DESCRIPTION

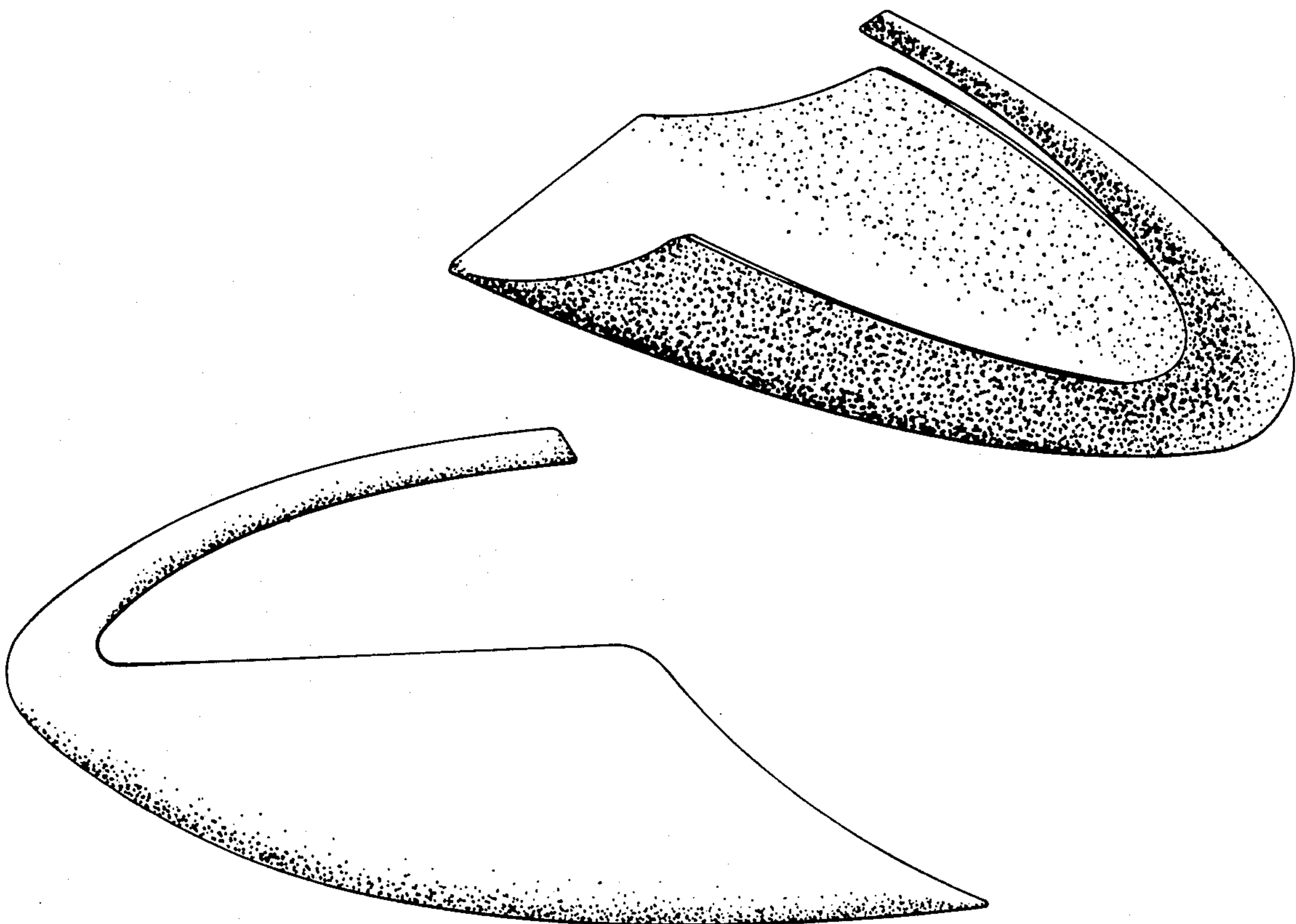
FIG. 1 is an isometric view of our scoop.

FIG. 5 is a top view of the scoop of FIG. 1.



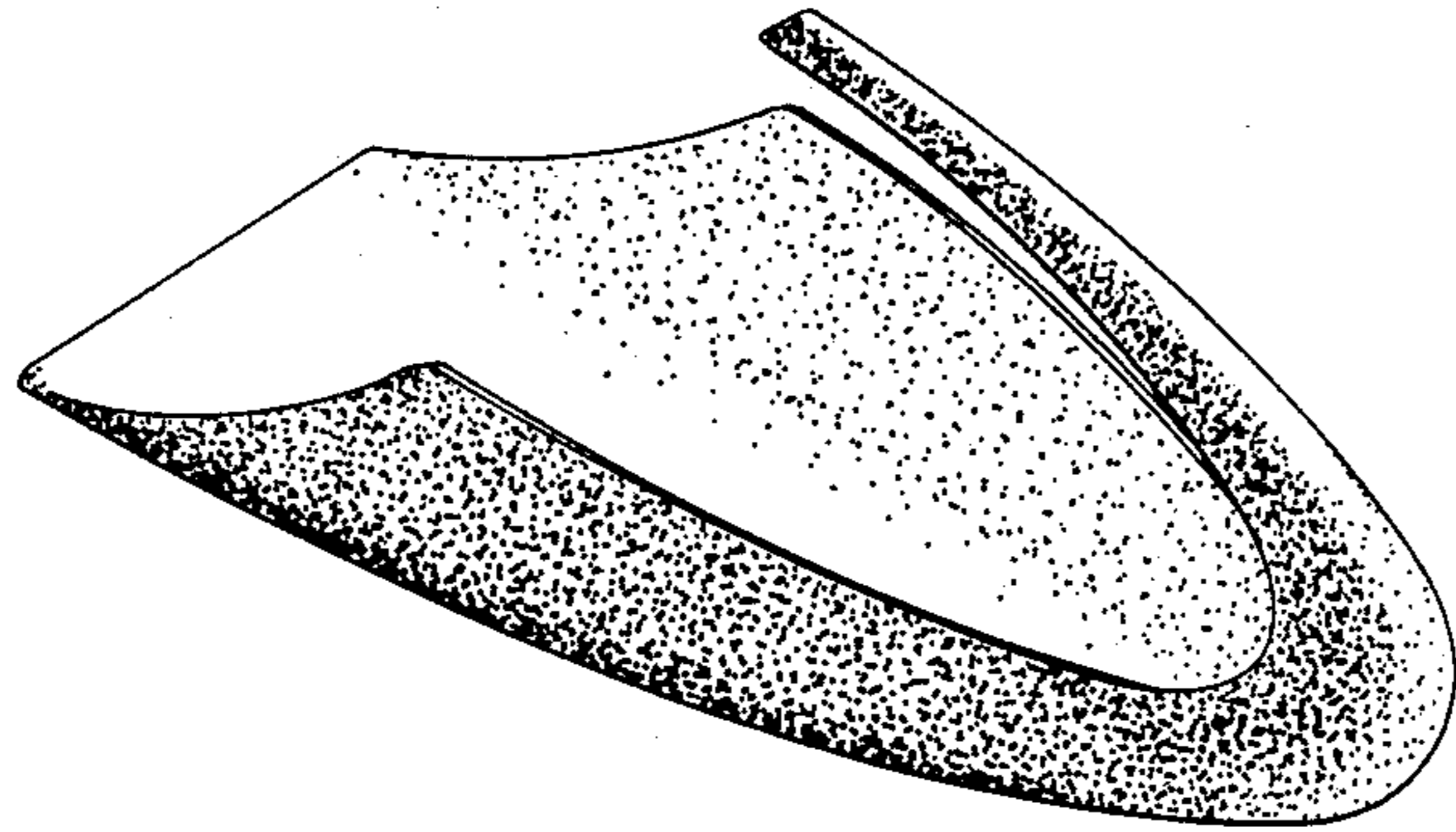

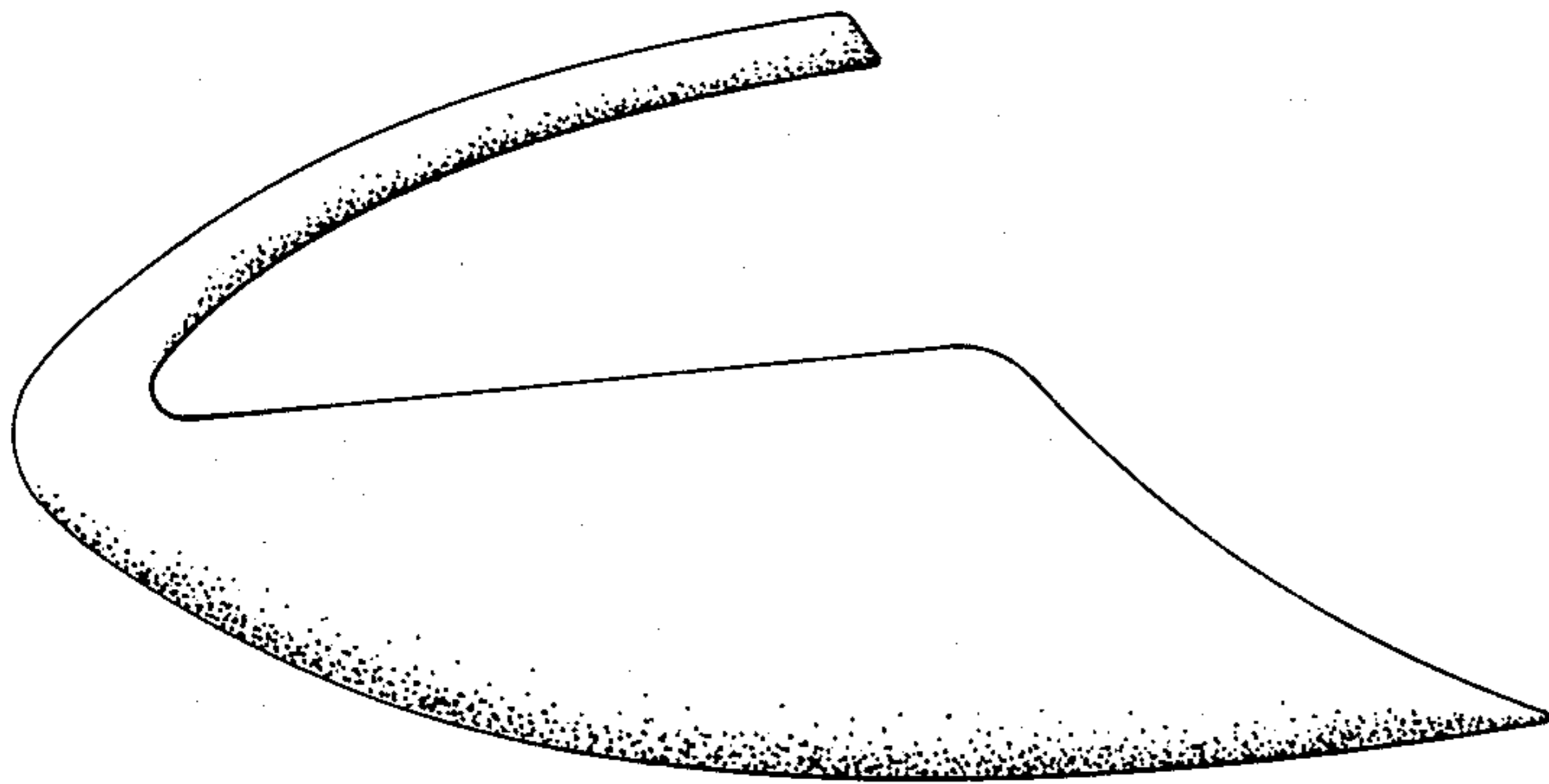

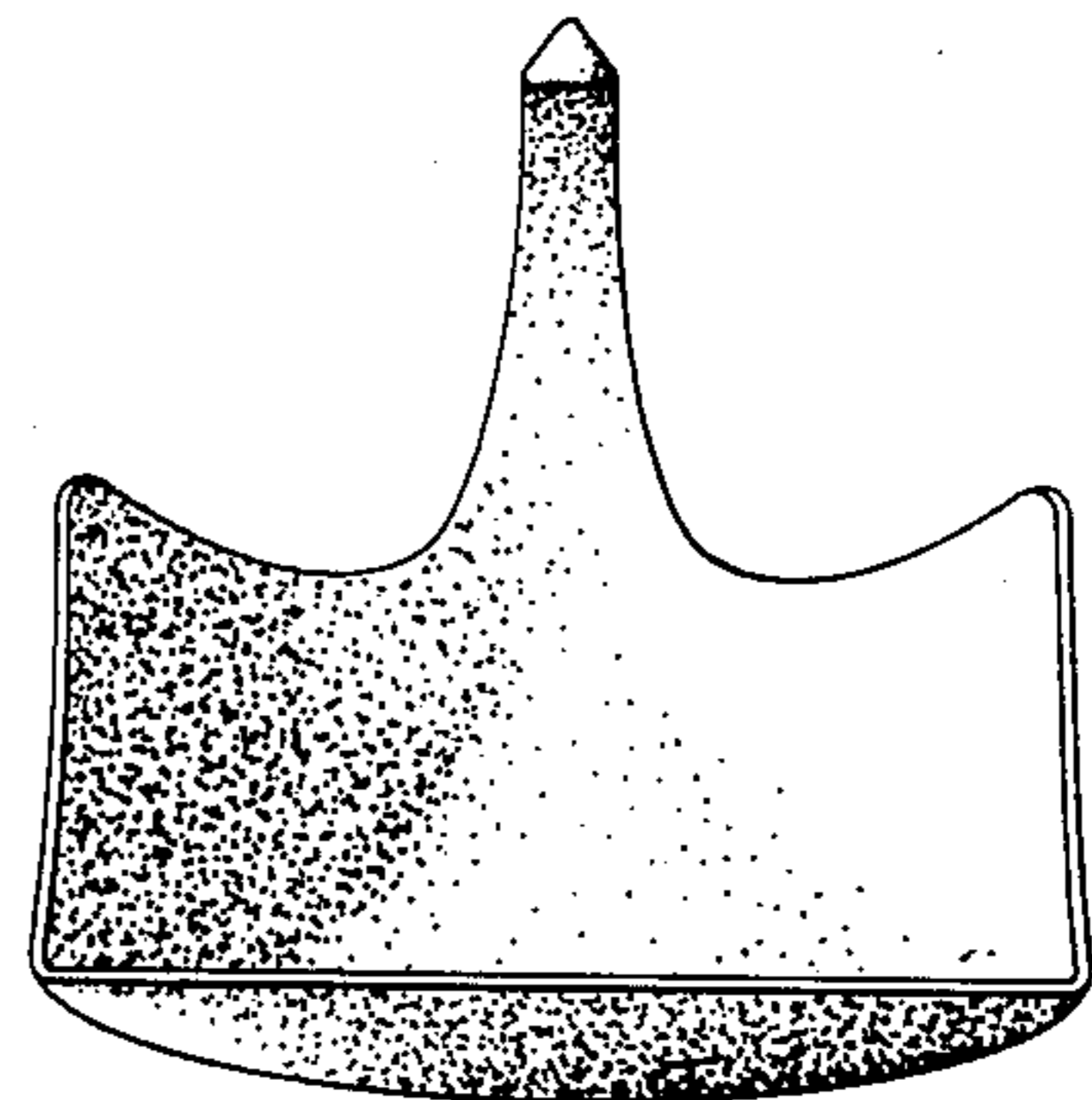

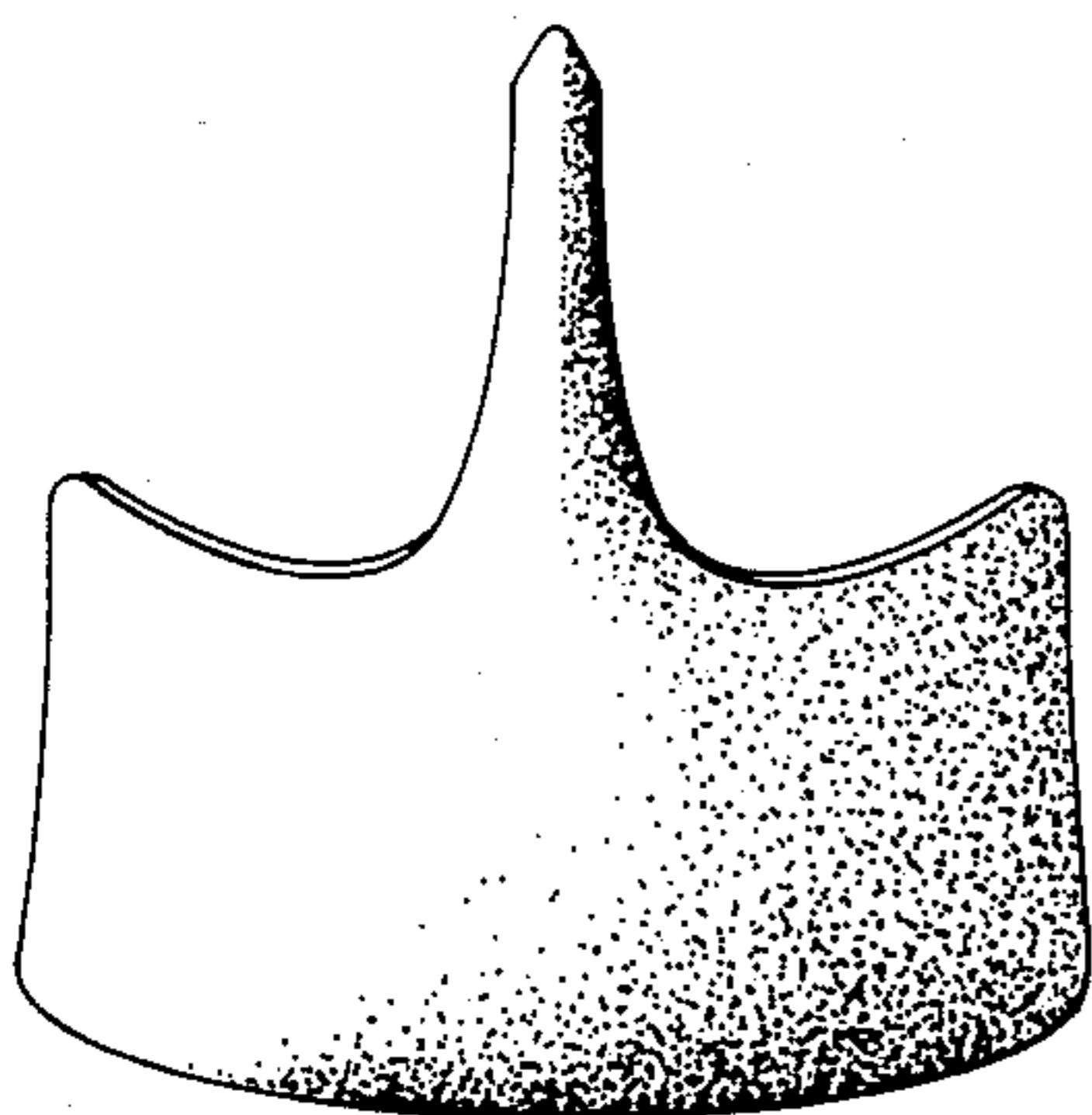

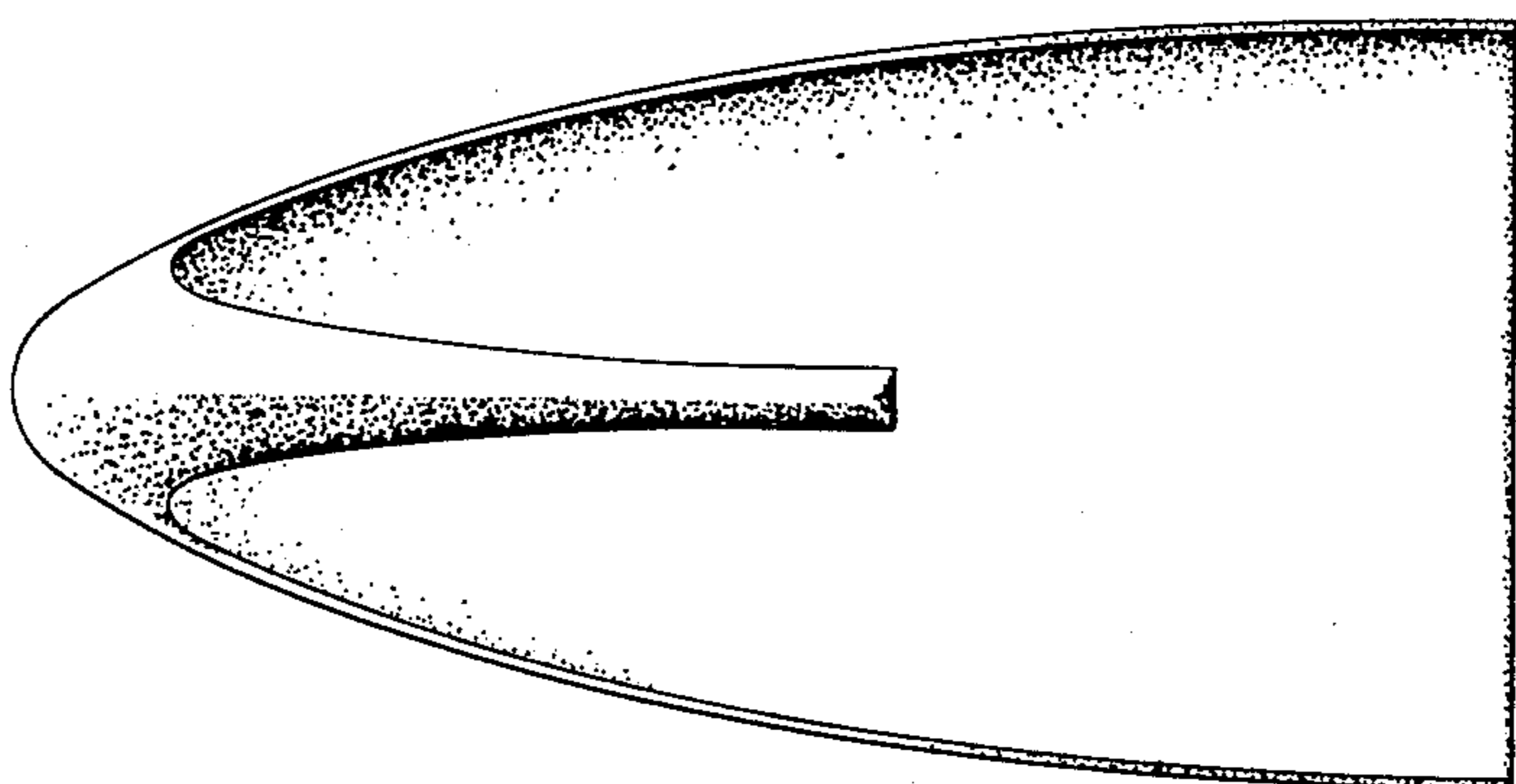
