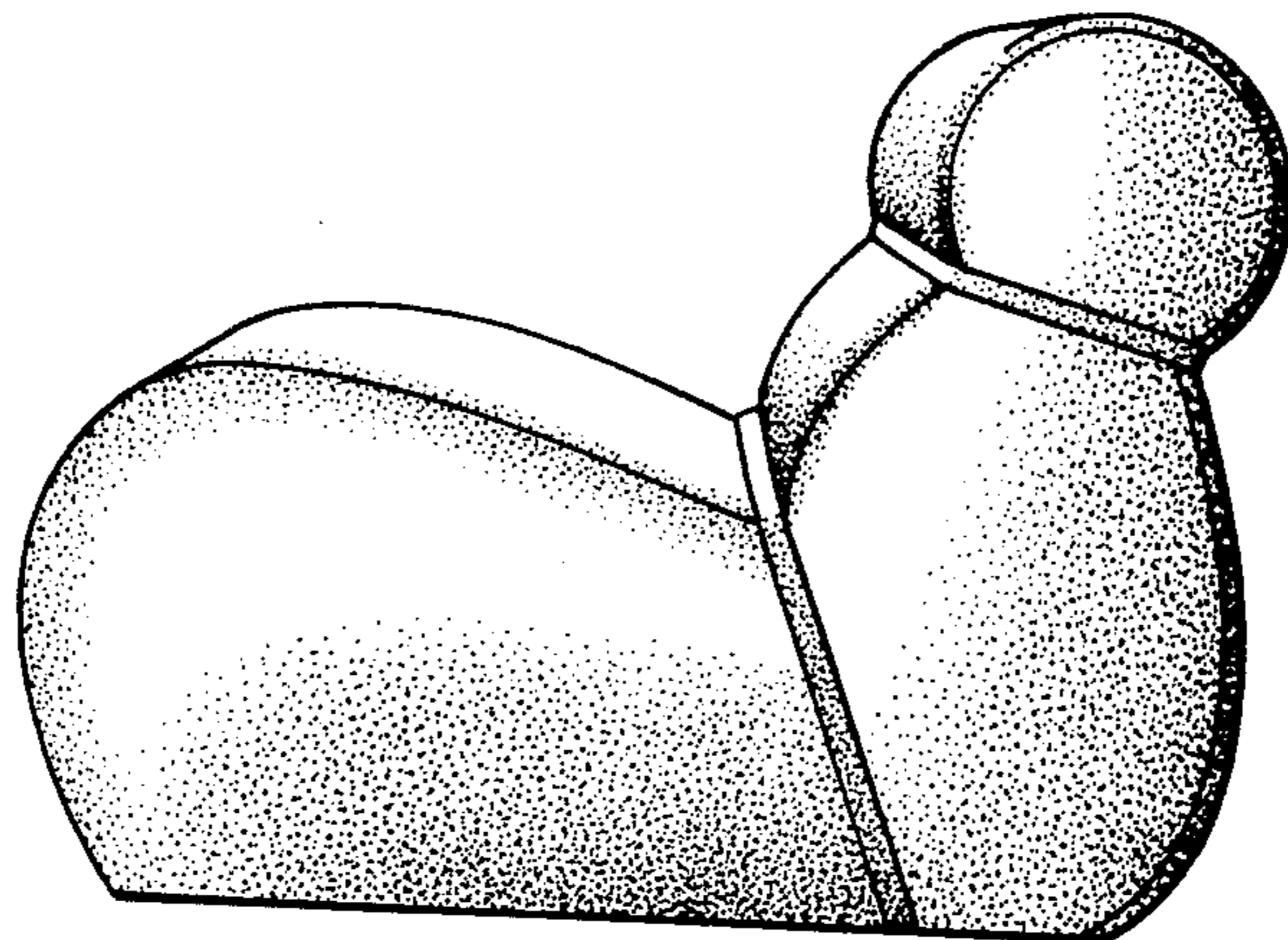
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of a modular chair showing my new design.

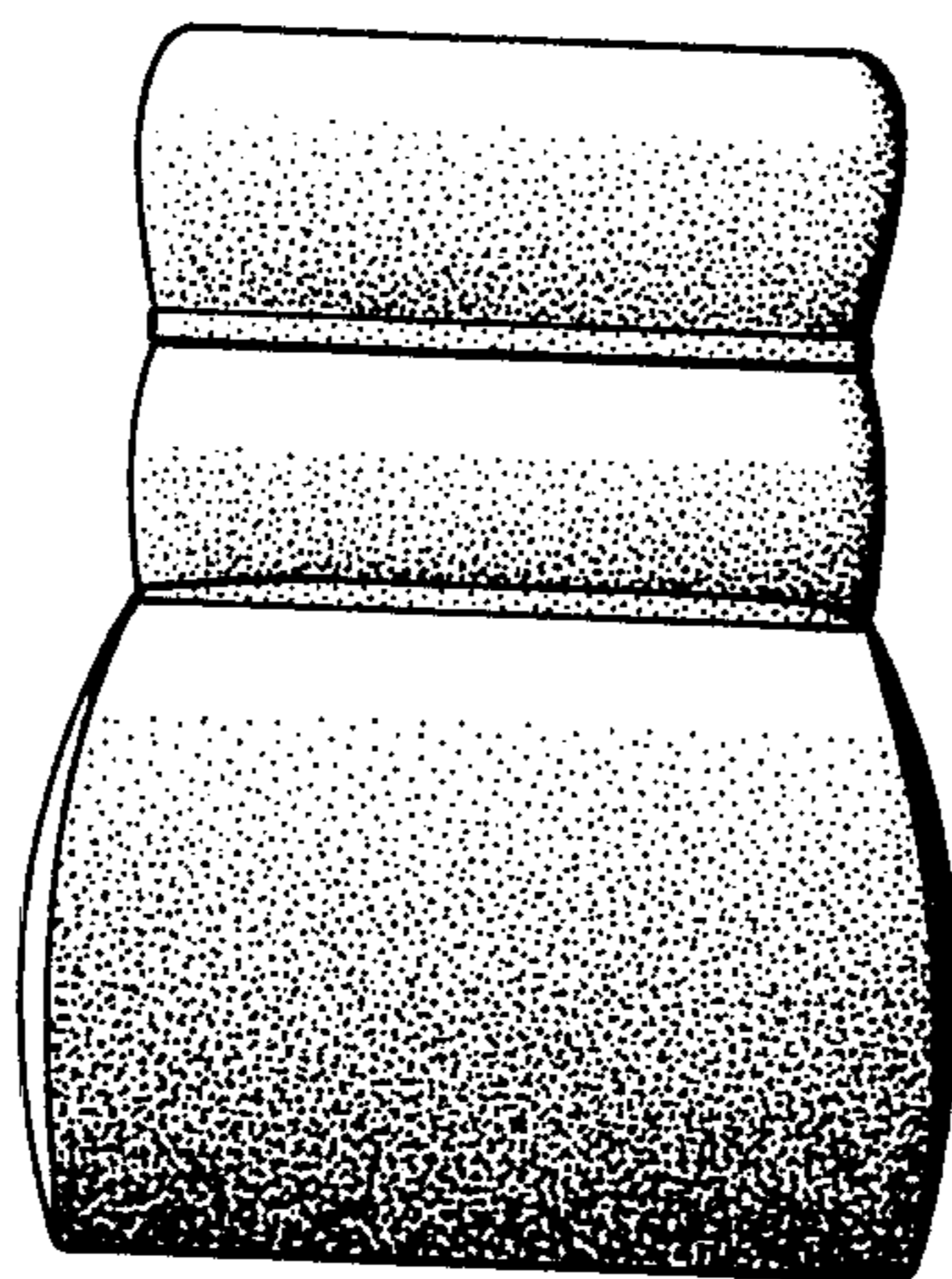
FIGS. 2 and 3 are front and rear perspective views, respectively, thereof.

Both sides are identical

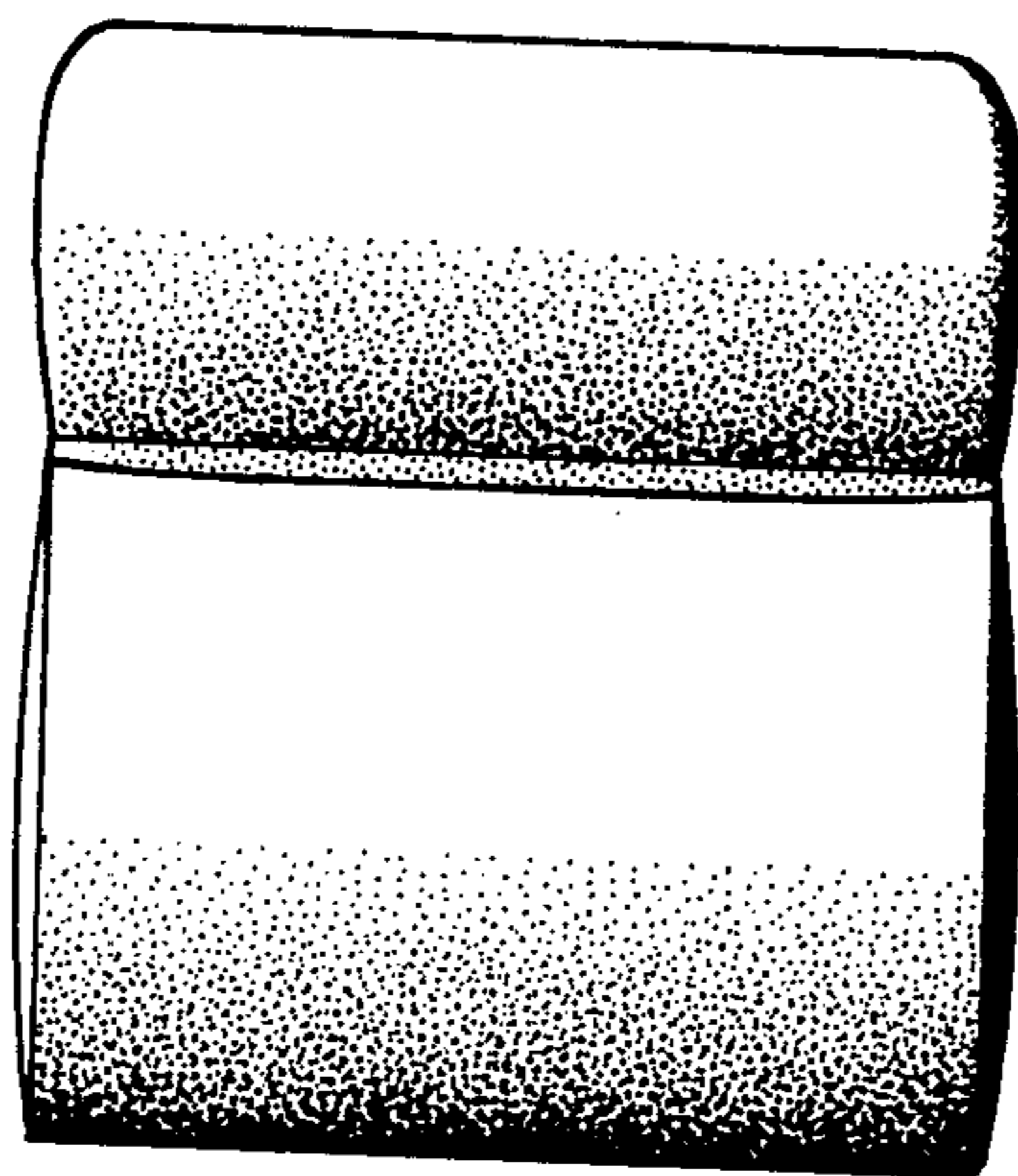
