The ornamental design for a shipping container, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a shipping container showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being the same in appearance; FIG. 4 is a top plan view; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.

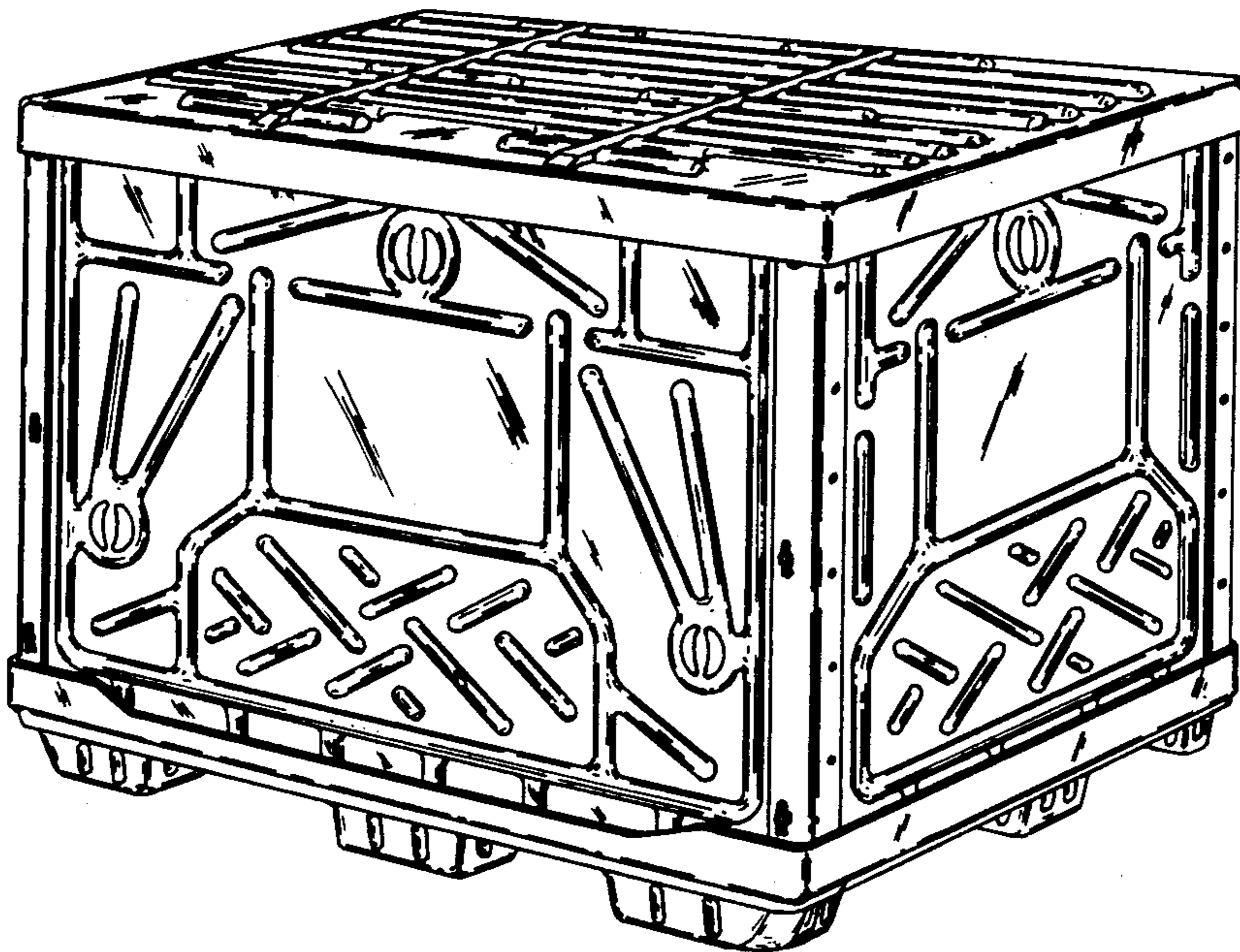

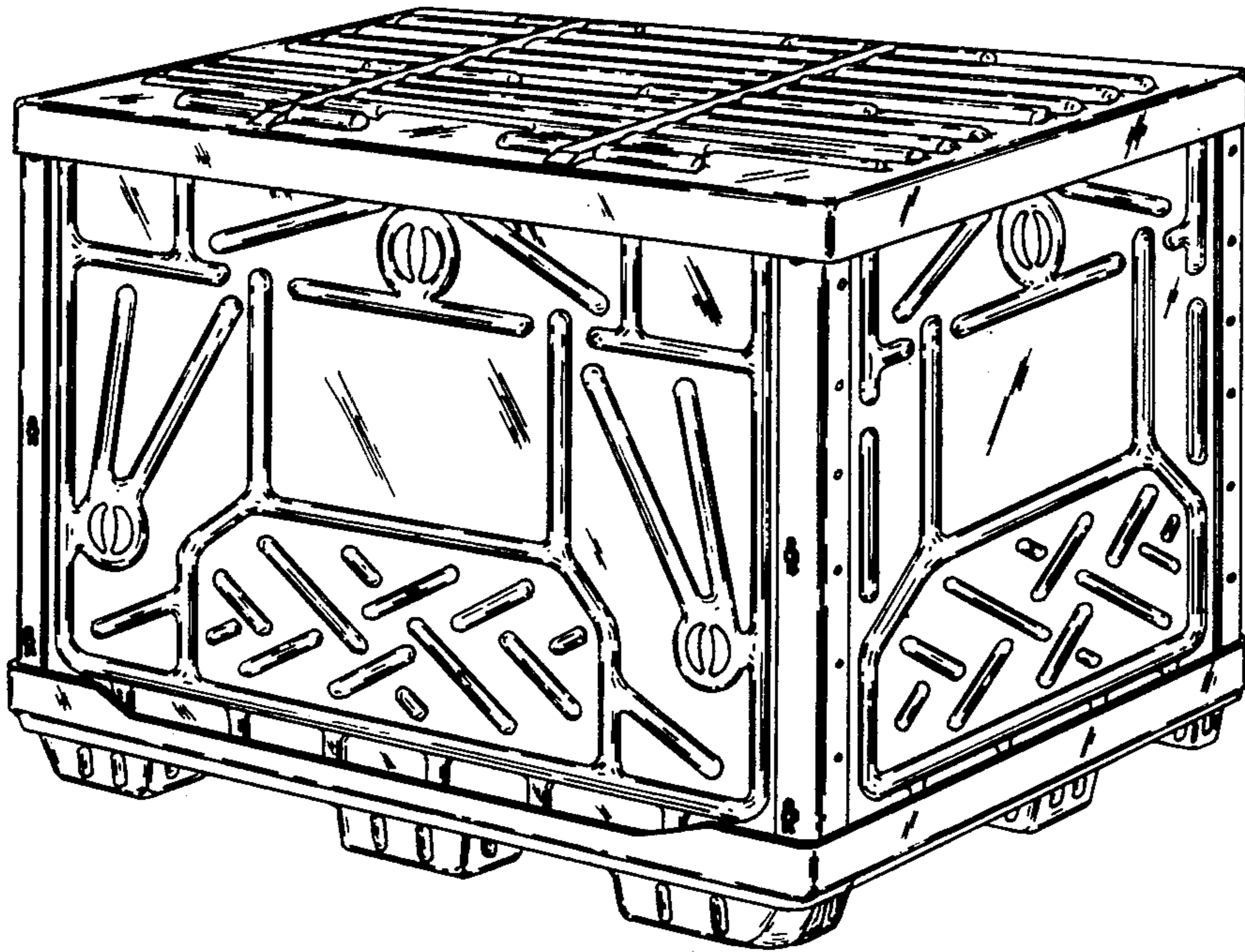

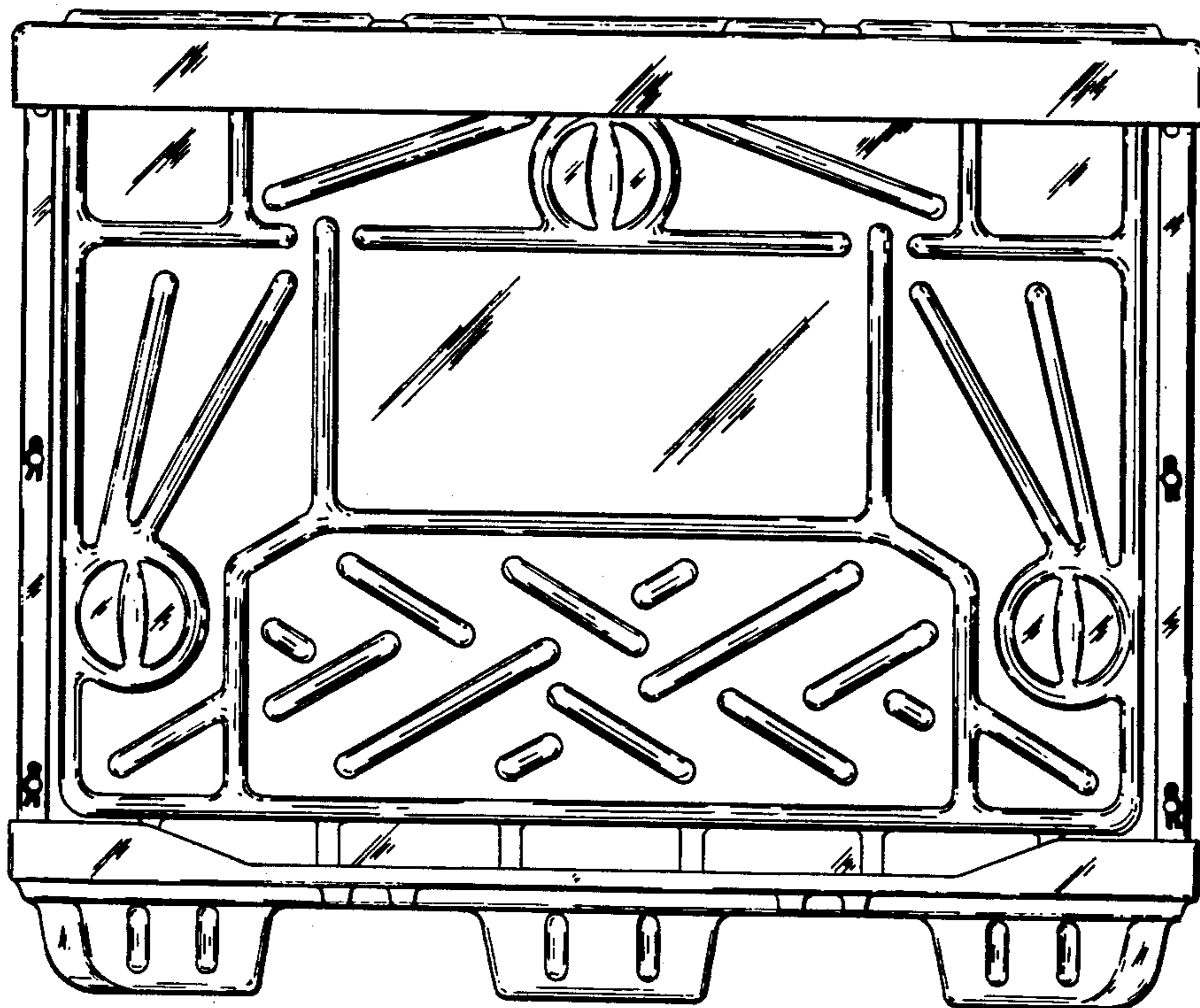

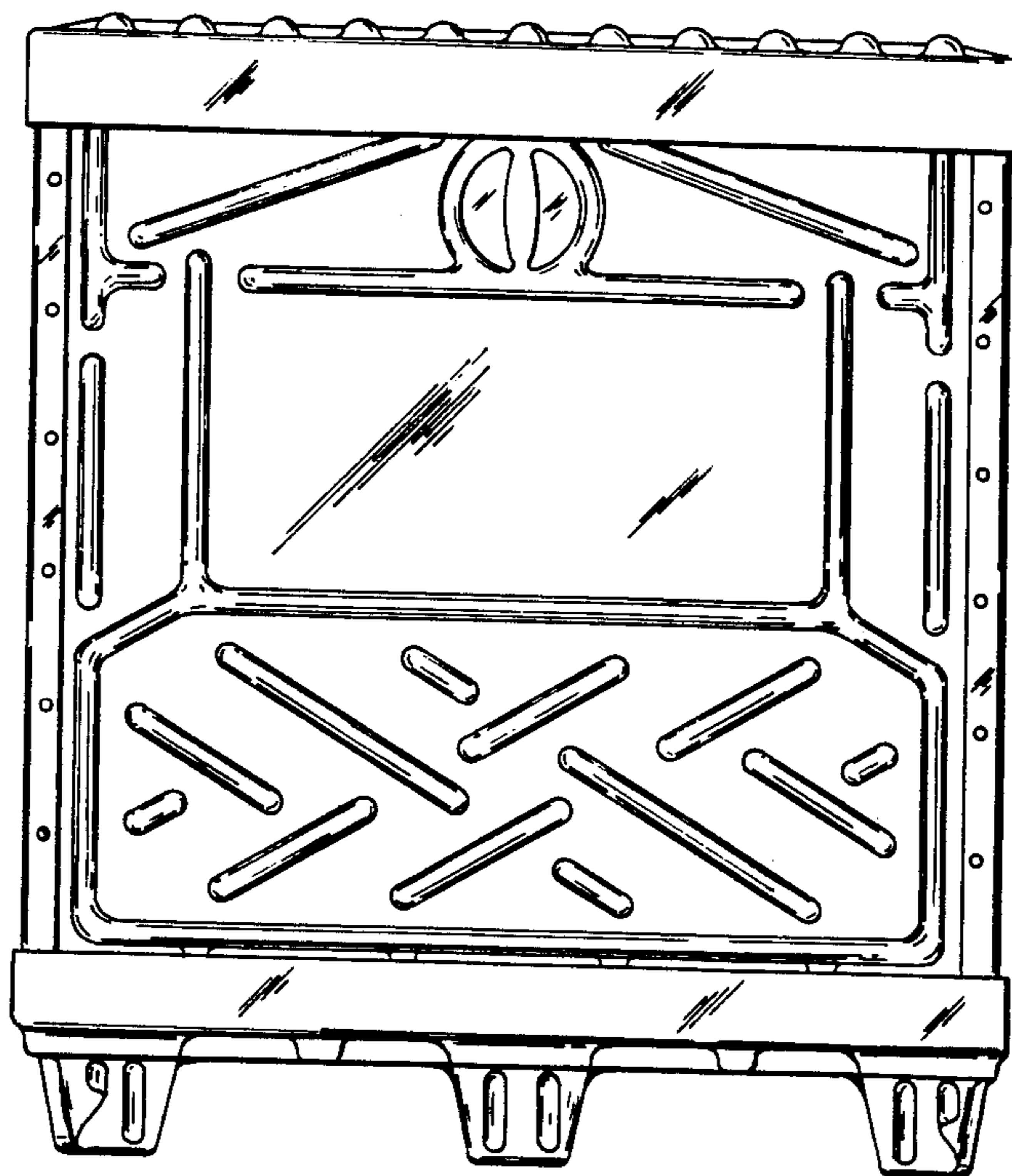

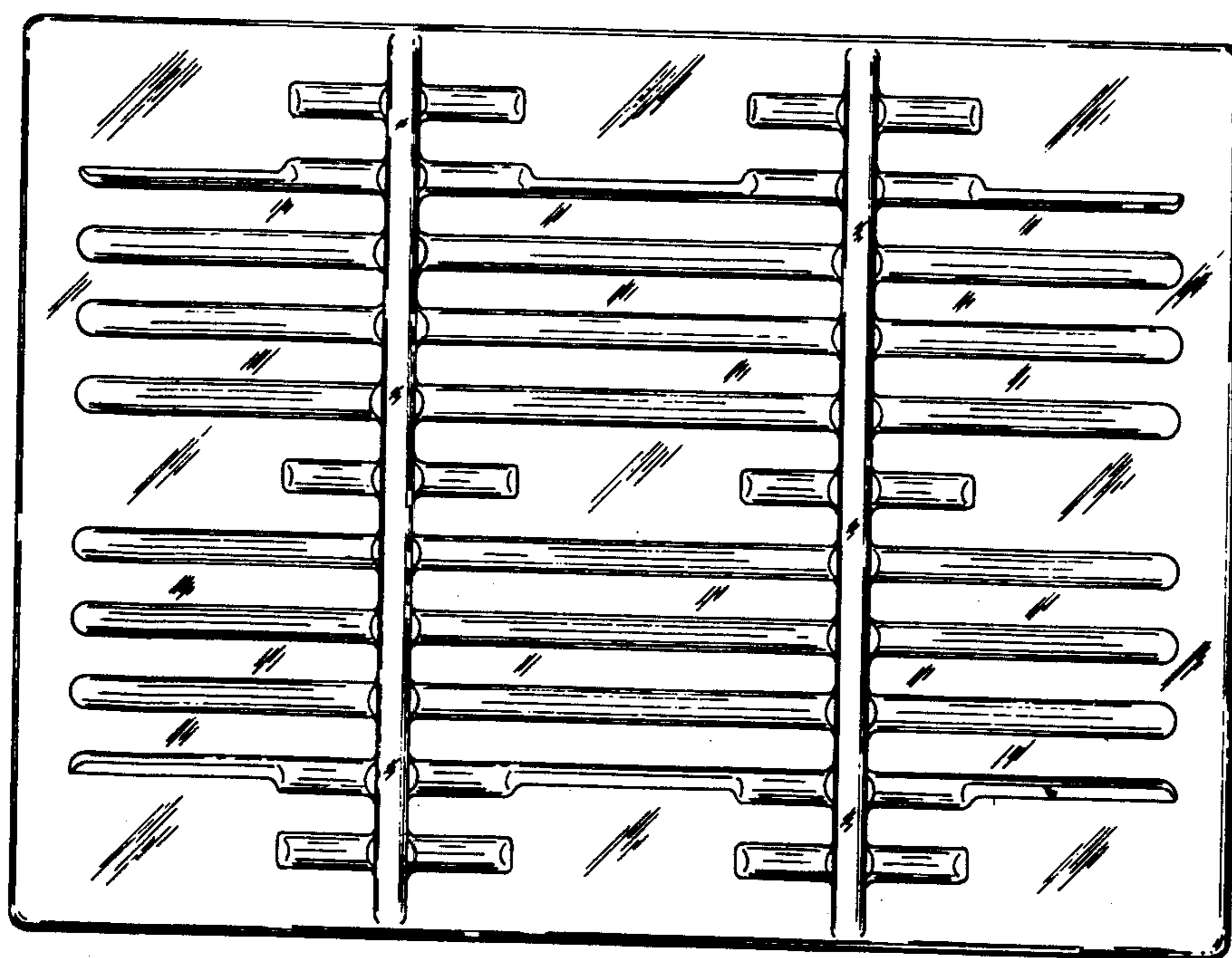

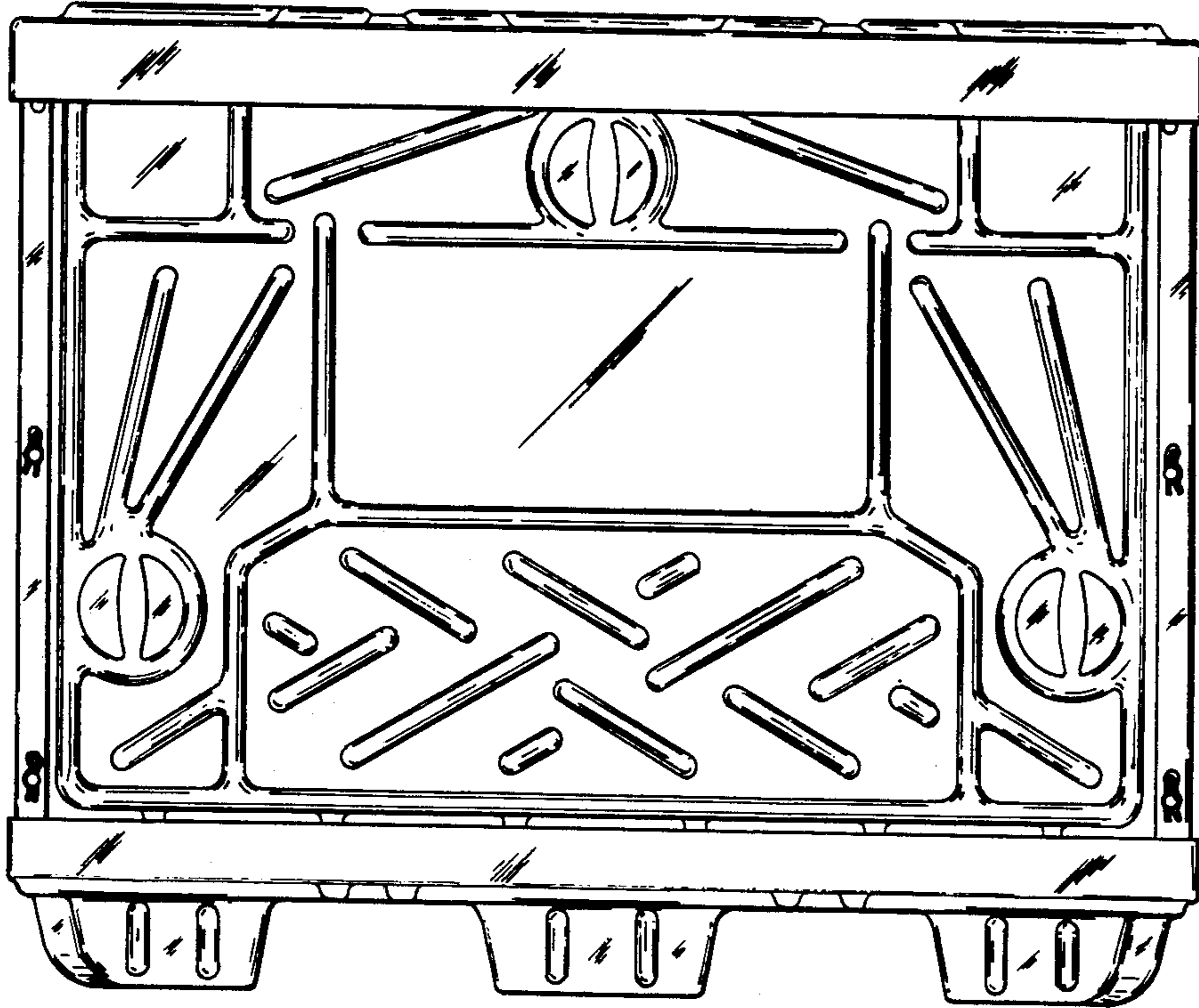
