[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a spoon or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a spoon showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof on a reduced scale;

FIG. 3 is a side view thereof on a reduced scale, the undisclosed side being substantially identical with the side shown in FIG. 3;

FIG. 4 is an cross-section taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 5 is a cross-section taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 1.
