DESCRIPTION

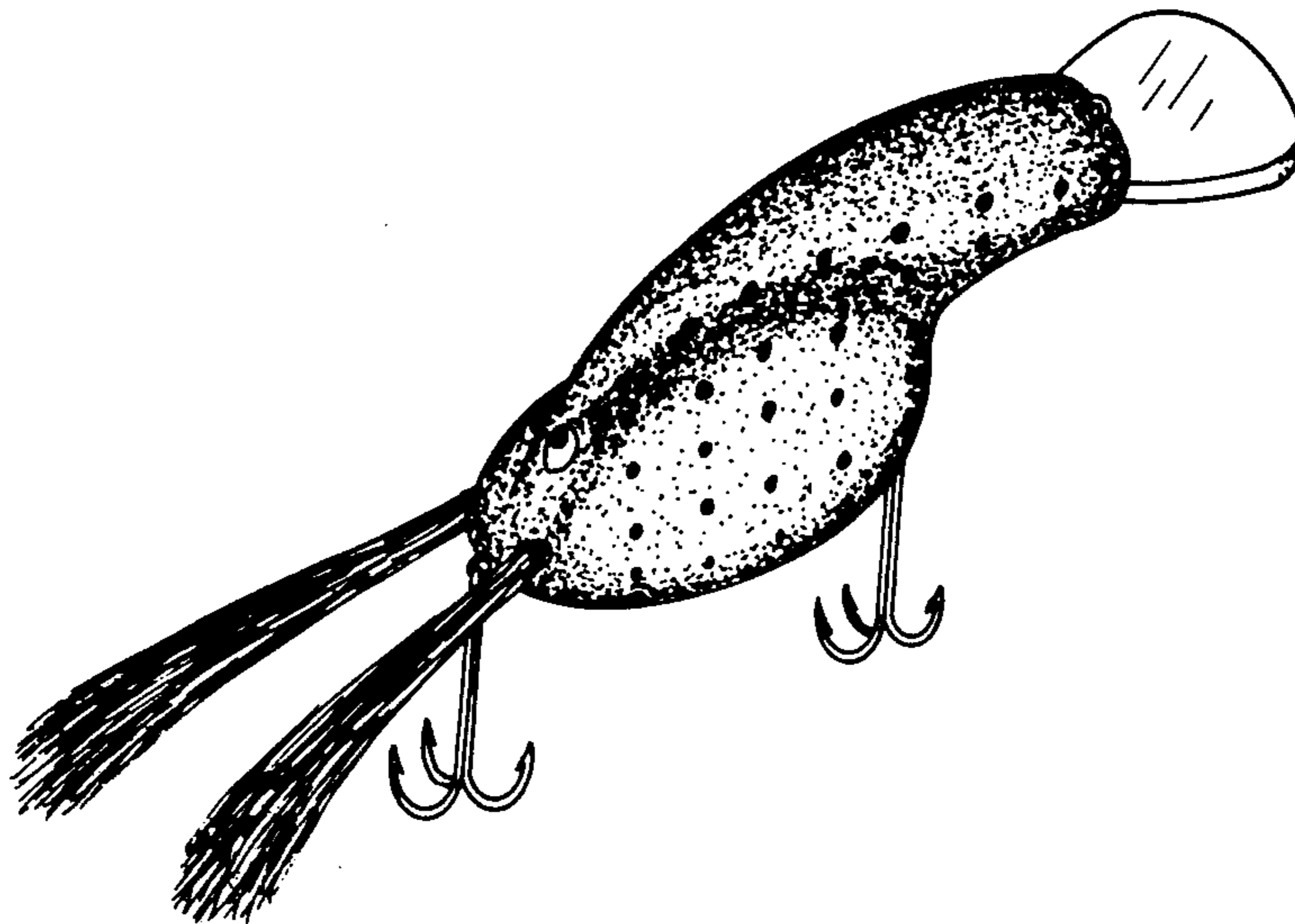
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a fishing lure showing my new design, the side not shown being identical to the side shown;

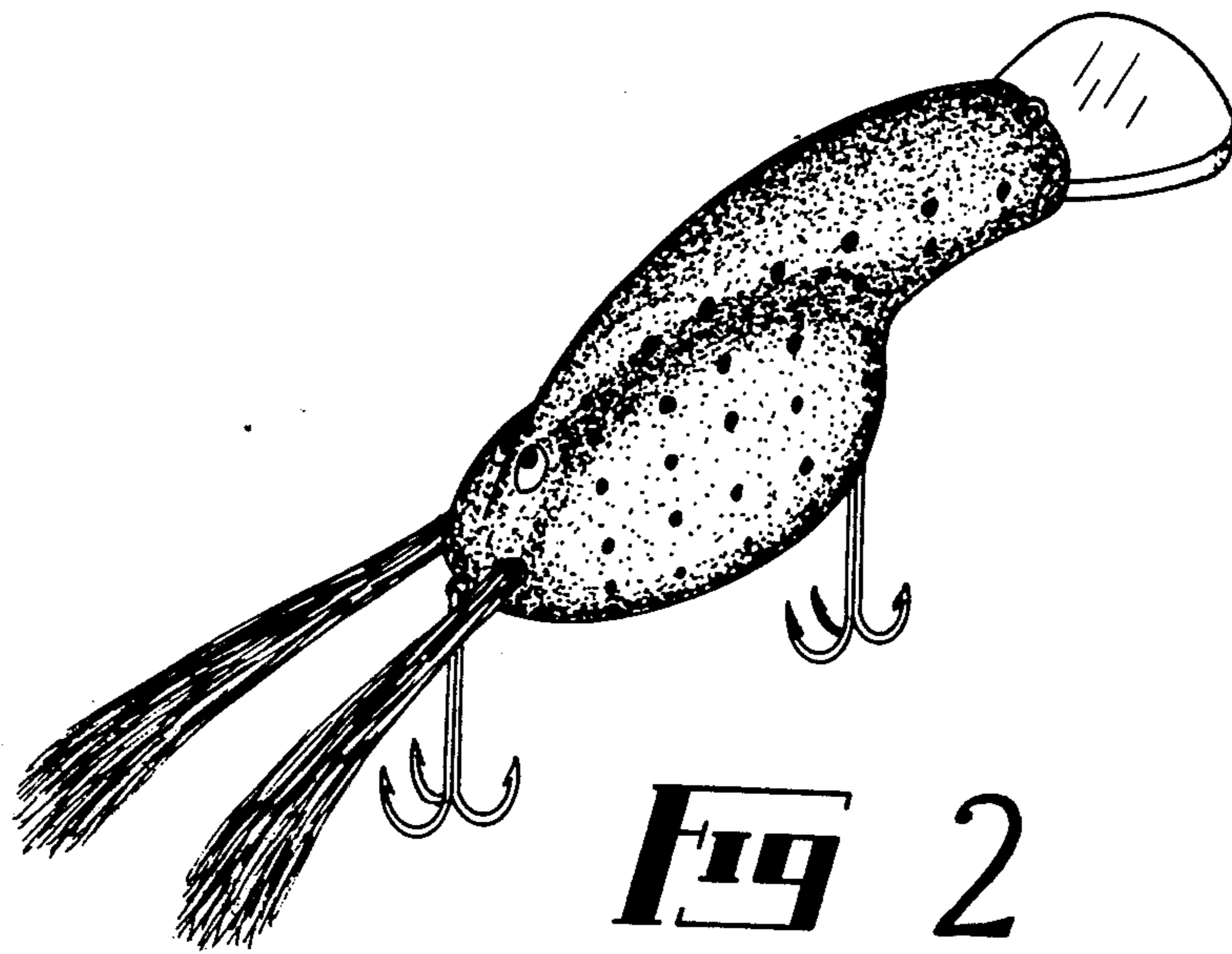
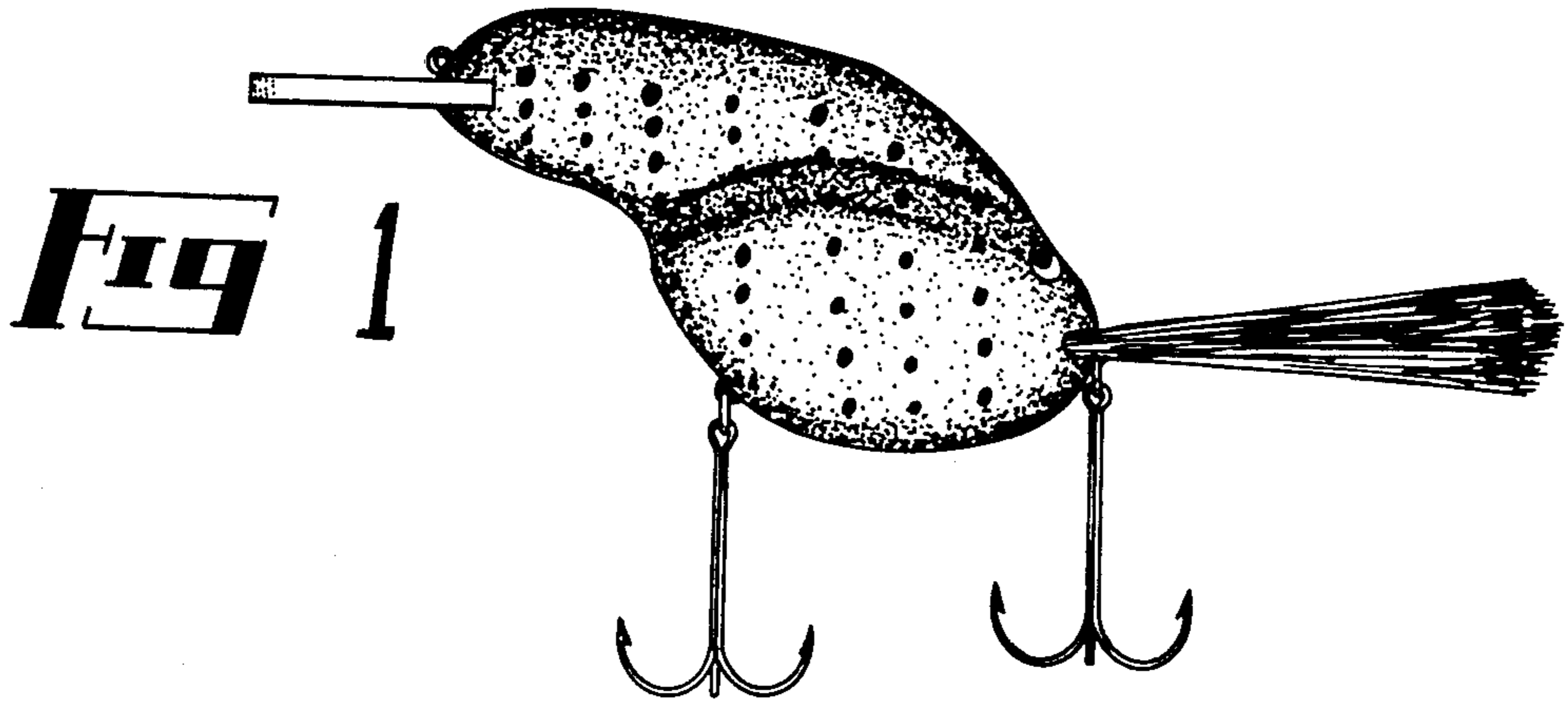
FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the fishing lure;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the fishing lure.





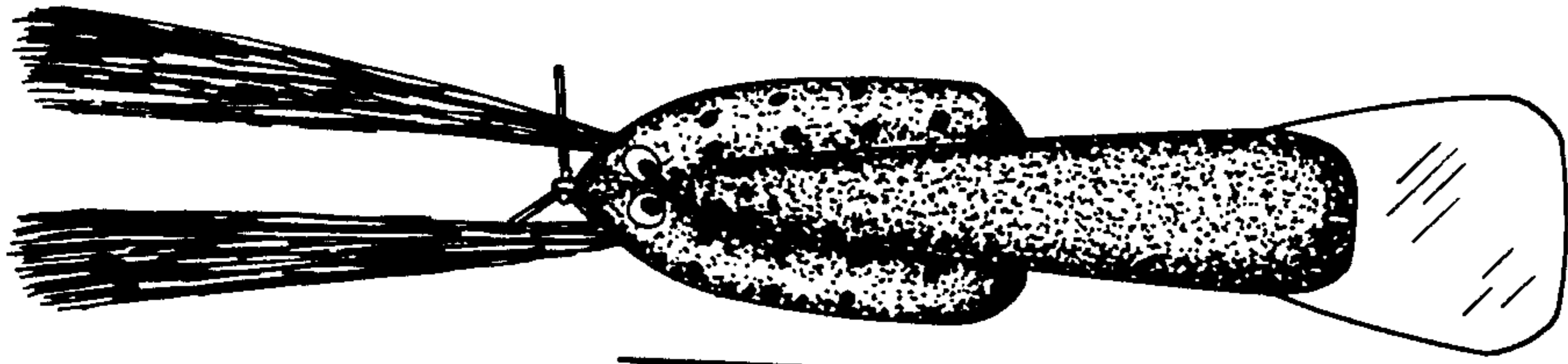

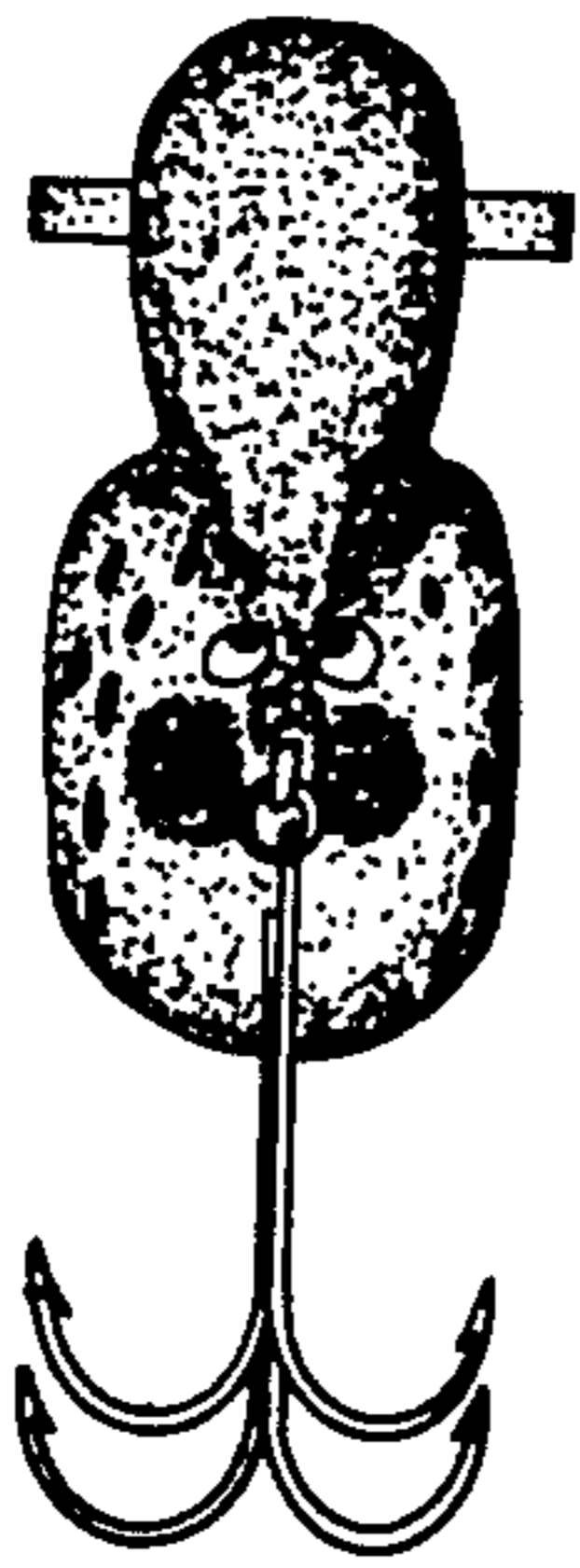

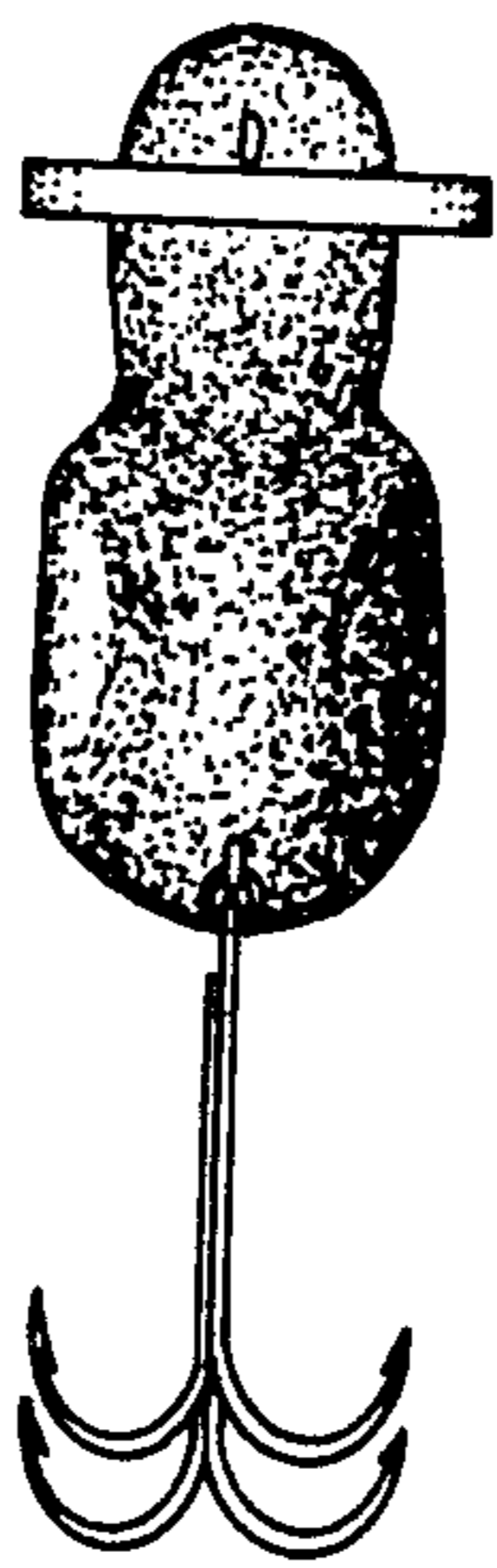
