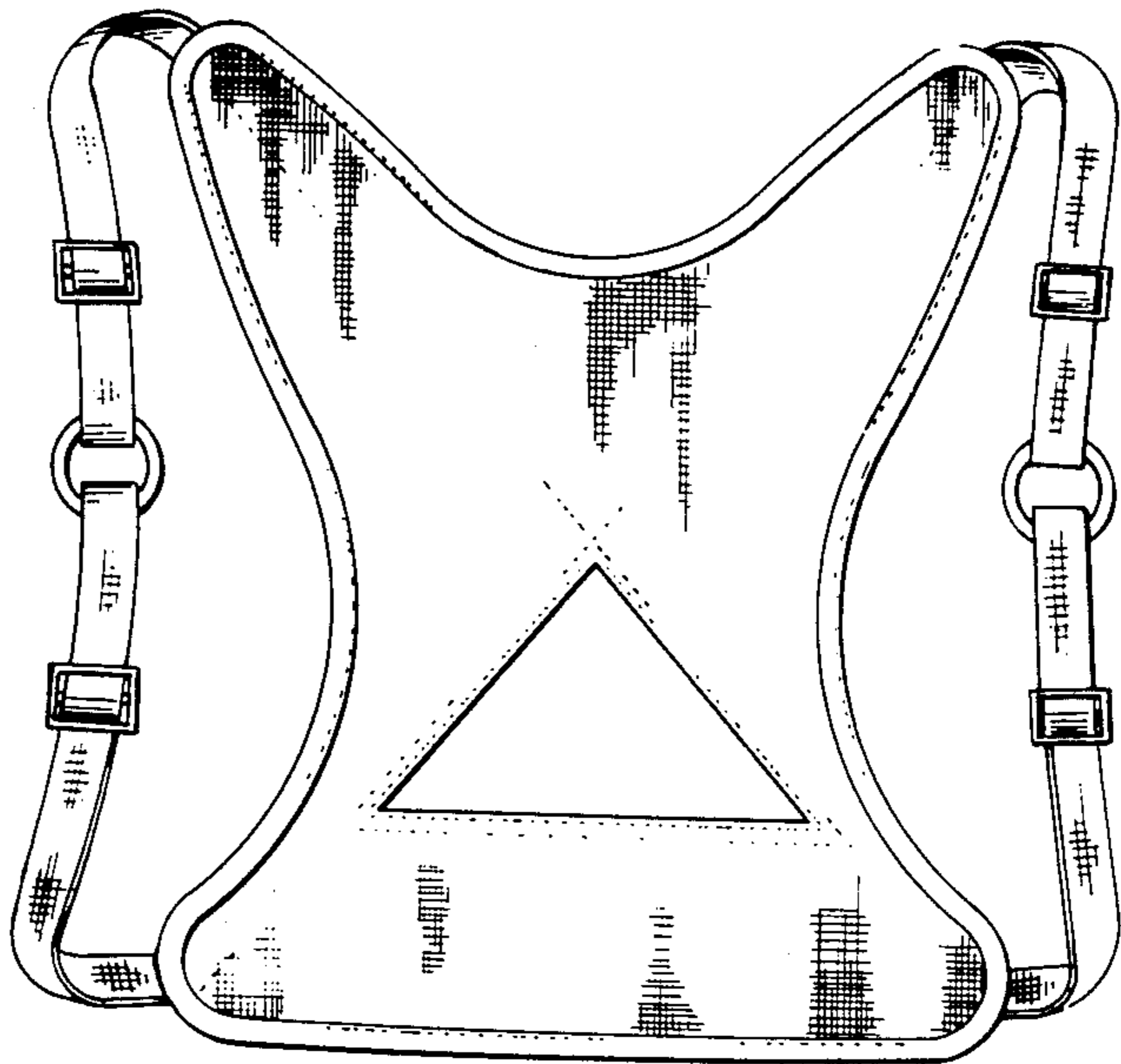
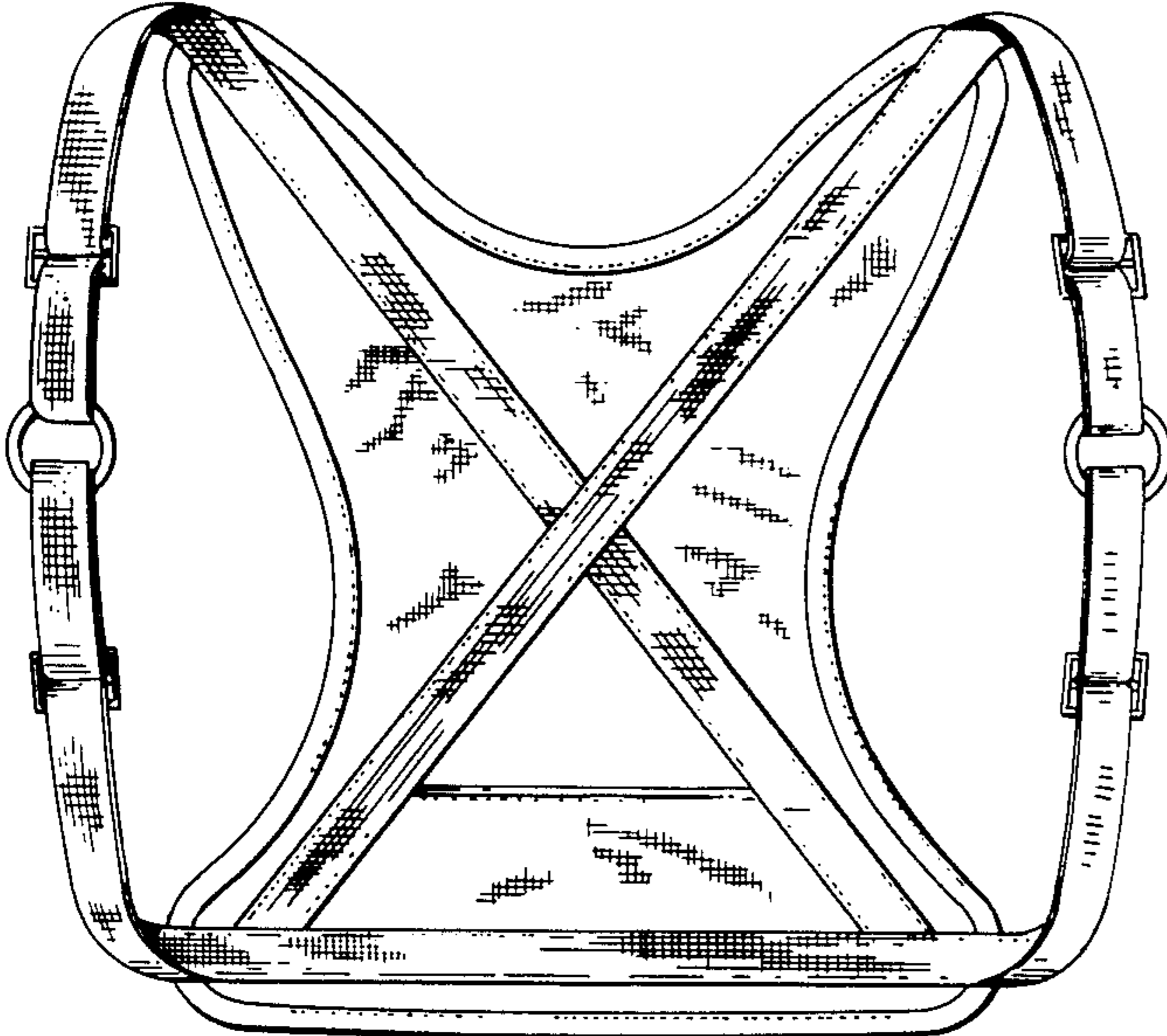

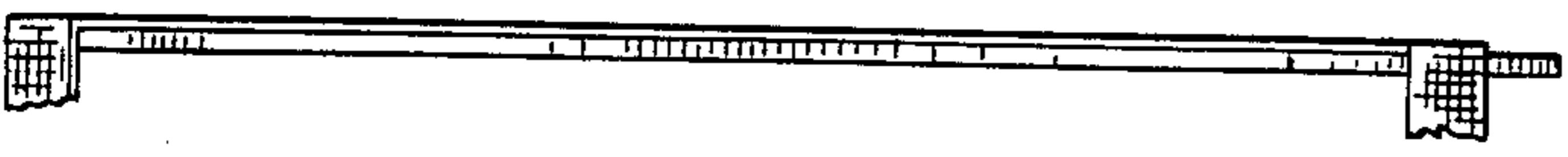
The ornamental design for human back support harness, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

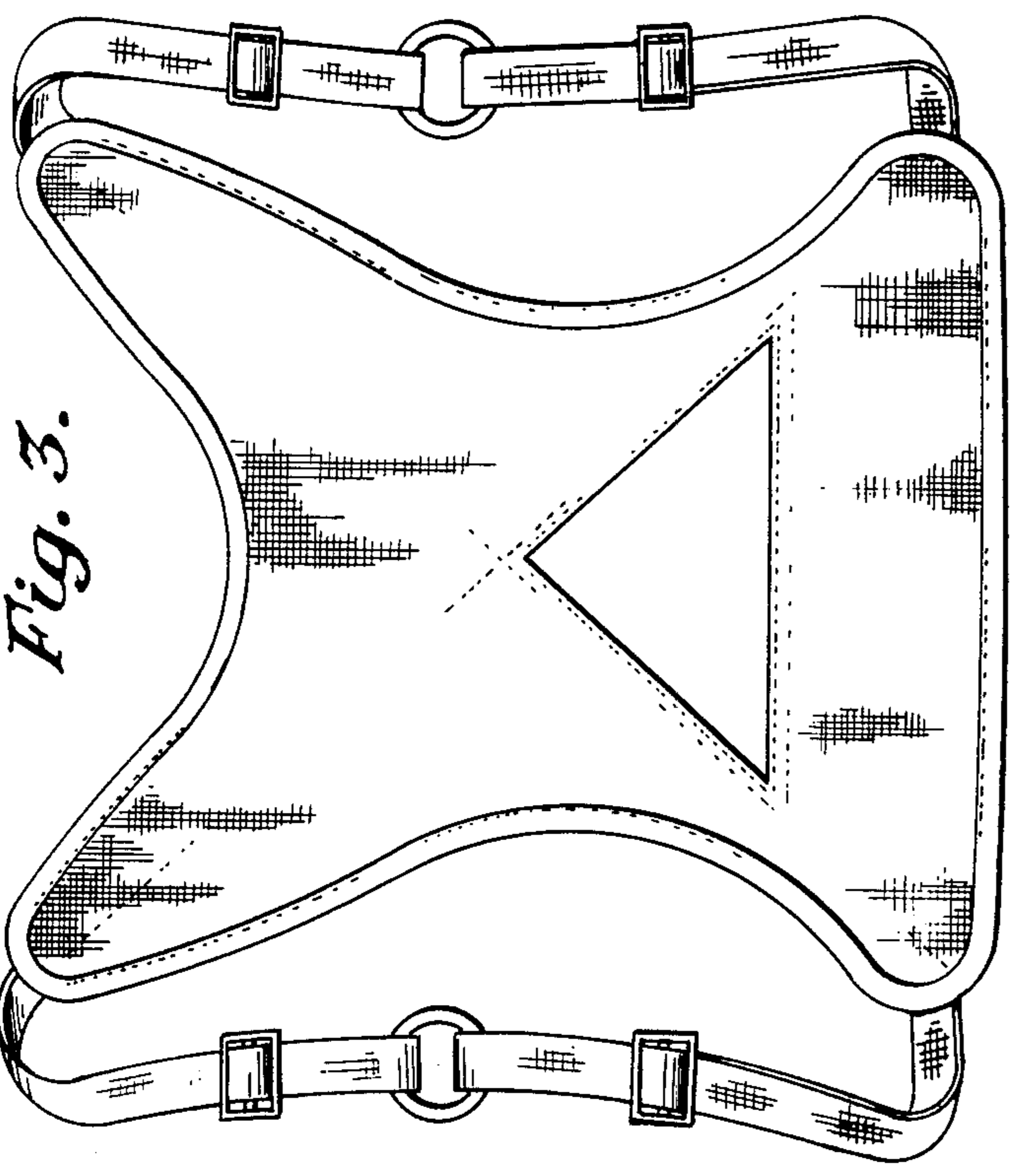
FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a human back support harness, showing my new design;

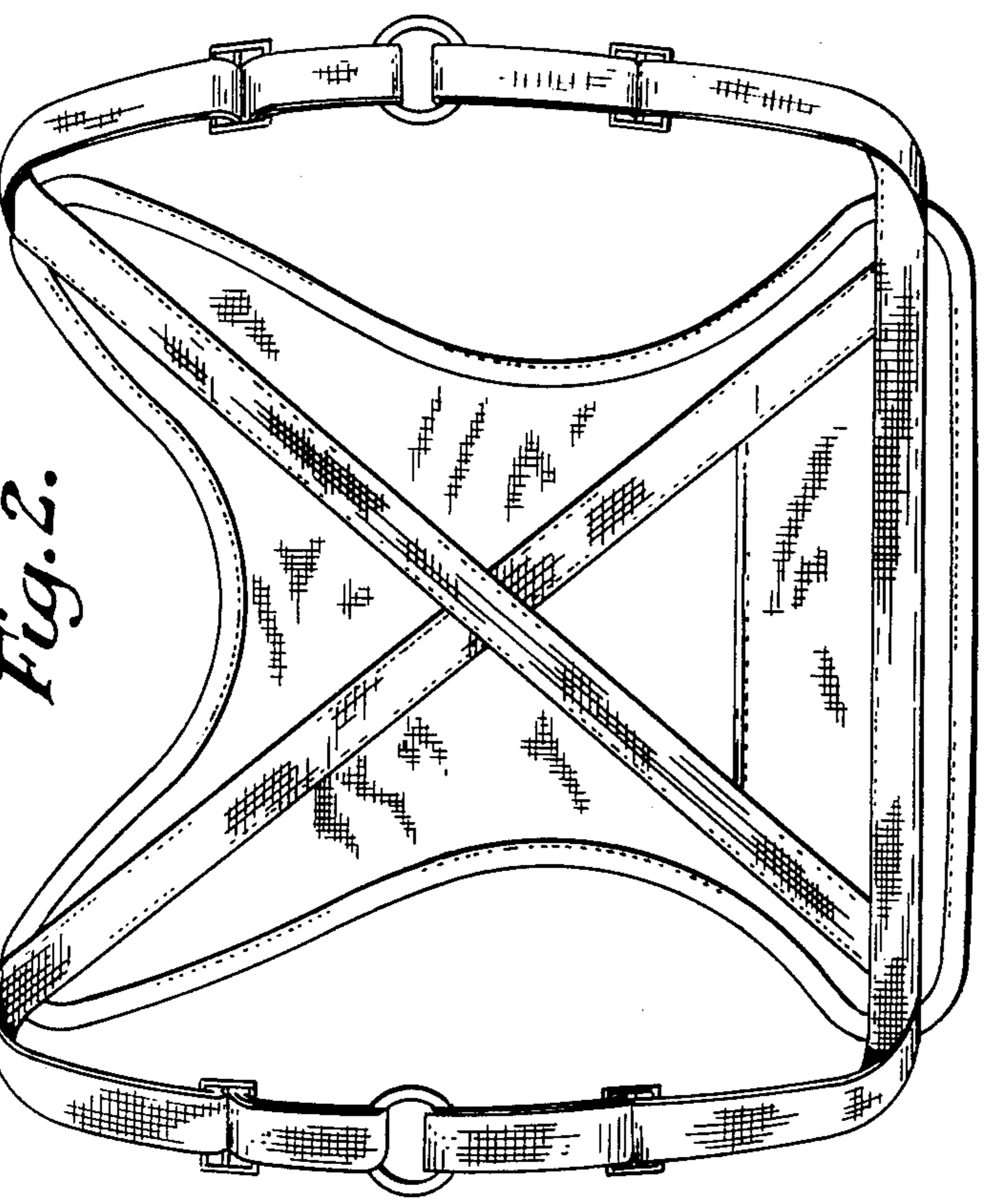




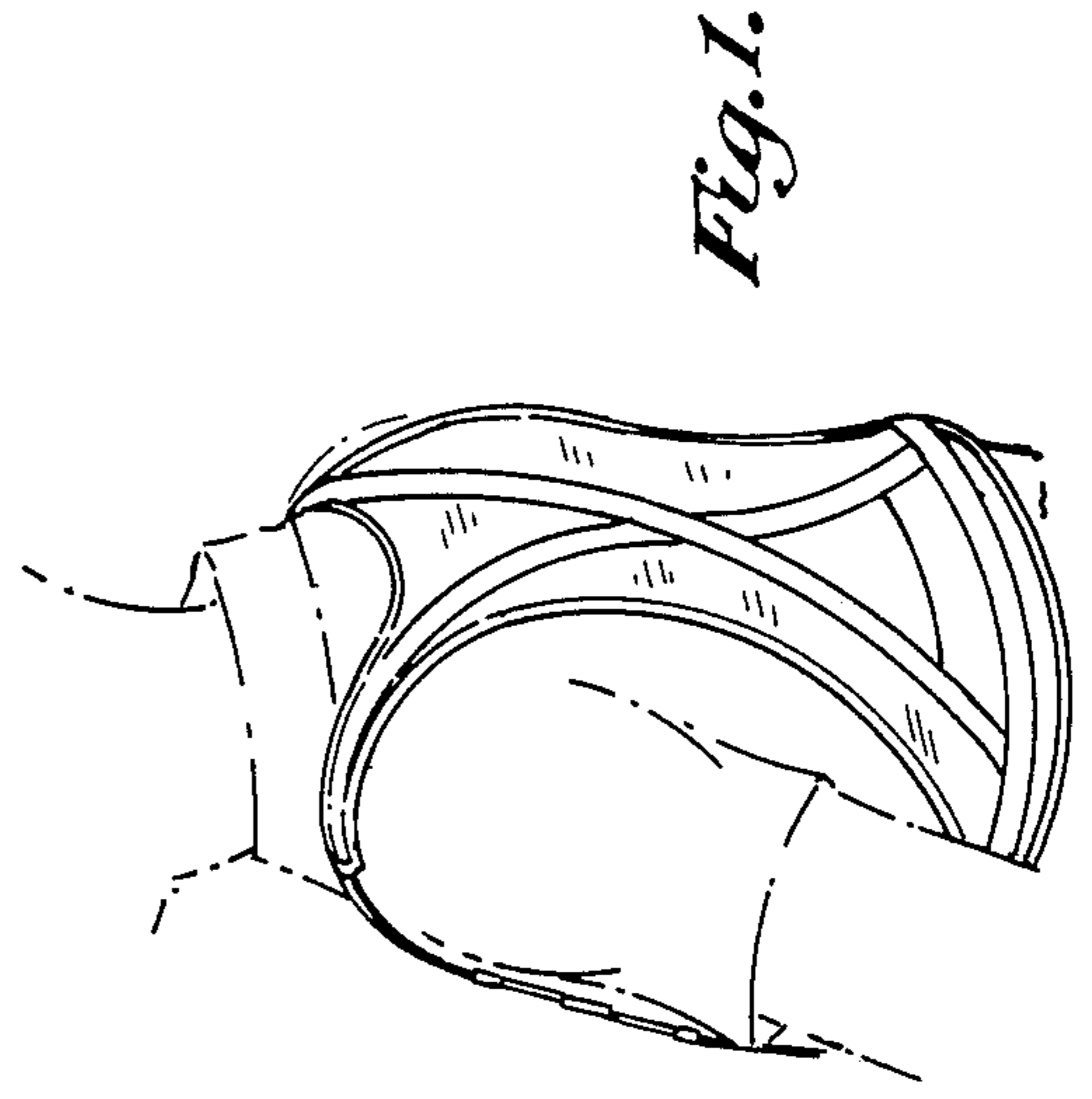
