**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of the burial facility design of this invention as it appears when viewed at ground level from the entrance side thereof.

FIG. 2 is a plan view of the burial facility design of the present invention.

FIG. 3 is an end elevation view illustrating my burial facility design as it appears when viewed from one end thereof.
