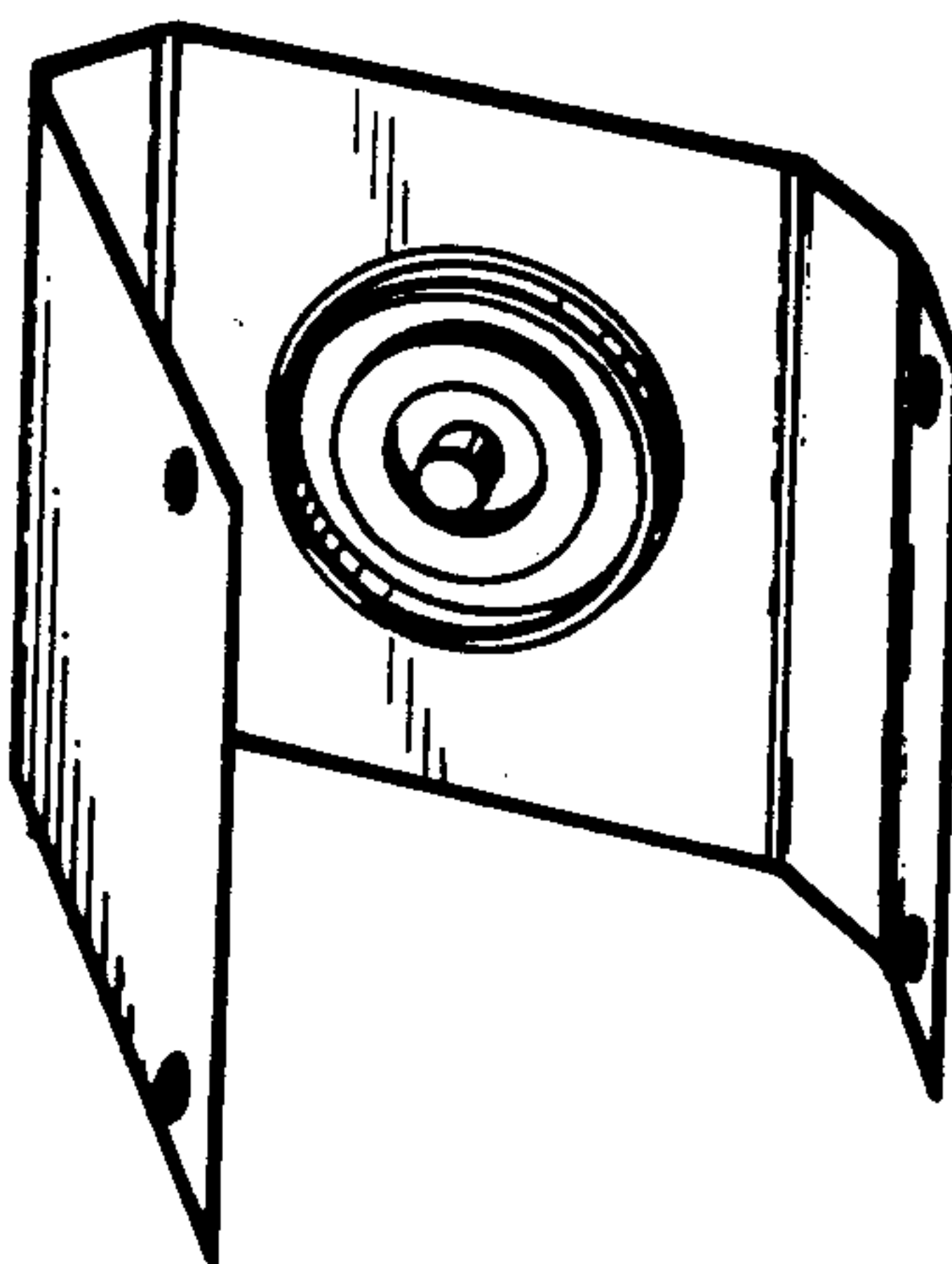
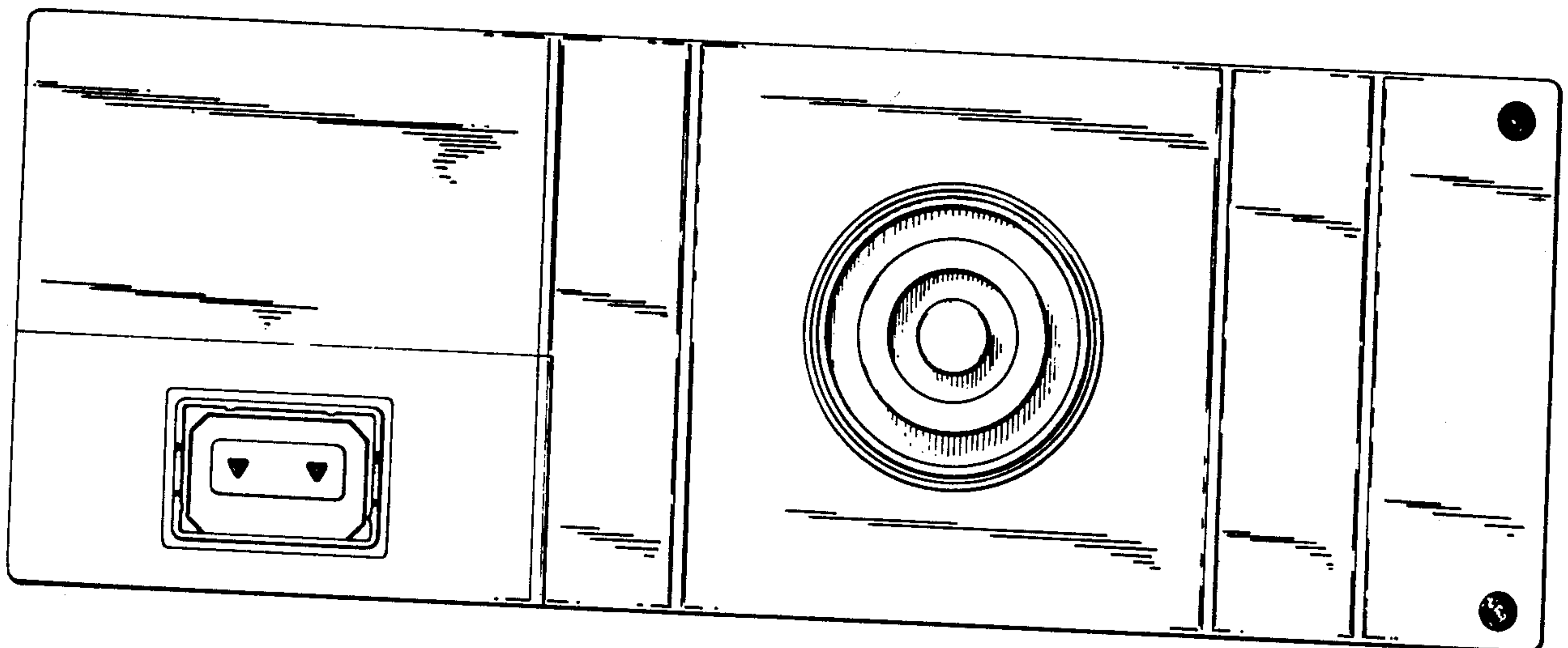

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an audio-visual storage case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an audio-visual storage case or the like showing our design in a fully open position; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 4 is a reduced scale left end elevational view; FIG. 5 is a reduced scale right end elevational view; FIG. 6 is a reduced scale rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a reduced scale perspective view in a partially open position.



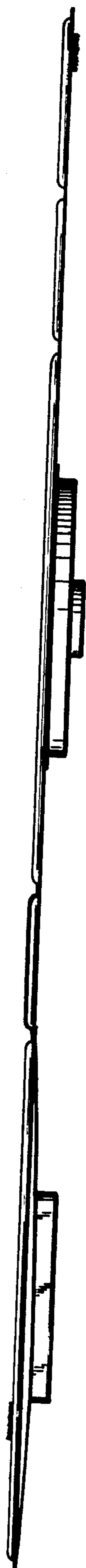

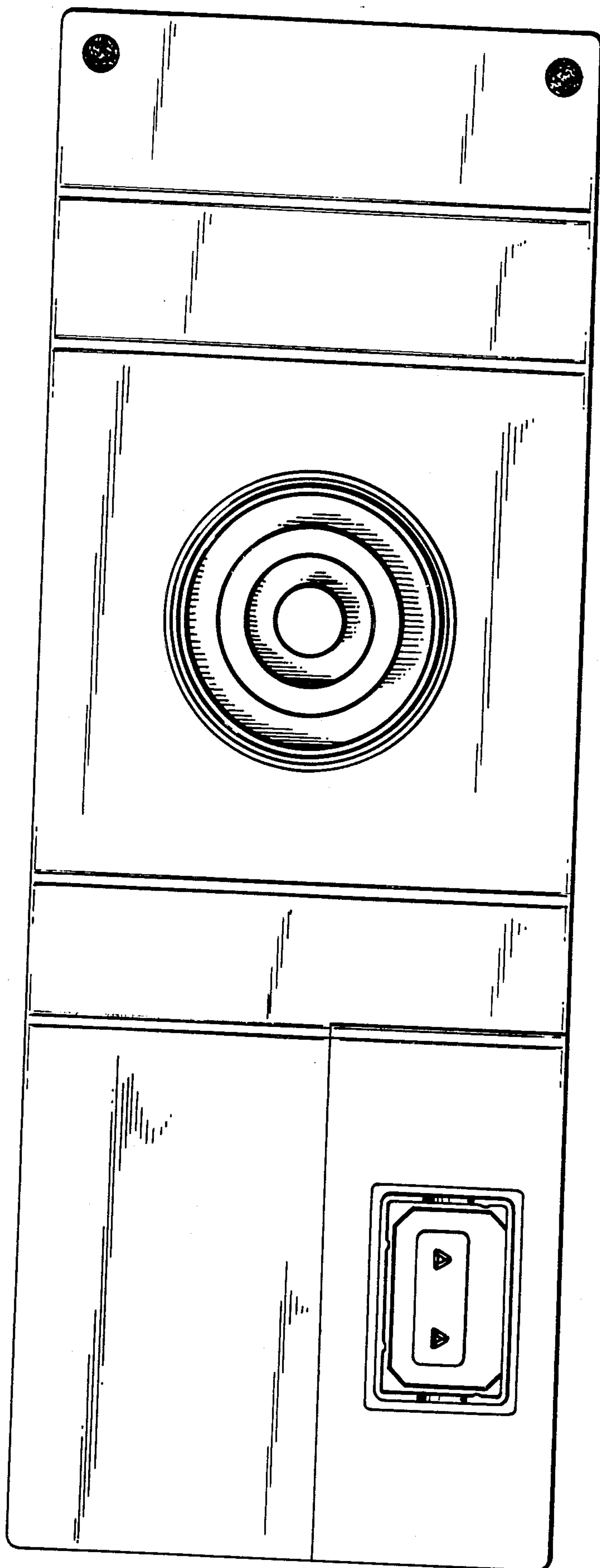

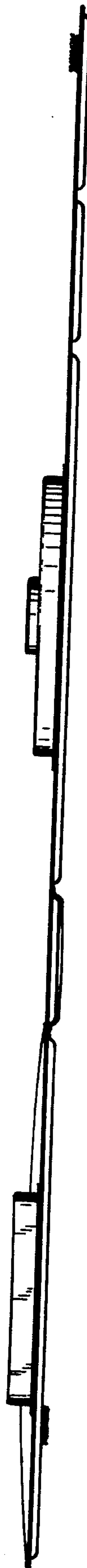

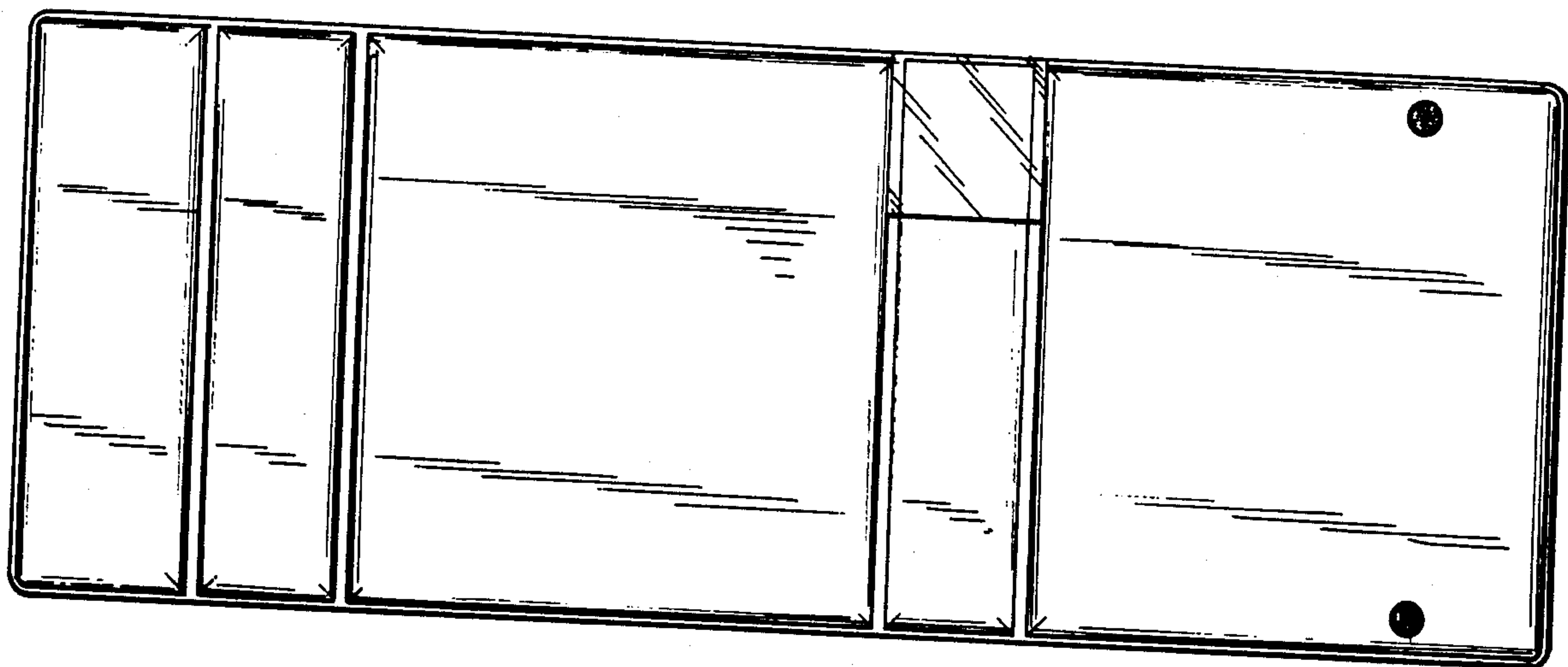

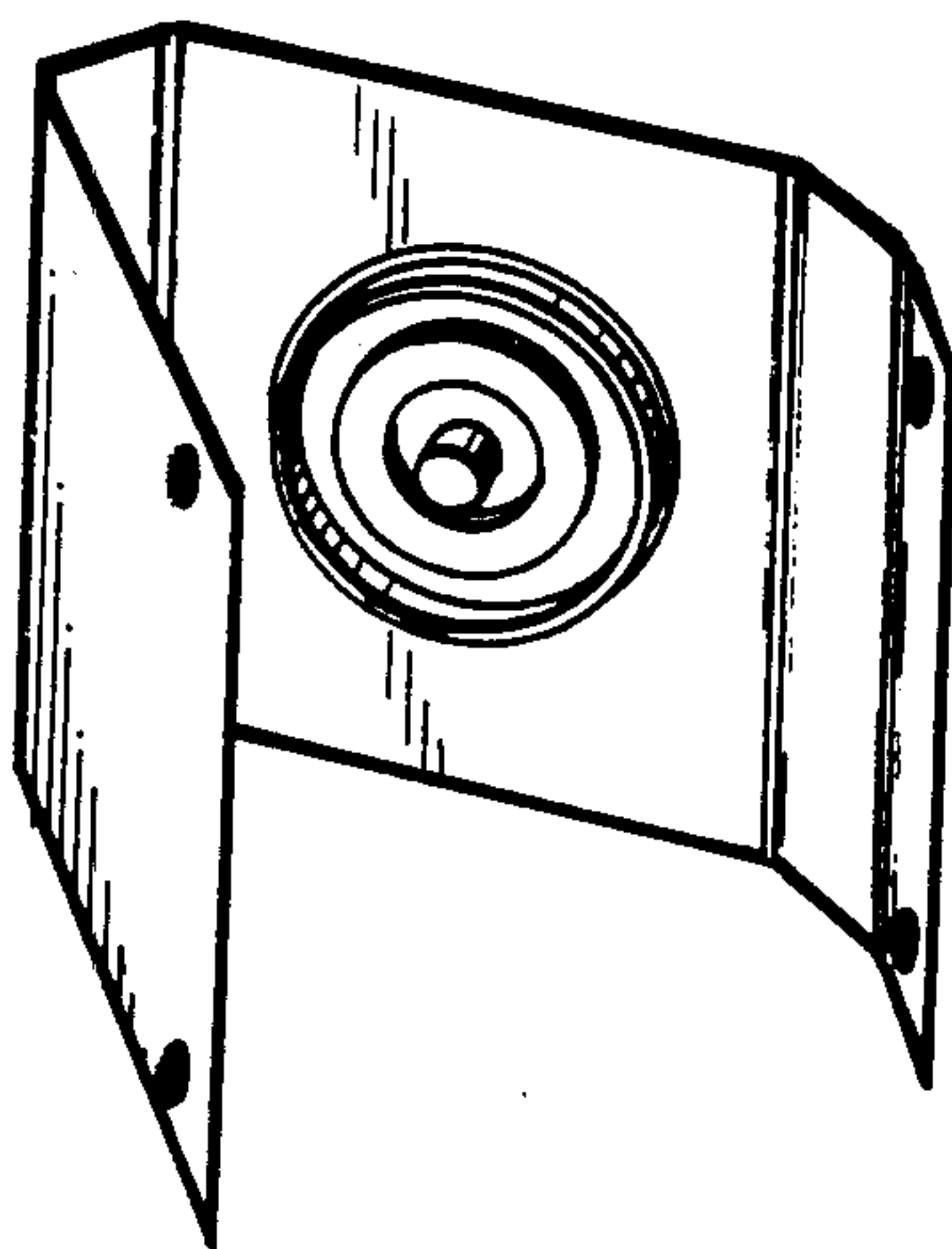
