The broken lines indicating the trailing hook and skirt are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed article.

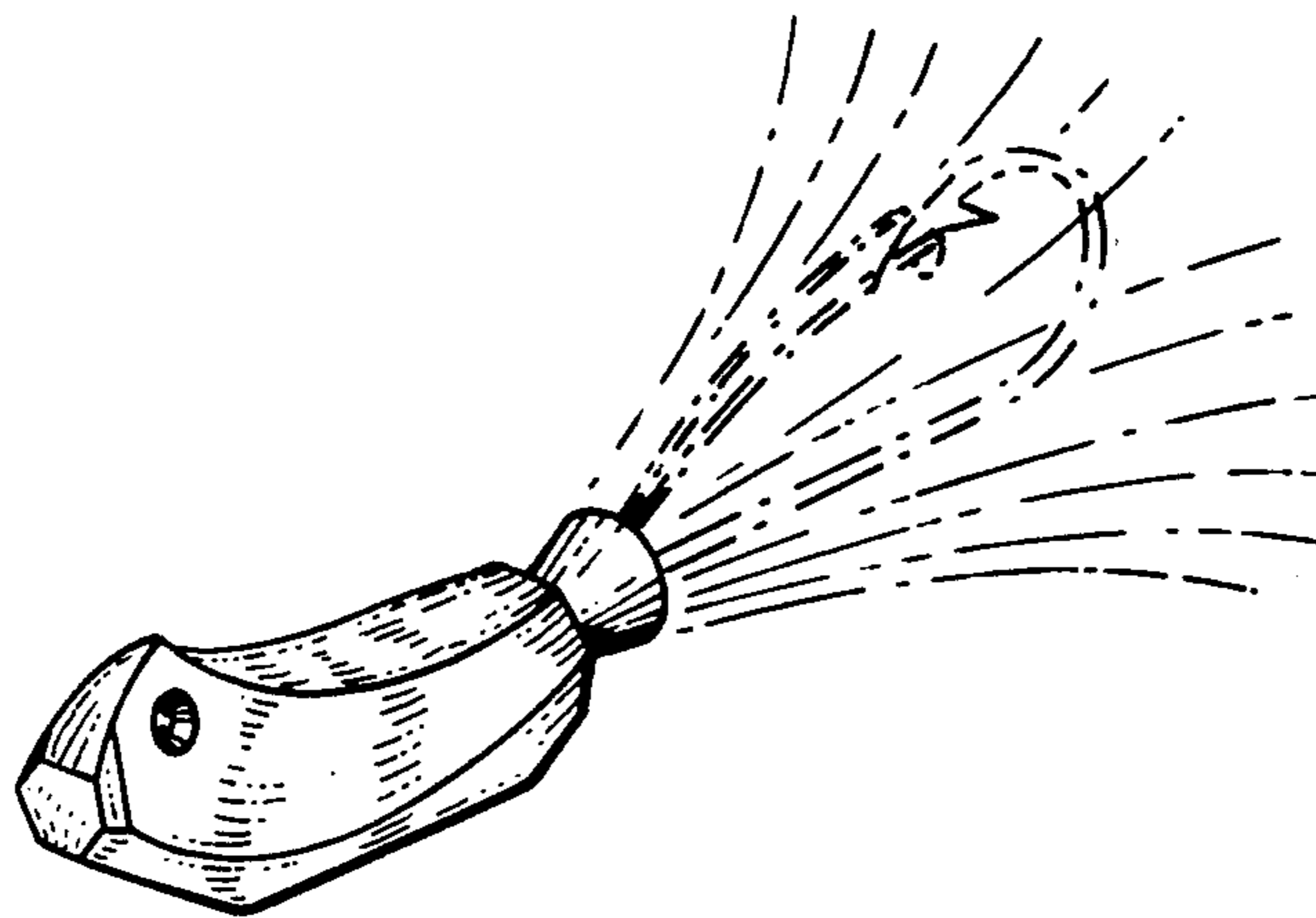

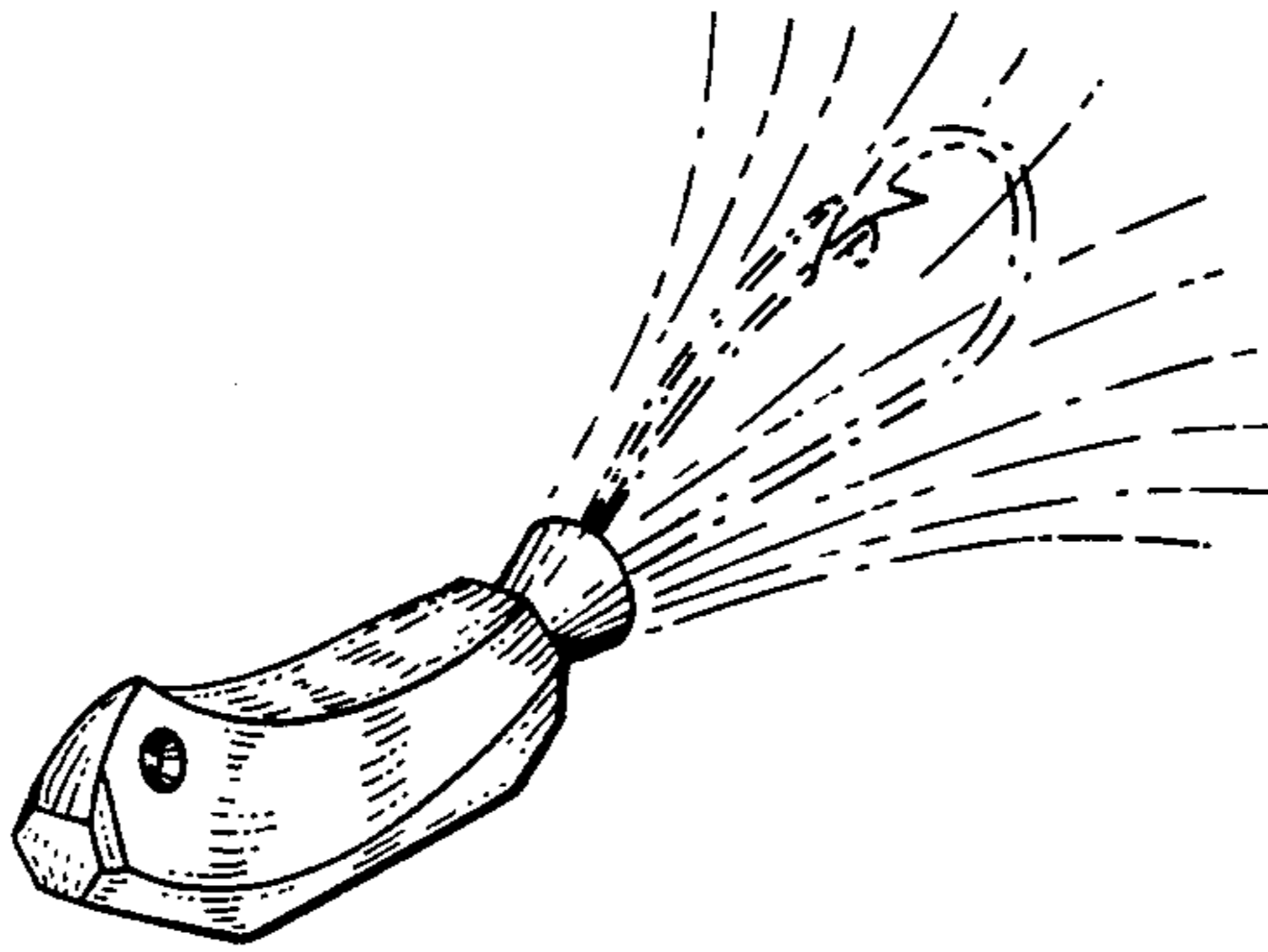

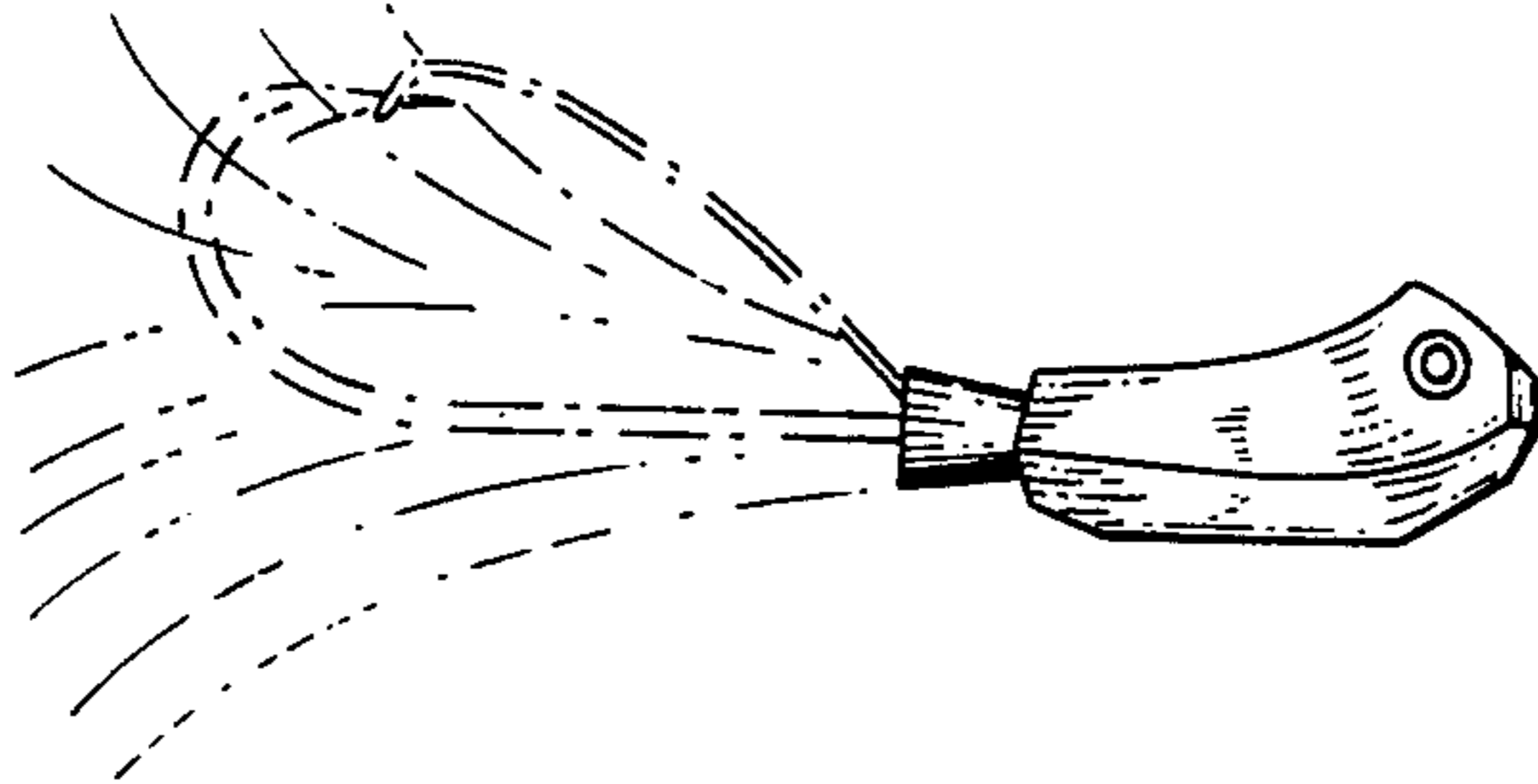

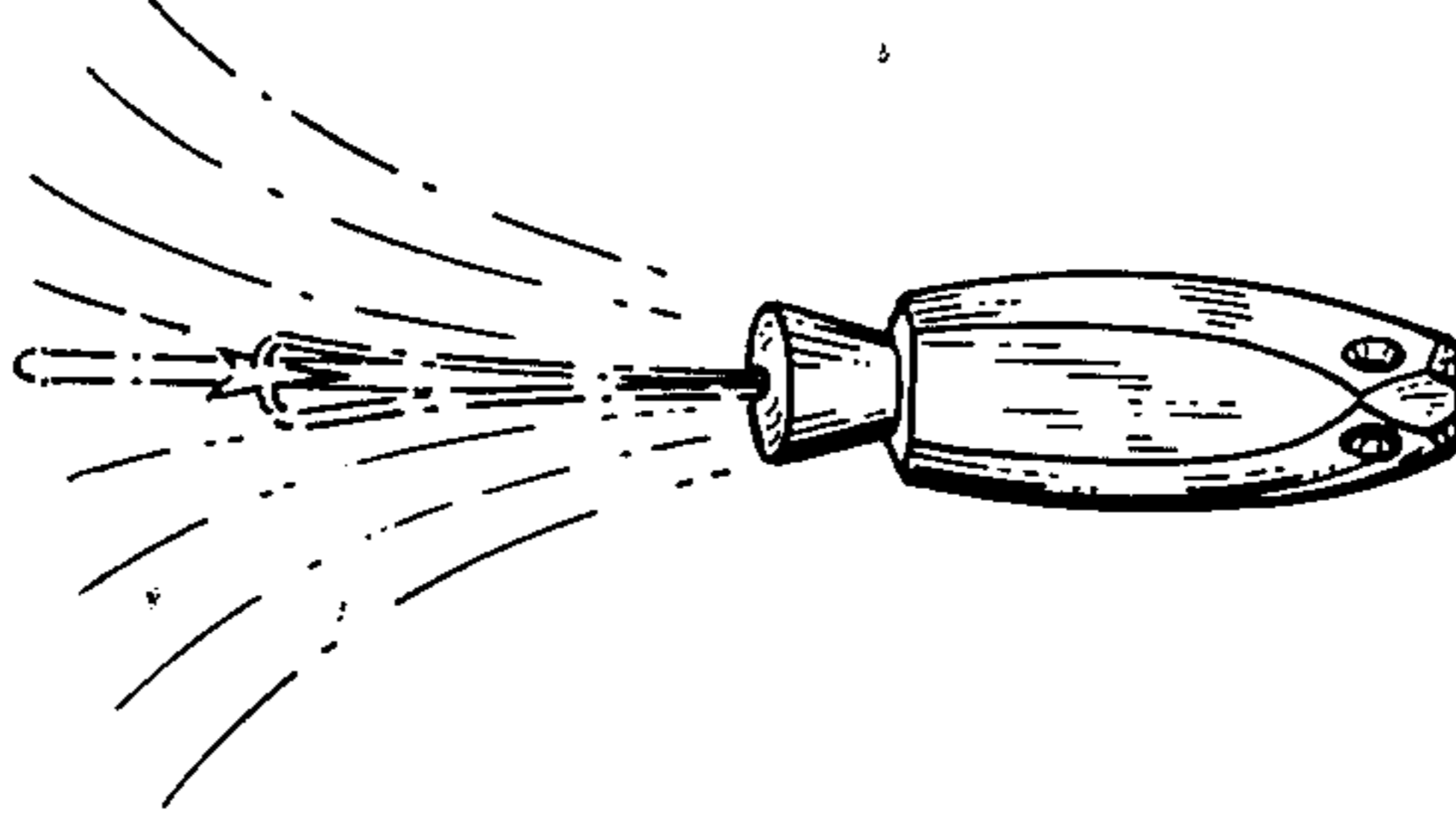

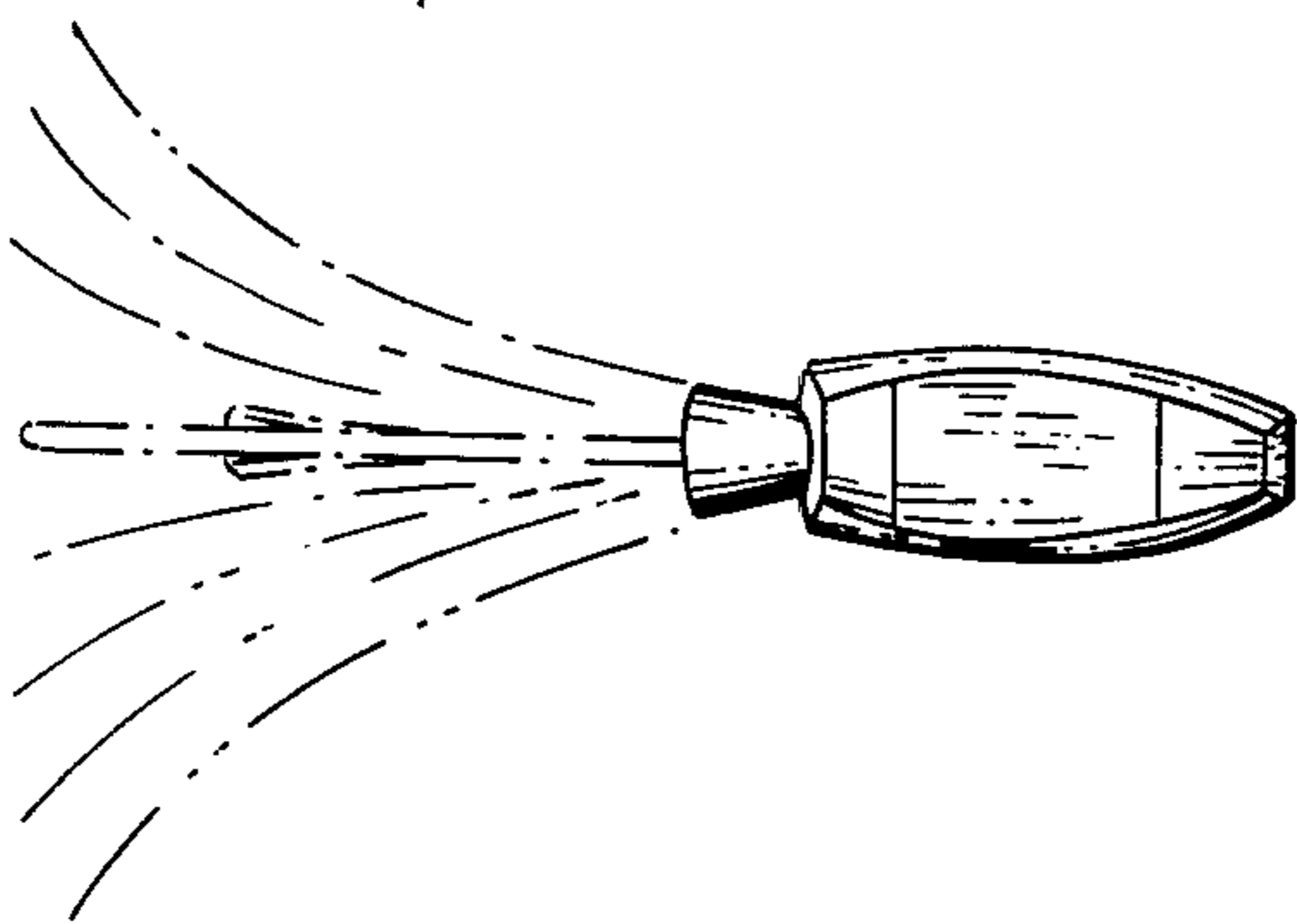
