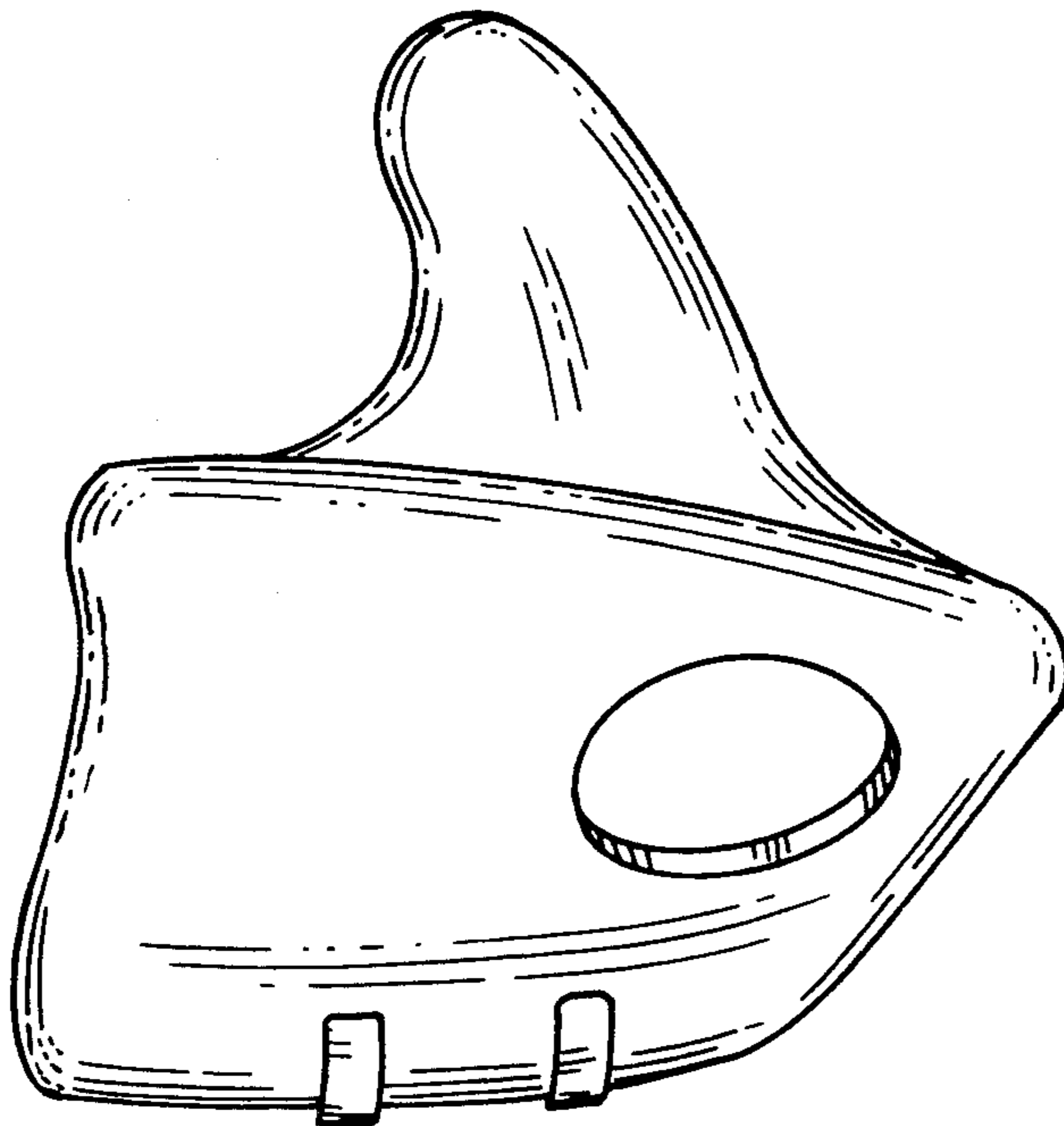

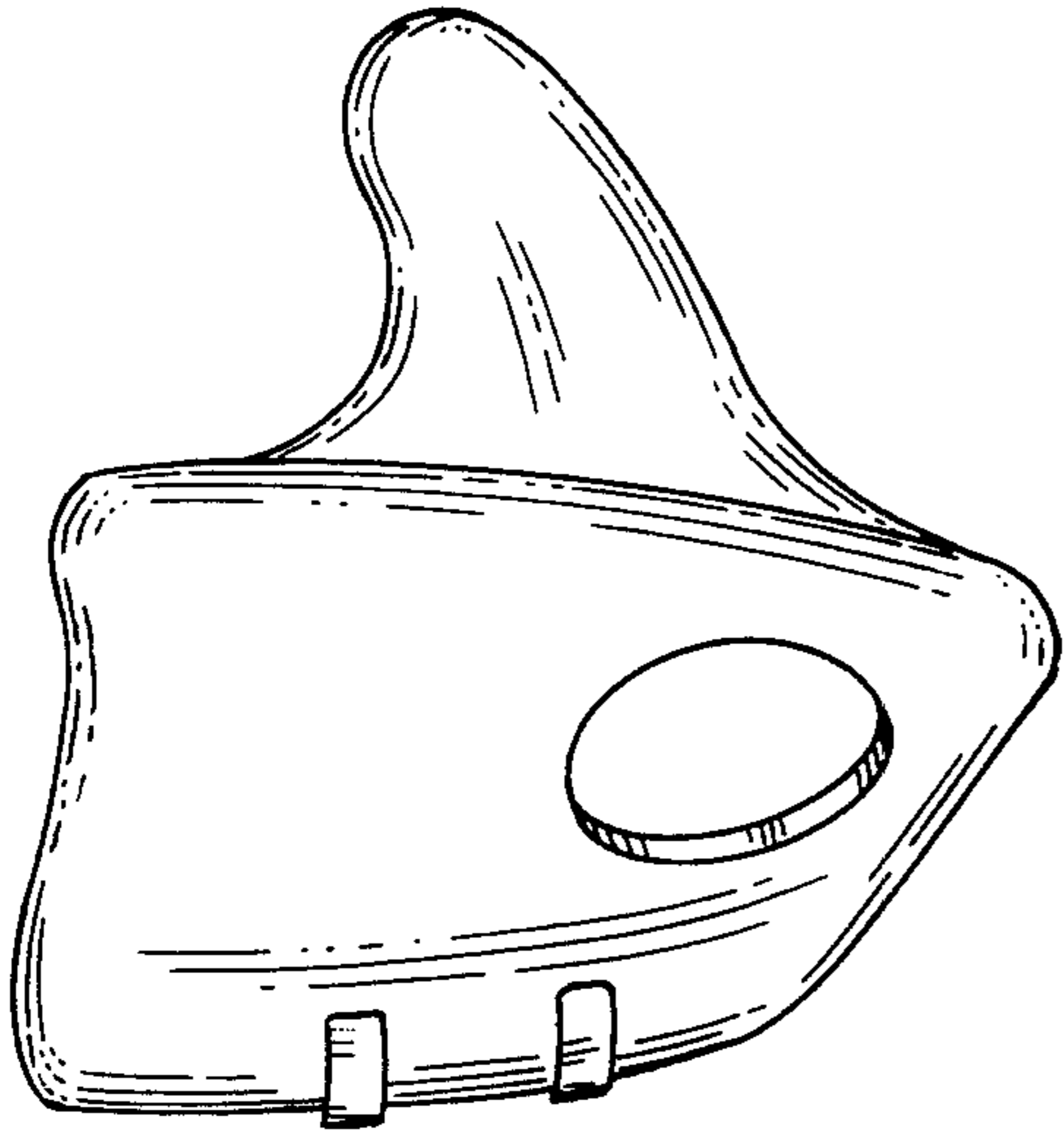
The ornamental design for a swim vest with dorsal fin, substantially as shown and described above.

DESCRIPTION

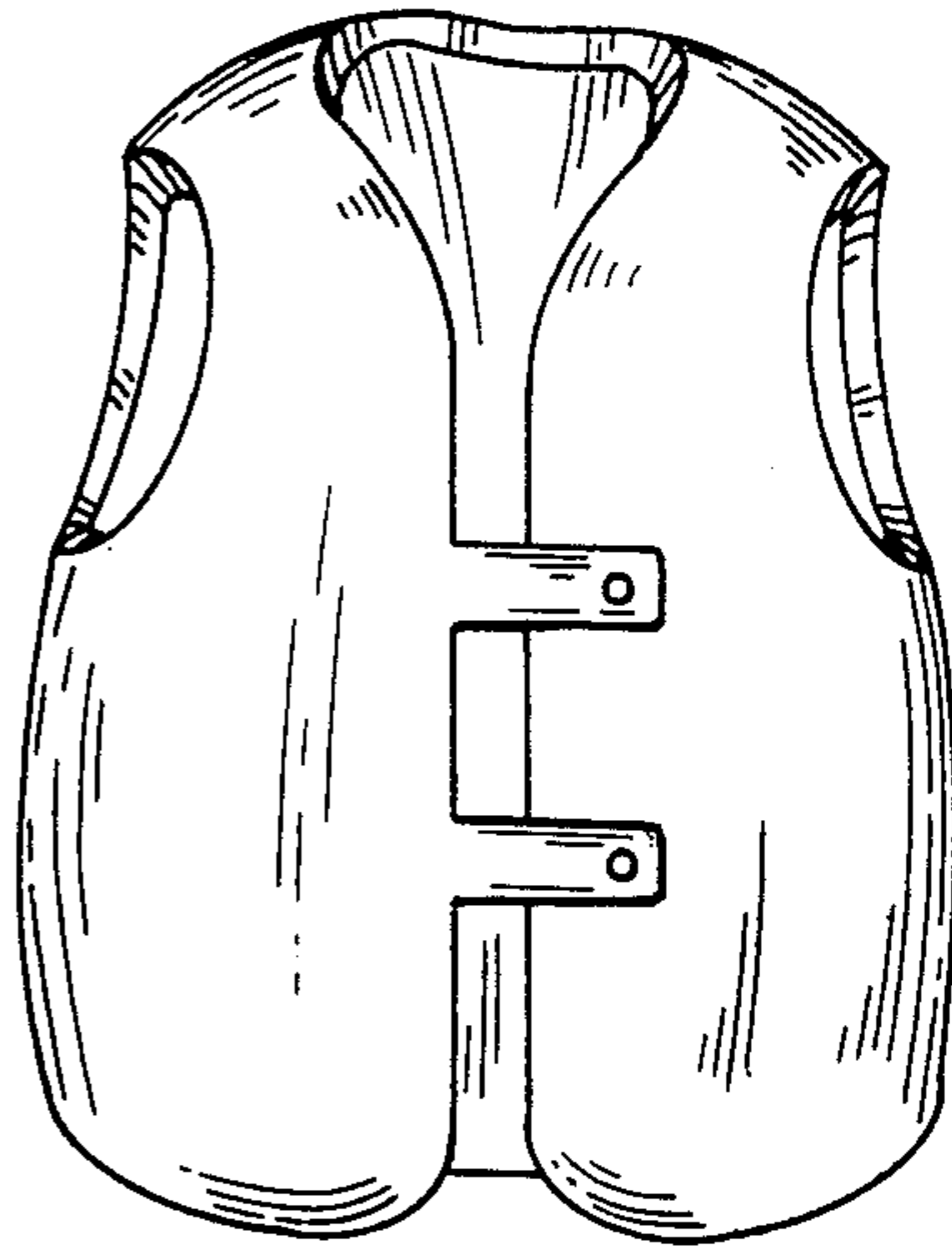
FIG. 1 is a side view of a swim vest with dorsal fin incorporating my design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view.



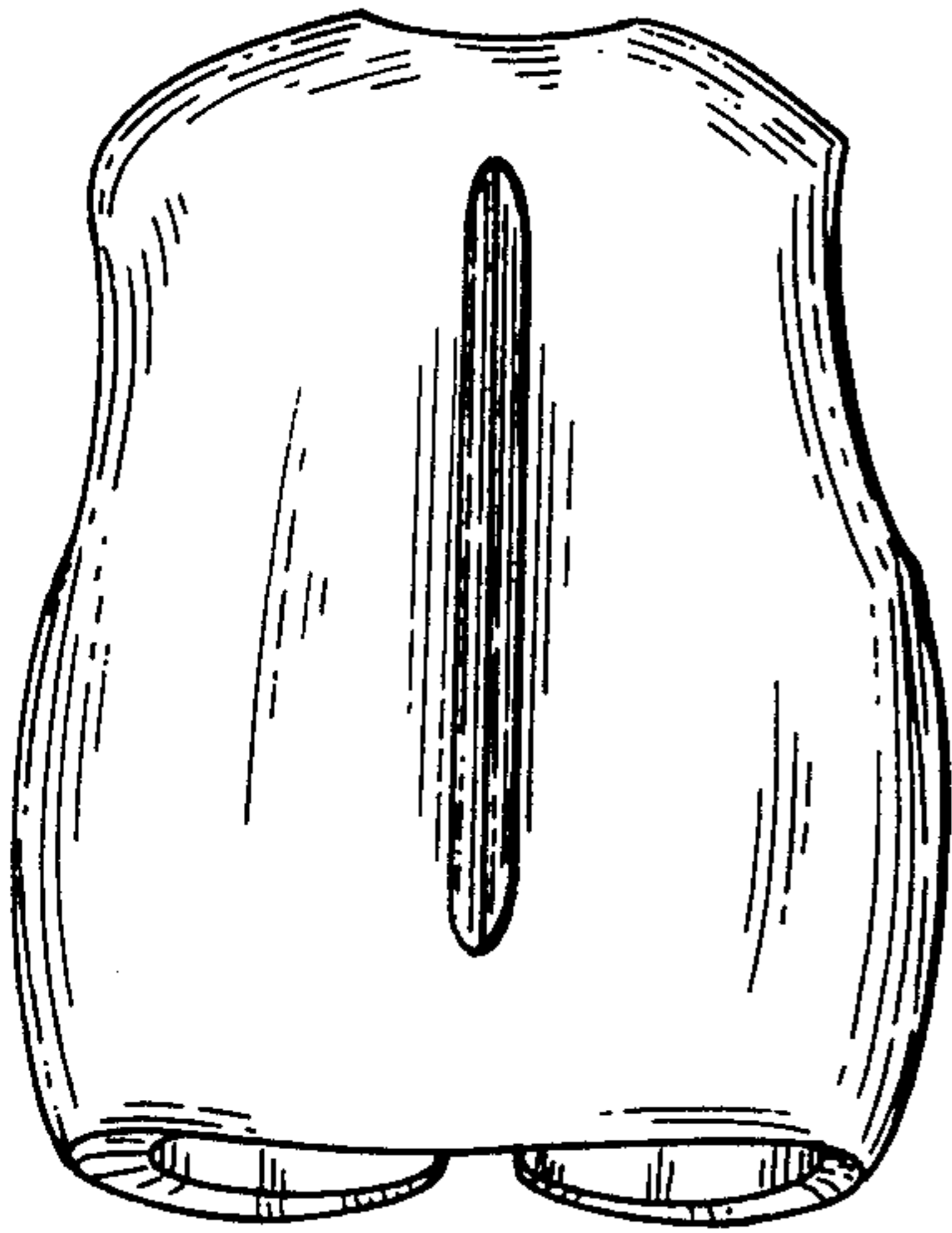

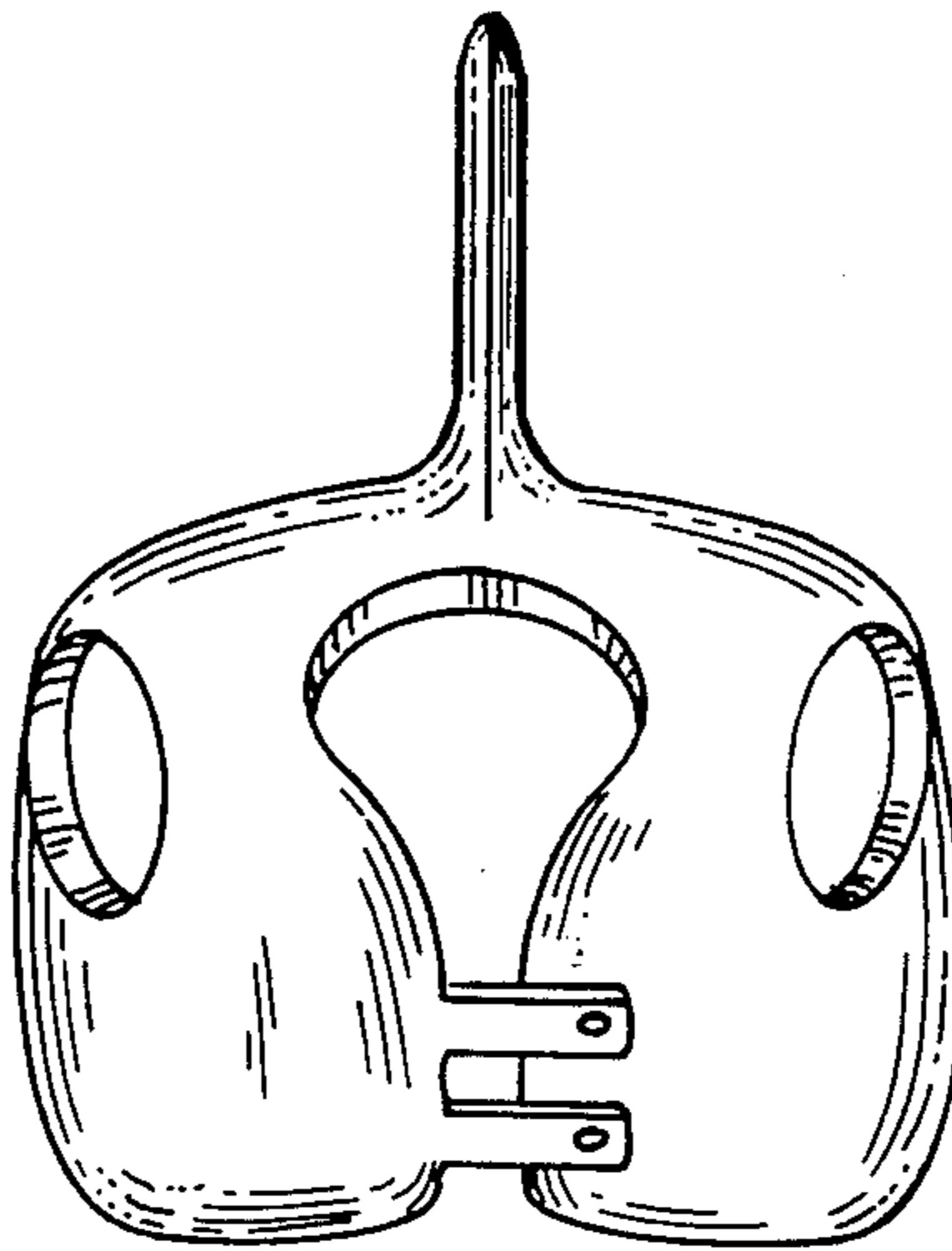
