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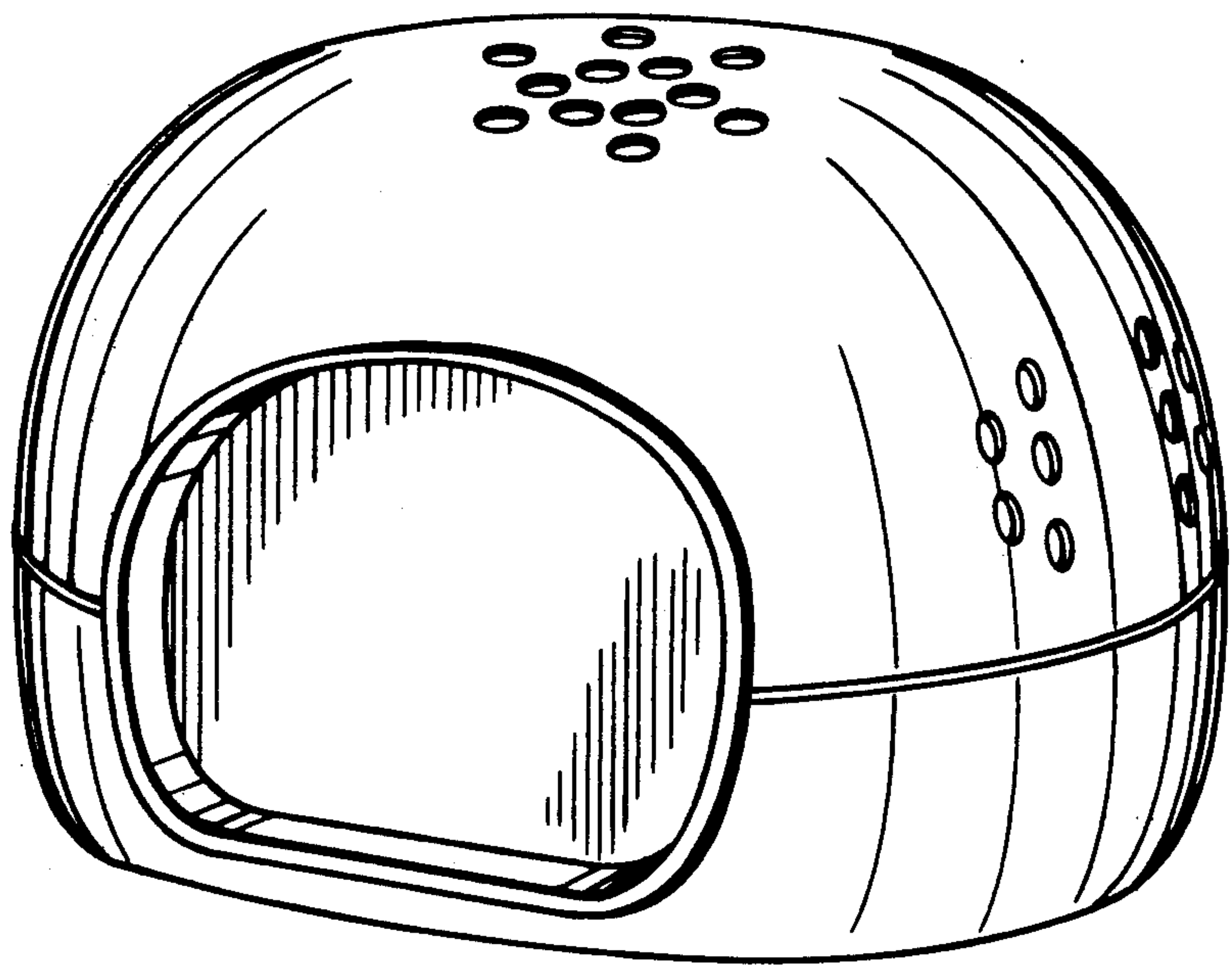
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[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pet house, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view as taken from the right side of FIG. 2, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;
FIG. 4 is a view as taken from above FIG. 3; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



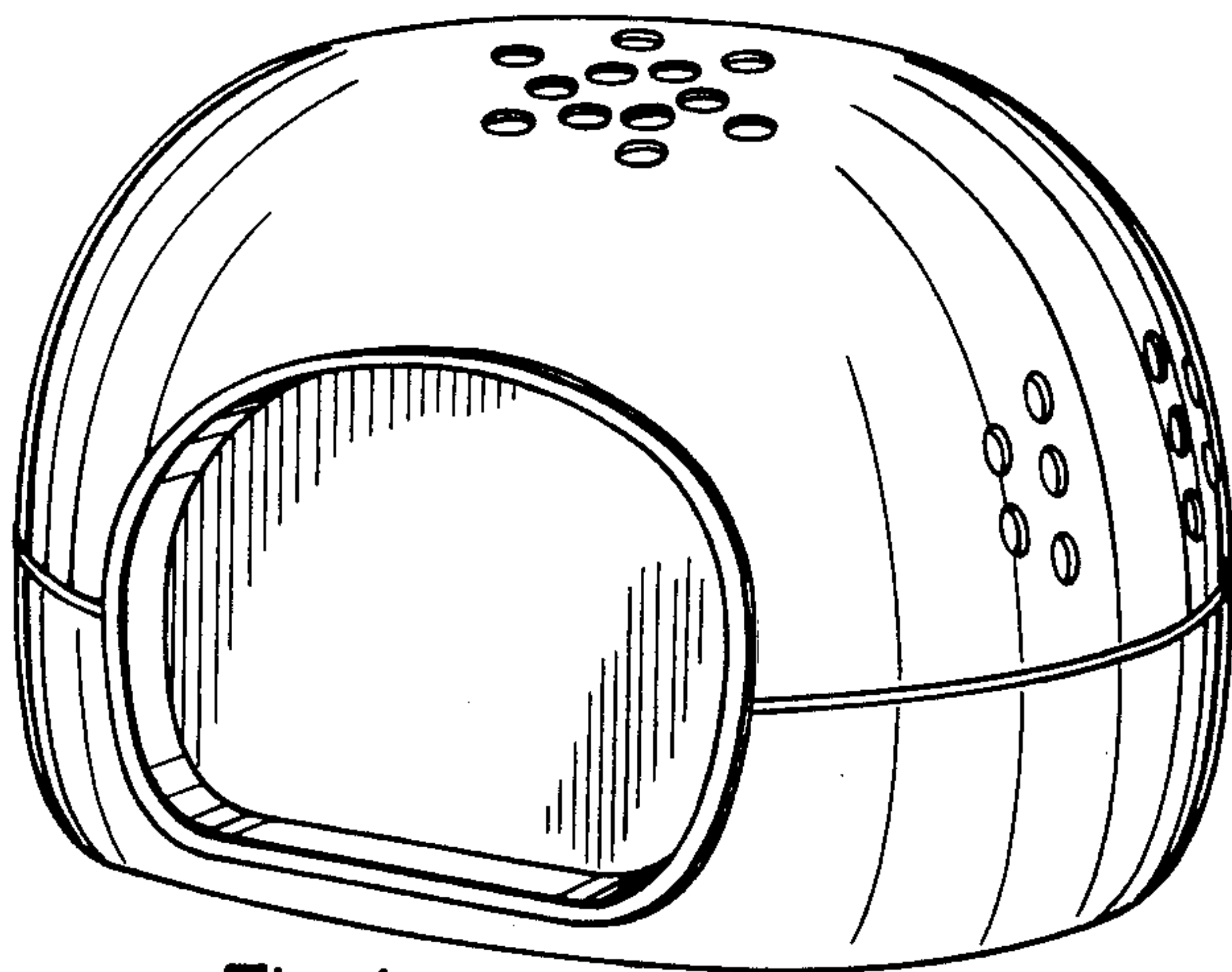

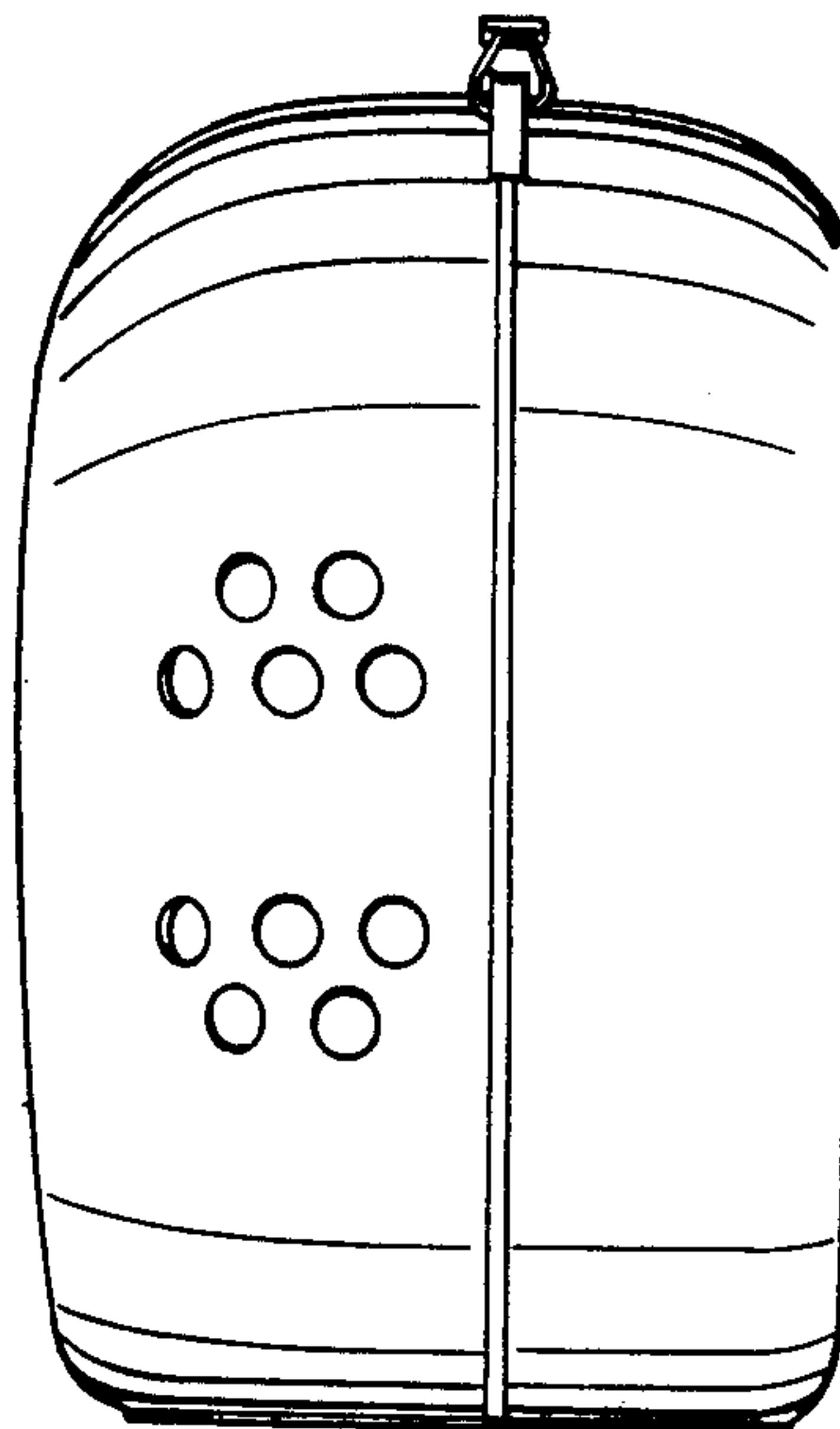

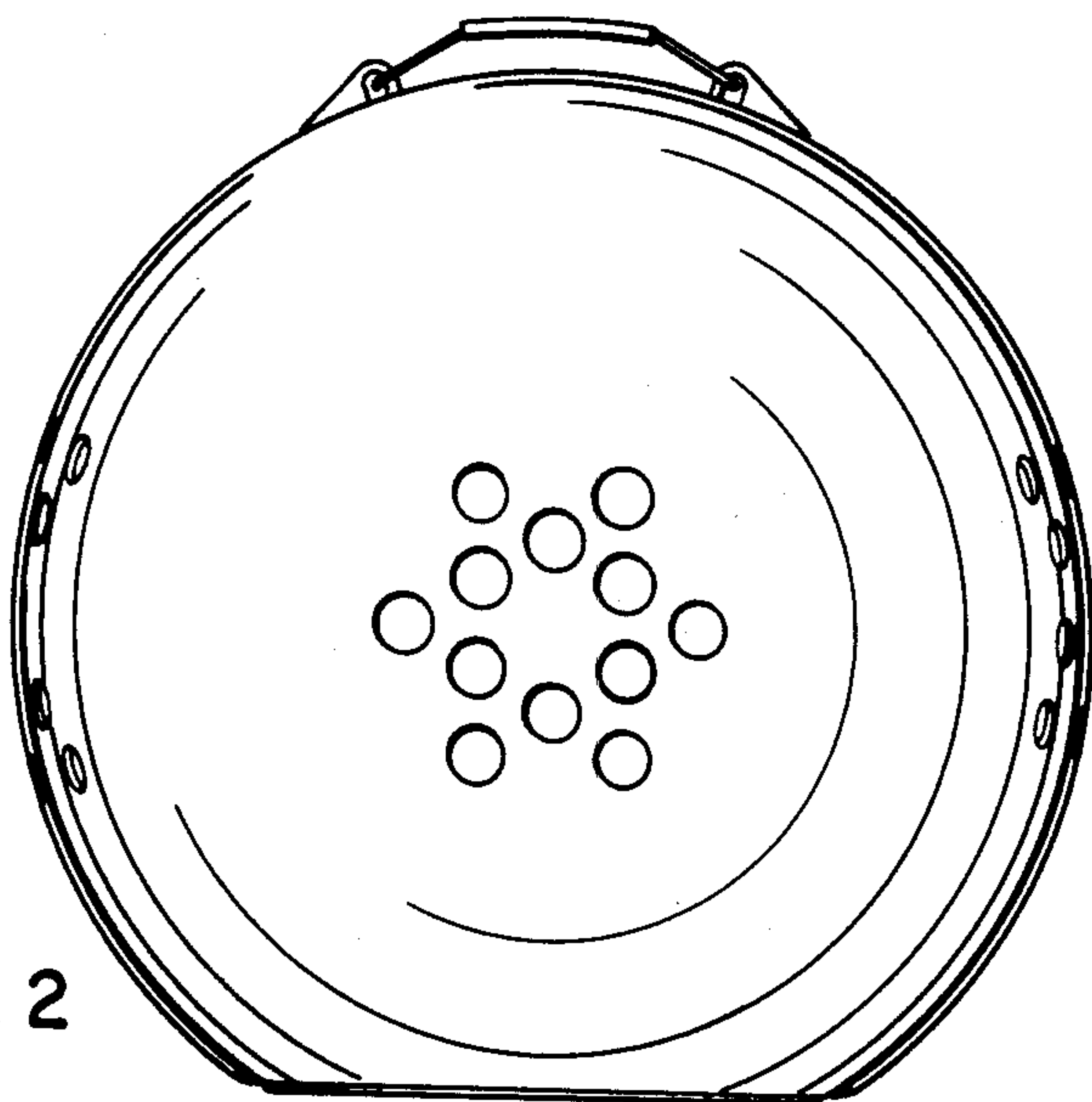

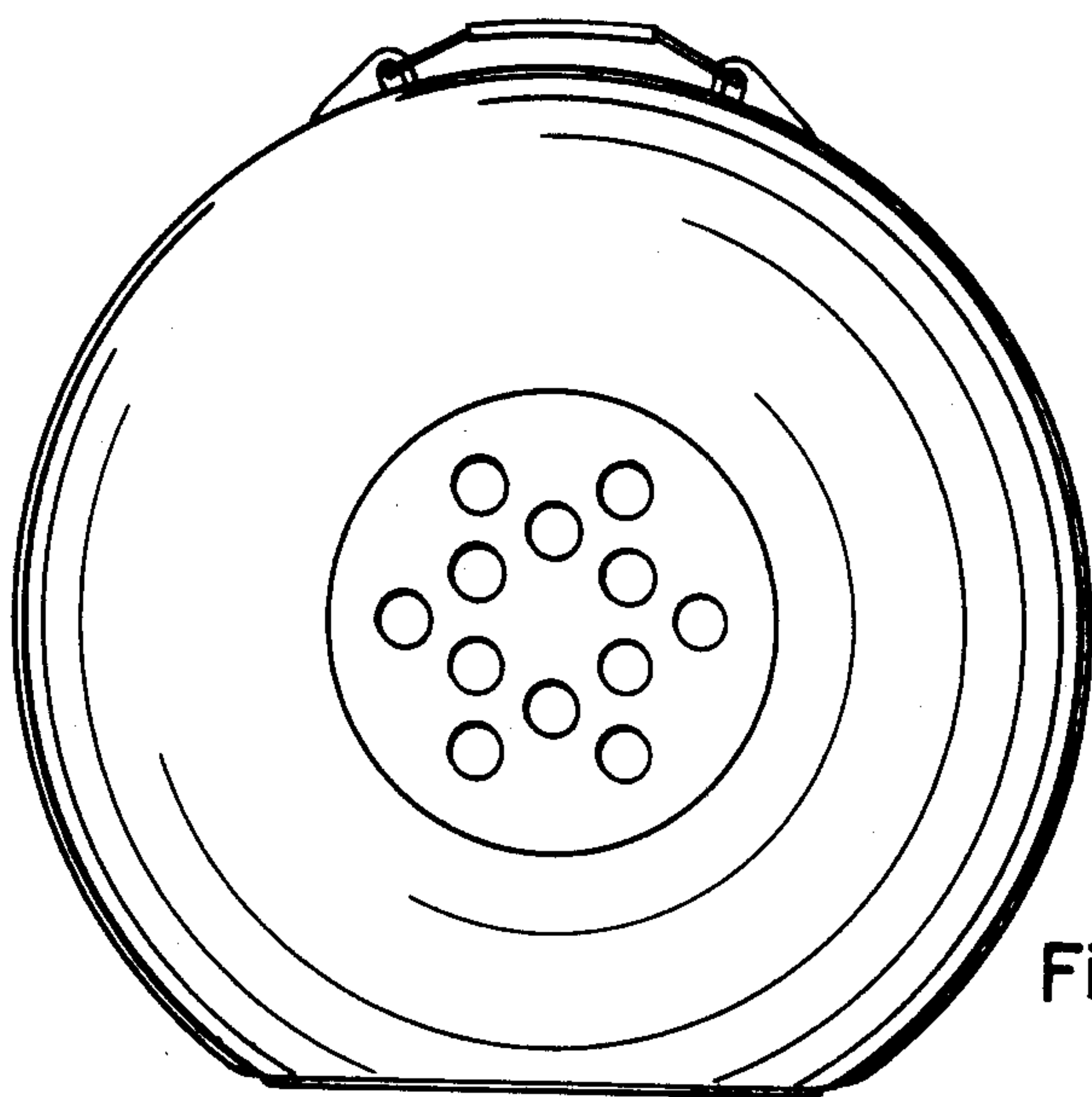

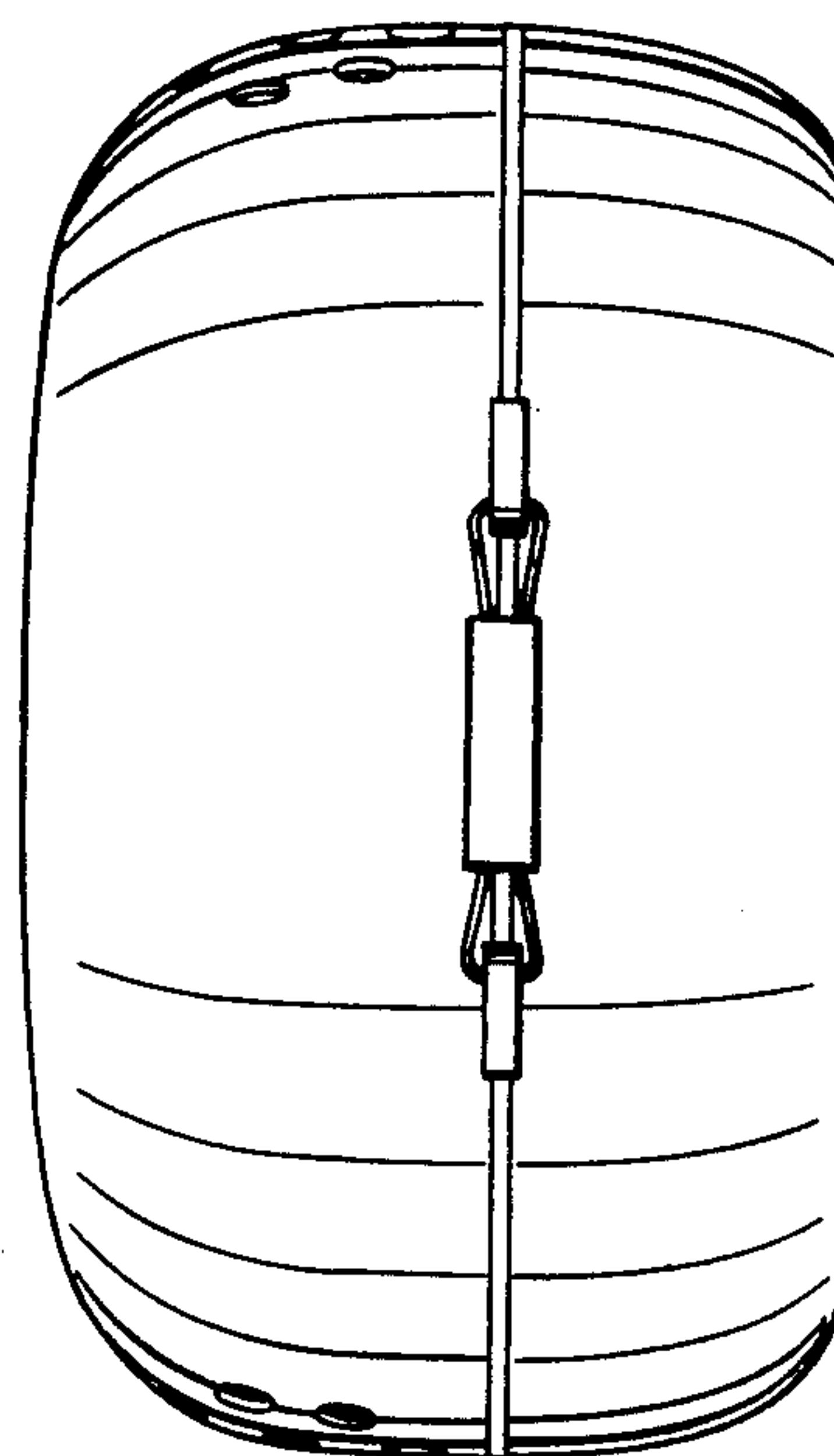
