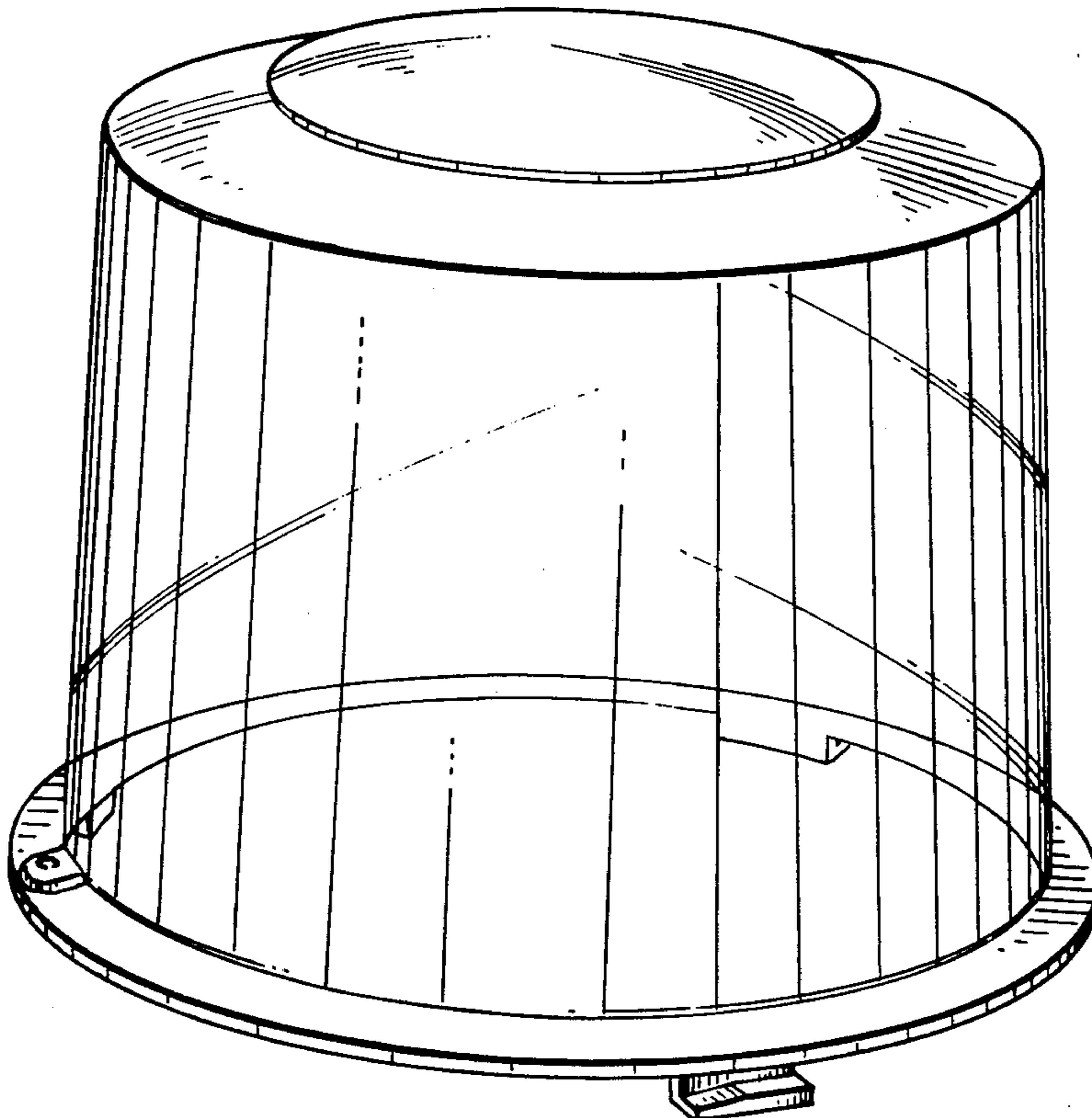
The ornamental design for a lens for a revolving lamp, as shown.

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the same.



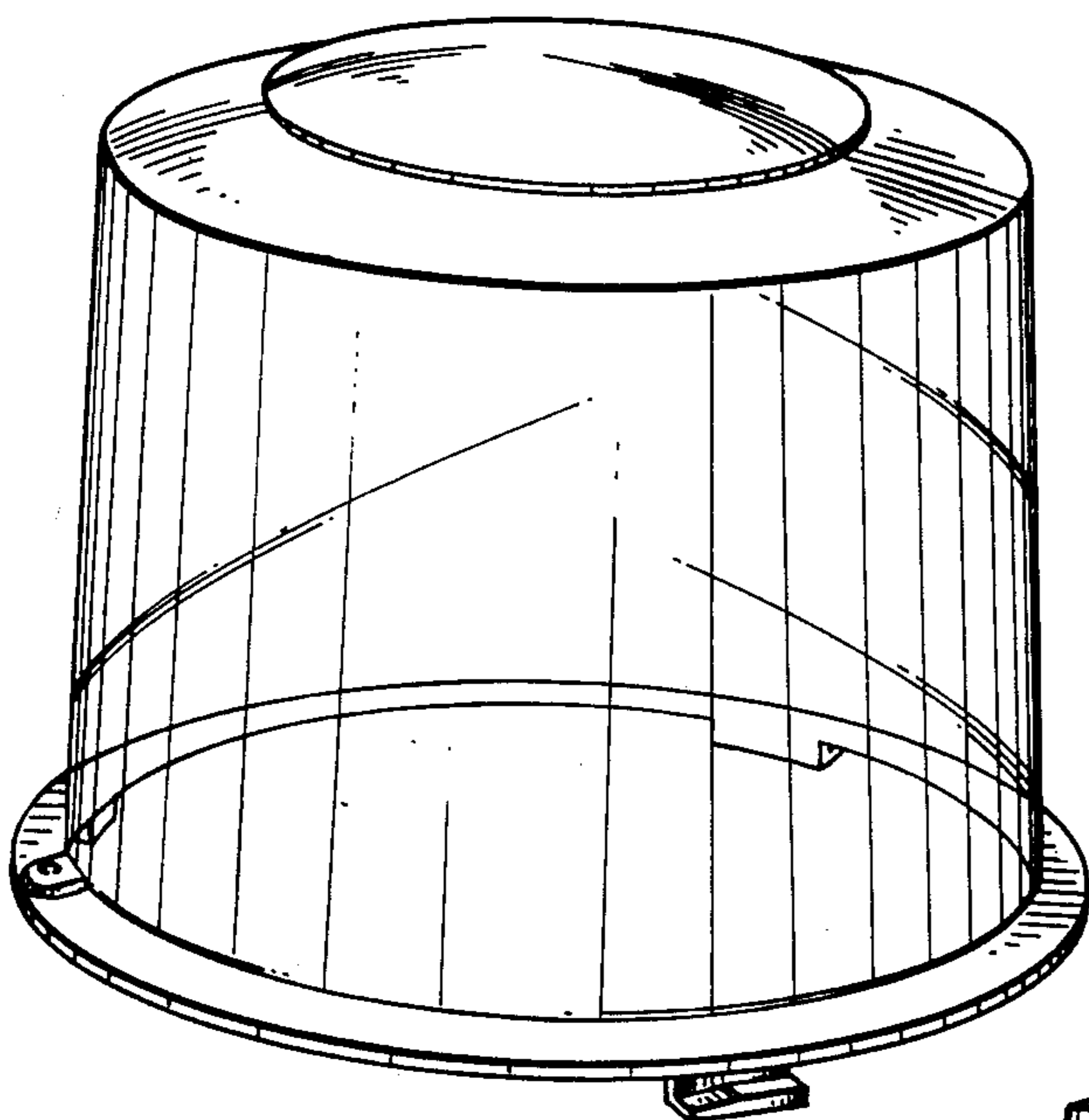

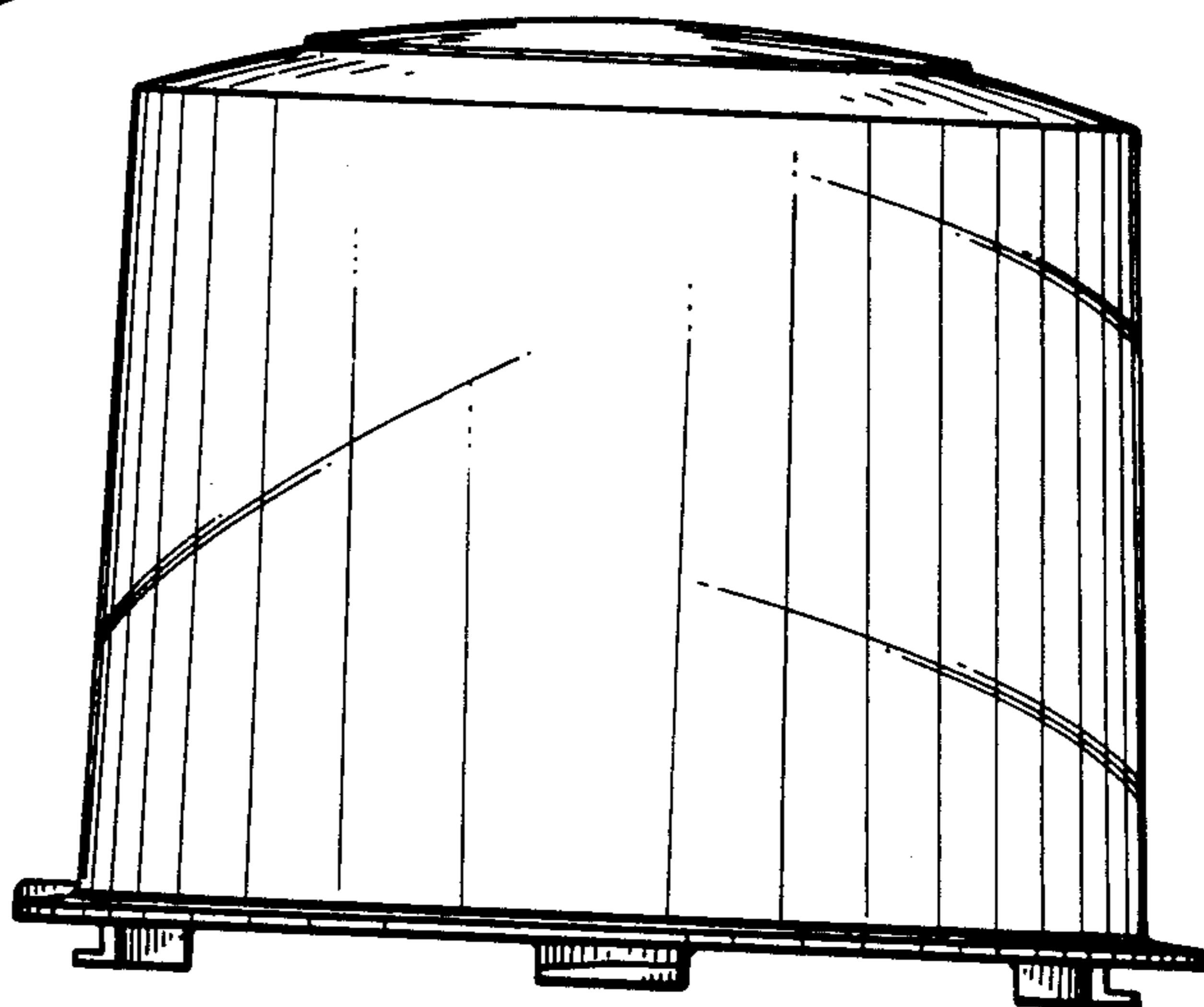

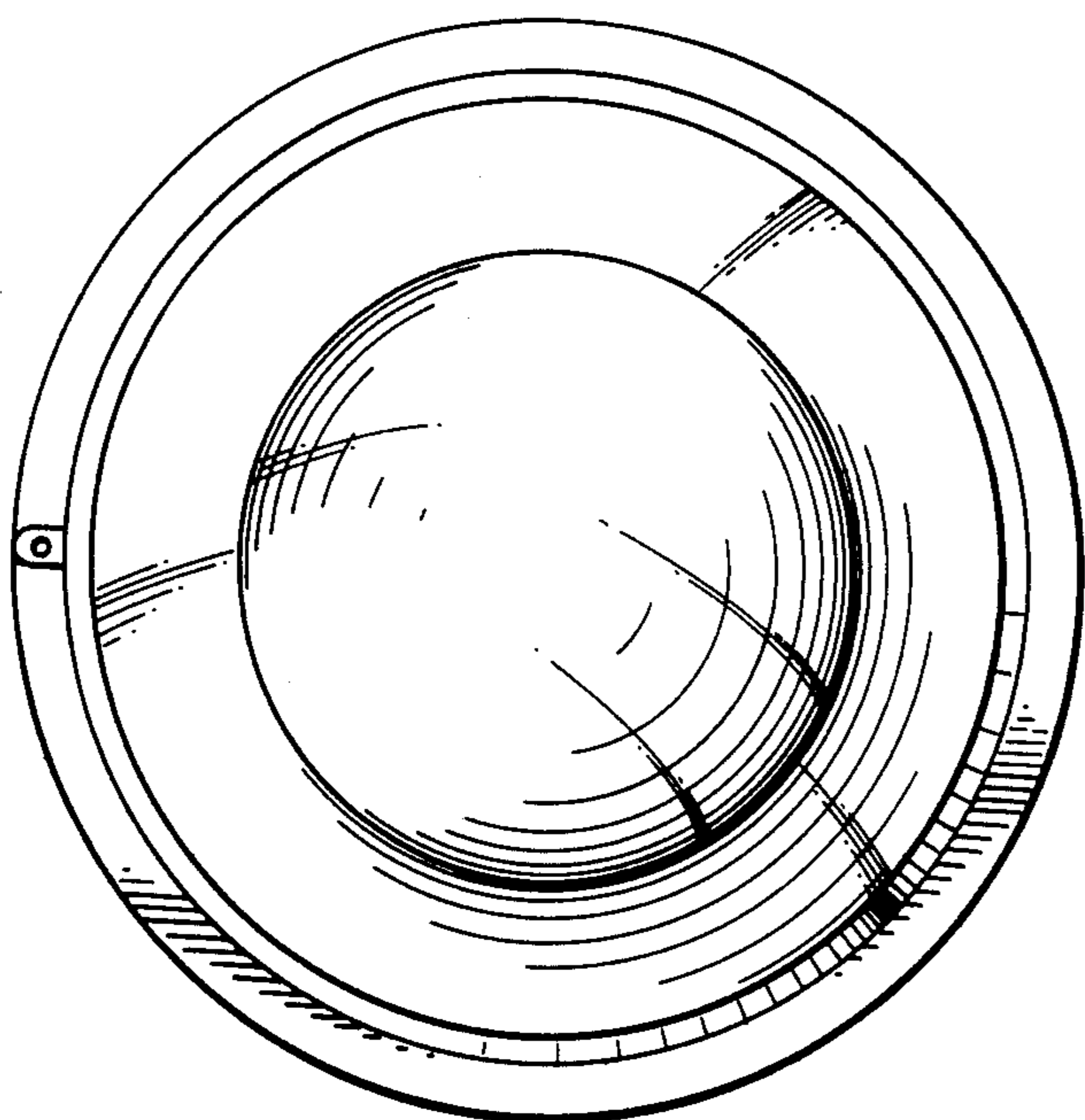
