[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a light for vaginal speculum, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the light for a vaginal speculum;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the light shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the light illustrated in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the light illustrated in FIG. 1; and
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the light shown in FIG. 1 with the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.

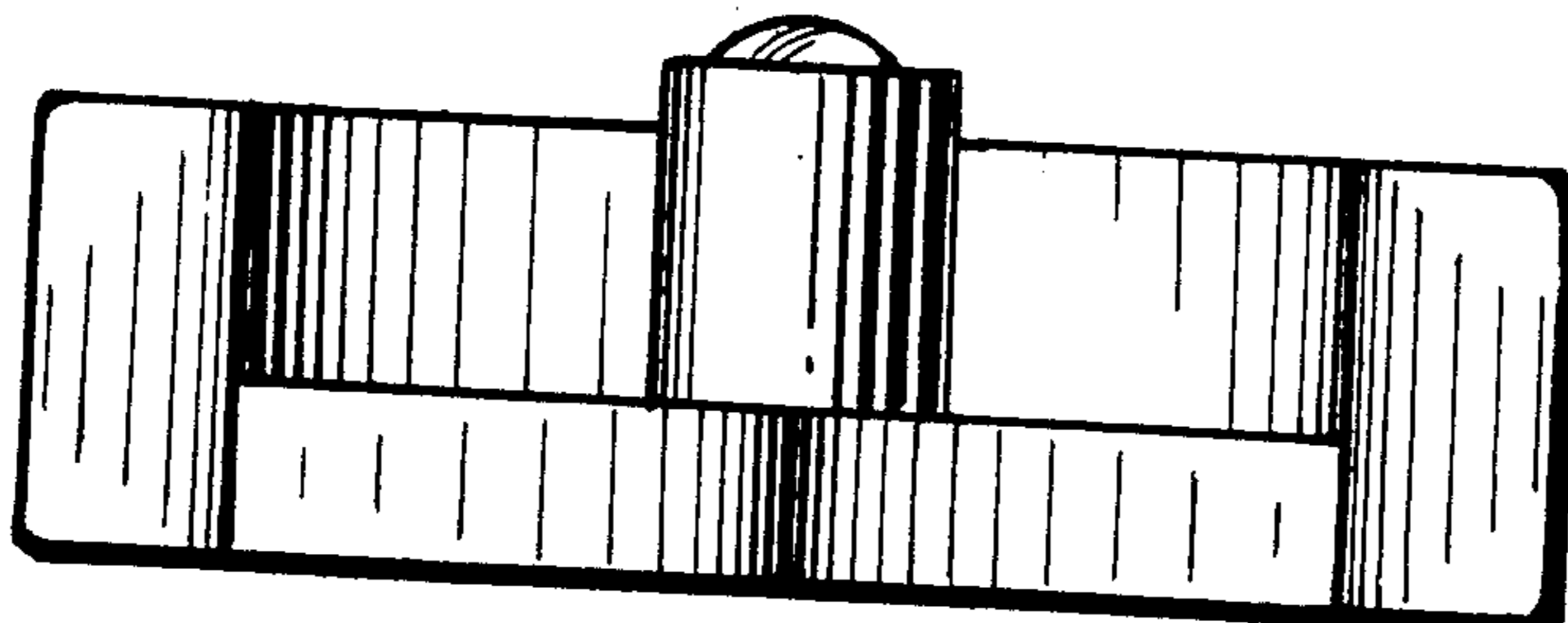
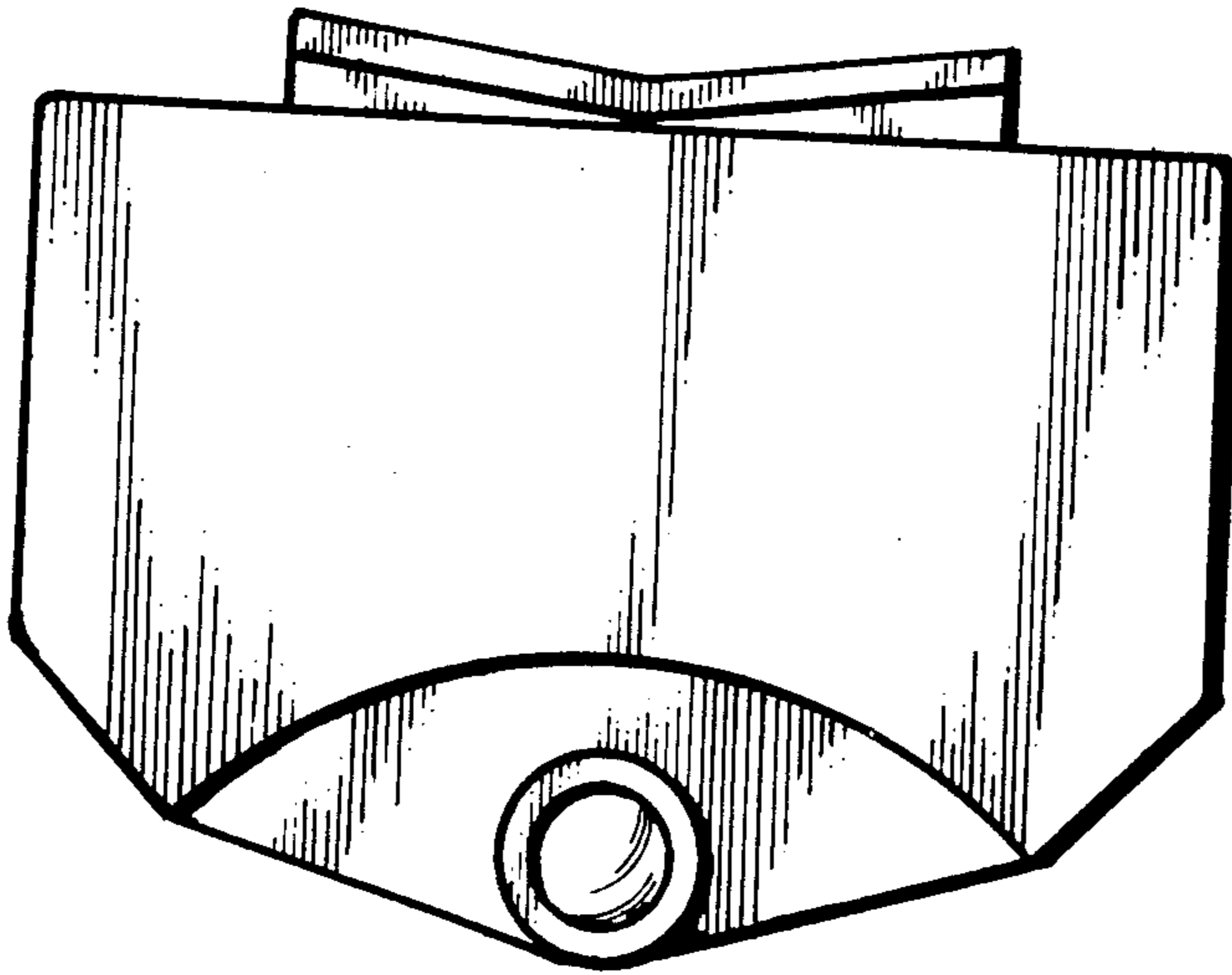

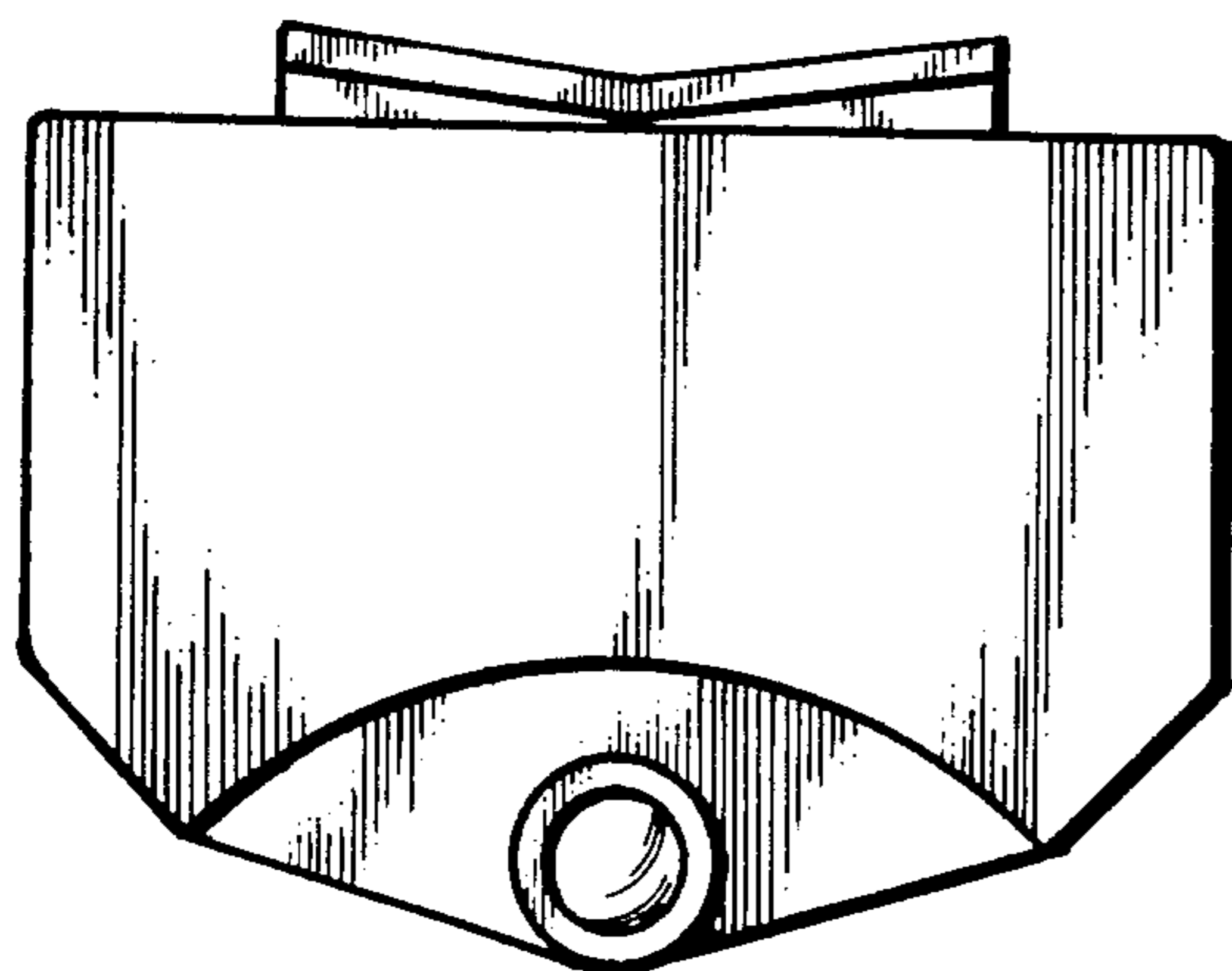

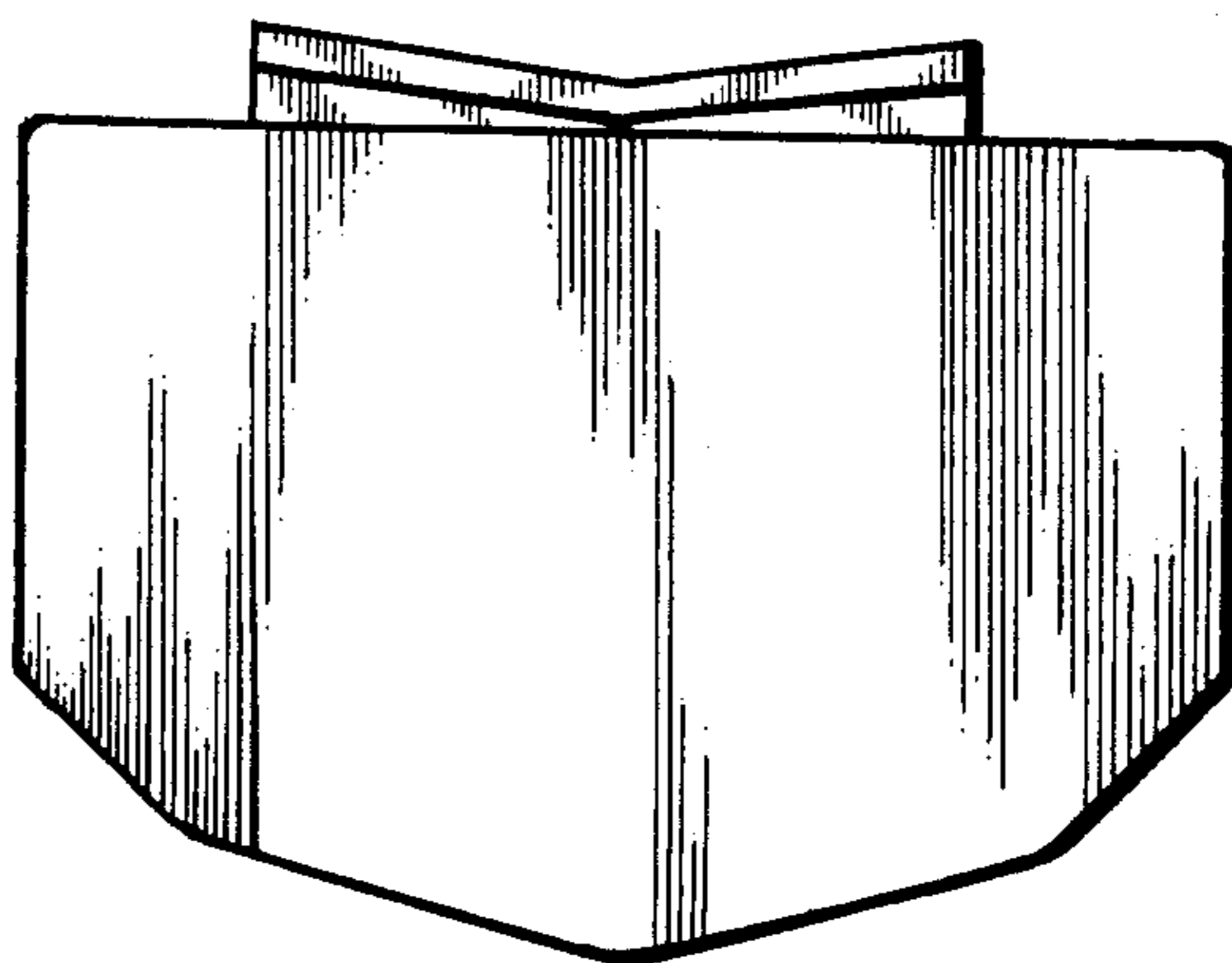

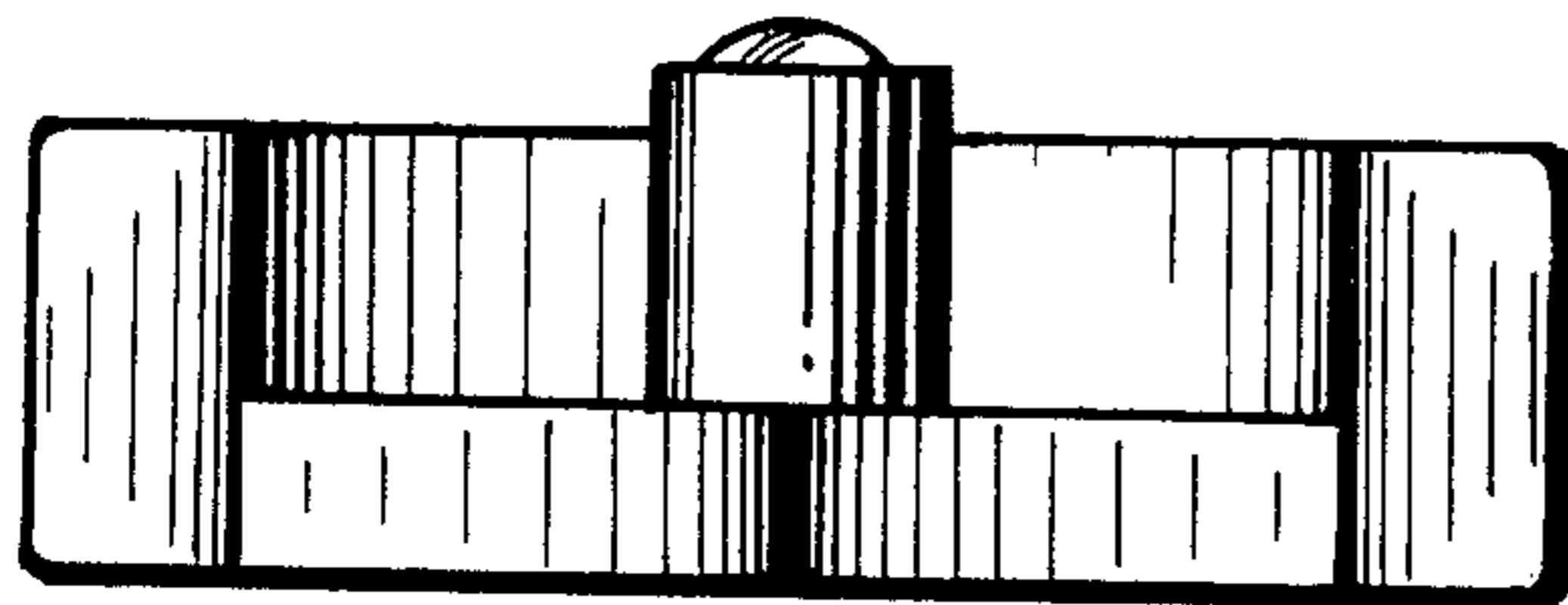

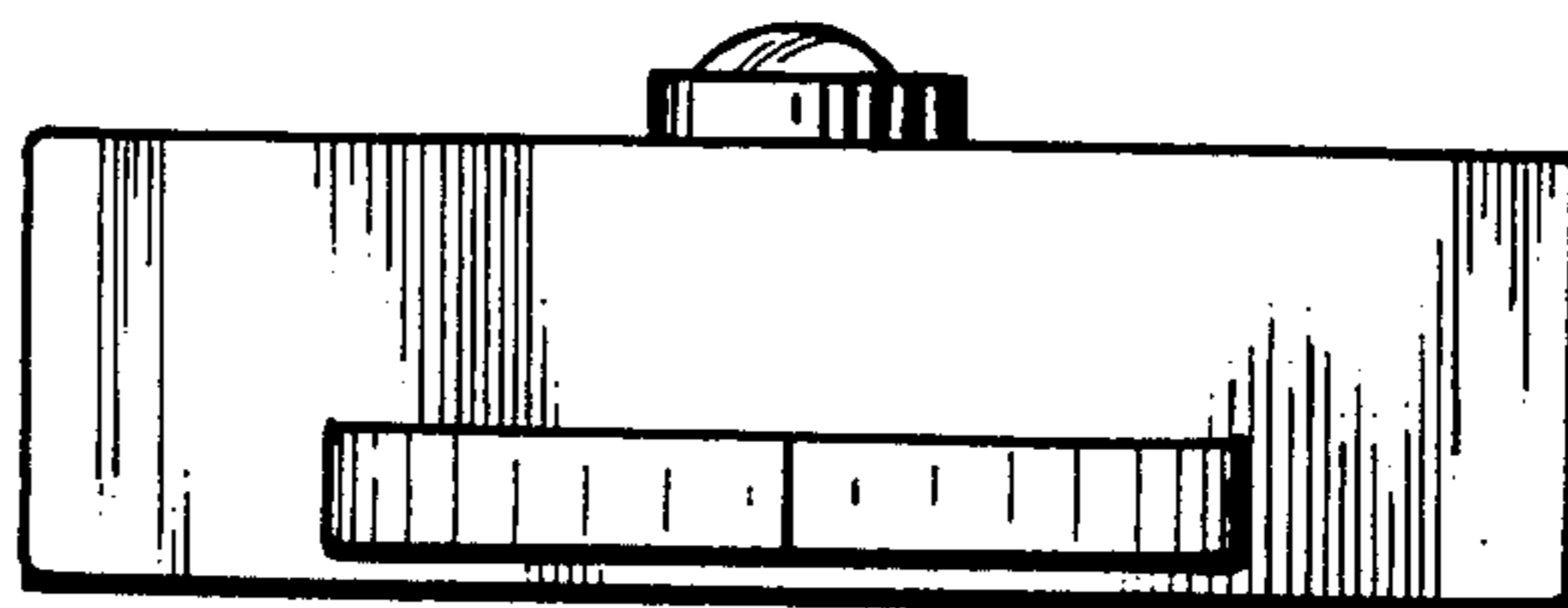
